

Socio-economic development of the Republic of Kazakhstan in January-October 2023

Date of release: November 16, 2023 Next date of release: December 15, 2023

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1. Social indicators

Population size and migration

The population of the country as of October 1, 2023 amounted to 19968 thousand people, including urban – 12388 thousand (62%), rural – 7580 thousand (38%) people.


In January-September 2023, compared to January-September 2022, the number of arrivals in Kazakhstan increased by 74%, the number of departures from Kazakhstan decreased by 37.4%.

The main migration exchange of the country takes place with the CIS countries. The share of arrivals from the CIS countries and departures to these countries amounted to 88% and 78.1%, respectively.

The number of migrants moving within the country increased by 26%. In terms of interregional movements, a positive net migration of population has developed in 3 regions of the country: the cities of Astana (35755 people), Almaty (28136 people) and Shymkent (1394 people).



Income of the population

The average per capita nominal cash income of the population, according to an estimate in September 2023, amounted to 179088 tenge (preliminary data), which is 15.9% higher than in September 2022, real cash income for the specified period increased by 3.7%.


Employment of the population

The number of employees at enterprises (organizations) in the III quarter of 2023³⁾ amounted to 3926.2 thousand people, of which at large and medium-sized enterprises –2872.6 thousand people.

In the III quarter of 2023, 305.0thousand people were hired by enterprises. 303.2 thousand people dropped out for various reasons. Worked by one employee 459.3 hours.

At the end of the III quarter of 2023, 55.9 thousand vacancies were not filled at enterprises (1.4% of the number of employees).

The number of unemployed, determined according to the methodology of the ILO, in the III quarter¹⁾ of 2023 amounted to 451.5 thousand people, the unemployment rate was 4.7%.

The employed population²⁾ amounted to 9106 thousand people, including employees -6916.1 thousand people, individual entrepreneurs -1595.2 thousand people, persons engaged in private practice -21.7 thousand people, individuals, who are founders (participants) of business partnerships and founders, shareholders (participants) of joint-stock companies, as well as members of production cooperatives -12.3 thousand people, independent workers -560.7 thousand people.

2. Economic indicators

Statistics of prices

The consumer price index in October 2023 compared to September 2023 was 100.7%. Prices for paid services and non-food products increased by 0.8%, food products - by 0.5%.

In the field of paid services, prices for rental housing increased by 2.3%, hotel services – by 2.2%, the organization of complex recreation – by 2.1%. Tariffs for water disposal increased by 3%, garbage collection – by 1.5%. A decrease in prices is observed for detergents and cleaning products by 0.6%.

An increase in prices in October this year was noted for coal by 2.3%, firewood – by 0.8%. Al-98 gasoline rose by 3.7%, Al-95/96 gasoline – by 1.5%. TV prices increased by 8.3%, laptop – by 6%, electric heater – by 4.7%.

Of food products, prices for tomatoes increased by 9.6%, eggs – by 5.5%, cucumbers – by 5.3%, flour – by 4.3%, confectionery – by 1.3%, bread – by 1.2%. An increase in prices was noted for tobacco products by 2.1%, alcoholic beverages – by 1.2%, mineral and drinking water – by 0.9%. Vegetables fell by 1.8%, sunflower oil – by 0.9%, cereals – by 0.8%.

In October 2023, compared with the previous month, the price index of producers of agricultural products amounted to 101.8%, crop production –101,4%, livestock products – 102.9%. Prices for wheat increased by 3.5%, rice paddy – by 3.4%, millet – by 1.4% and for sufflower seeds decreased by 4.1%, forage grain crops – by 2.7%, barley – by 2.4%, rape seeds – by 1.1%. Fresh grapes rose in price by 42.1%, tomatoes of the closed ground - by 11.8%, peppers - by 5.3%, pome fruits – by 2.9%, table beet – by 1.5%, potato – by 1.3%. Prices for poultry meat increased by 5.6%, horses – by 2.1%, sheeps – by 0.6%, and pigs decreased by 0.2%. Chicken eggs rose in price by 10.1%, cow's milk – by 0.8%.

Prices of manufacturing enterprises for industrial products in October 2023 increased by 4% compared to the previous month. Oil prices were higher by 11.2%, natural gas – by 1.4%, metal ores – by 1.2%, coal – by 0.3%. Of petroleum products, propane and butane liquefied rose by 2.6%, diesel fuel - by 2.1%, fuel oil – by 0.5%. An increase in prices was noted for lead by 6.3%, aluminum – by 2.7%, for ferroalloys – a decrease by 10.3%, rolled ferrous metals – by 1.3%, zinc – by 0.8%. From food products, rye flour rose by 8.2%, wheat flour – by 7.8%, cereals – by 3.2%, bread – by 3%, poultry meat – by 2.5%, pasta – by 1.9%, rice – by 1.4%, tea fell by 1.4%, vegetable oil – by 1.2%.

In the service sector, tariffs for the carriage of goods by all modes of transport in October 2023 compared to September 2023 increased by 0.4%, tariffs for communication services, postal and courier services have not changed.

In October 2023, compared to the previous month, the price index in construction amounted to 100.3%, for construction and installation work –100.3%, for machinery and equipment – 99.6%, for other work and costs – 100.1%.

Gross domestic product

In the structure of GDP for January-September 2023, preliminary data, the production of goods amounted to 37.1%, the production of services - 54.2%. The main share in the production of GDP is occupied by industry - 27.7%, wholesale and retail trade; repair of cars and motorcycles - 15.8%.

Investment statistics

In January-October 2023, the volume of investments in fixed capital amounted to 13333.3 billion tenge, which is 12.6% more than in January-October 2022.

The predominant sources of investment financing remain the own funds of economic entities, the volume of which in January-October 2023 amounted to 9994.9 billion tenge.

In January-October 2023, compared with January-October 2022, there is an increase costs for the purchase of machinery, equipment and vehicles and their capital repairs by 26.0%.

A significant share of investments in fixed capital in January-October 2023 accounted for mining and quarrying (28.8%), operations with real estate (18.5%), transport and warehousing (13.6%) and manufacturing industry (9.2%).

Statistics of domestic trade


The volume of retail trade in January-October 2023 amounted to 14827.1 billion tenge, which is 6.9% more than the corresponding period in 2022. Retail sales of goods by trading enterprises increased by 10,9%, individual entrepreneurs, including those trading in the markets, decreased by 0.5% compared to January-October 2022.

As of November 1, 2023, the volume of commodity stocks of trading enterprises (for reporting enterprises) in retail trade amounted to 1537.7 billion tenge, in trading days - 70 days.

The share of food products in the total volume of retail trade is 32.4%, non-food products – 67.6%. The volume of sales of food products compared to January-October 2022 decreased by 6.2%, non-food products increased by 14.7%.

The volume of wholesale trade in January-October 2023 amounted to 32184.6 billion tenge, or 11.9% more than the corresponding period in 2022. Non-food products and industrial and technical products (82.5%) prevail in the structure of wholesale trade.

Foreign trade turnover in January-September 2023 amounted to 102 billion US dollars (increased by 2.4% in nominal terms compared to January-September 2022), including exports -57.5 billion US dollars (10.2% less) and imports -44.5 billion US dollars (increased by 25%).

Exports with the EAEU countries amounted to 7818,8 million US dollars, or 11.8% more than in January-September 2022, imports -12836,4 million US dollars, decreased by 8.9% compared to the corresponding period last year.


The volume of industrial production in January-October 2023 amounted to 38119,7 billion tenge.

In the mining and quarrying industry – 18059,7 billion tenge, in the manufacturing industry 17666,3 billion tenge, in the supply of electricity, gas, steam, hot water and air conditioning – 2066,8 billion tenge, in water supply, collection, waste treatment and disposal, pollution elimination activities – 326,9 billion tenge.

Statistics of building and housing construction

In January-October 2023, the volume of construction work (services) amounted to 5281.2 billion tenge.

The largest amount of work in January-October 2023 was performed on the construction of facilities (2470.3 billion tenge), non-residential buildings (1969 billion tenge), and residential buildings (842 billion tenge).

The volume of construction and installation work in January-October 2023 compared to January-October 2022 increased by 9.5 and amounted to 4443.6 billion tenge. The volume of construction work on capital repairs increased by 42.1% compared to the corresponding period last year, while on current repairs it increased by 20.7%.


In January-October 2023, the construction of 31153 new buildings was completed, of which 29308 are residential and 1845 are non-residential.

The following social and cultural facilities were put into operation:

- secondary school 60;
- preschool organizations 32;
- hospital 1;
- outpatient organizations 19.

as a percentage of the corresponding month of the previous year




In January-October 2023, 2374.1 billion tenge was allocated for housing construction. In the total volume of investments in fixed capital, the share of disbursed funds in housing construction amounted to 17.8%.

The main source of financing for housing construction in January-October 2023 is the own funds of developers, the share of which is 88.5%.

as a percentage of the corresponding month of the previous year




In January-October 2023, the total area of housing put into operation increased by 13.8% and amounted to 13337.3 thousand square meters, of which in multi-apartment buildings - by 25.4% (7972.1 thousand square meters). At the same time, the total area of individual residential buildings put into operation decreased by 0.3% (5293 thousand square meters).

In the total volume of commissioned housing, the share of multi-apartment buildings was 59.8%, individual - 39.7%. The average actual cost of construction of 1 square meter of total housing area increased by 18.8%.





Cargo turnover

Cargo turnover for January-October 2023 decreased by 3.1% from the level of the corresponding period of the previous year. In January-October 2023, compared to January-October 2022, there is a increase in the turnover of railway transport (by 4.7%).





Passenger turnover in January-October 2023 increased by 11.5% compared to the corresponding period of the previous year. In January-October 2023, compared to January-October 2022, there is an increase in passenger traffic in road transport (by 3.7%) and air transport (by 33.7%).

Main performance indicators of transport in the Republic of Kazakhstan (January-October 2023)


Statistics of communications

IPV for communication services in January-October 2023 compared to January-October 2022 amounted to 108%, of which 117,2% for Internet services, 106,1% for other telecommunications services and 95.4% for mobile services. A significant share in the total volume of communication services is occupied by Internet services, mobile communications and other telecommunication services, the shares of which amounted to 46.2%, 21.2% and 20.3 respectively.

The structure of performance indicators for SMEs as of November 1, 2023

According to the Statistical Business Register, the largest number of operating individual entrepreneurs is concentrated in Almaty city (16.6%) of the total, Astana city (11.1%), Turkistan (8.4%), Shymkent city (7.3%), Almaty (6.7%) and Karagandy (5.1%) regions.

At the same time, a significant number of active peasant or farm enterprises were recorded in Turkistan (30%), Zhambyl (11%), Almaty (10.6%) and Zhetisu (7.5%) regions.
