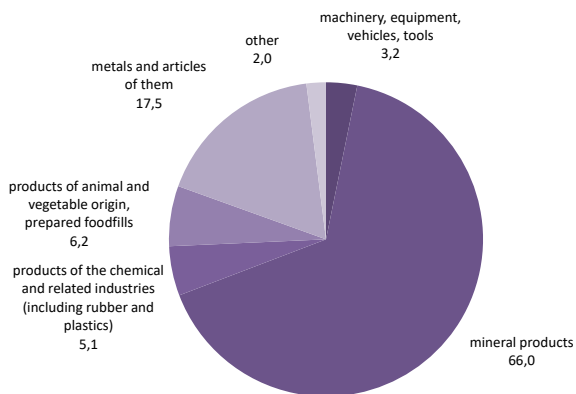

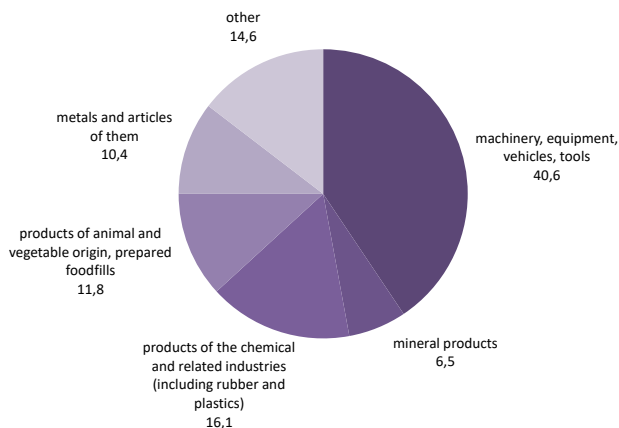
### Good structure of export in January-December 2021

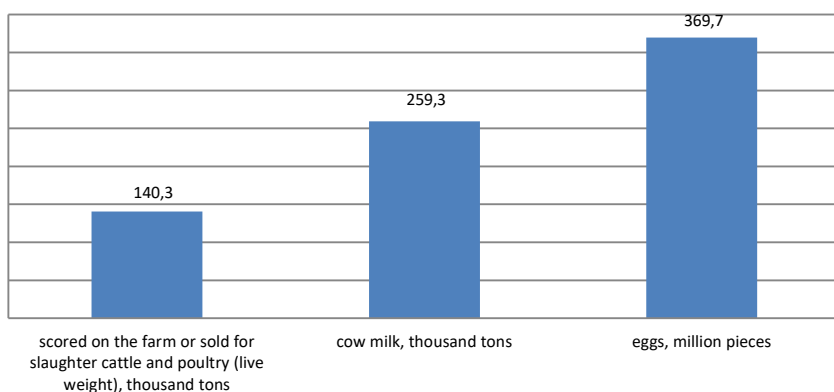

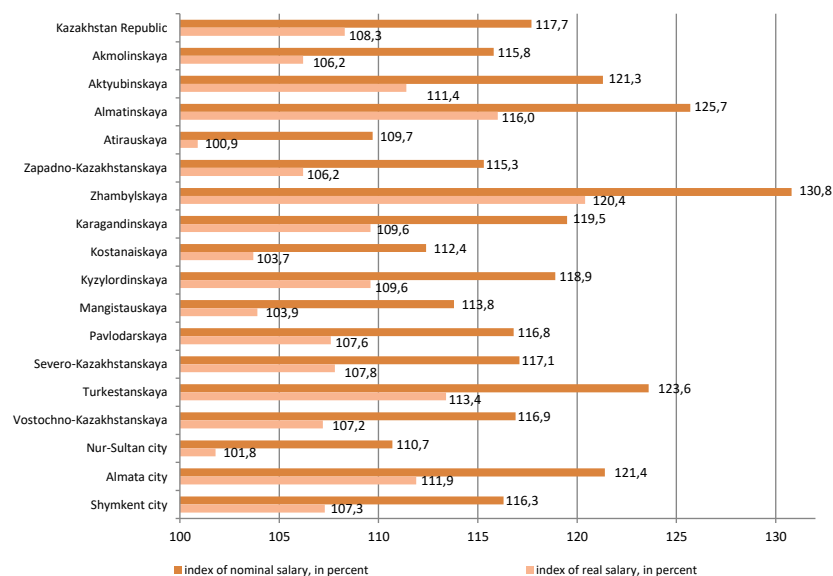
