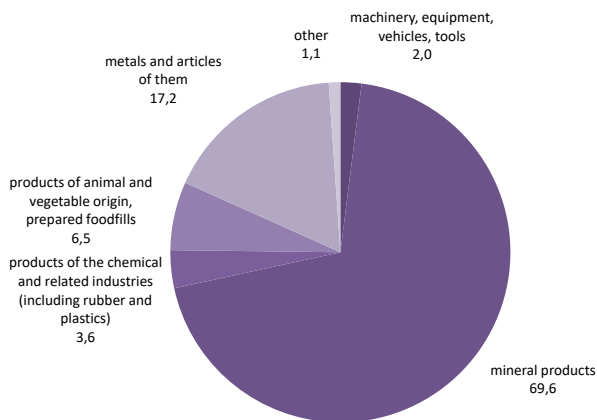

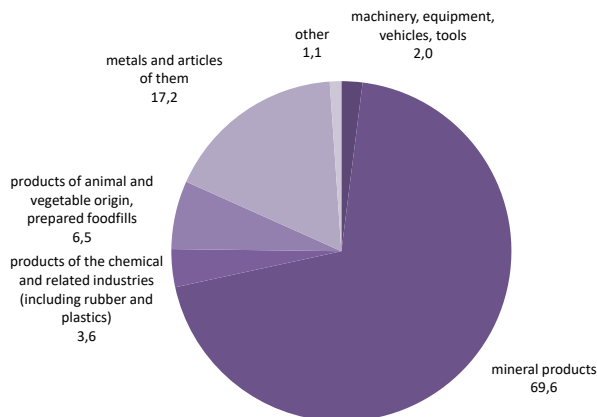
### Good structure of export in January-February 2022

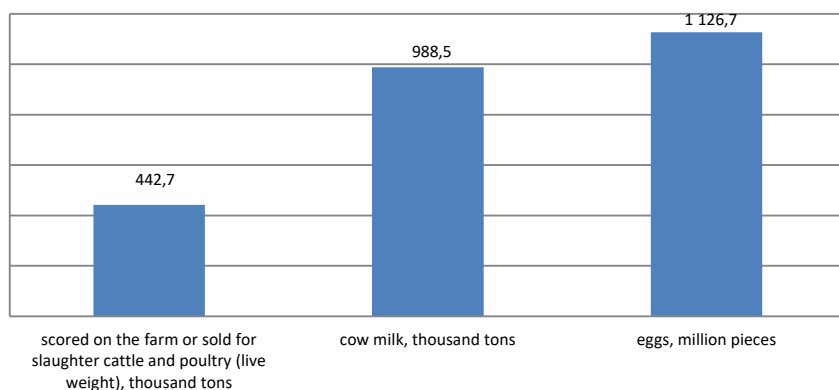

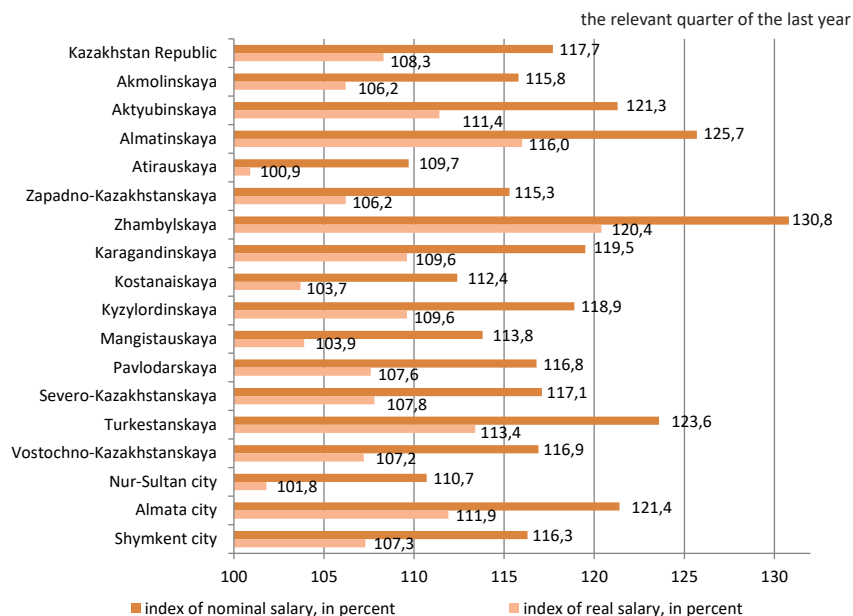
