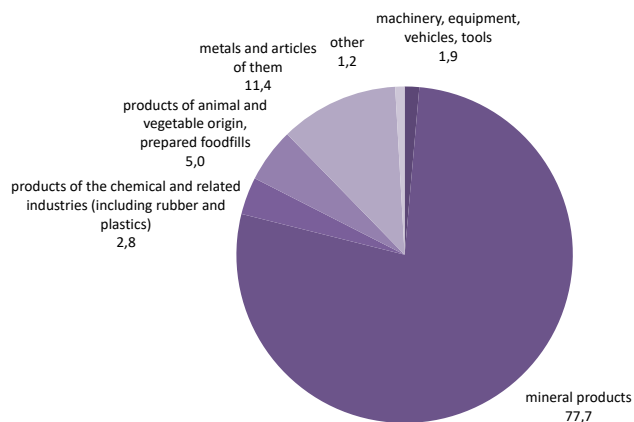

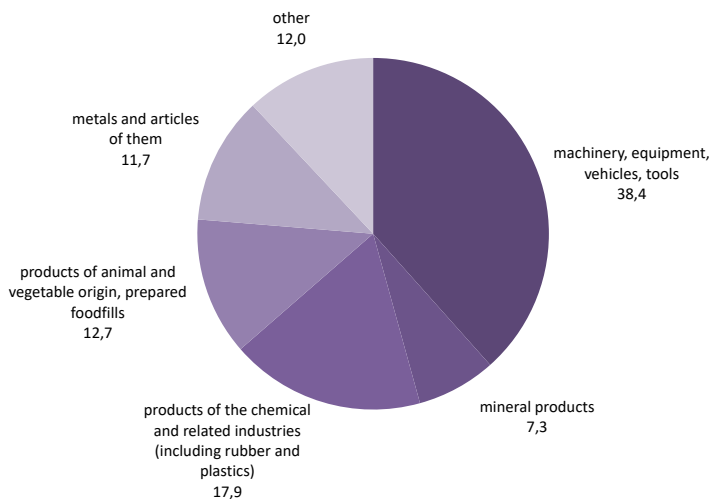
Good structure of export in January-April 2020

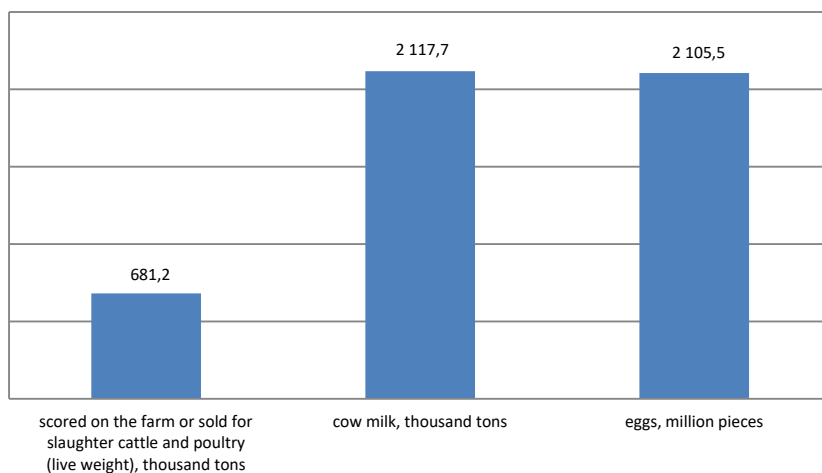

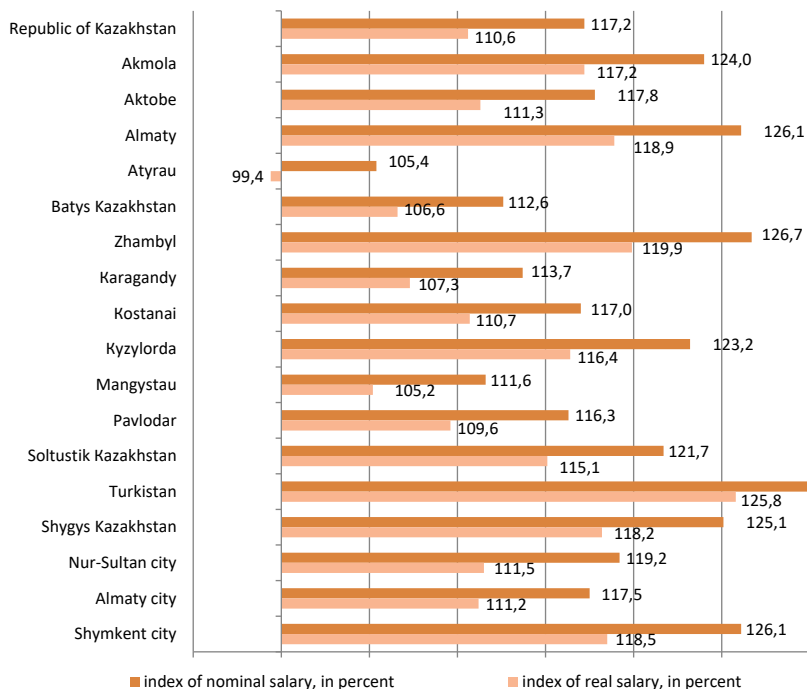
