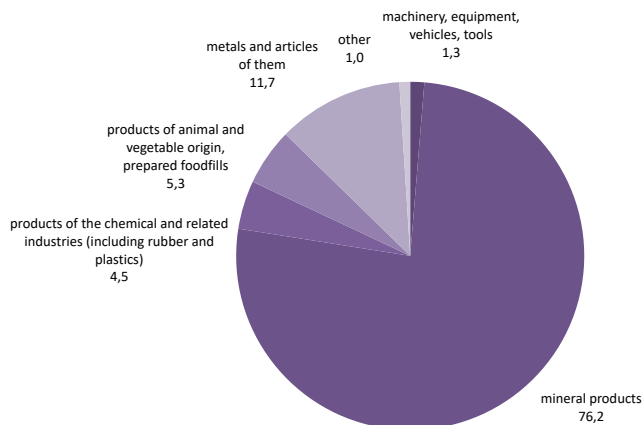

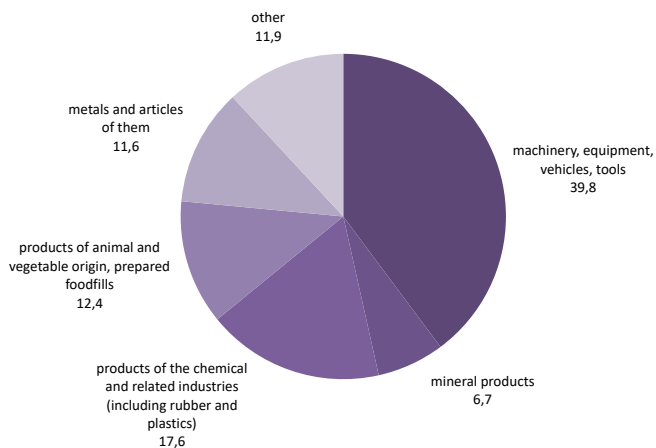
Good structure of export in January-May 2020

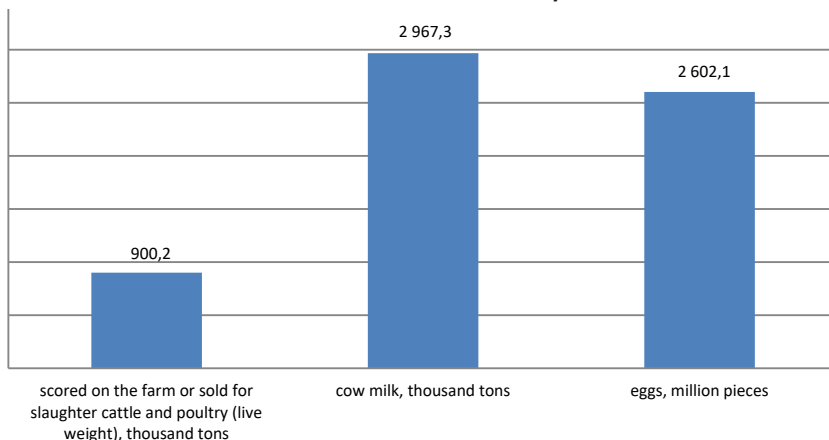

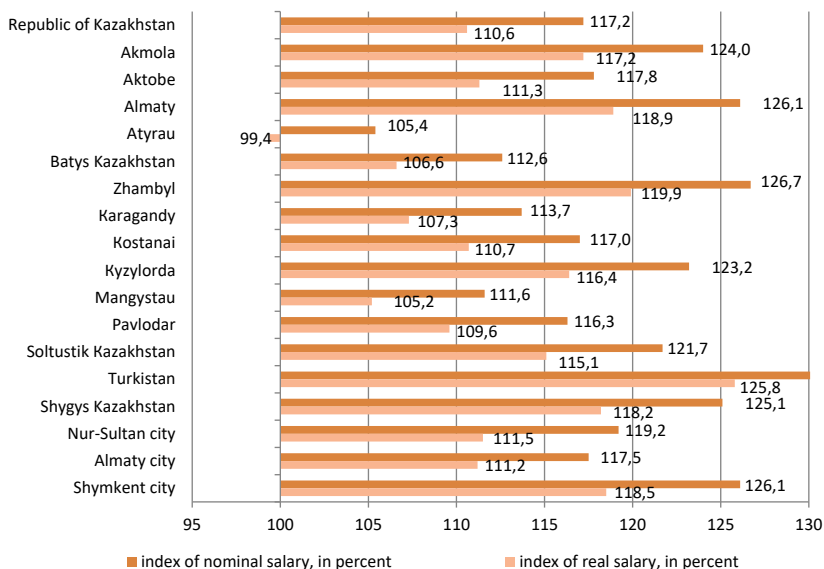
