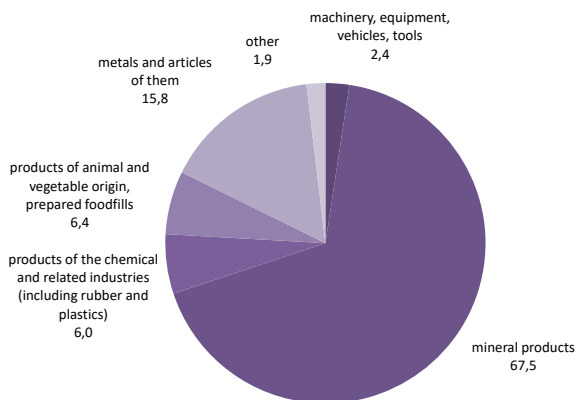

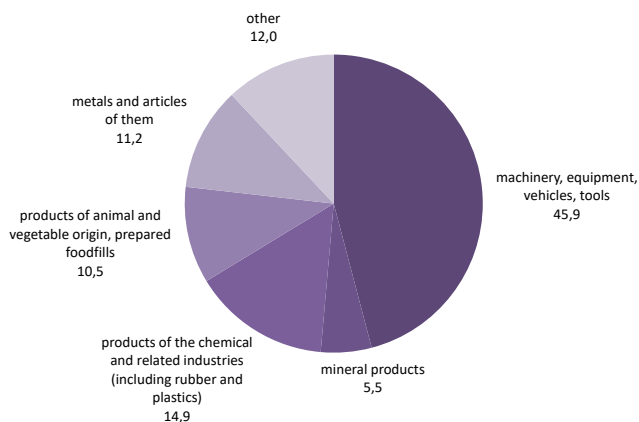
### Good structure of export in January-October 2020

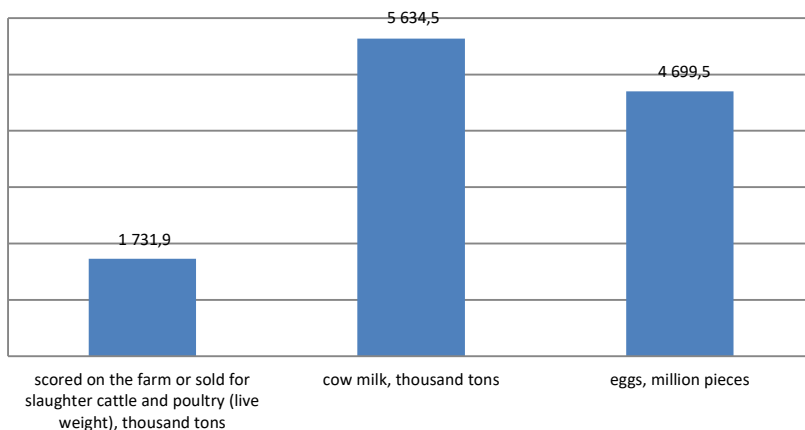

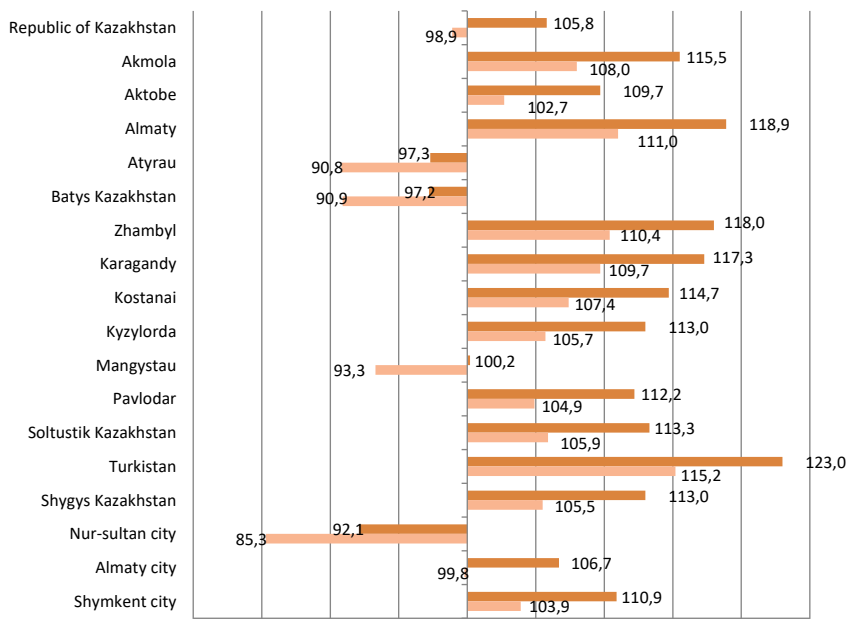
