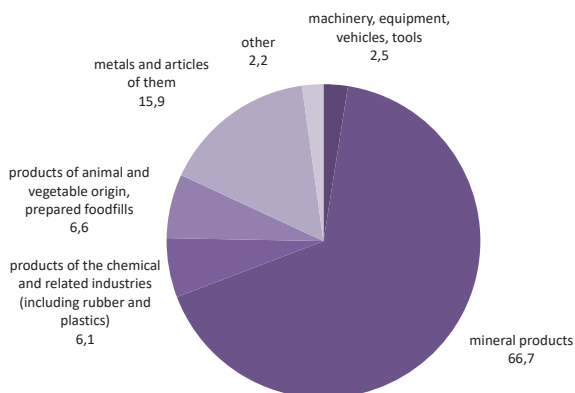

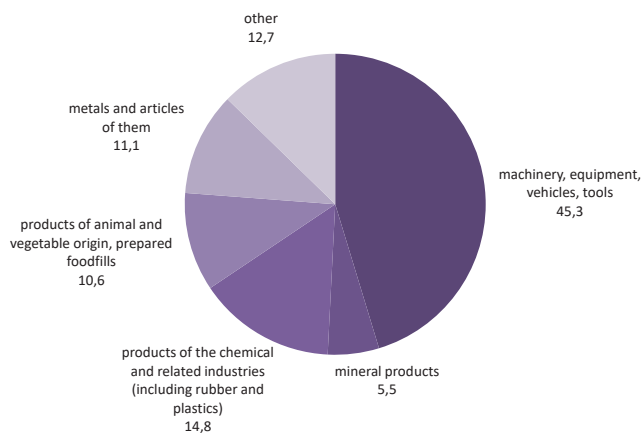
### Good structure of export in January-November 2020

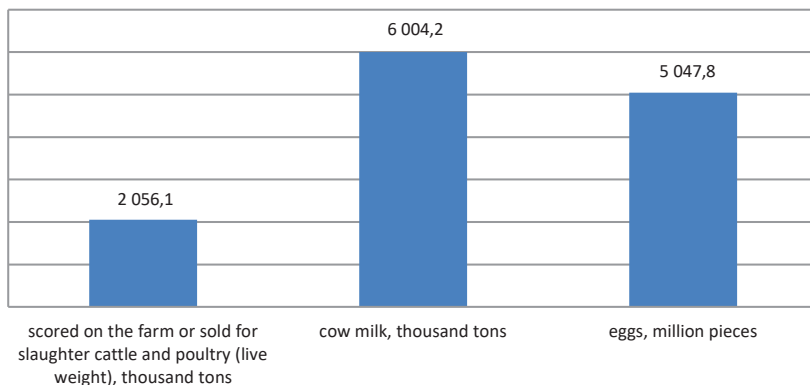

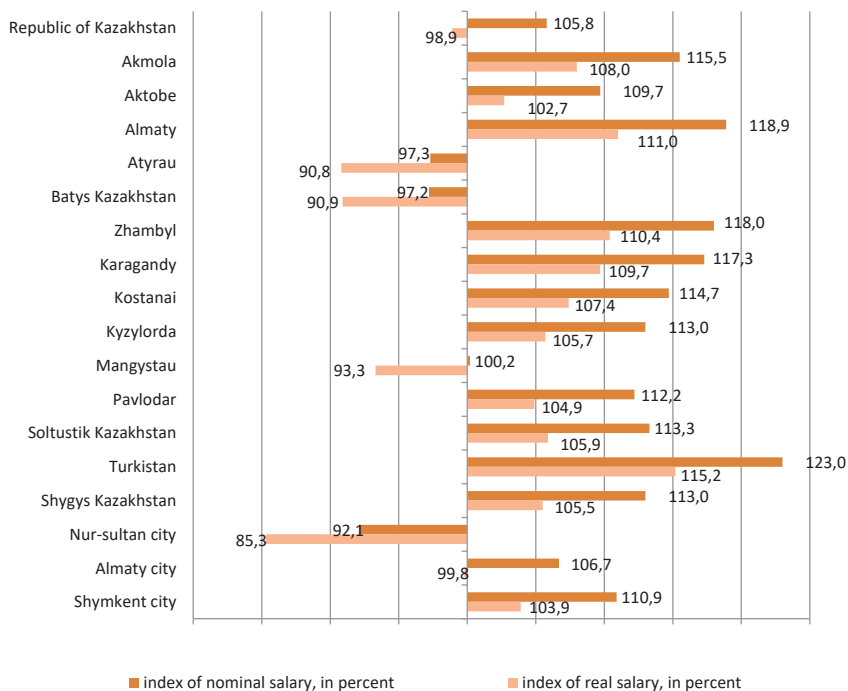
