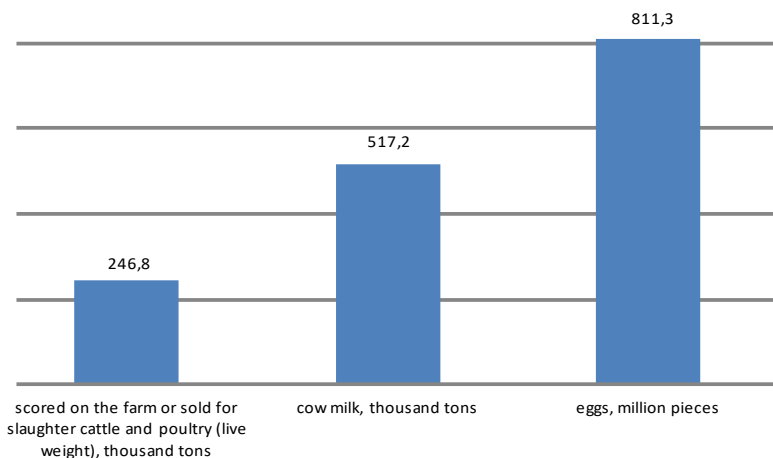

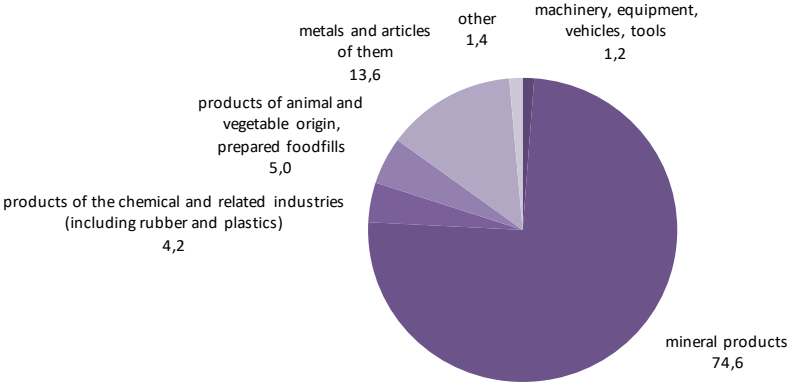

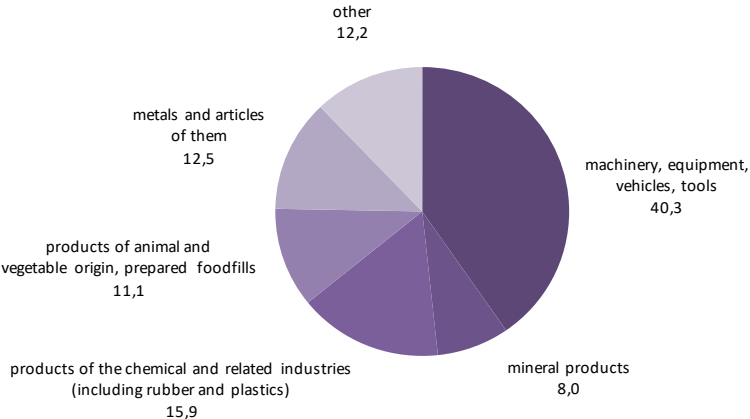
**Good structure of export in January-December 2018**

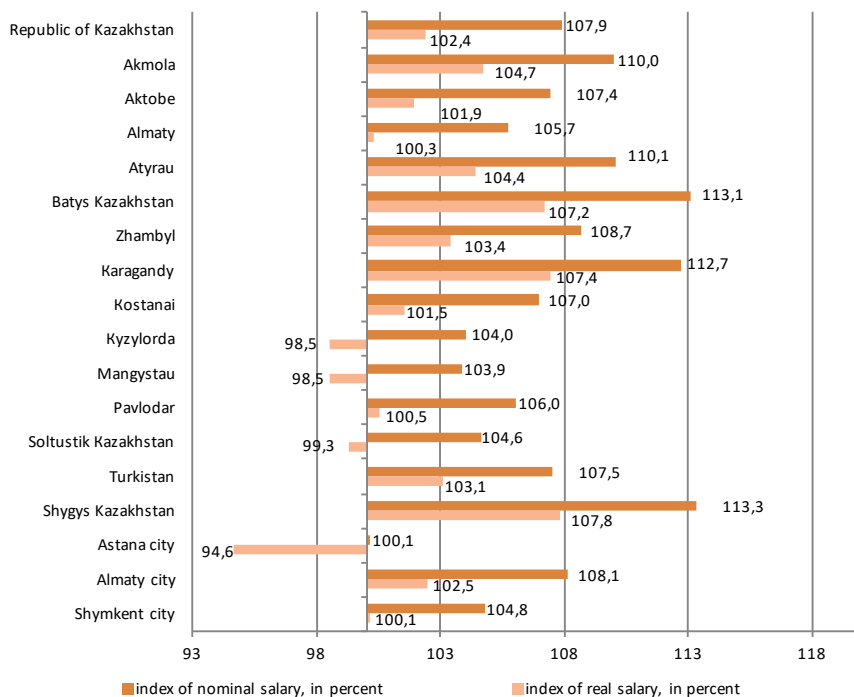
