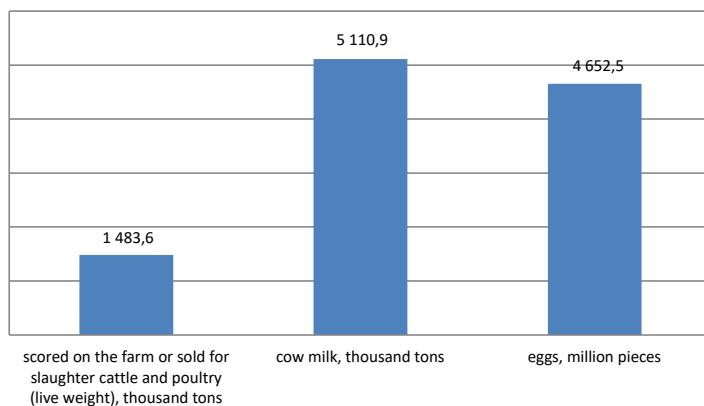

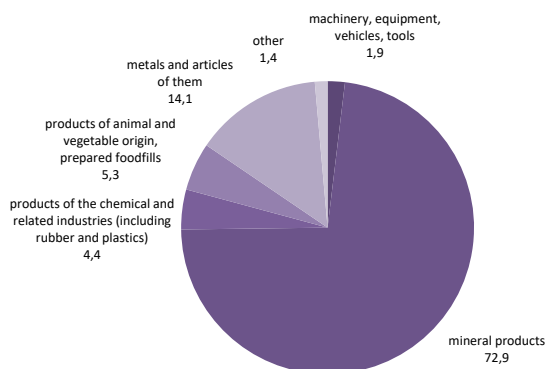

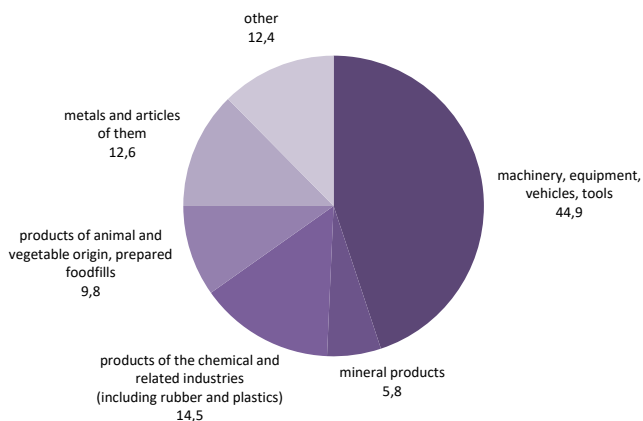
### Good structure of export in January-September 2019

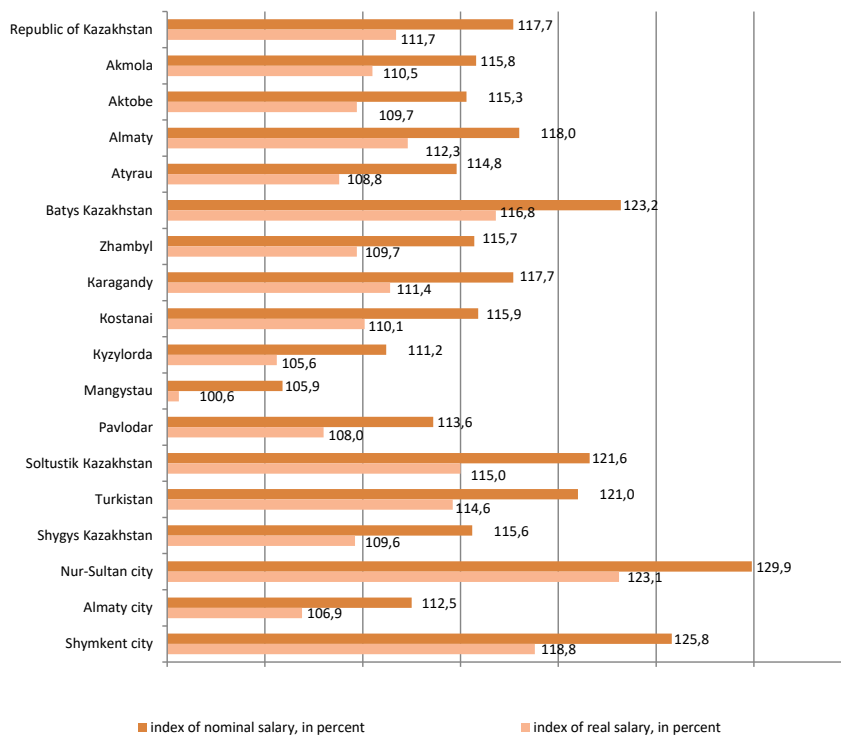
