# 1. Social indicators

## Population size and migration

The population of the country as of October 1, 2024 amounted to 20223.2 thousand people, including urban – 12705 thousand (62.8%), rural – 7518.2 thousand (37.2%) people.

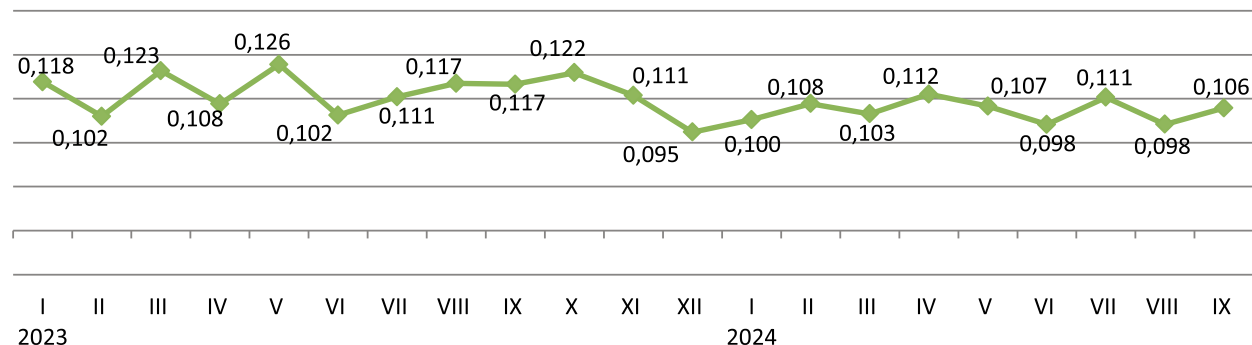
In January-September 2024, compared to January-September 2023, the number of arrivals in Kazakhstan increased by 6.5%, the number of departures from Kazakhstan decreased by 19.9%.

The main migration exchange of the country takes place with the CIS countries. The share of arrivals from the CIS countries and departures to these countries amounted to 79.7% and 76.9%, respectively.

The number of migrants moving within the country increased by 47.4%. In terms of interregional movements, a positive net migration of population has developed in 4 regions of the country: the cities of Astana (52853 people), Almaty (26157 people), Shymkent (5948 people) and Almaty region (765 people).

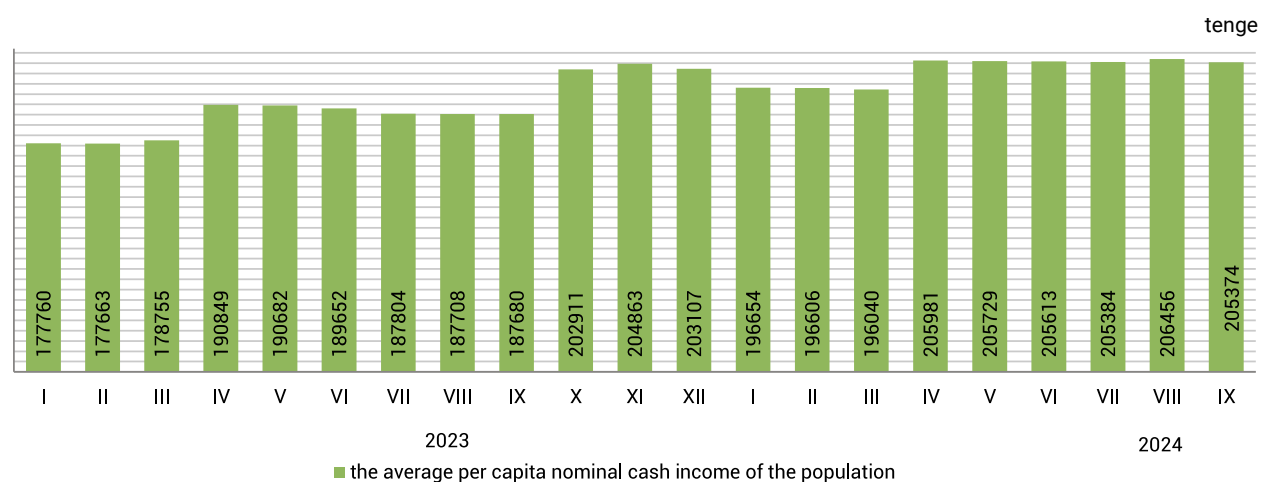

## Income of the population

The average per capita nominal cash income of the population, according to an estimate in September 2024, amounted to 205374 tenge (preliminary data), which is 9.4% higher than in September 2023, real cash income for the specified period increased by 1%.

## Employment of the population

The number of unemployed, determined according to the methodology of the ILO, in the III quarter<sup>1)</sup> of 2024 amounted to 448.6 thousand people, the unemployment rate was 4.6%.

The employed population<sup>2)</sup> amounted to 9233.8 thousand people, including employees – 7020.1 thousand people, individual entrepreneurs – 1680.9 thousand people, persons engaged in private practice – 25.1 thousand people, individuals, who are founders (participants) of business partnerships and founders, shareholders (participants) of joint-stock companies, as well as members of production cooperatives – 13.7 thousand people, independent workers – 494 thousand people.

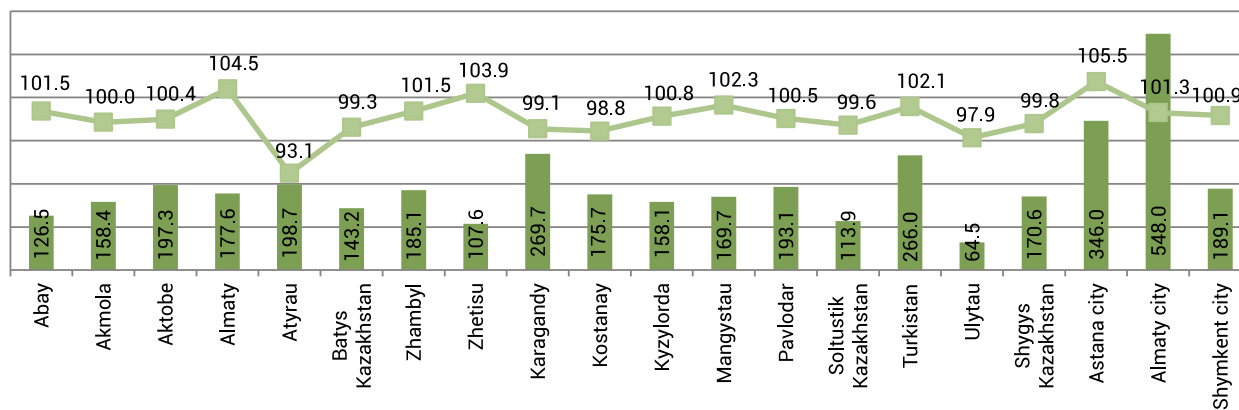

The number of employees at enterprises (organizations) in the III quarter of 2024<sup>3)</sup> amounted to 3958.9 thousand people, of which at large and medium-sized enterprises – 2863.7 thousand people.

In the III quarter of 2024, 307.3 thousand people were hired by enterprises. 306.3 thousand people dropped out for various reasons. Worked by one employee 465.4 hours.

At the end of the III quarter of 2024, 58.7 thousand vacancies were not filled at enterprises (1.5% of the number of employees).

In the III quarter of 2024, the average monthly nominal salary amounted to 390328 tenge (excluding employees of small enterprises engaged in entrepreneurial activities). In the III quarter of 2024, the median salary was estimated to be 269378 tenge.

From January 1, 2024, the minimum wage is set at 85000 tenge.

## 2. Economic indicators

### Statistics of prices

The consumer price index in October 2024 compared to September 2024 was 100.9%. Prices for paid services increased by 1.4%, non-food products – by 1%, food products – by 0.4%.

In the field of housing and communal services, tariffs for cold water increased by 25%, sanitation – by 5.3%, housing maintenance – by 1%, electricity, hot water – by 0.6%. Passenger rail transport services have risen in price by 13%, celluler communications – by 5%.

An increase in prices was noted for firewood by 4.7%, coal – by 1.1%. Household appliances rose in price 2.6%, clothing and shoes – by 0.9%, construction materials, personal goods – by 0.4%.

Of food products, prices for cucumbers increased by 9.7%, tomatoes – by 8.6%, lemons – by 7%, oranges – by 6.7%, salt – by 6.5%, eggs – by 3.2%, sunflower oil – by 2.4%. A decrease in prices was noted for carrots by 10%, grapes – by 5.7%, apples – by 3.4%, beets – by 3.2%. onions – by 2.8%, potatoes – by 2.1%.

In October 2024, compared with the previous month, the producer price index for agricultural products amounted to 99.7%, crop production – 98.9%, livestock products – 102.2%.

Prices for wheat, except durum wheat and buckwheat decreased by 2.5%, dried lentils – by 2.3%, durum wheat – by 0.7%, and rice increased in price by 2.6%, safflower and rape seeds – by 0.8%, sunflower seeds – by 0.7%.

There is a decrease in prices for carrot by 6.7%, cucumbers of the closed ground - by 4.2%, forage grain crops - by 2.7%, garlic - by 1.7%, and an increase in prices for fresh grapes - by 8.2%, corn for silage - by 2%, pome fruits – by 1.5%, bulb onions - by 1%.

Chicken eggs increased in price by 8.2%, domestic bird – by 2.5%, raw cow's milk – by 1.3%, cattle – by 1.1% and natural honey decreased in price by 1.3%, pigs – by 0.7%.

Prices of manufacturing enterprises for industrial products in October 2024 decreased by 0.6% compared to the previous month. Oil prices were lower by 3.6%, coal – by 0.3%, metal ores – higher by 0.7%. Of petroleum products, diesel fuel rose in price by 3.1%, propane and butane liquefied – by 1.5%, fuel oil fell in price by 3.5%.

An increase in prices was noted for precious metals by 5.9%, zinc – by 5.7%, aluminum – by 5.4%, copper – by 5.3%, lead – by 0.7%, for rolled ferrous metals – a decrease by 1.6%.

From food products, cereals fell in price by 2.7%, sugar – by 1.6%, rice – by 0.6%, dairy products rose in price by 1.6%, livestock meat – by 1.1%, bread – by 0.7%, poultry meat – by 0.6%, wheat flour – by 0.4%.

In the service sector, tariffs for the transportation of goods by all types transportation in October 2024 increased by 0.9% compared to the previous month, communication services and tariffs for postal and courier services remained unchanged.

In October 2024 compared to the previous month the price index in construction amounted to 100.3%. Prices for other work and costs increased by 10.2%, construction and installation work – 0.1%, machinery and equipment decreased by 0.1

## Short-term economic indicator

The short-term economic indicator for January-October 2024 compared to January-October 2023 amounted to 105.3%. The calculation of the short-term economic indicator is carried out to ensure efficiency and is based on changes in output indices for basic sectors: agriculture, industry, construction, trade, transport and communications, accounting for over 60% of GDP.

## Gross Domestic Product

In the structure of GDP for January-June 2024, to reported data, the production of goods amounted to 35,9%, the production of services – 57,1%. The main share in the production of GDP is occupied by industry – 28,3%, wholesale and retail trade; repair of cars and motorcycles – 16,0%.

According to the reporting data, in the sectoral structure of income formation for January-June 2024, compensation of employees in the production of goods and services amounted to 27,8% and 39,1%, respectively, the share of other taxes on production is 2,5 % in the production of goods and 2% in the production of services, respectively, the share of gross operating surplus /gross mixed income was 69,7 % and 58,9%.

The Gross domestic product calculated by the final expenditure method for January–June 2024 amounted to 50972953,8 million tenge. In comparison with the corresponding period of last year in real terms there is an increase in the component of final consumption expenditure: households – by 5,6%, non-profit organizations serving households – by 12% and a decrease in government administration – by (-5,2)%.

## Investment statistics

In January-October 2024, the volume of investments in fixed capital amounted to 13613.6 billion tenge, which is 1.9% more than in January-October 2023.

The predominant sources of investment financing remain the own funds of economic entities, the volume of which in January-October 2024 amounted to 8964.5 billion tenge.

In January-October 2024, compared with January-October 2023, there is an increase costs for works on construction and capital repair of buildings and constructions by 8.5%.

A significant share of investments in fixed capital in January-October 2024 accounted for mining and quarrying (20.9%), operations with real estate (19.5%), transport and warehousing (17.9%) and manufacturing industry (9.9%).

The volume of investments of large enterprises in January-October 2024 amounted to 4483.7 billion tenge.

## Statistics of domestic trade

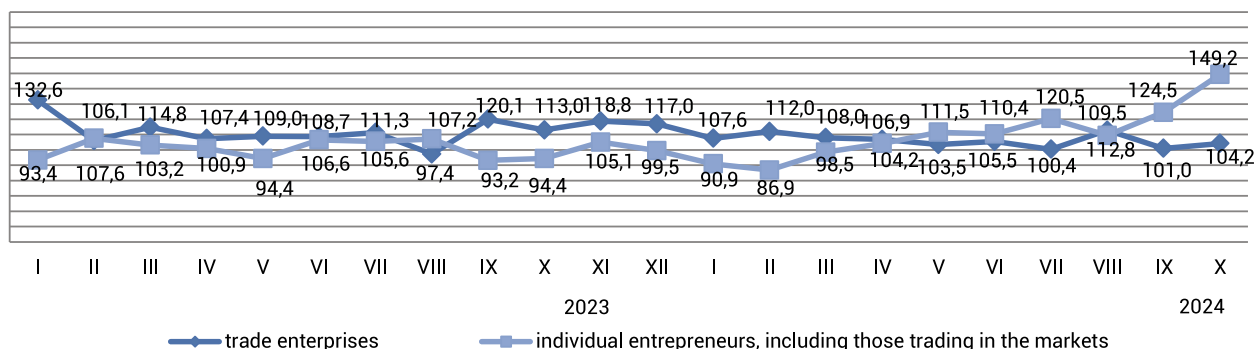
The volume of retail trade in January-October 2024 amounted to 17096.7 billion tenge, which is 8.7% more than the corresponding period in 2023. Retail sales of goods by trading enterprises increased by 5.9%, individual entrepreneurs, including those trading in the markets, decreased by 14.5% compared to January-October 2023.

As of November 1, 2024, the volume of commodity stocks of trading enterprises (for reporting enterprises) in retail trade amounted to 1605.1 billion tenge, in trading days - 63 days.

The share of food products in the total volume of retail trade is 32.6%, non-food products – 67.4%. The volume of sales of food products compared to January-October 2023 increased by 8.9%, non-food products increased by 8.5%.

The volume of wholesale trade in January-October 2024 amounted to 35687.4 billion tenge, which is 6.6% more than the corresponding period in 2023. Non-food products and industrial and technical products (81.4%) prevail in the structure of wholesale trade.

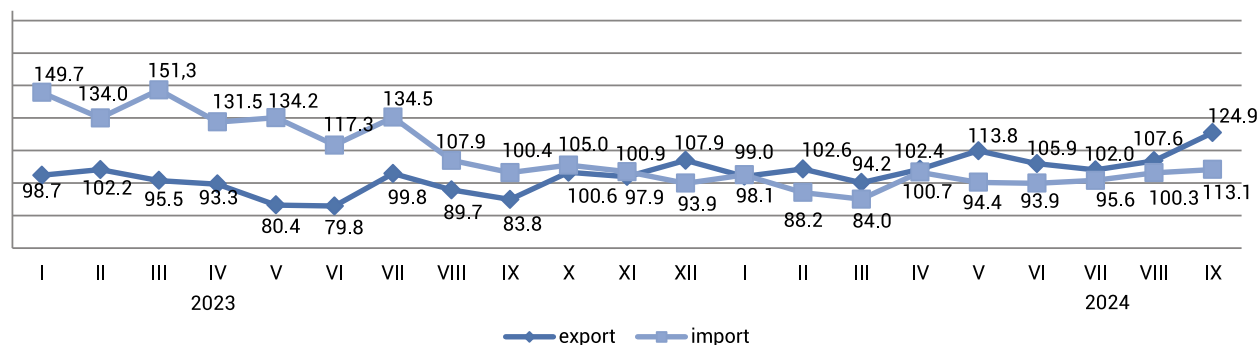

Foreign trade turnover in January-September 2024 amounted to 104.3 billion US dollars (increased by 1.1% in nominal terms compared to January-September 2023) including exports – 61.4 billion US dollars (5.6% more) and imports – 43 billion US dollars (less by 4.8%).

Exports with the EAEU countries amounted to 7793.2 million US dollars or 8.2% less than in January-September 2023 imports – 13616.3 million US dollars increased by 2.1% compared to the corresponding period last year.

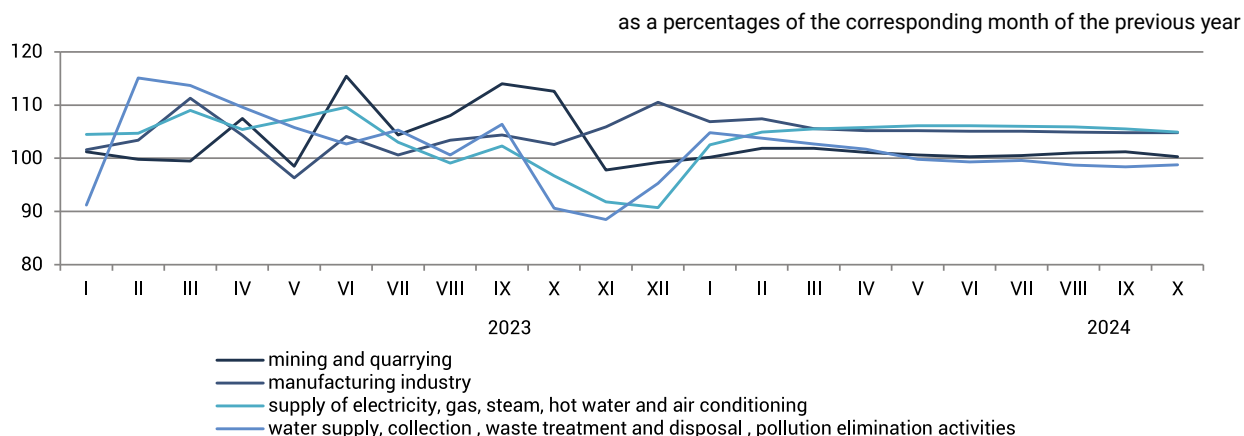

## Statistics of building and housing construction

In January-October 2024, the volume of construction work increased by 10.2% and amounted to 6110.2 billion tenge.

The largest amount of work in January-October 2024 was performed on the construction of facilities (3095.7 billion tenge), non-residential buildings (1971.4 billion tenge) and residential buildings (1043.1 billion tenge).

The volume of construction and installation work in January-October 2024 compared to January-October 2023 increased by 8.3% and amounted to 5076.6 billion tenge. The volume of construction work on major repairs increased by 22.2% and on current repairs by 17.9%.

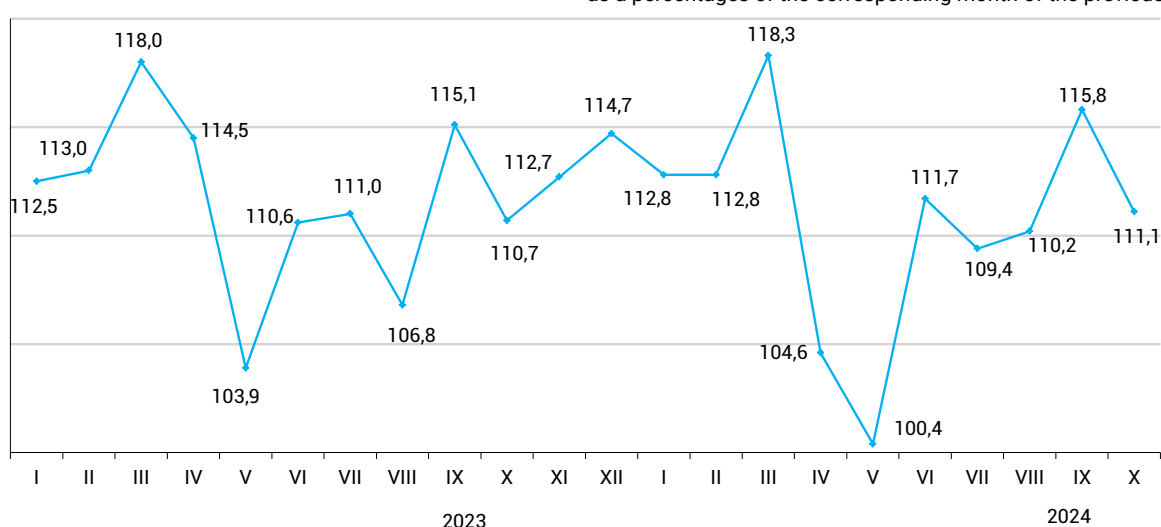
In January-October 2024, the construction of 32510 new buildings was completed, of which 30571 are residential and 1939 are non-residential.

as a percentages of the corresponding month of the previous year



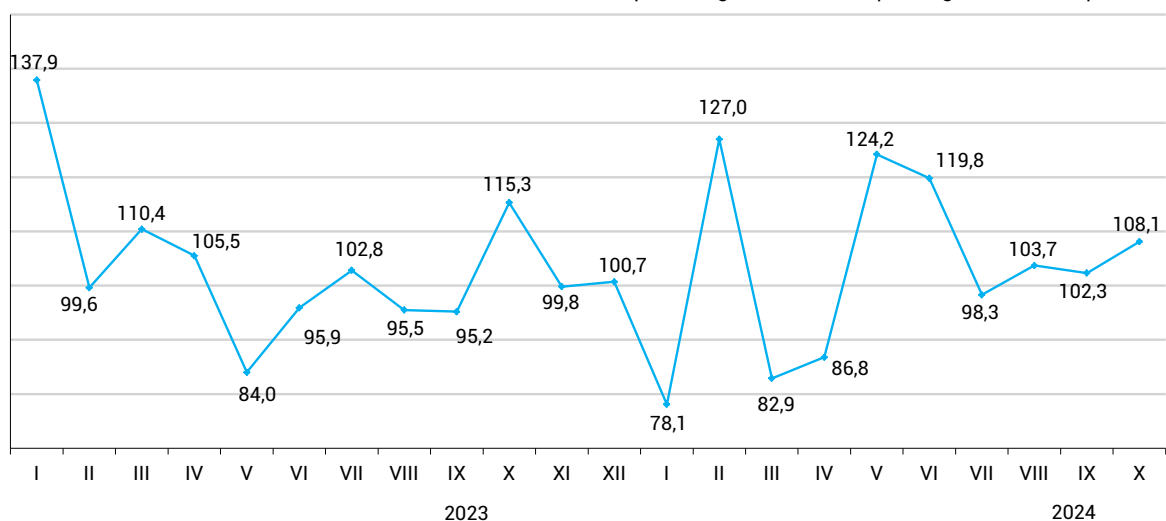

In January-October 2024, 2539.2 billion tenge was allocated for housing construction. In the total volume of investments in fixed capital, the share of disbursed funds in housing construction amounted to 18.6%.

The main source of financing for housing construction in January-October 2024 is the own funds of developers, the share of which is 87.5%.

as a percentages of the corresponding month of the previous year

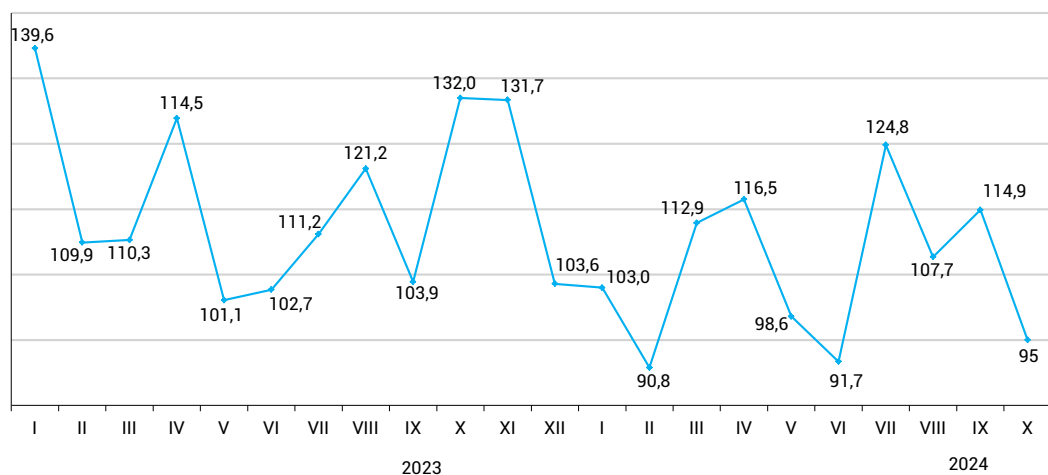


In January- October 2024, the total area of housing put into operation to January-October 2023 increased by 4.8% and amounted to 13984 thousand square meters, of which in multi-apartment buildings – by 7.2% (8542.8 thousand square meters), of individual residential buildings – by 0.4% (5316.8 thousand square meters).

In the total volume of commissioned housing, the share of multi-apartment buildings was 61.1%, individual – 38%. The average actual cost of construction of 1 square meter of total housing area increased by 3.9%.

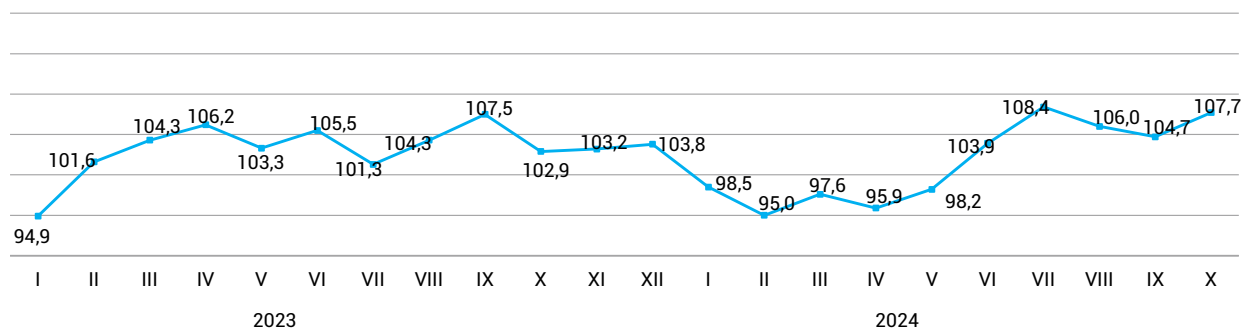

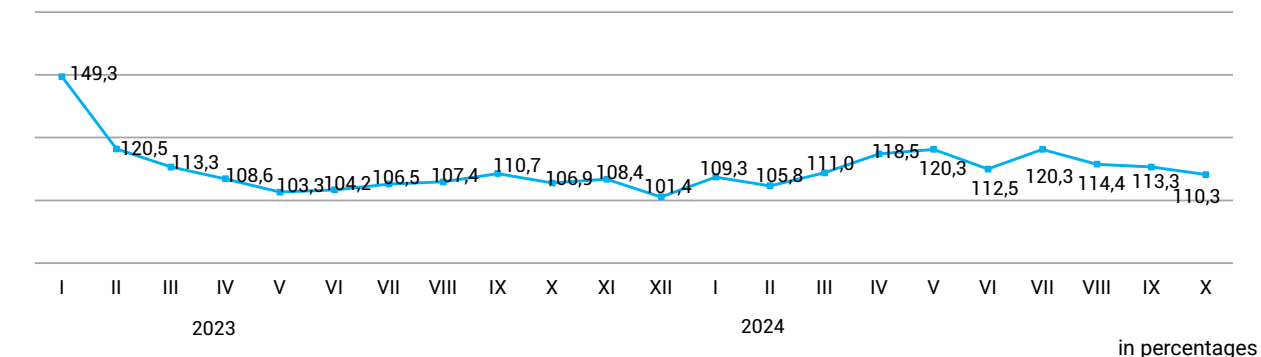

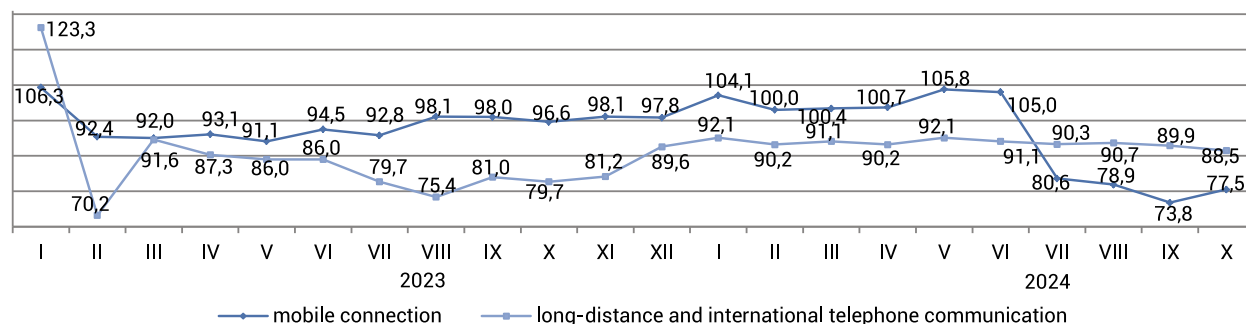

## Statistics of communications

Indices of the physical volume for communication services in January-October 2024 compared to January-October 2023 amounted to 105.7%, of which 116.8% for Internet services, 101.3% for other telecommunications services and 85.8% for mobile services. A significant share in the total volume of communication services is occupied by Internet services, other telecommunication services and mobile communications, the shares of which amounted to 52.4%, 18.7% and 17.2% respectively.

### The structure of performance indicators for SMEs as of November 1, 2024

As of October 1, 2024, the number of active subjects SMEs increased by 1.2% compared to the corresponding date of the previous year. In the total number of active subjects SMEs, the share of individual entrepreneurs was 69.6%, legal entities of small enterprises – 17.4%, peasant or farm enterprises – 12.8%, legal entities of medium enterprises – 0.2%.
