1 .Social indicators

Population size and migration

The population of the country as of July 1, 2024 amounted to 20159.7 thousand people, including urban – 12573.6 thousand (62.4%), rural – 7586.1 thousand (37.6%) people.

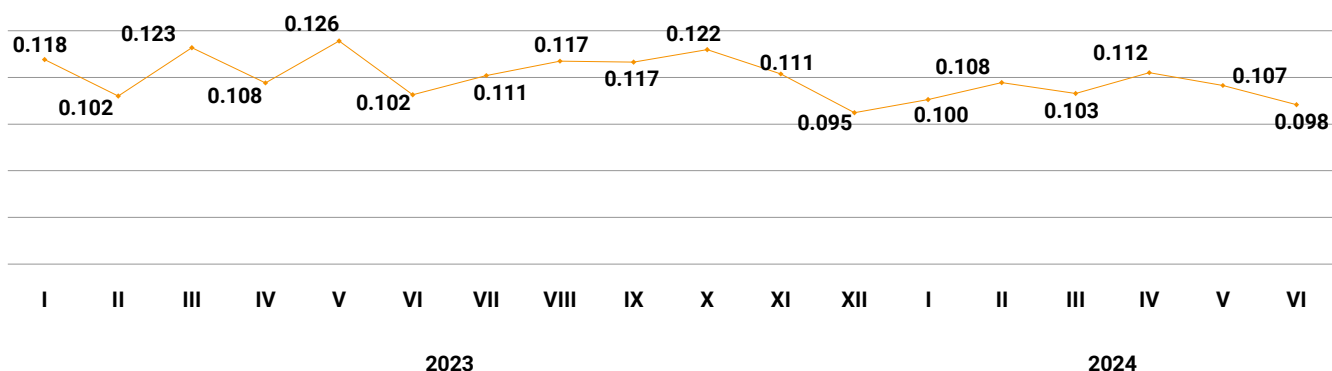
In January-June 2024, compared to January-June 2023, the number of arrivals in Kazakhstan increased by 4.4%, the number of departures from Kazakhstan decreased by 0.4%.

The main migration exchange of the country takes place with the CIS countries. The share of arrivals from the CIS countries and departures to these countries amounted to 78.2% and 77%, respectively.

The number of migrants moving within the country increased by 73.5%. In terms of interregional movements, a positive net migration of population has developed in 4 regions of the country: the cities of Astana (29305 people), Almaty (15750 people), Shymkent (4562 people) and in Almaty region (1258 people).

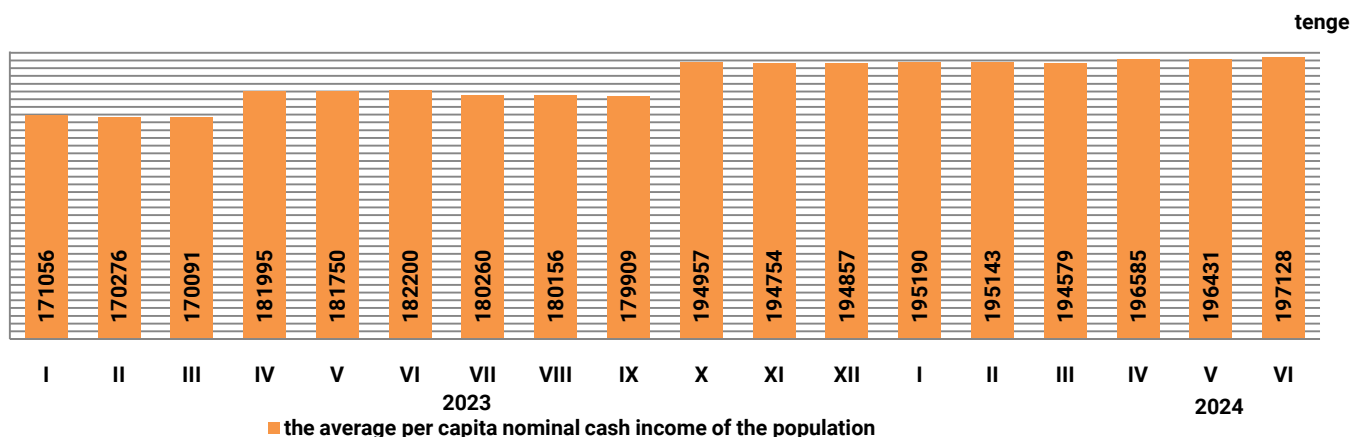

Income of the population

The average per capita nominal cash income of the population, according to an estimate in June 2024, amounted to 197128 tenge (preliminary data), which is 8.2% higher than in June 2023 real cash income for the specified period decreased by 0.2%.

Employment of the population

The number of unemployed, determined according to the methodology of the ILO, in the II quarter¹⁾ of 2024 amounted to 451 thousand people, the unemployment rate was 4.7%.

The employed population²⁾ amounted to 9190.4 thousand people, including employees – 6971 thousand people, individual entrepreneurs – 1717 thousand people, persons engaged in private practice – 32.5 thousand people, individuals, who are founders (participants) of business partnerships and founders, shareholders (participants) of joint-stock companies, as well as members of production cooperatives – 14.9 thousand people, independent workers – 455 thousand people

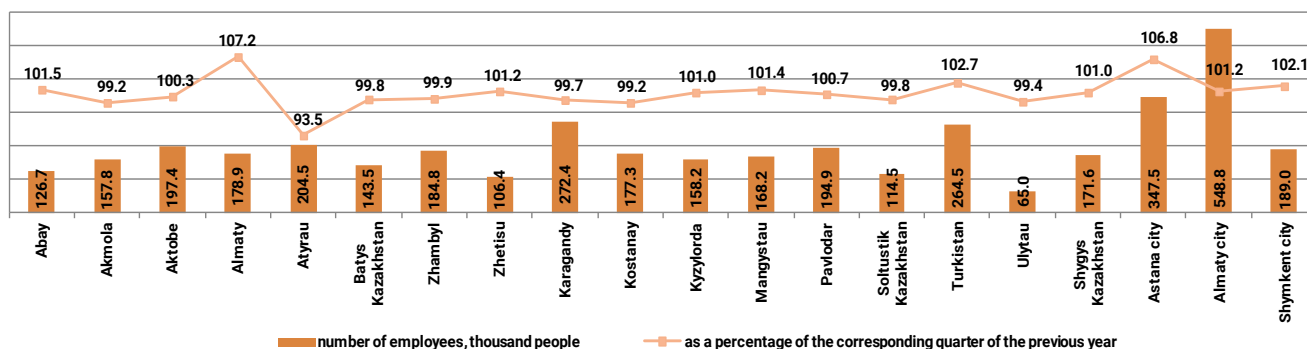

The number of employees at enterprises (organizations) in the II quarter of 2024³⁾ amounted to 3971.9 thousand people, of which at large and medium-sized enterprises – 2876.2 thousand people.

In the II quarter of 2024, 262.5 thousand people were hired by enterprises. 274.7 thousand people dropped out for various reasons. Worked by one employee 463.5 hours.

At the end of the II quarter of 2024, 55.8 thousand vacancies were not filled at enterprises (1.4% of the number of employees).

In the II quarter of 2024, the average monthly nominal salary amounted to 403251 tenge (excluding employees of small enterprises engaged in entrepreneurial activities). In the II quarter of 2024, the median salary was estimated to be 278296 tenge.

From January 1, 2024, the minimum wage is set at 85000 tenge.

2. Economic indicators

Statistics of prices

The consumer price index in July 2024 compared to June 2024 was 100.7%. Prices for paid services increased by 1.6%, non-food products – by 0.7%, food products – by 0.2%.

Increase in prices was noted for cellular communication services by 11.5%, Internet communication – by 6.8%. Air transport services rose in price by 12.9%, organization of complex recreation – by 11.5%.

The increase in prices for liquefied gas in cylinders in July this year amounted to 5.3%. The price of dishes rose by 1%, clothes and shoes – by 0.8%. Prices for medicines increased by 0.6%.

As for foodstuffs, prices for cabbage increased by 16.8%, potatoes – by 7.5%, bulb onions – by 7.3%. Increase in prices is observed for tobacco products by 3.8%, mineral water – by 1.6%. The prices of tomatoes decreased by 18.2%, sweet pepper – by 11.2%, beet – by 6.3%, cucumbers – by 5.8%.

In July 2024, compared with the previous month, the producer price index for agricultural products amounted to 99.8%, crop production – 100%, livestock products – 99.3%.

Prices for dried lentils decreased by 2%, buckwheat – by 0.6%, forage grain crops - by 0.5% and for dried peas – increased by 2.9%, rice paddy – by 1.5%. Tomatoes of the closed ground fell in price by 8.5%, table carrot – by 0.8%, potato – 0.4%.

Poultry meat fell in price by 2.6%, chicken eggs – by 1.6% and raw mare's milk rose in price by 3.7%.

Prices of manufacturing enterprises for industrial products in July 2024 increased by 2.3% compared to the previous month. Prices for metal ores increased by 3.9%, oil – by 3.7%, coal – by 1.9%, natural gas – by 1.1%. Of petroleum products, propane and butane liquefied rose by 8.3%.

An increase in prices was noted for precious metals by 3.7%, aluminum – by 3.6%, lead – by 2.2%, rolled ferrous metals – by 1.2%, zinc – by 0.8%, for ferroalloys – a decrease by 2.7%, copper – by 2%.

From food products, vegetable oil rose by 3.7%, fish – by 1.9%, wheat flour and sugar – by 1.4%, bread – by 1%, cereals – by 0.9%, pasta – by 0.6%, poultry meat – fell by 0.9%.

In the service sector, tariffs for the transportation of goods by all calendar transportation in July 2024 increased by 0.6% compared to the previous month, communication services and tariffs for postal and courier services remained unchanged.

In July 2024 compared to the previous month the prices index in construction and for construction and installation work amounted to 100.1%, for machinery and equipment – 99.7%. for other work and costs – 100.4%.

The short-term economic indicator for January–July 2024 compared to January–July 2023 amounted to 104,1%. The calculation of the short-term economic indicator is carried out to ensure efficiency and is based on changes in output indices for basic sectors: agriculture, industry, construction, trade, transport and communications, accounting for over 60% of GDP.

Gross Domestic Product

In the structure of GDP for January-December 2023, to reported data, the production of goods amounted to 36,2%, the production of services – 56,4%. The main share in the production of GDP is occupied by industry – 26,7%, wholesale and retail trade; repair of cars and motorcycles – 18,2%.

According to the reporting data, in the sectoral structure of income formation for 2023, compensation of employees in the production of goods and services amounted to 28,2% and 36,3%, respectively, the share of other net taxes on production is 0,5% in the production of goods and 1,4% in the production of services, respectively, the share of gross operating surplus / gross mixed income was 71,2 % and 62,3%.

Investments statistics

In January-July 2024 the volume of investments in fixed capital amounted to 8284.9 billion tenge, which is 0.4% more than in January-July 2023.

The predominant sources of investment financing remain the own funds of economic entities, the volume of which in January-July 2024 amounted to 5861.4 billion tenge.

In January-July 2024, compared with January-July 2023, there is an increase costs for the purchase of machinery, equipment and vehicles and their capital repairs by 8.6%.

A significant share of investments in fixed capital in January-July 2024 accounted for mining and quarrying (22.3%), operations with real estate (20.4%), transport and warehousing (17.4%) and manufacturing industry (9.8%).

The volume of investments of large enterprises in January-July 2024 amounted to 2816.4 billion tenge.

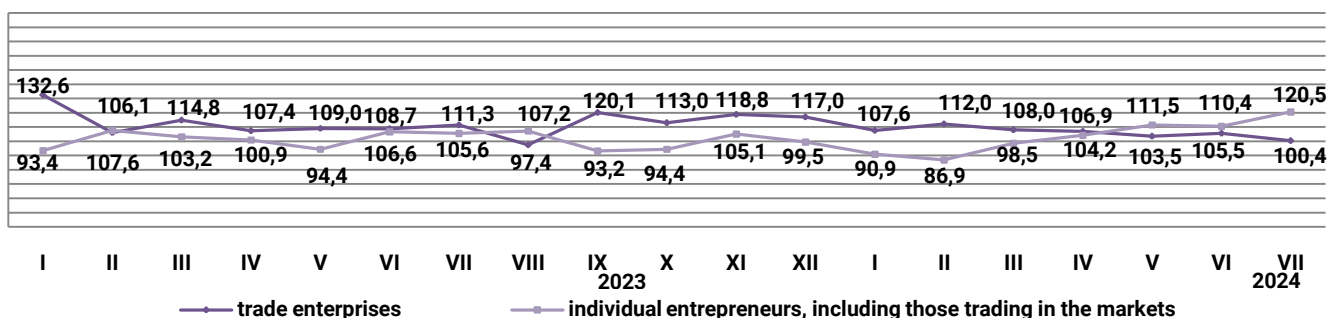
The volume of retail trade in January-July 2024 amounted to 10653.9 billion tenge, which is 5.9% more than the corresponding period in 2023. Retail sales of goods by trading enterprises increased by 6%, individual entrepreneurs, including those trading in the markets, decreased by 5.7% compared to January-July 2023.

As of August 1, 2024, the volume of commodity stocks of trading enterprises (for reporting enterprises) in retail trade amounted to 1605.3 billion tenge, in trading days - 64 days.

The share of food products in the total volume of retail trade is 30.8%, non-food products – 69.2%. The volume of sales of food products compared to January-July 2023 increased by 8.4%, non-food products increased by 4.8%.

The volume of wholesale trade in January-July 2024 amounted to 22303.3 billion tenge, which is 4.4% more than the corresponding period in 2023. Non-food products and industrial and technical products (79.7%) prevail in the structure of wholesale trade.

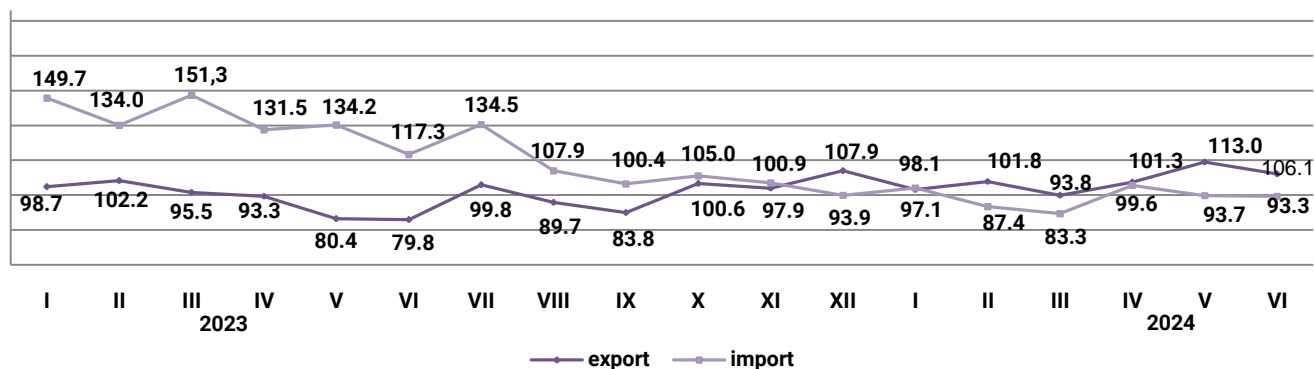

Foreign trade turnover in January–June 2024 amounted to 66.9 billion US dollars (less by 2.1% in nominal terms compared to January–June 2023), including exports – 39.3 billion US dollars (2.1% more) and imports – 27.6 billion US dollars (less by 7.6%).

Exports with the EAEU countries amounted to 4898 million US dollars, or 18% less than in January–June 2023, imports – 8458.6 million US dollars, decreased by 5.4% compared to the corresponding period last year.

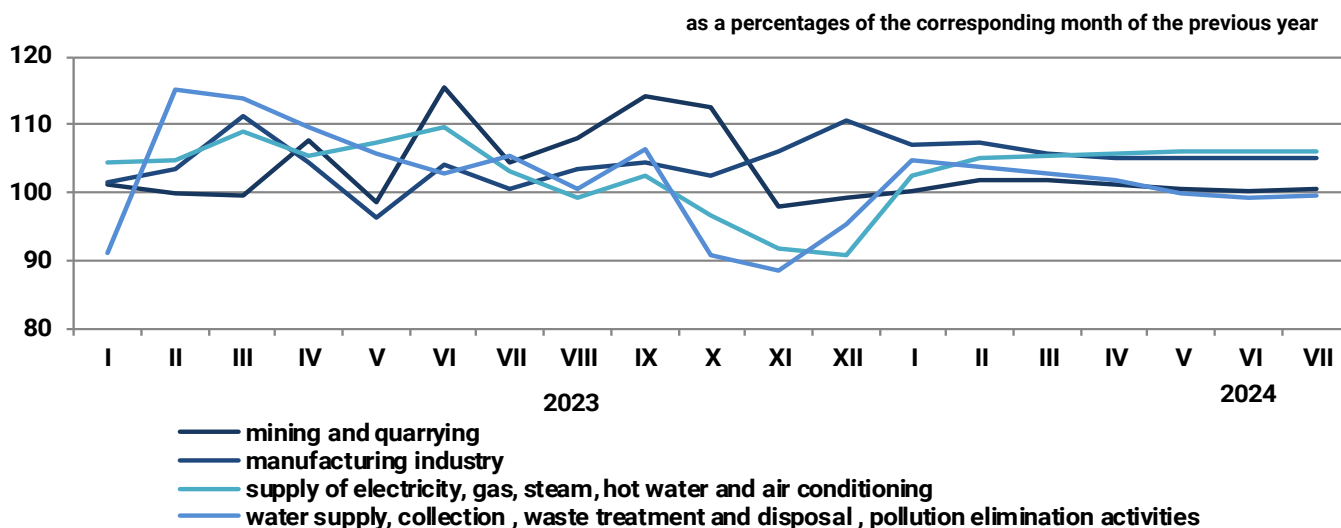

Statistics of building and housing construction

In January-July 2024, the volume of construction work increased by 8.7% and amounted to 3347.7 billion tenge.

The largest amount of work in January-July 2024 was performed on the construction of facilities (1608.9 billion tenge), non-residential buildings (1160.2 billion tenge) and residential buildings (578.6 billion tenge).

The volume of construction and installation work in January-July 2024 compared to January-July 2023 increased by 8.7% and amounted to 2837.3 billion tenge. The volume of construction work on major repairs increased by 6.2% and on current repairs by 11.6%.

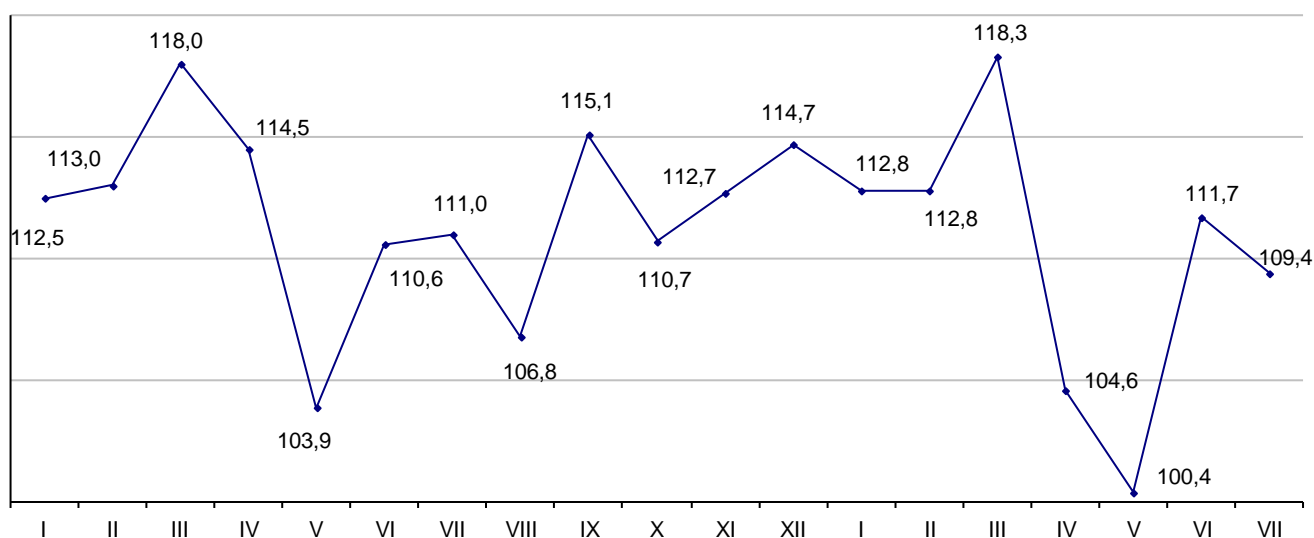
In January-July 2024, the construction of 19556 new buildings was completed, of which 18481 are residential and 1075 are non-residential.

as a percentage of the corresponding month of the previous year



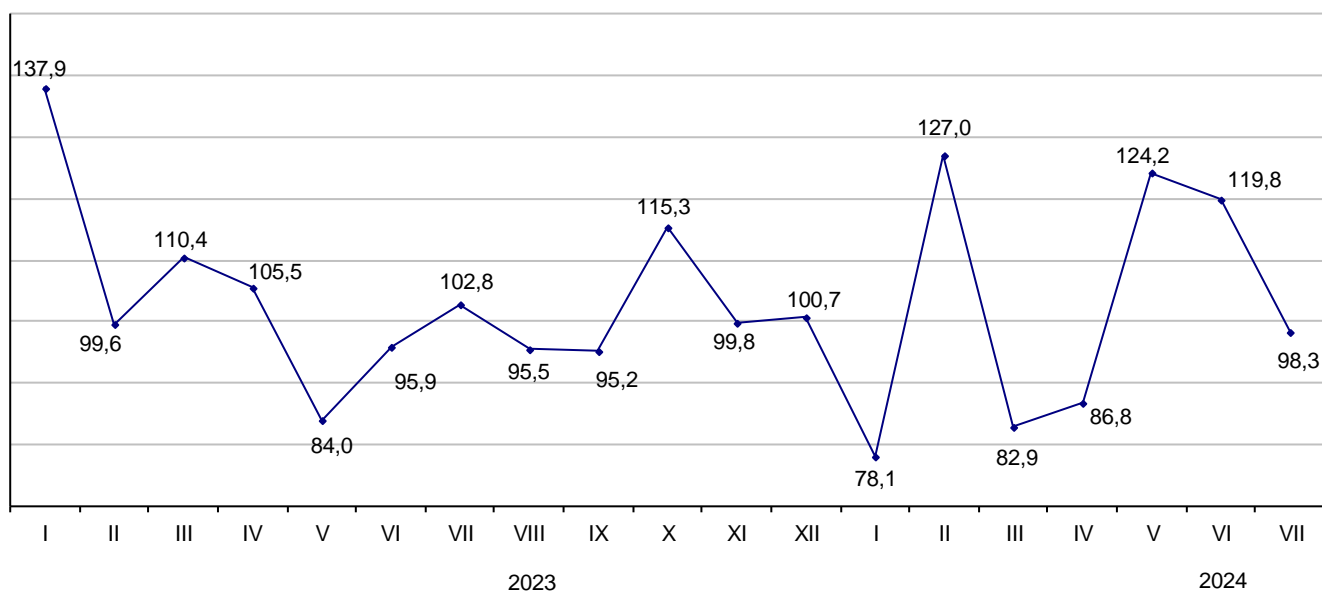

In January-July 2024, 1618.3 billion tenge was allocated for housing construction. In the total volume of investments in fixed capital, the share of disbursed funds in housing construction amounted to 19.5%.

The main source of financing for housing construction in January-July 2024 is the own funds of developers, the share of which is 87.6%.

as a percentages of the corresponding month of the previous year

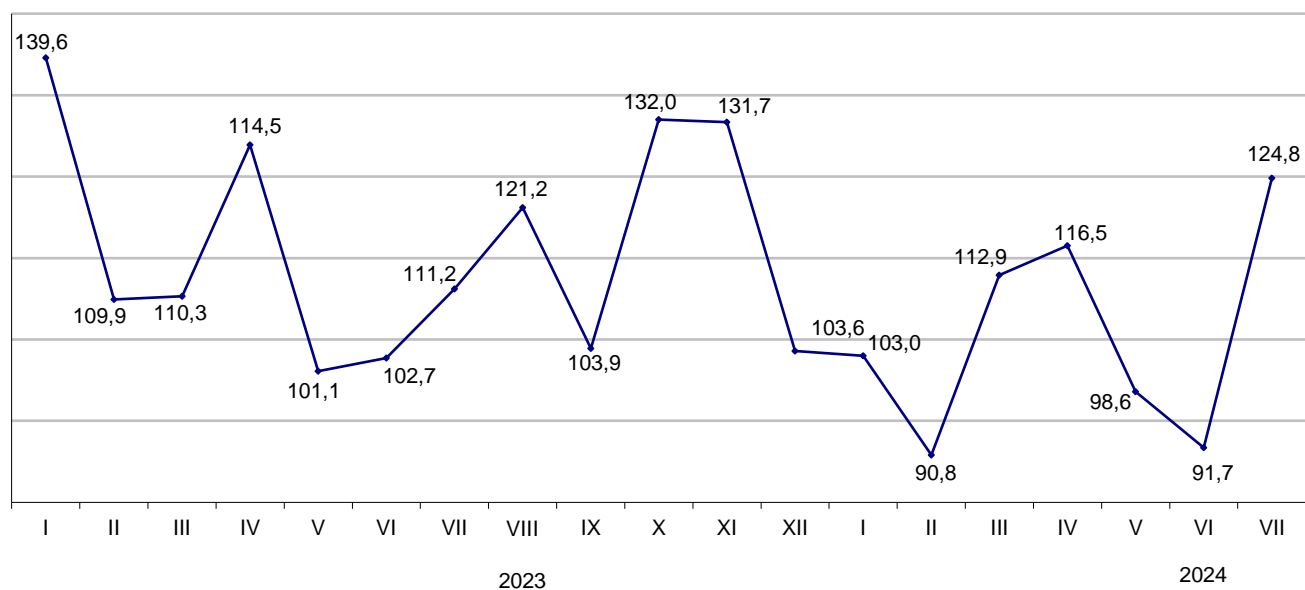


In January-July 2024, the total area of housing put into operation to January-July 2023 increased by 4.2% and amounted to 8914.4 thousand square meters. of which in multi-apartment buildings - by 10.7% (5566.7 thousand square meters). At the same time, the total area of individual residential buildings put into operation decreased by 5.2% (3298.7 thousand square meters).

In the total volume of commissioned housing, the share of multi-apartment buildings was 62.4%, individual –37%. The average actual cost of construction of 1 square meter of total housing area increased by 3%.

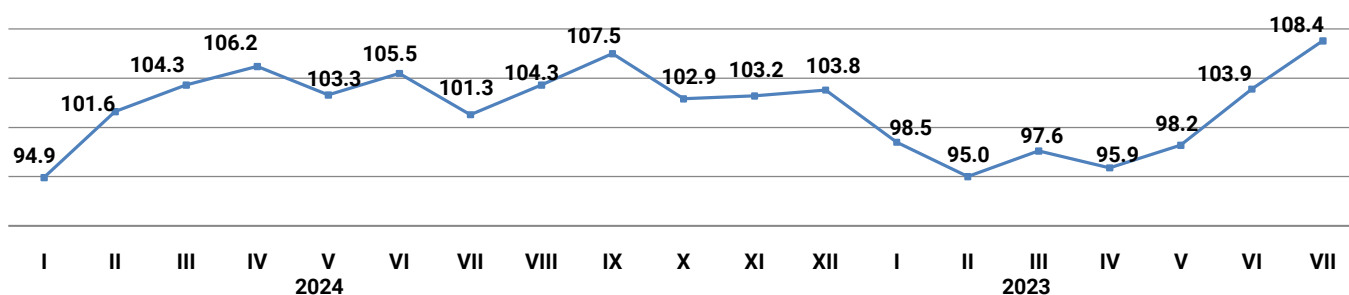

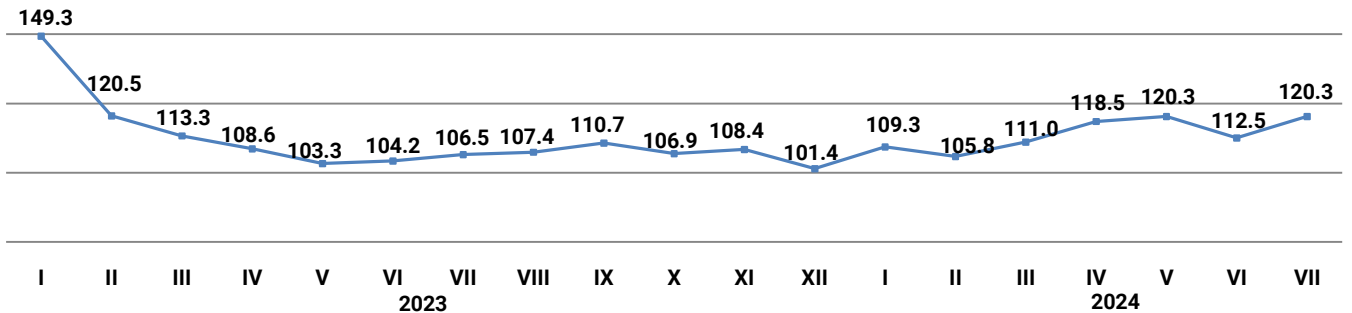

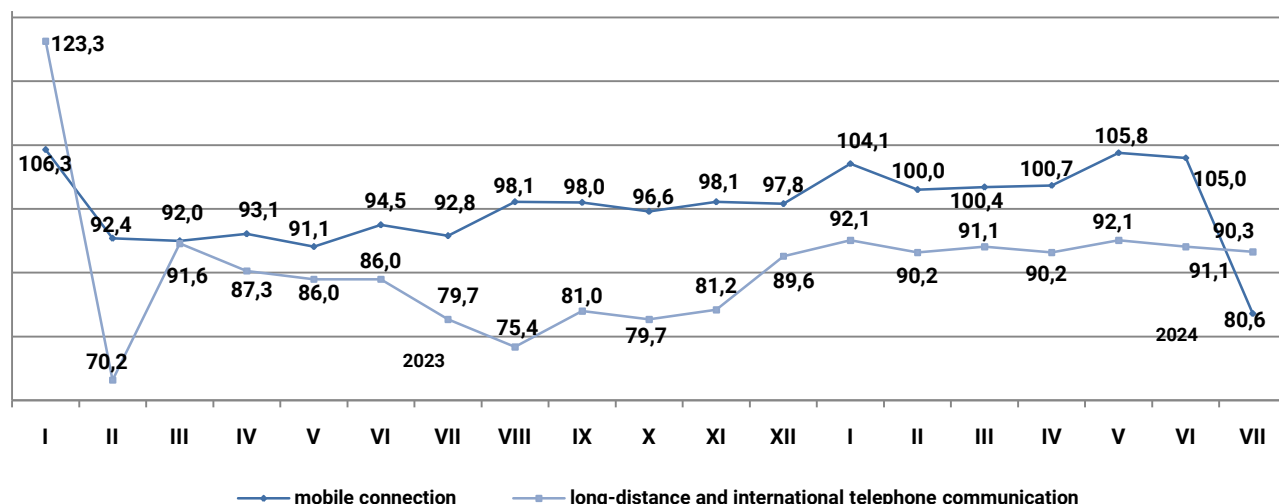

Statistics of communications

Indices of the physical volume for communication services in January-July 2024 compared to January-July 2023 amounted to 108.3%, of which 115.3% for Internet services, 99.2% for other telecommunications services and 104.2% for mobile services. A significant share in the total volume of communication services is occupied by Internet services, mobile communications and other telecommunication services, the shares of which amounted to 48.6%, 20.3% and 19.4 respectively.
