# 1. Social indicators

## Population size and migration

The population of the country as of September 1, 2024 amounted to 20201.8 thousand people, including urban – 12681.1 thousand (62.8%), rural – 7520.7 thousand (37.2%) people.

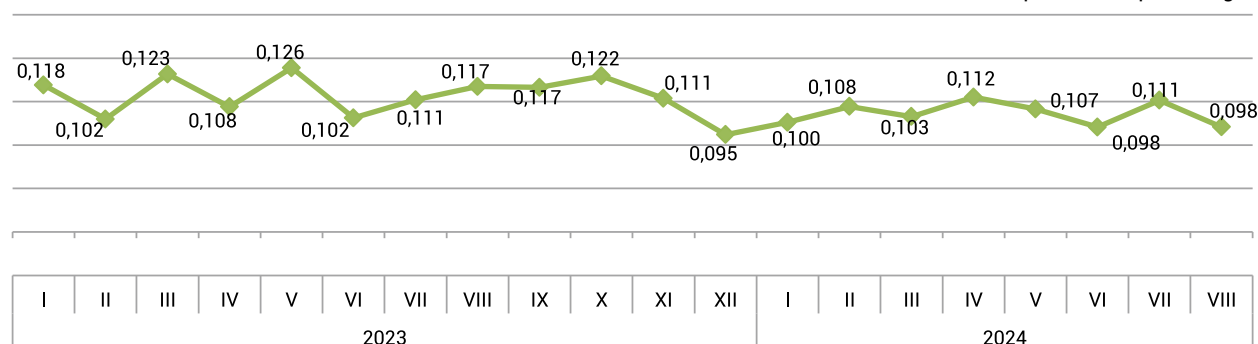
In January-August 2024, compared to January-August 2023, the number of arrivals in Kazakhstan increased by 2.2%, the number of departures from Kazakhstan decreased by 20%.

The main migration exchange of the country takes place with the CIS countries. The share of arrivals from the CIS countries and departures to these countries amounted to 78.9% and 78.8%, respectively.

The number of migrants moving within the country increased by 43.7%. In terms of interregional movements, a positive net migration of population has developed in 3 regions of the country: the cities of Astana (43728 people), Almaty (23610 people) and Shymkent (5287 people).

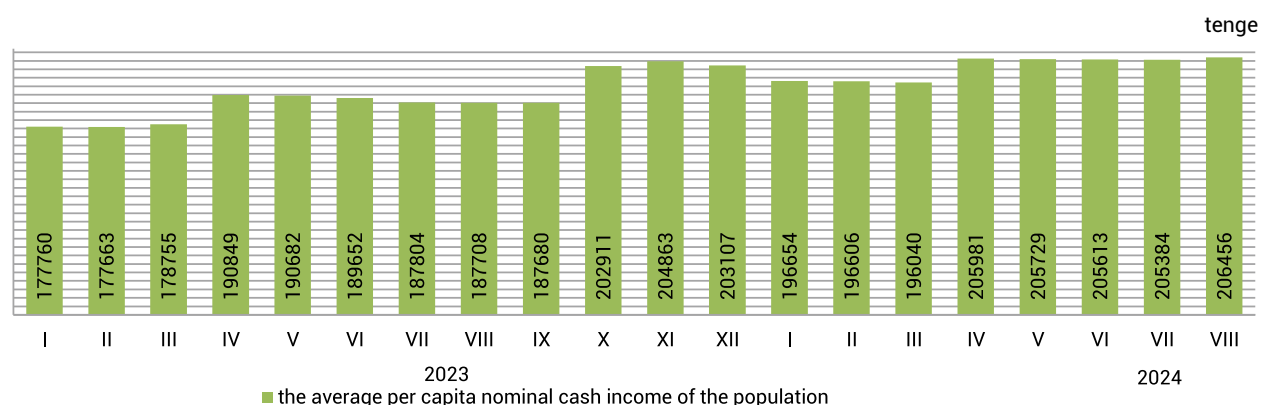

## Income of the population

The average per capita nominal cash income of the population, according to an estimate in August 2024, amounted to 206456 tenge (preliminary data), which is 10% higher than in August 2023, real cash income for the specified period increased by 1.5%.

## Employment of the population

The number of unemployed, determined according to the methodology of the ILO, in the II quarter<sup>1)</sup> of 2024 amounted to 451 thousand people, the unemployment rate was 4.7%.

The employed population<sup>2)</sup> amounted to 9190.4 thousand people, including employees – 6971 thousand people, individual entrepreneurs – 1717 thousand people, persons engaged in private practice – 32.5 thousand people, individuals, who are founders (participants) of business partnerships and founders, shareholders (participants) of joint-stock companies, as well as members of production cooperatives – 14.9 thousand people, independent workers – 455 thousand people.

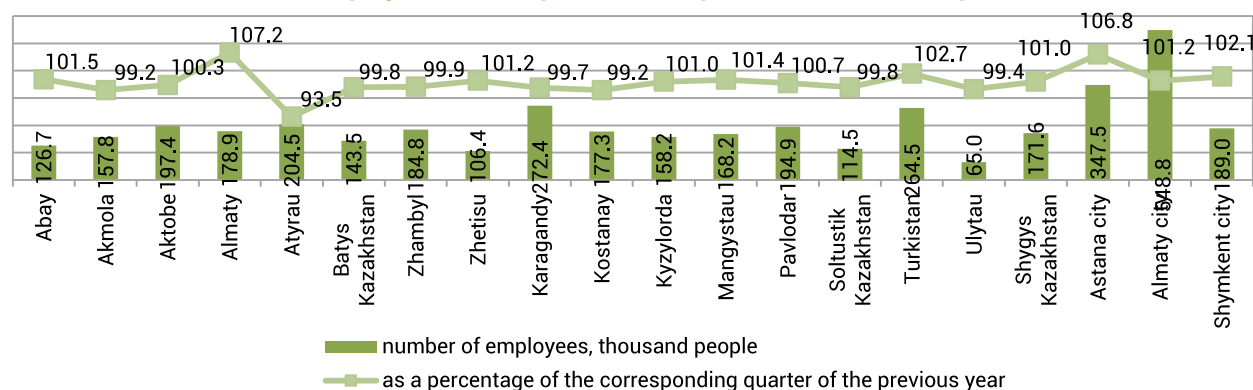

The number of employees at enterprises (organizations) in the II quarter of 2024<sup>3)</sup> amounted to 3971.9 thousand people, of which at large and medium-sized enterprises – 2876.2 thousand people.

In the II quarter of 2024, 262.5 thousand people were hired by enterprises. 274.7 thousand people dropped out for various reasons. Worked by one employee 463.5 hours.

At the end of the II quarter of 2024, 55.8 thousand vacancies were not filled at enterprises (1.4% of the number of employees).

In the II quarter of 2024, the average monthly nominal salary amounted to 403251 tenge (excluding employees of small enterprises engaged in entrepreneurial activities). In the II quarter of 2024, the median salary was estimated to be 278296 tenge.

From January 1, 2024, the minimum wage is set at 85000 tenge.

## 2. Economic indicators

### Statistics of prices

The consumer price index in September 2024 compared to August 2024 was 100.4%. Prices for paid services increased by 1%, non-food products – by 0.6%. The price index for products was 100%.

In the field of housing and communal services, tariffs for cold water increased by 6.2%, water disposal, electricity – by 1.1%. The price level for the services of private educational organizations increased by 17.1%, vocational secondary education – by 12.3%, higher education – by 10.3%.

An increase in prices was noted for firewood by 2.9%, coal – by 2.5%. Prices for cars increased by 1.7%, furniture and household items – by 1.4%, clothes and shoes – by 0.9%.

Of food products, prices for cucumbers increased by 11.9%, oranges – by 7.8%, eggs – by 6%, tomatoes – by 5.1%, sunflower oil – by 4.1%. A decrease in prices was noted for potatoes by 13.5%, carrots – by 11.9%, grapes – by 10.3%, onions – by 10%, beets – by 5.9%.

In September 2024, compared with the previous month, the producer price index for agricultural products amounted to 100.1%, crop production – 99.6%, livestock products – 101.5%.

Prices for dried lentils decreased by 4%, wheat, except durum wheat – by 1.5%, corn (maize) – by 1.3%, and barley increased in price by 2.1%, safflower seeds – by 0.9%, flax seeds – by 0.3%.

There is a decrease in prices for carrot by 5.5%, beet - by 1.8%, watermelons - by 1%, and an increase in prices for potato - by 5.5%, cucumbers of the closed ground - by 3.8%, peppers – by 3.2%, pome fruits - by 3.1%, cucumbers of the open ground - by 2.6%, eggplant - by 2.2%, grapes and cut flowers and flower buds - by 1.4%, tomatoes of the open and closed ground - by 1.3%.

Chicken eggs increased in price by 11.1%, raw mare's milk – by 1.5%, natural honey – by 1.2%, and sheeps decreased in price by 0.7%, pigs – by 0.2%.

Prices of manufacturing enterprises for industrial products in September 2024 increased by 0.5% compared to the previous month. Metal ores prices were higher by 3.5%, natural gas – by 2%, coal – lower by 0.3%, oil – by 0.2%. Of petroleum products, propane and butane liquefied rose by 3.4%.

An increase in prices was noted for zinc by 2.3%, precious metals – by 1.7%, for lead – a decrease by 4.5%, copper – by 3.2%, aluminum – by 1.1%, ferroalloys – by 0.5%.

From food products, wheat flour rose by 1.8%, vegetable oil – by 1.2%, pasta – by 0.6%, bread – by 0.3%, sugar fell by 7.5%, rice – by 1.3%, cereals – by 0.8%, poultry meat – by 0.5%.

In the service sector, tariffs for the transportation of goods by all types transportation in September 2024 decreased by 0.3% compared to the previous month, tariffs for communication services increased by 0.1%, tariffs for postal and courier services remained unchanged.

In September 2024 compared to the previous month the price index in construction amounted to 100.0%. Prices for other work and costs increased by 0.5%, machinery and equipment by 0.3%, construction and installation work – remained unchanged.

## Short-term economic indicator

The short-term economic indicator for January–September 2024 compared to January–August 2023 amounted to 105.3%. The calculation of the short-term economic indicator is carried out to ensure efficiency and is based on changes in output indices for basic sectors: agriculture, industry, construction, trade, transport and communications, accounting for over 60% of GDP.

## Gross Domestic Product

In the structure of GDP for January-June 2024, to reported data, the production of goods amounted to 35,9%, the production of services – 57,1%. The main share in the production of GDP is occupied by industry – 28,3%, wholesale and retail trade; repair of cars and motorcycles – 16,0%.

According to the reporting data, in the sectoral structure of income formation for January-June 2024, compensation of employees in the production of goods and services amounted to 27,8% and 39,1%, respectively, the share of other taxes on production is 2,5 % in the production of goods and 2% in the production of services, respectively, the share of gross operating surplus /gross mixed income was 69,7 % and 58,9%.

The Gross domestic product calculated by the final expenditure method for January–June 2024 amounted to 50972953,8 million tenge. In comparison with the corresponding period of last year in real terms there is an increase in the component of final consumption expenditure: households – by 5,6%, non-profit organizations serving households – by 12% and a decrease in government administration – by (-5,2)%.

## Investment statistics

In January-September 2024, the volume of investments in fixed capital amounted to 11744.9 billion tenge, which is 0.6% more than in January-September 2023.

The predominant sources of investment financing remain the own funds of economic entities, the volume of which in January-September 2024 amounted to 7829.1 billion tenge.

In January-September 2024, compared with January-September 2023, there is an increase costs for works on construction and capital repair of buildings and constructions by 7.2%.

A significant share of investments in fixed capital in January-September 2024 accounted for mining and quarrying (21%), operations with real estate (19.5%), transport and warehousing (18%) and manufacturing industry (9.4%).

The volume of investments of large enterprises in January-September 2024 amounted to 3852.8 billion tenge.

## Statistics of domestic trade

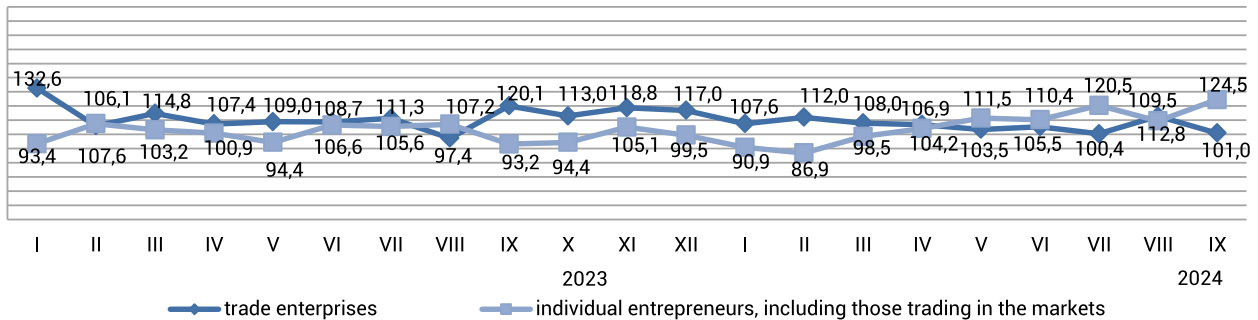
The volume of retail trade in January-September 2024 amounted to 14935.7 billion tenge, which is 7.3% more than the corresponding period in 2023. Retail sales of goods by trading enterprises increased by 6.1%, individual entrepreneurs, including those trading in the markets, decreased by 9.7% compared to January-September 2023.

As of October 1, 2024, the volume of commodity stocks of trading enterprises (for reporting enterprises) in retail trade amounted to 1643.6 billion tenge, in trading days - 68 days.

The share of food products in the total volume of retail trade is 32.8%, non-food products –67.2%. The volume of sales of food products compared to January-September 2023 increased by 8.4%, non-food products increased by 6.7%.

The volume of wholesale trade in January-September 2024 amounted to 30949.3 billion tenge, which is 5.7% more than the corresponding period in 2023. Non-food products and industrial and technical products (80.9%) prevail in the structure of wholesale trade.

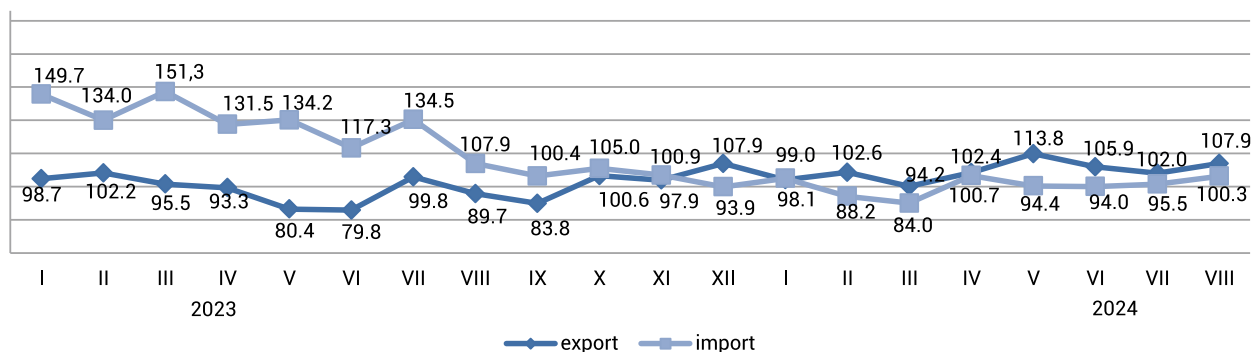

Foreign trade turnover in January–August 2024 amounted to 91.7 billion US dollars (less by 0.6% in nominal terms compared to January–August 2023) including exports–53.5 billion US dollars (3.3% more) and imports–38.1 billion US dollars (less by 5.6%).

Exports with the EAEU countries amounted to 6915.4 million US dollars or 9.8% less than in January–August 2023 imports – 12015.3 million US dollars increased by 0.9% compared to the corresponding period last year.

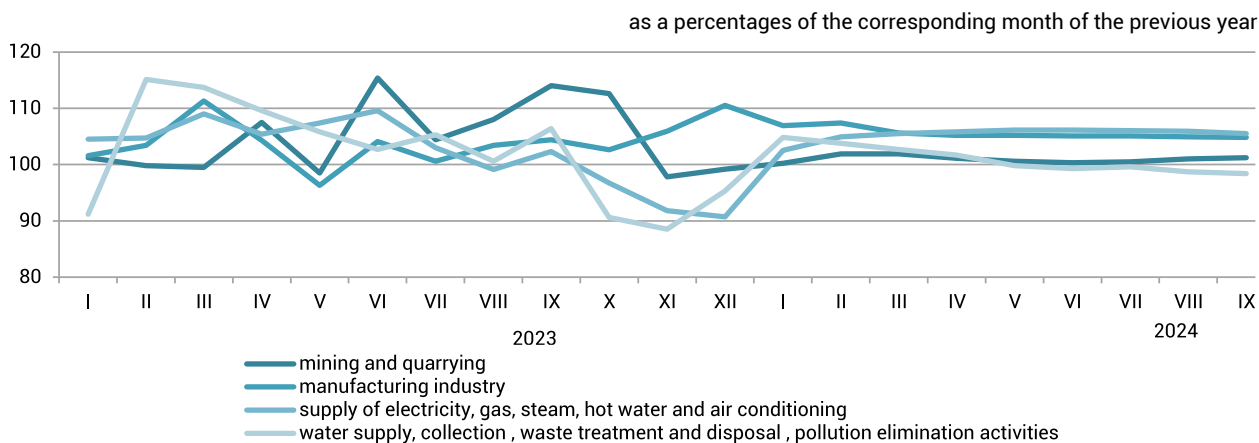

## Statistics of building and housing construction

In January-September 2024, the volume of construction work increased by 10.1% and amounted to 5434.2 billion tenge.

The largest amount of work in January-September 2024 was performed on the construction of facilities (2718.9 billion tenge), non-residential buildings (1776.1 billion tenge) and residential buildings (939.3 billion tenge).

The volume of construction and installation work in January-September 2024 compared to January-September 2023 increased by 9.1% and amounted to 4539.1 billion tenge. The volume of construction work on major repairs increased by 14.4% and on current repairs by 15.9%.

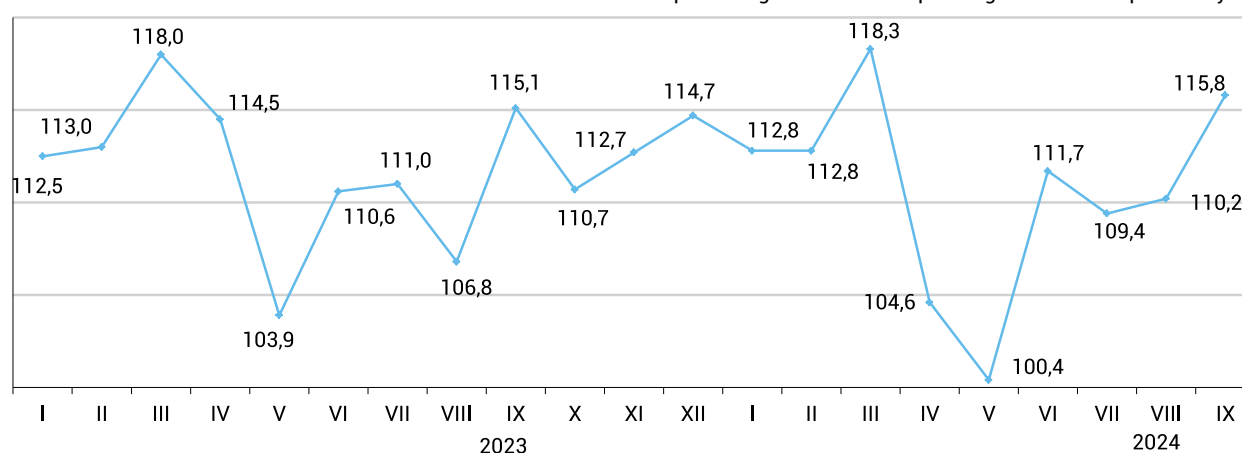
In January-September 2024, the construction of 28357 new buildings was completed, of which 26577 are residential and 1780 are non-residential.

as a percentages of the corresponding month of the previous year



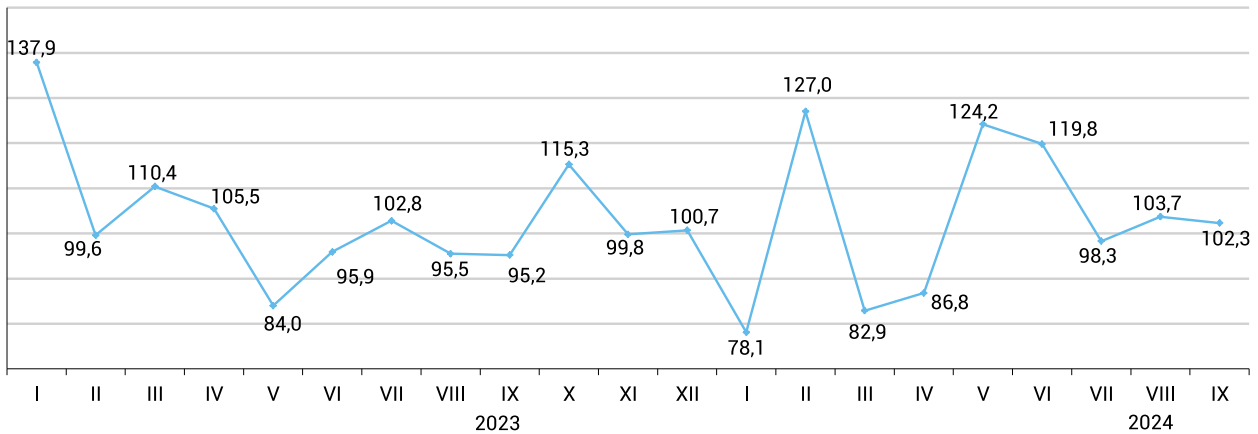

In January-September 2024, 2187.5 billion tenge was allocated for housing construction. In the total volume of investments in fixed capital, the share of disbursed funds in housing construction amounted to 18.6%.

The main source of financing for housing construction in January-September 2024 is the own funds of developers, the share of which is 87.6%.

as a percentages of the corresponding month of the previous year

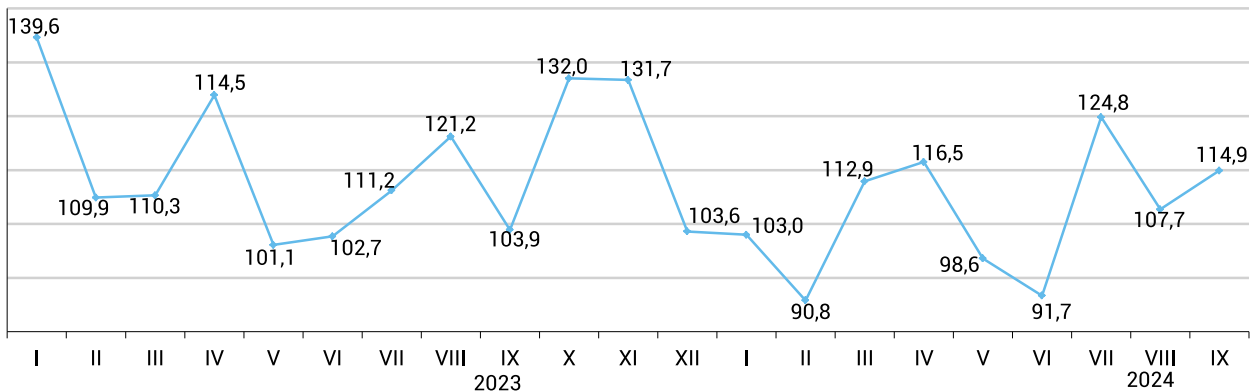


In January-September 2024, the total area of housing put into operation to January-September 2023 increased by 6.2% and amounted to 12426.6 thousand square meters. of which in multi-apartment buildings - by 10.1% (7600.9 thousand square meters). At the same time, the total area of individual residential buildings put into operation decreased by 0.5% (4709.4 thousand square meters).

In the total volume of commissioned housing, the share of multi-apartment buildings was 61.2%, individual -37.9%. The average actual cost of construction of 1 square meter of total housing area increased by 2.5%.

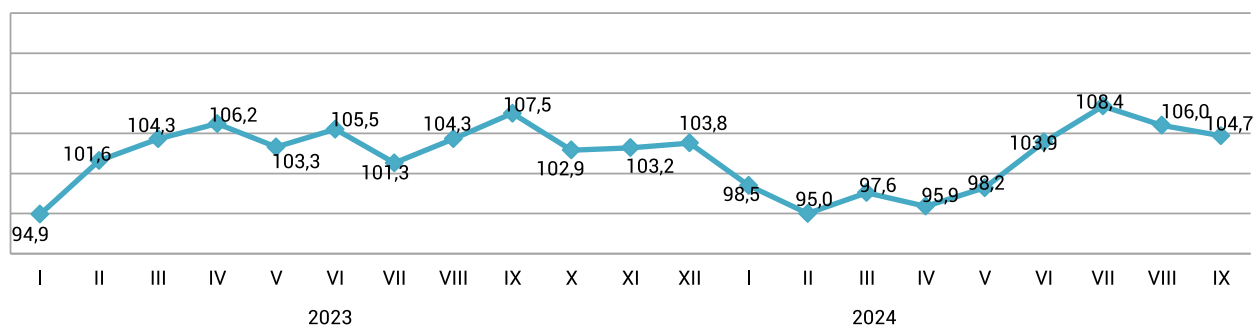

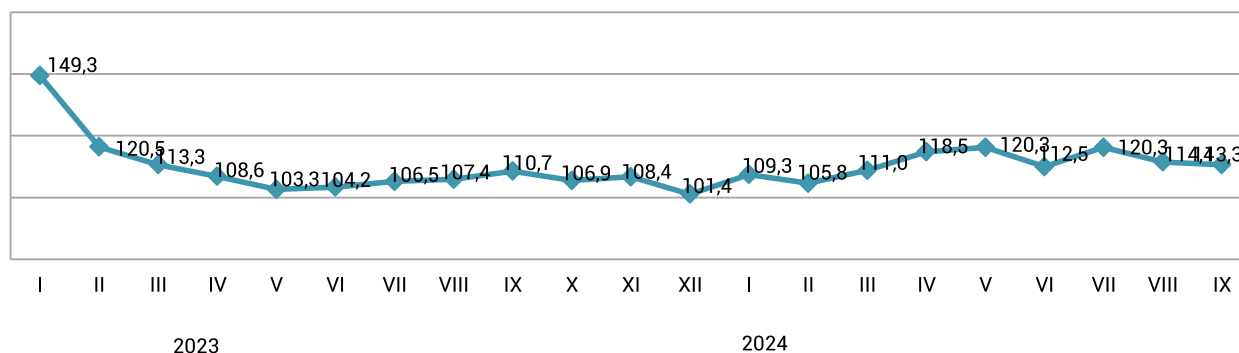

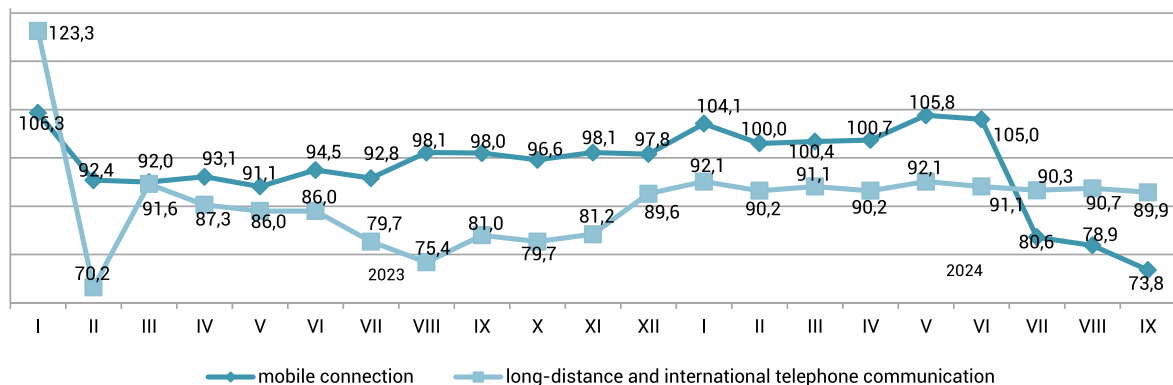

## Statistics of communications

Indices of the physical volume for communication services in January-September 2024 compared to January-September 2023 amounted to 106.4%, of which 117.1% for Internet services, 102.7% for other telecommunications services and 86.9% for mobile services. A significant share in the total volume of communication services is occupied by Internet services, other telecommunication services and mobile communications, the shares of which amounted to 51.8%, 19% and 17.4 respectively.

## Small and medium business<sup>1)</sup>

### The structure of performance indicators for SMEs as of October 1, 2024

As of October 1, 2024, the number of active subjects SMEs increased by 0.9% compared to the corresponding date of the previous year. In the total number of active subjects SMEs, the share of individual entrepreneurs was 69.5%, legal entities of small enterprises – 17.5%, peasant or farm enterprises – 12.9%, legal entities of medium enterprises – 0.1%.

In the II quarter of 2024, wage arrears at enterprises of the republic amounted to 458 billion tenge and increased by 14.8% compared to the corresponding period of 2023. The overdue debt amounted to about 47.7 million tenge.
