# 1. Social indicators

## Population size and migration

The population of the country as of November 1, 2024 amounted to 20244 thousand people, including urban – 12727.4 thousand (62.9%), rural – 7516.6 thousand (37.1%) people.

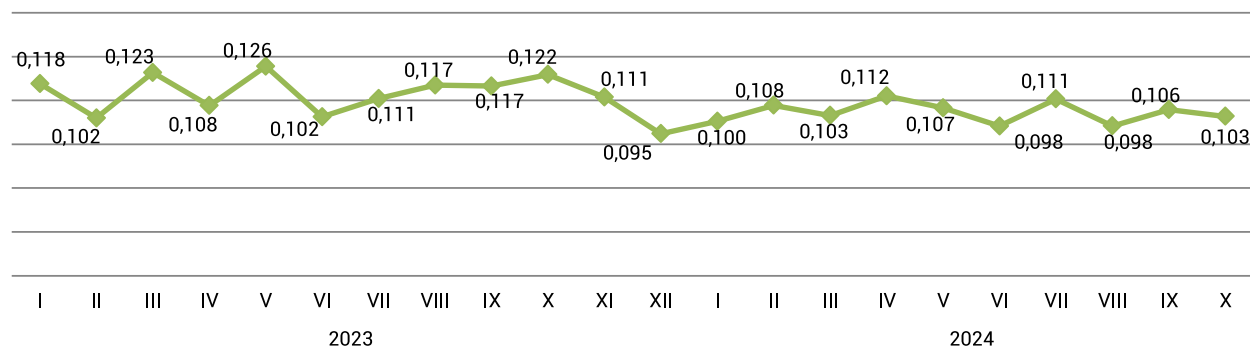
In January-October 2024, compared to January-October 2023, the number of arrivals in Kazakhstan increased by 7.6%, the number of departures from Kazakhstan decreased by 18.5%.

The main migration exchange of the country takes place with the CIS countries. The share of arrivals from the CIS countries and departures to these countries amounted to 80.2% and 76.5%, respectively.

The number of migrants moving within the country increased by 47.9%. In terms of interregional movements, a positive net migration of population has developed in 4 regions of the country: the cities of Astana (60505 people), Almaty (28665 people), Shymkent (6682 people) and Almaty region (2068 people).

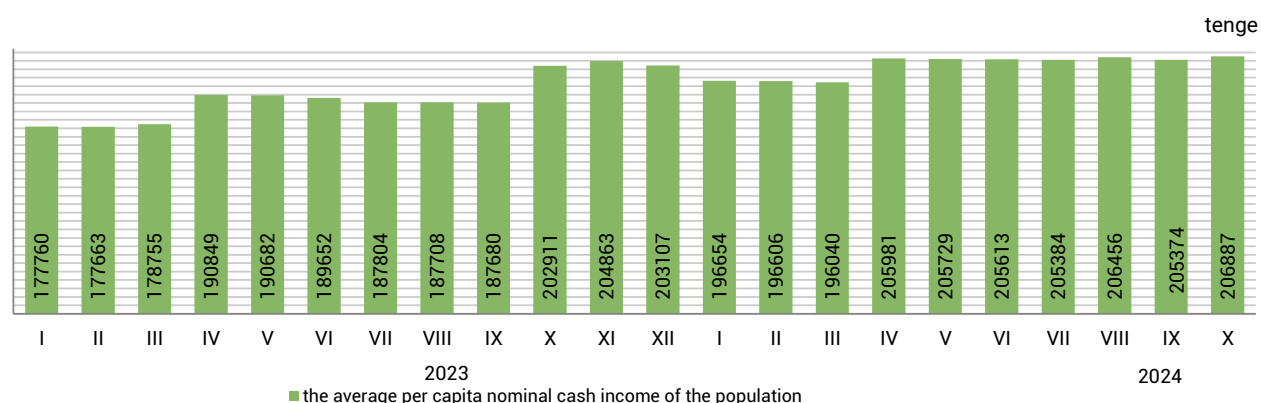

## Income of the population

The average per capita nominal cash income of the population, according to an estimate in October 2024, amounted to 206887 tenge (preliminary data), which is 2% higher than in October 2023, real cash income for the specified period decreased by 6%.

## Employment of the population

The number of unemployed, determined according to the methodology of the ILO, in the III quarter<sup>1)</sup> of 2024 amounted to 448.6 thousand people, the unemployment rate was 4.6%.

The employed population<sup>2)</sup> amounted to 9233.8 thousand people, including employees – 7020.1 thousand people, individual entrepreneurs – 1680.9 thousand people, persons engaged in private practice – 25.1 thousand people, individuals, who are founders (participants) of business partnerships and founders, shareholders (participants) of joint-stock companies, as well as members of production cooperatives – 13.7 thousand people, independent workers – 494 thousand people.

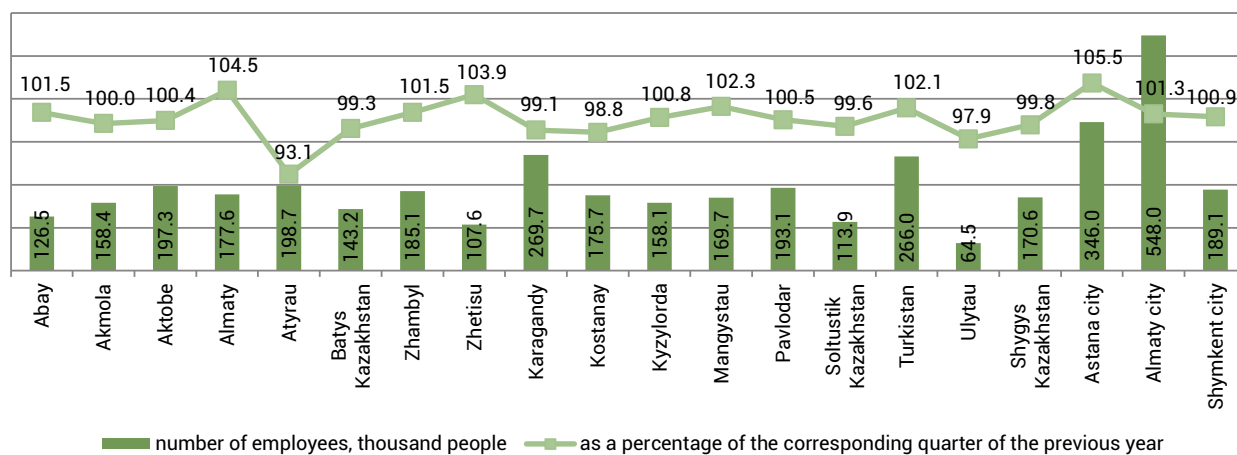

The number of employees at enterprises (organizations) in the III quarter of 2024<sup>3)</sup> amounted to 3958.9 thousand people, of which at large and medium-sized enterprises – 2863.7 thousand people.

In the III quarter of 2024, 307.3 thousand people were hired by enterprises. 306.3 thousand people dropped out for various reasons. Worked by one employee 465.4 hours.

At the end of the III quarter of 2024, 58.7 thousand vacancies were not filled at enterprises (1.5% of the number of employees).

## Remuneration of labor at enterprises and organizations\*

In the III quarter of 2024, the average monthly nominal salary amounted to 390328 tenge (excluding employees of small enterprises engaged in entrepreneurial activities). In the III quarter of 2024, the median salary was estimated to be 269378 tenge.

From January 1, 2024, the minimum wage is set at 85000 tenge.

## 2. Economic indicators

### Statistics of prices

In November 2024, the monthly consumer price index, as in the previous month, was 0.9%. Food prices increased by 1.1%, paid services – by 0.8%, non-food products – by 0.7%.

Of food products, prices for cucumbers increased by 40.3%, tomatoes – by 37.3%, sweet peppers – by 15.5%, onions – by 13.9%, garlic – by 10.1%, cabbage – by 8.9%, potatoes – by 6.2%, oranges – by 4.8%, lemons – by 4.1%, sunflower oil – by 4%. A decrease in prices was noted for rice by 2%, sugar – by 1.9%, apples – by 0.7%.

In the field of housing and communal services, tariffs for hot water increased by 11.4%, electricity - by 3.4%, garbage collection – by 2.2%, central heating – by 2.1%. Tire repair services rose in price by 3%, visits to the baths – by 2.6%, hairdressing and beauty salon services – by 1.2%.

An increase in prices in November this year was noted for firewood by 1.4%, coal – by 1%. A smartphone increased in price by 9.8%, a gold engagement ring – by 6.2%, clothes and shoes – by 0.9%.

In November 2024, compared with the previous month, the producer price index for agricultural products amounted to 98.7%, crop production – 97.9%, livestock products – 101%.

Prices for wheat, except durum wheat, decreased by 6.1%, durum wheat – by 1.8%, dried peas – by 0.9%, rice – by 0.7%, and rapeseed seeds – increased by 4.2%, sunflower seeds – by 2.8%, curly flax seeds – by 1.2%.

A decrease in prices was noted for forage crops – by 1.7%, table beets – by 0.4%, and for potatoes, prices increased by 5%, garlic – by 4%, pome fruits – by 3.4%, carrots and onions – by 0.9%.

Poultry rose in price by 2.5%, raw cow's milk and honey by 0.9%, horses and eggs by 0.6%, and pigs fell in price by 0.4%.

Prices of manufacturing enterprises for industrial products in November 2024 increased by 0.9% compared to the previous month. Metal ores prices were higher by 1.1%, natural gas – by 0.8%, oil – by 0.5%, coal – by 0.2%. Of petroleum products, fuel oil rose in price by 3.7%, propane and butane liquefied – by 0.7%.

An increase in prices was noted for aluminum by 7.4%, zinc – by 6.6%, lead – by 2.9%, precious metals – by 2.5%, copper – by 1.3%, for ferroalloys – a decrease by 0.7%.

From food products, wheat flour rose in price by 7.1%, vegetable oil – by 2.6%, poultry meat and pasta – by 1%, bread – by 0.5%, dairy products – by 0.4%, sugar fell in price by 2.6%, rice – by 0.7%, cereals – by 0.4%.

In the service sector, tariffs for the transportation of goods by all types transportation in November 2024 increased by 0.3% compared to the previous month, communication services and tariffs for postal and courier services remained unchanged.

In November 2024 compared to the previous month the price index in construction amounted to 100.7%. Prices for construction and installation work increased by 0.7%, other work and costs - by 0.4%, machinery and equipment – by 0.3%.

The short-term economic indicator for January–November 2024 compared to January–November 2023 amounted to 105.6%. The calculation of the short-term economic indicator is carried out to ensure efficiency and is based on changes in output indices for basic sectors: agriculture, industry, construction, trade, transport and communications, accounting for over 60% of GDP.

## Gross Domestic Product

In the structure of GDP for January-September 2024, flash estimates, the production of goods amounted to 36,4%, the production of services – 56,5%. The main share in the production of GDP is occupied by industry – 27%, wholesale and retail trade; repair of cars and motorcycles – 16,2%.

## Investment statistics

In January-November 2024, the volume of investments in fixed capital amounted to 15758 billion tenge, which is 3.1% more than in January-November 2023.

The predominant sources of investment financing remain the own funds of economic entities, the volume of which in January-November 2024 amounted to 10345.5 billion tenge.

In January-November 2024, compared with January-November 2023, there is an increase costs for works on construction and capital repair of buildings and constructions by 10.2%.

A significant share of investments in fixed capital in January-November 2024 accounted for mining and quarrying (20.3%), operations with real estate (19.3%), transport and warehousing (17.8%) and manufacturing industry (10.5%).

The volume of investments of large enterprises in January-November 2024 amounted to 5264.6 billion tenge.

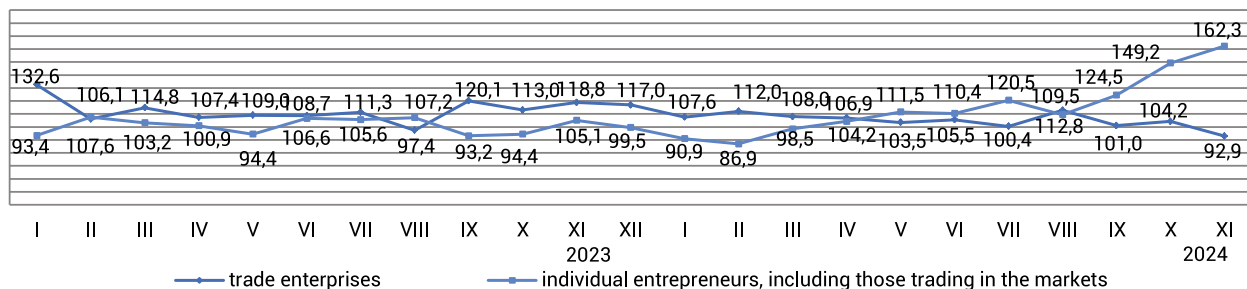
The volume of retail trade in January-November 2024 amounted to 19486 billion tenge, which is 9.3% more than the corresponding period in 2023. Retail sales of goods by trading enterprises increased by 4.3%, individual entrepreneurs, including those trading in the markets, decreased by 19.8% compared to January-November 2023.

As of December 1, 2024, the volume of commodity stocks of trading enterprises (for reporting enterprises) in retail trade amounted to 1722.9 billion tenge, in trading days – 67 days.

The share of food products in the total volume of retail trade is 32.4%, non-food products – 67.6%. The volume of sales of food products compared to January-November 2023 increased by 9%, non-food products increased by 9.4%.

The volume of wholesale trade in January-November 2024 amounted to 41222 billion tenge, which is 7.6% more than the corresponding period in 2023. Non-food products and industrial and technical products (82%) prevail in the structure of wholesale trade.

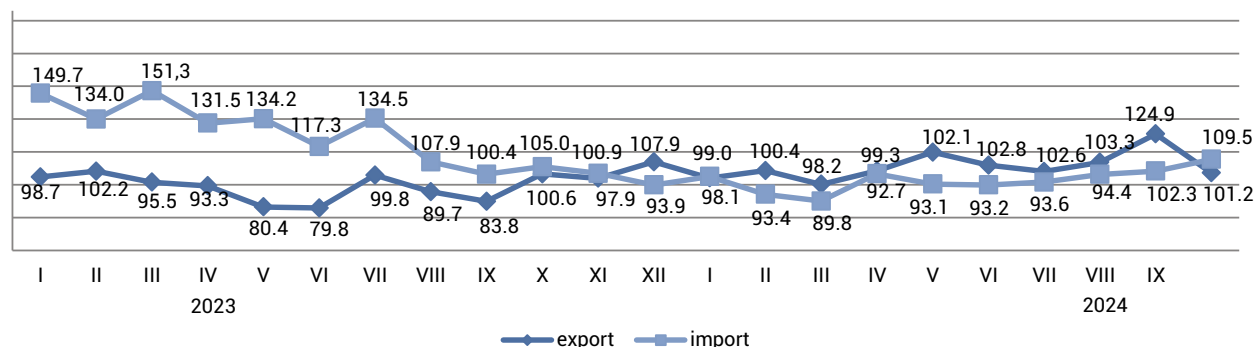

Foreign trade turnover in January–October 2024 amounted to 116.9 billion US dollars (increased by 1.5% in nominal terms compared to January–October 2023) including exports – 68.5 billion US dollars (5.1% more) and imports – 48.4 billion US dollars (less by 3.3%).

Exports with the EAEU countries amounted to 8704.2 million US dollars or 8.9% less than in January–October 2023, imports – 15376 million US dollars increased by 3.9% compared to the corresponding period last year.

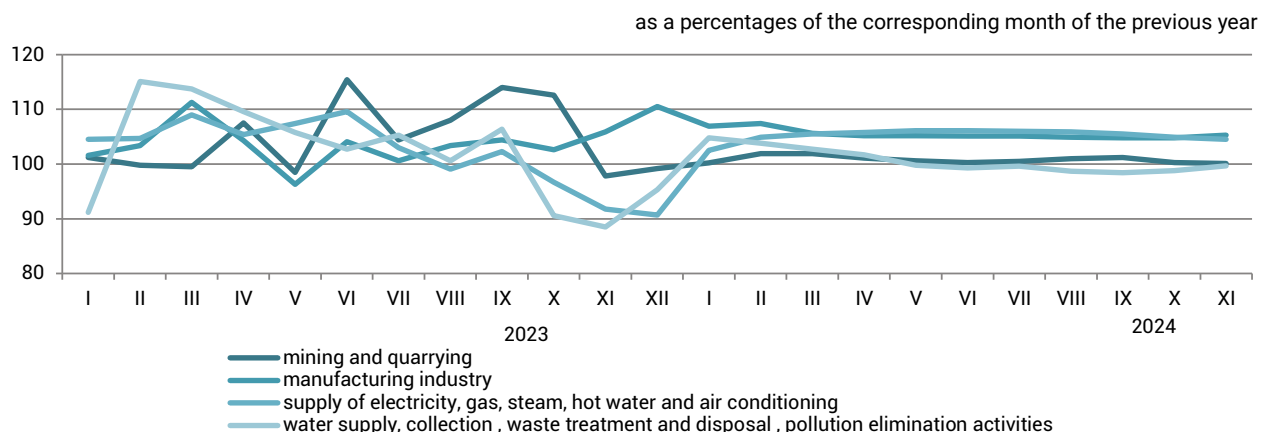

## Statistics of building and housing construction

In January-November 2024, the volume of construction work increased by 10.3% and amounted to 6852.6 billion tenge.

The largest amount of work in January-November 2024 was performed on the construction of facilities (3489.9 billion tenge), non-residential buildings (2196.7 billion tenge) and residential buildings (1166 billion tenge).

The volume of construction and installation work in January-November 2024 compared to January-November 2023 increased by 8.3% and amounted to 5688.9 billion tenge. The volume of construction work on major repairs increased by 23.5% and on current repairs by 18.7%.

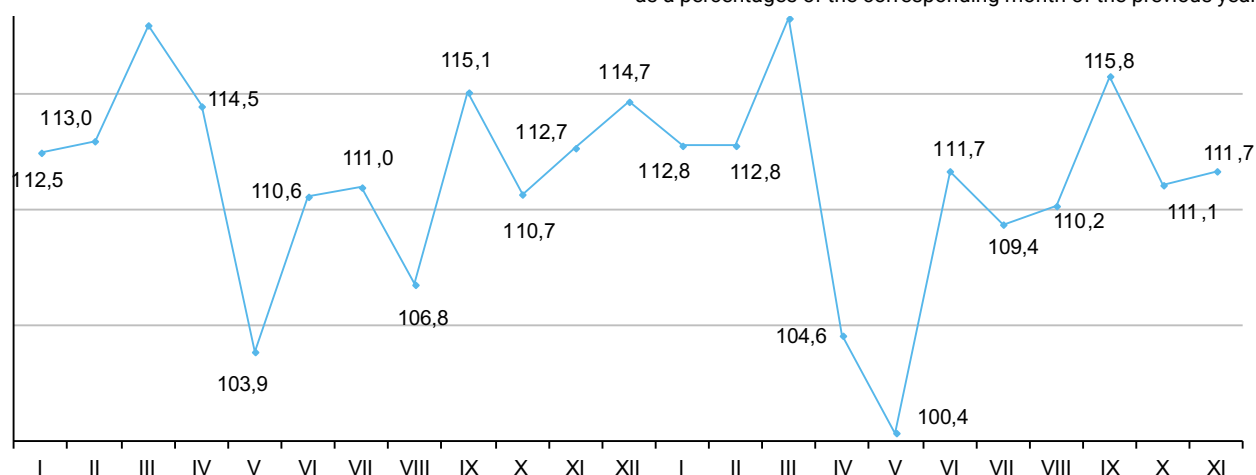
In January-November 2024, the construction of 36455 new buildings was completed, of which 34289 are residential and 2166 are non-residential.

as a percentages of the corresponding month of the previous year



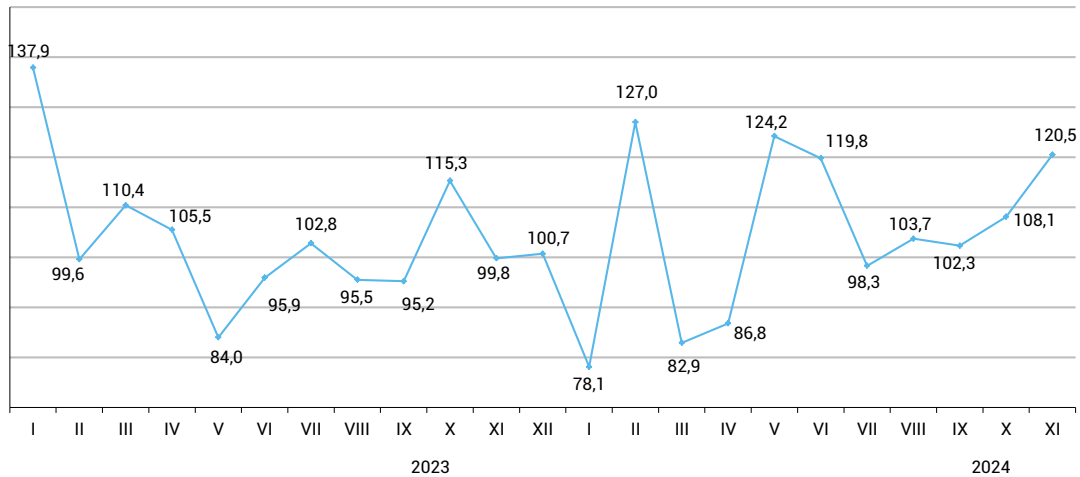

In January-November 2024, 2904.4 billion tenge was allocated for housing construction. In the total volume of investments in fixed capital, the share of disbursed funds in housing construction amounted to 18.4%.

The main source of financing for housing construction in January-November 2024 is the own funds of developers, the share of which is 87.6%.

as a percentages of the corresponding month of the previous year

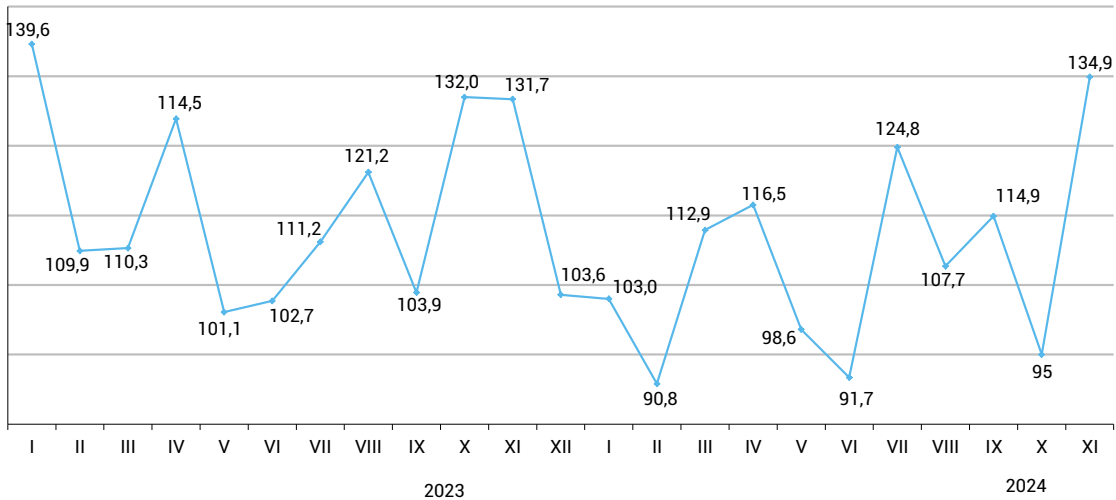


In January-November 2024, the total area of housing put into operation to January-November 2023 increased by 8.3% and amounted to 16317.2 thousand square meters, of which in multi-apartment buildings - by 11.9% (10191.3 thousand square meters), of individual residential buildings - by 1.8% (5968.9 thousand square meters).

In the total volume of commissioned housing, the share of multi-apartment buildings was 62.5%, individual – 36.6%. The average actual cost of construction of 1 square meter of total housing area increased by 4.1%.

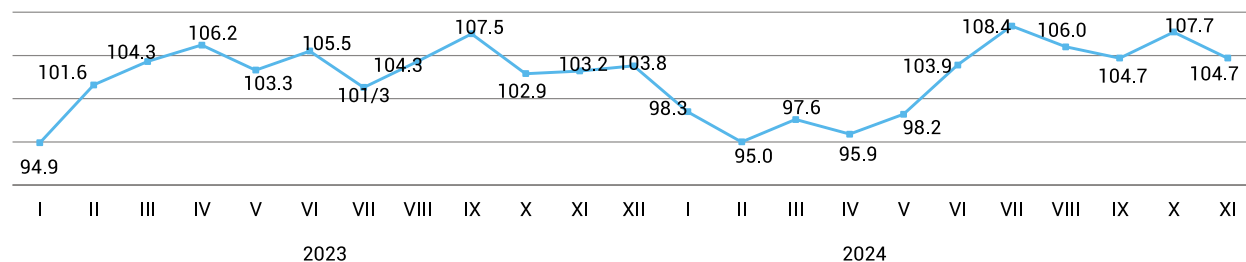

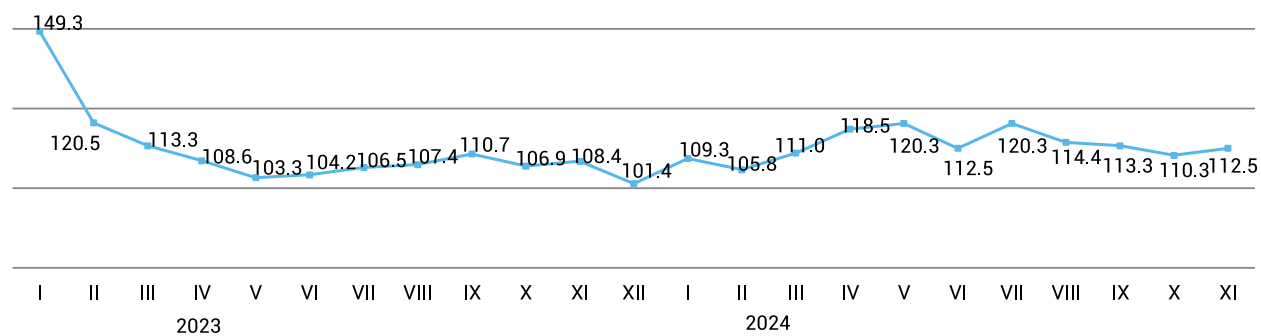

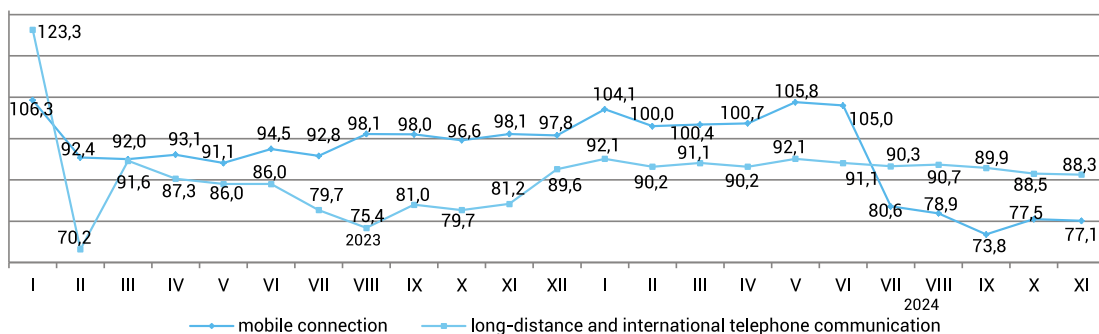

## Statistics of communications

Indices of the physical volume for communication services in January-November 2024 compared to January-November 2023 amounted to 105.3%, of which 116.6% for Internet services, 100.3% for other telecommunications services and 85% for mobile services. As of December 1, 2024, the number of active subjects SMEs increased by 2.1% compared to the corresponding date of the previous year. In the total number of active subjects SMEs, the share of individual entrepreneurs was 69.8%, legal entities of small enterprises – 17.4%, peasant or farm enterprises – 12.6%, legal entities of medium enterprises – 0.2%.
