2. Social indicators

2.1 Population size and migration

The population of the country as of February 1, 2025 amounted to 20300,6 thousand people, including urban – 12795,5 thousand (63%), rural – 7505,1 thousand (37%) people.

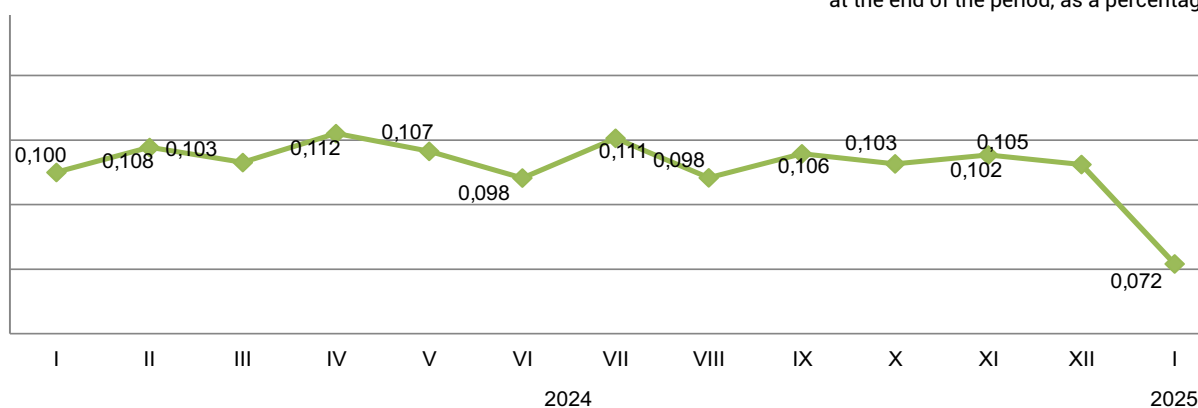
In January 2025, compared to January 2024, the number of arrivals in Kazakhstan decreased by 29,9%, the number of departures from Kazakhstan decreased by 83,8%.

The main migration exchange of the country takes place with the CIS countries. The share of arrivals from the CIS countries and departures to these countries amounted to 78,3% and 50%, respectively.

The number of migrants moving within the country increased by 13%. In terms of interregional movements, a positive net migration of population has developed in 4 regions of the country: the cities of Astana (6483 people), Almaty (3792 people), Shymkent (1023 people) and Almaty region (583 people).

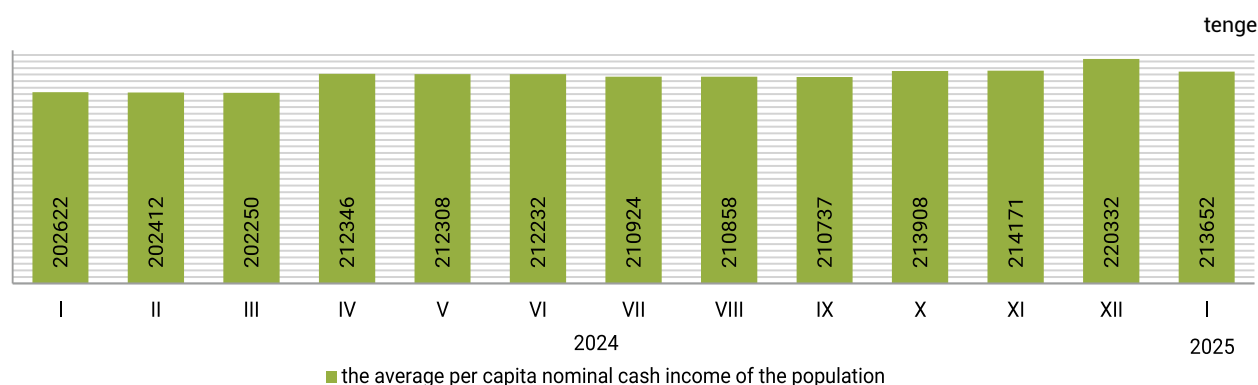

2.2 Income of the population

The average per capita nominal cash income of the population, according to an estimate in January 2025, amounted to 213652 tenge (preliminary data), which is 5.4% higher than in January 2024, real cash income for the specified period decreased by 3.2%.

2.3 Employment of the population

The number of unemployed, determined according to the methodology of the ILO, in the IV quarter of 2024¹⁾ amounted to 448,3 thousand people, the unemployment rate was 4,6%.

The employed population²⁾ amounted to 9197 thousand people, including employees – 7047,8 thousand people, individual entrepreneurs – 1696,3 thousand people, persons engaged in private practice – 31,1 thousand people, individuals, who are founders (participants) of business partnerships and founders, shareholders (participants) of joint-stock companies, as well as members of production cooperatives – 22,3 thousand people, independent workers – 399,5 thousand people.

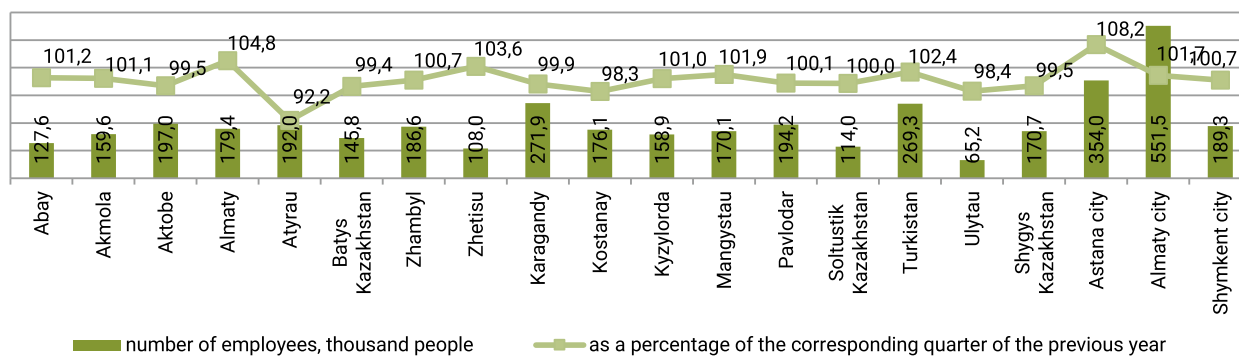

The number of employees at enterprises (organizations) in the IV quarter of 2024³⁾ amounted to 3981,1 thousand people, of which at large and medium-sized enterprises – 2872,3 thousand people.

In the IV quarter of 2024, 247,7 thousand people were hired by enterprises. 250.5 thousand people dropped out for various reasons. Worked by one employee 481,7 hours.

At the end of the IV quarter of 2024, 53,4 thousand vacancies were not filled at enterprises (1,3% of the number of employees).

2.4 Remuneration of labor at enterprises and organizations*

In the IV quarter of 2024, the average monthly nominal salary amounted to 434982 tenge (excluding employees of small enterprises engaged in entrepreneurial activities). In the IV quarter of 2024, the median salary was estimated to be 308717 tenge.

From January 1, 2024, the minimum wage is set at 85000 tenge.

3. Economic indicators

3.1 Statistics of prices

In February 2025, the monthly consumer price index was 1.5% (in January 2025 – 1.1%). Prices for paid services increased by 2.1%, food products – by 1.5%, non-food products – by 1%.

In the field of housing and communal services, tariffs for cold water increased by 29.2%, central heating – by 6.2%, hot water – by 5.3%, intercom – by 4.7%, electricity – by 1.8%. Bath services increased by 2.1%, initial appointment with a doctor by – 1.9%, hairdressers and beauty salons – by 1.3%.

Among food products, prices for cucumbers increased by 12.7%, cabbage – by 12.3%, tomatoes – by 6.1%, beets – by 5.1%, lemons – by 4.9%, beef – by 3.7%, garlic – by 3.2%, potatoes, grapes – by 3.1%, sunflower oil – by 3%, apples – by 2.7%, lamb – by 2.3%. A decrease in prices was noted for oranges by 2.2%, rice – by 1.4%, eggs – by 1.2%, buckwheat groats – by 1%.

The price increase in February was noted for household appliances by 2.5%, cars – by 1.3%, building materials – by 1.1%, clothing and footwear – by 1%. Liquefied natural gas in cylinders rose in price by 10.5%.

In February 2025, compared with the previous month, the producer price index for agricultural products was 98.6%, crop production – 100.3%, livestock products – 96.7%.

Prices for pome fruits decreased by 4%, berries – 3.5%, carrots – by 1%, buckwheat – by 0.8%, millet – by 0.6%, wheat – by 0.2%.

The increase in prices was noted for indoor cucumbers by 18.9%, indoor cucumbers by 4.9%, table beets by 3.5%, potatoes by 1.3%, sunflower seeds by 0.7%.

Among livestock products, egg prices decreased by 5.2%, natural honey prices increased by 6.9%.

Prices of manufacturing enterprises for industrial products in February 2025 decreased by 0.2% compared to the previous month. Metal ores prices were lower by 3.7%, oil – by 1%, natural gas – by 0.7%, coal – higher by 3.4%. Of petroleum products, propane and butane liquefied rose in price by 5.6%, diesel fuel – by 0.9%, gasoline – by 0.7%, fuel oil – by 0.4%.

An decrease in prices was noted for lead by 7.9%, zinc – by 7.5%, aluminum – by 4.3%, copper – by 1.4%, for precious metals – a increase by 2.3%, rolled ferrous metals – by 0.7%.

From food products, sugar rose in price by 3.7%, tea – by 2.4%, poultry meat – by 1.5%, pasta – by 1.2%, dairy products – by 0.9%, livestock meat – by 0.7%, wheat flour fell in price by 3%, rice – by 0.5%.

In the service sector, tariffs for the transportation of goods by all modes of transport in February 2025 decreased by 3.7% compared to the previous month, while tariffs for communication services and tariffs for postal and courier services remained unchanged.

In February 2025 compared to the previous month the price index in construction amounted to 99.9%. Prices for construction and installation work decreased by – 0.2%, for work and costs increased by 0.4%, machinery and equipment by 2%.

3.4 Investment statistics

In January-February 2025, the volume of investments in fixed capital amounted to 1 857,5 billion tenge, which is 0,5% more than in January-February 2024.

The predominant sources of investment financing remain the own funds of economic entities, the volume of which in January-February 2025 amounted to 1 259,8 billion tenge.

In January-February 2025, compared with January-February 2024, there is an increase costs for works on construction and capital repair of buildings and constructions by 18.3%.

A significant share of investments in fixed capital in January-February 2025 accounted for industry (40,5%) (including mining and quarrying – 22,4%, manufacturing industry – 11%), operations with real estate (20,2%), transport and warehousing and education (12%).

The volume of investments of large enterprises in January-February 2025 amounted to 652,6 billion tenge.

3.5 Statistics of domestic trade

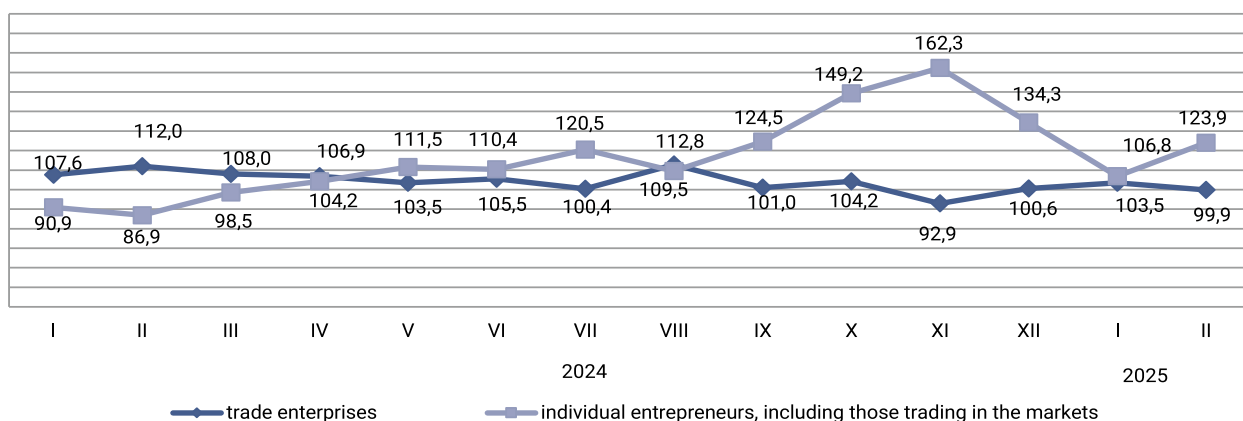
The volume of retail trade in January-February 2025 amounted to 2786,1 billion tenge, which is 4,7% more than the corresponding period in 2024. Retail sales of goods by trading enterprises increased by 1,7%, individual entrepreneurs, including those trading in the markets, increased by 16,1% compared to January-February 2024.

As of March 1, 2025, the volume of commodity stocks of trading enterprises (for reporting enterprises) in retail trade amounted to 1525,1 billion tenge, in trading days - 69 days.

The share of food products in the total volume of retail trade is 27,2%, non-food products – 72,8%. The volume of sales of food products compared to January-February 2024 increased by 4,5%, non-food products increased by 4,7%.

The volume of wholesale trade in January-February 2025 amounted to 6102,4 billion tenge, which is 6,6% more than the corresponding period in 2024. Non-food products and industrial and technical products (80,8%) prevail in the structure of wholesale trade.

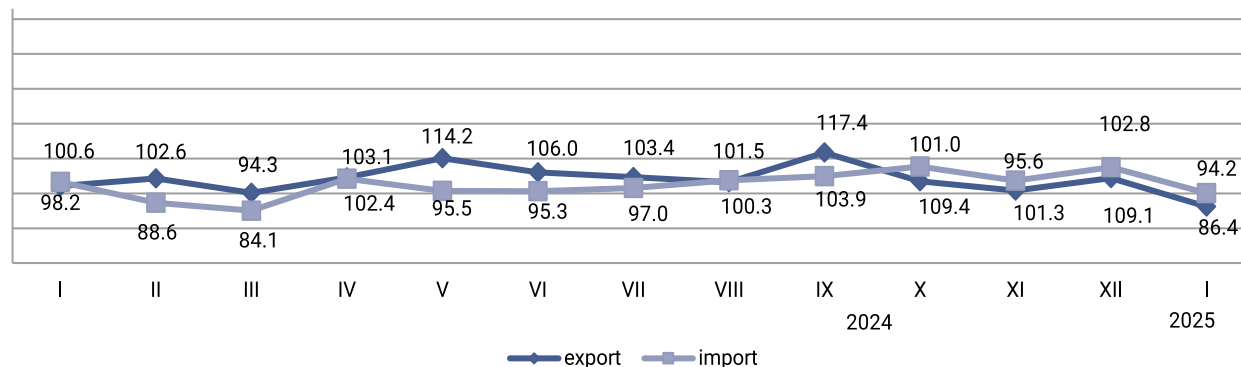

Foreign trade turnover in January 2025 amounted to 9,1 billion US dollars (decreased by 10,3% in nominal terms compared to January 2024) including exports – 5,1 billion US dollars (13.6% less) and imports – 4 billion US dollars (less by 5,8%).

Exports with the EAEU countries amounted to 600,7 million US dollars or 17,6% less than in January 2024, imports – 1162,5 million US dollars decreased by 4,9% compared to the corresponding period last year.

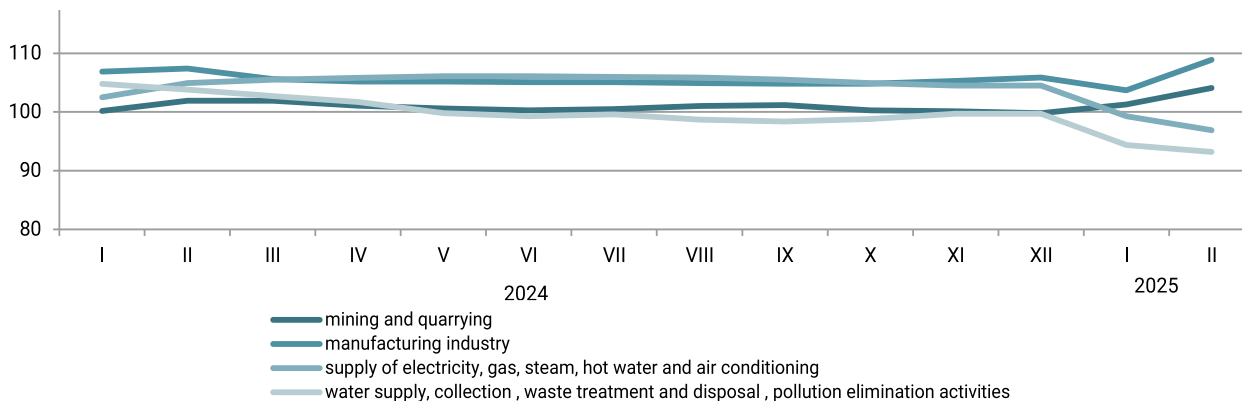

3.9 Statistics of building and housing construction

In January-February 2025, the volume of construction work increased by 12,8% and amounted to 408,1 billion tenge.

The largest amount of work in January-February 2025 was performed on the construction of non-residential buildings (185,2 billion tenge) facilities (171,6 billion tenge) and residential buildings (51,3 billion tenge).

The volume of construction and installation work in January-February 2025 compared to January-February 2024 increased by 8,6% and amounted to 360,8 billion tenge. The volume of construction work on major repairs increased by 62,6% and on current repairs by 59,6%.

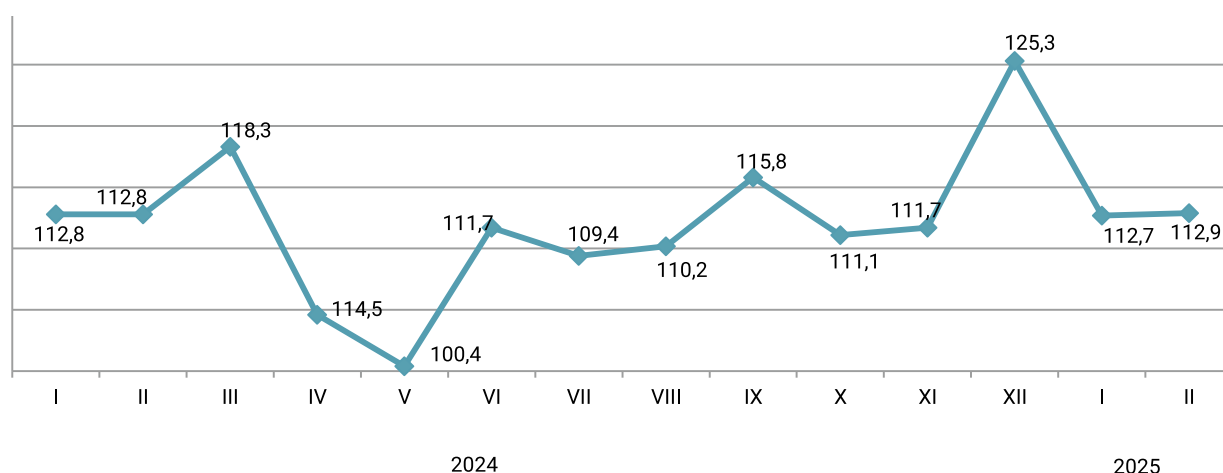
In January-February 2025, the construction of 4478 new buildings was completed, of which 4159 are residential and 319 are non-residential.

as a percentages of the corresponding month of the previous year



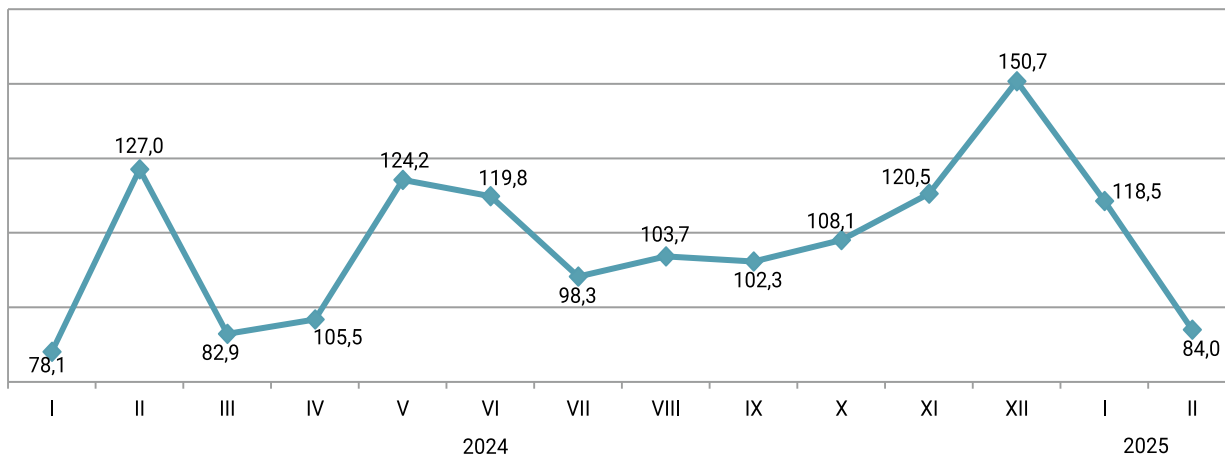

In January-February 2025, 362,4 billion tenge was allocated for housing construction. In the total volume of investments in fixed capital, the share of disbursed funds in housing construction amounted to 19,5%.

The main source of financing for housing construction in January-February 2025 is the own funds of developers, the share of which is 91,1%.

as a percentages of the corresponding month of the previous year

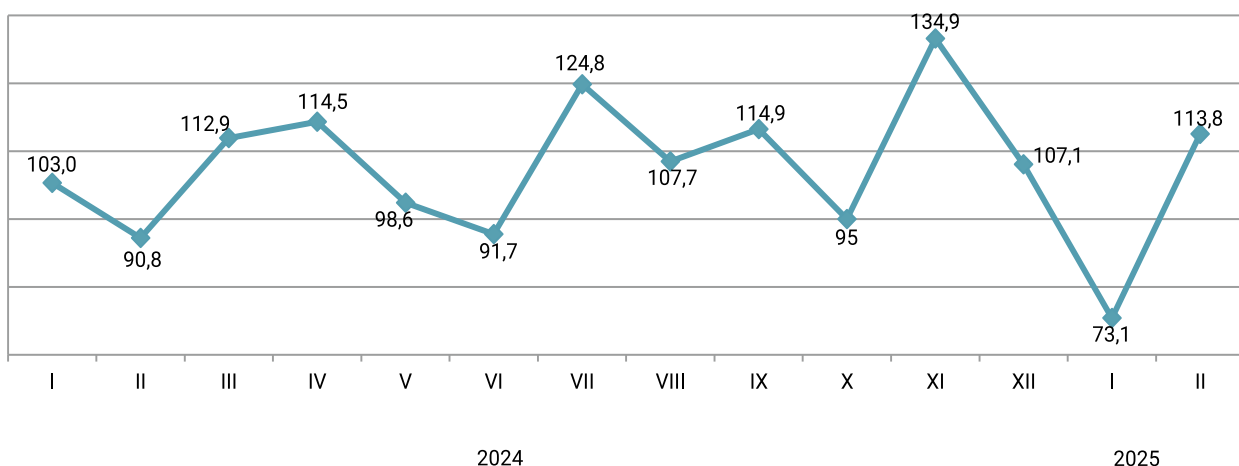


In January- February 2025, the total area of housing put into operation to January-February 2024 decreased by 6,8% and amounted to 1933,2 thousand square meters, of which in multi-apartment buildings – by 10,2% (1215,9 thousand square meters), of individual residential buildings increased – by 2% (713 thousand square meters).

In the total volume of commissioned housing, the share of multi-apartment buildings was 62,9%, individual – 36,9%. The average actual cost of construction of 1 square meter of total housing area increased by 14,7%.

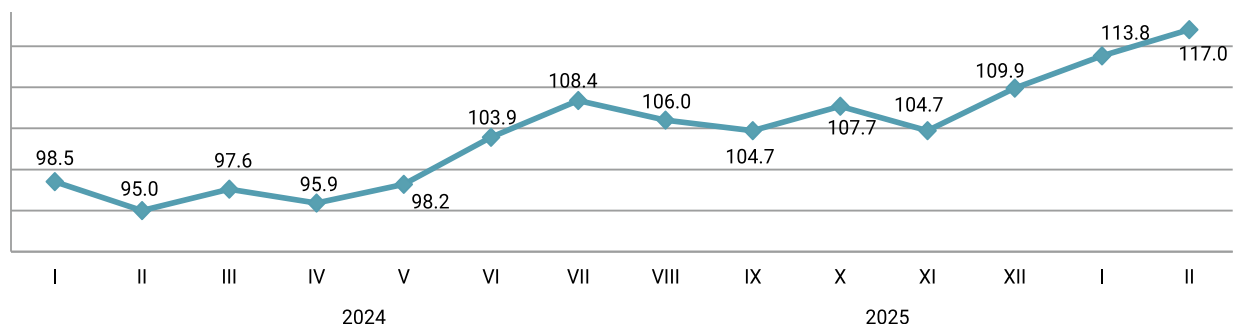

3.10 Statistics of transport

Cargo turnover

Cargo turnover for January-February 2025 increased by 15,4% from the level of the corresponding period of the previous year and amounted to 89,8 billion t-km. In January-February 2025 compared to January-February 2024 there is an increase in cargo turnover in rail transport (by 11,8%), pipeline transport (by 13,1%) and automobile (by 68,8%) transport.

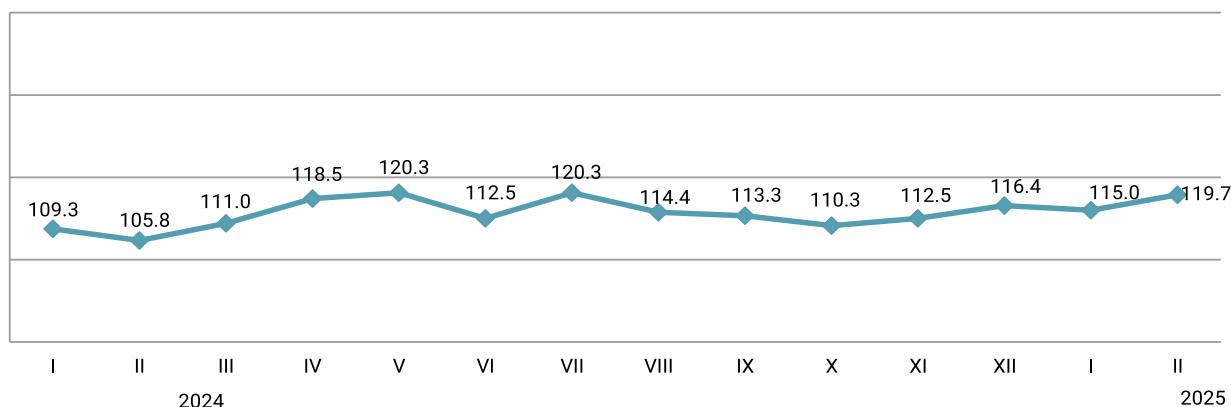

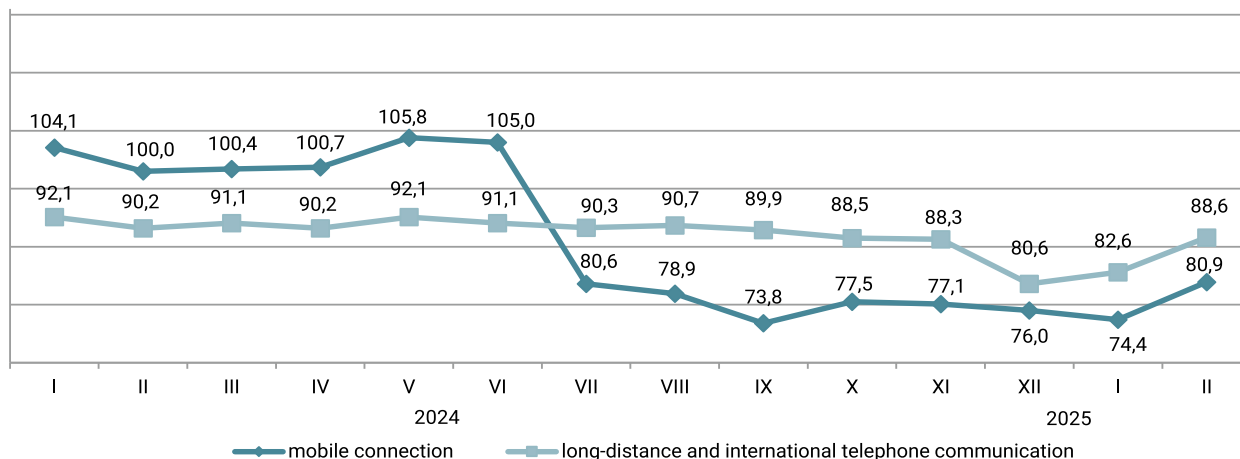

3.12 Statistics of enterprises

In February, compared to January 2025, there is a slight increase in the number of registered legal entities (by 0,2%), compared to the corresponding period of the previous year, their number increased by 1,9%. At the same time, there is an decrease in the number of operating legal entities - by 0,8%, compared to the corresponding period of the previous year, their number increased by 0,2%. Since the beginning of the year, by type of economic activity, the largest number of registered legal entities remains in the industry «Wholesale and retail trade; car and motorcycle repair», the share of which as of March 1, 2025, amounted to 27,2%. On the second place - "Construction" (13,3%), on the third - "Provision of other types of services" (10%). Together, the share of these three types of activities is 50,5% of all registered legal entities.
