2. Social indicators

2.1 Population size and migration

The population of the country as of March 1, 2025 amounted to 20316,2 thousand people, including urban – 12813,8 thousand (63%), rural – 7502,4 thousand (37%) people.

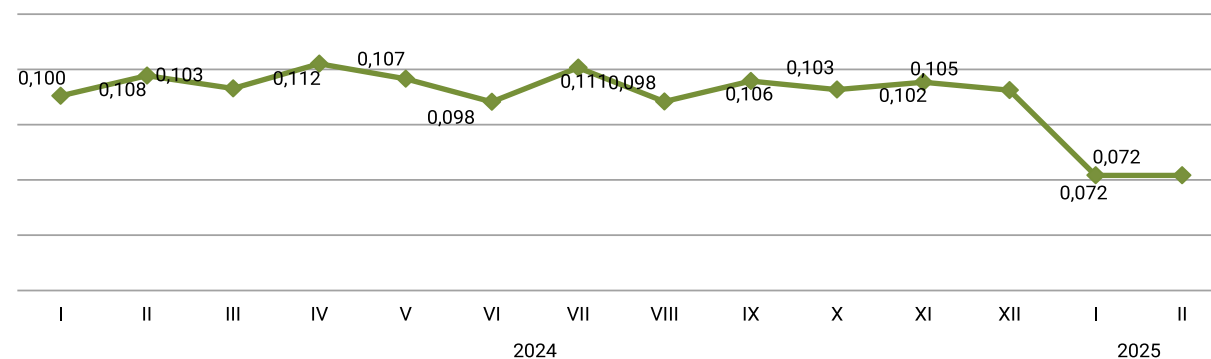
In February 2025, compared to February 2024, the number of arrivals in Kazakhstan decreased by 32,9%, the number of departures from Kazakhstan decreased by 81,2%.

The main migration exchange of the country takes place with the CIS countries. The share of arrivals from the CIS countries and departures to these countries amounted to 85,5% and 66,9%, respectively.

The number of migrants moving within the country increased by 18,3%. In terms of interregional movements, a positive net migration of population has developed in 4 regions of the country: the cities of Astana (12152 people), Almaty (5492 people), Shymkent (2057 people) and Almaty region (2199 people).

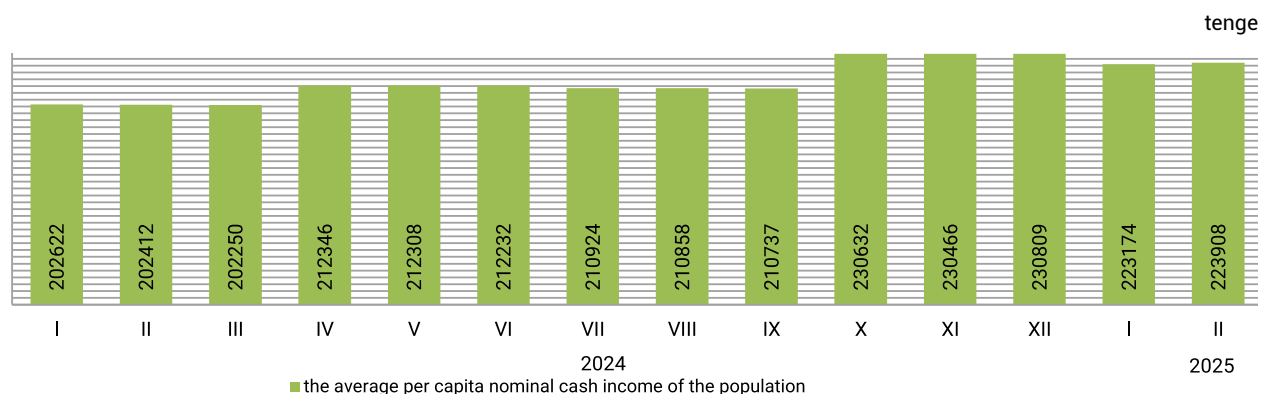

2.2 Income of the population

The average per capita nominal cash income of the population, according to an estimate in February 2025, amounted to 223908 tenge (preliminary data), which is 10.6% higher than in February 2024, real cash income for the specified period increased by 1.1%.

2.3 Employment of the population

The number of unemployed, determined according to the methodology of the ILO, in the IV quarter of 2024¹⁾ amounted to 448,3 thousand people, the unemployment rate was 4,6%.

The employed population²⁾ amounted to 9197 thousand people, including employees – 7047,8 thousand people, individual entrepreneurs – 1696,3 thousand people, persons engaged in private practice – 31,1 thousand people, individuals, who are founders (participants) of business partnerships and founders, shareholders (participants) of joint-stock companies, as well as members of production cooperatives – 22,3 thousand people, independent workers – 399,5 thousand people.

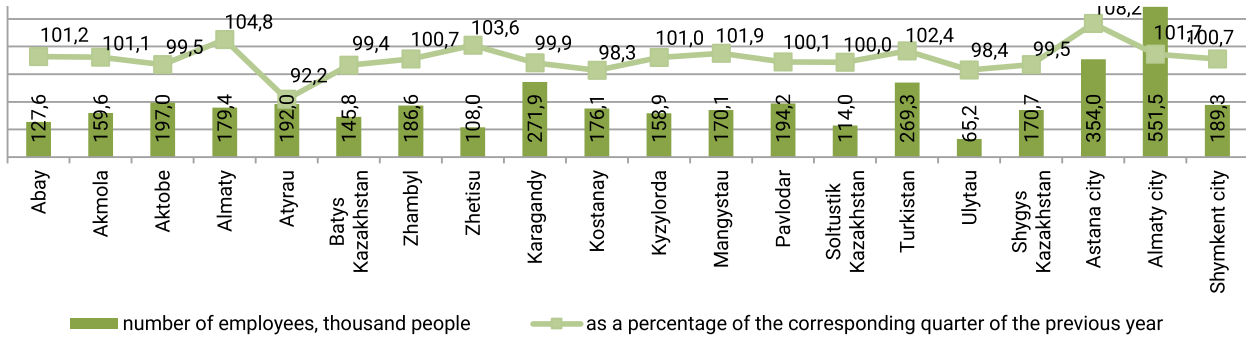

The number of employees at enterprises (organizations) in the IV quarter of 2024³⁾ amounted to 3981,1 thousand people, of which at large and medium-sized enterprises – 2872,3 thousand people.

In the IV quarter of 2024, 247,7 thousand people were hired by enterprises. 250.5 thousand people dropped out for various reasons. Worked by one employee 481,7 hours.

At the end of the IV quarter of 2024, 53,4 thousand vacancies were not filled at enterprises (1,3% of the number of employees).

In the IV quarter of 2024, the average monthly nominal salary amounted to 434982 tenge (excluding employees of small enterprises engaged in entrepreneurial activities). In the IV quarter of 2024, the median salary was estimated to be 308717 tenge.

From January 1, 2024, the minimum wage is set at 85000 tenge.

3. Economic indicators

3.1 Statistics of prices

In March 2025, the monthly consumer price index was 1.3%. Prices for food products by 1.6%, paid services increased – by 1.3%, non-food products – by 0.8%.

Among food products, prices increased for bananas by 14.5%, tomatoes – by 11.4%, beets – by 8.5%, cabbage – by 7.4%, beef – by 3.5%, lamb, potatoes – by 3.4%, oranges, granulated sugar – by 3.2%, grapes – by 3.1%, brine cheeses – by 3%. A decrease in prices was noted for cucumbers by 6.8%, eggs – by 1.8%, onions – by 1.3%, sweet peppers – by 1.1%.

In the sphere of housing and communal services, tariffs for cold water increased by 15.2%, sanitation – by 11.9%, central heating – by 3.1%, and hot water – by 2.4%. Railway passenger transport services rose in price by 3.2%, dental services – by 2.3%.

The increase in prices in March this year was noted for tablets by 10.4%, laptops – by 8%, furniture and household items, and a gold wedding ring – by 2%. Liquefied natural gas in cylinders rose in price by 2.1%.

In March 2025, compared with the previous month, the producer price index for agricultural products was 99.9%, crop production – 100.8%, livestock products – 99%.

Prices for indoor cucumbers decreased by 18.2%, perennial crops by 1.9%, buckwheat by 1.2%.

Prices increased for indoor tomatoes by 21%, potatoes by 3.7%, sunflower seeds by 1%, wheat by 0.8%.

Among livestock products, egg prices decreased by 1.7%, while horse prices increased by 1.3%.

Prices of manufacturing enterprises for industrial products in March 2025 increase by 0.3% compared to the previous month. Coal prices were higher by 1.8%, metal ores – by 0.9%, oil – lower by 1.4%, natural gas – by 0.6%. Of petroleum products, gasoline rose in price by 2.4%, diesel fuel – by 1.3%, propane and butane liquefied fell in price by 1.6%.

An increase in prices was noted for rolled ferrous metals by 2.5%, lead – by 2%, precious metals and copper – by 1.2%, aluminum – by 1.1%, for zinc – a decrease by 3%.

From food products, sugar rose in price by 3.4%, pasta – by 1.9%, wheat flour – by 1.3%, livestock meat – by 1.2%, poultry meat – by 1%, bread, dairy products and vegetable oil – by 0.4%, rice fell in price by 0.3%.

In the service sector, tariffs for the transportation of goods by all modes of transport in March 2025 increased by 0.2% compared to the previous month, while tariffs for communication services and tariffs for postal and courier services remained unchanged.

In March 2025 compared to the previous month the price index in construction amounted to 100.5%. Prices for construction and installation work increased by – 0.4%, work and costs by 0.4%, machinery and equipment by 2.4%.

3.4 Investment statistics

In January-March 2025, the volume of investments in fixed capital amounted to 3067,9 billion tenge, which is 6,3% more than in January-March 2024.

The predominant sources of investment financing remain the own funds of economic entities, the volume of which in January-March 2025 amounted to 2071,9 billion tenge.

In January-March 2025, compared with January-March 2024, there is an increase costs for works on construction and capital repair of buildings and constructions by 21.5%.

A significant share of investments in fixed capital in January-March 2025 accounted for industry (39,2%) (including mining and quarrying – 19,2%, manufacturing industry – 12,7%), operations with real estate (20,6%), transport and warehousing (13,4%) and education (10,1%).

The volume of investments of large enterprises in January-March 2025 amounted to 982,2 billion tenge.

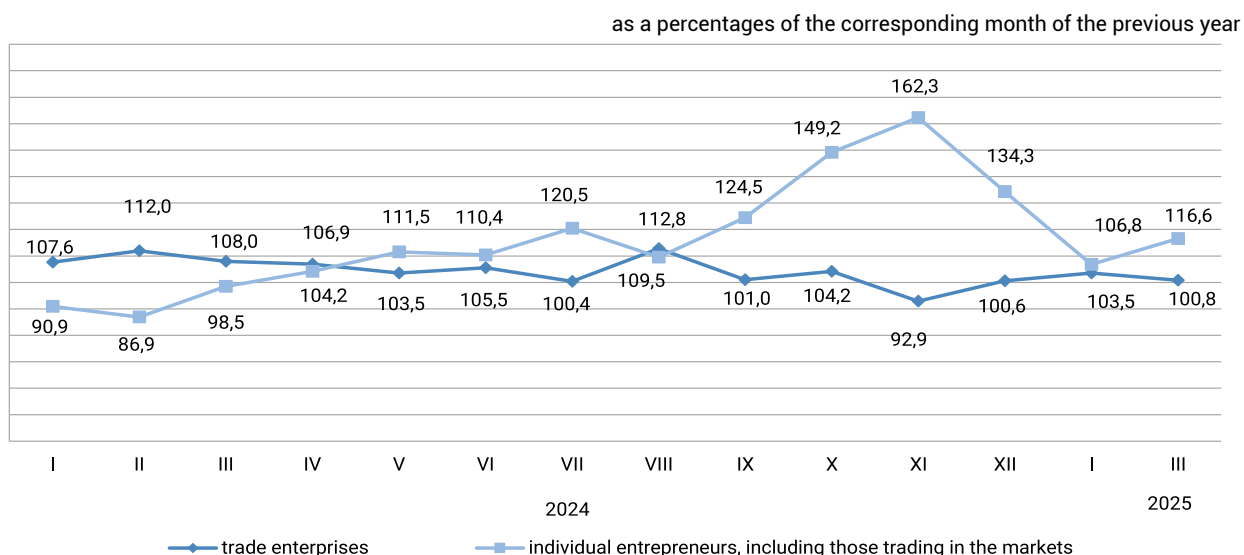
3.5 Statistics of domestic trade

The volume of retail trade in January-March 2025 amounted to 4582.6 billion tenge, which is 4.8% more than the corresponding period in 2024. Retail sales of goods by trading enterprises increased by 1.4%, individual entrepreneurs, including those trading in the markets, increased by 16.4% compared to January-March 2024.

As of April 1, 2025, the volume of commodity stocks of trading enterprises (for reporting enterprises) in retail trade amounted to 1572.1 billion tenge, in trading days - 69 days.

The share of food products in the total volume of retail trade is 28.8%, non-food products –71.2%. The volume of sales of food products compared to January-March 2024 increased by 3.6%, non-food products increased by 5.3%.

The volume of wholesale trade in January-March 2025 amounted to 9395.4 billion tenge, which is 7% more than the corresponding period in 2024. Non-food products and industrial and technical products (82.2%) prevail in the structure of wholesale trade.

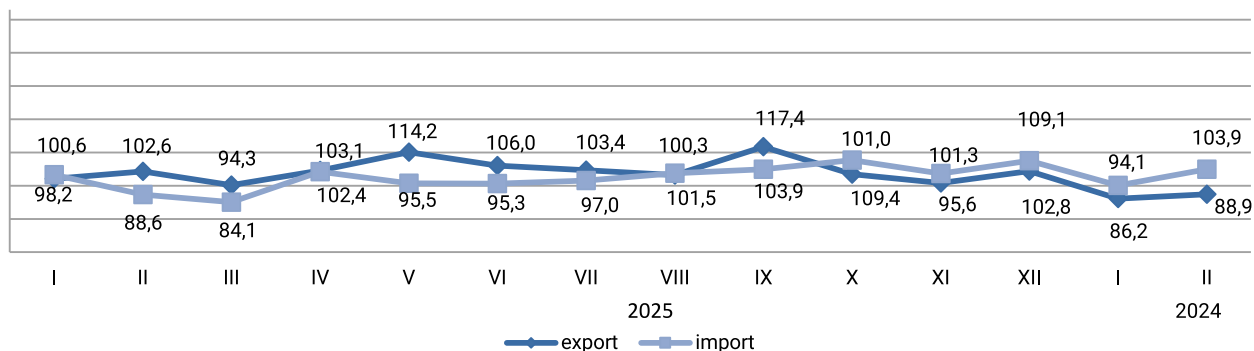

Foreign trade turnover in January-February 2025 amounted to 19 billion US dollars (decreased by 7,8% in nominal terms compared to January-February 2024) including exports – 10,8 billion US dollars (12,4% less) and imports – 8,3 billion US dollars (less by 1,1%).

Exports with the EAEU countries amounted to 1220,1 million US dollars or 19,7% less than in January-February 2024, imports – 2511,3 million US dollars decreased by 4,9% compared to the corresponding period last year.

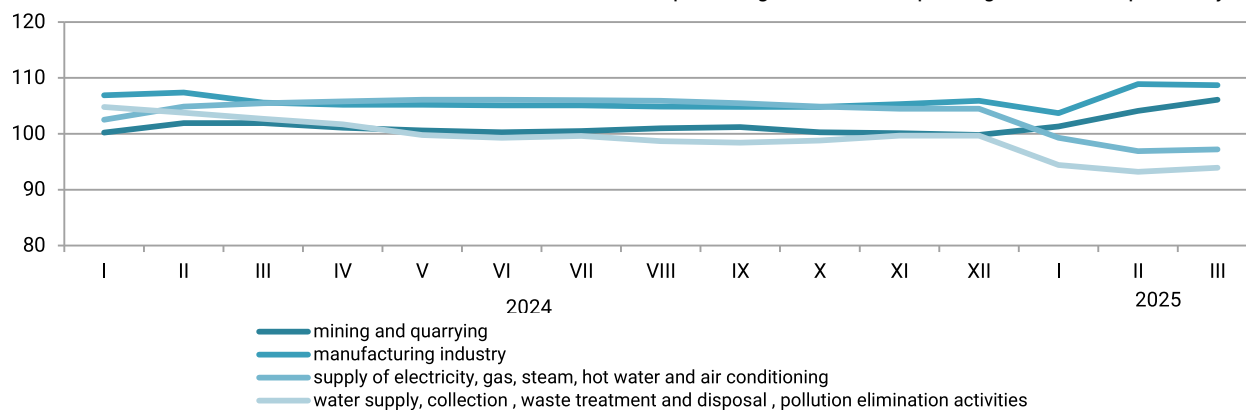

3.9 Statistics of building and housing construction

In January-March 2025, the volume of construction work increased by 16,9% and amounted to 1014,8 billion tenge.

The largest amount of work in January-March 2025 was performed on the construction of facilities (467,6 billion tenge), non-residential buildings (373,3 billion tenge) and residential buildings (173,9 billion tenge).

The volume of construction and installation work in January-March 2025 compared to January-March 2024 increased by 14% and amounted to 887,9 billion tenge. The volume of construction work on major repairs increased by 49,9% and on current repairs by 33,3%.

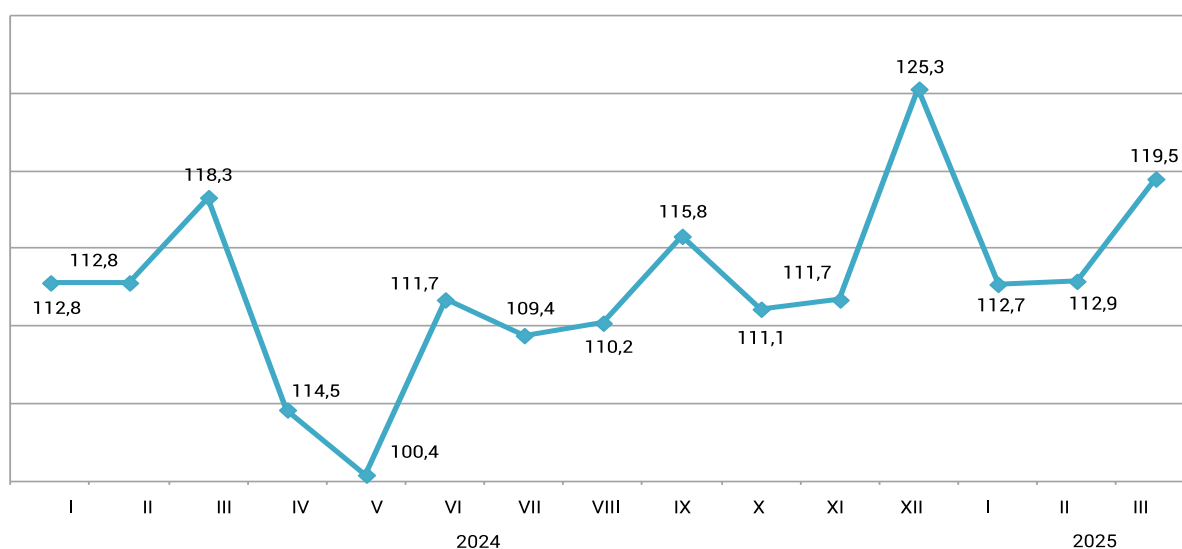
In January-March 2025, the construction of 7450 new buildings was completed, of which 6879 are residential and 571 are non-residential.

as a percentages of the corresponding month of the previous year



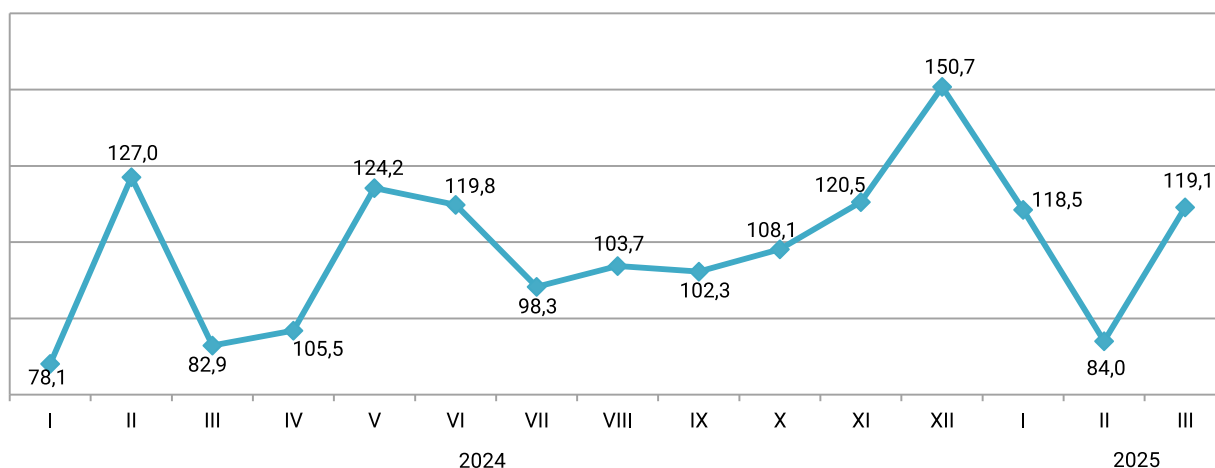

as a percentages of the corresponding month of the previous year

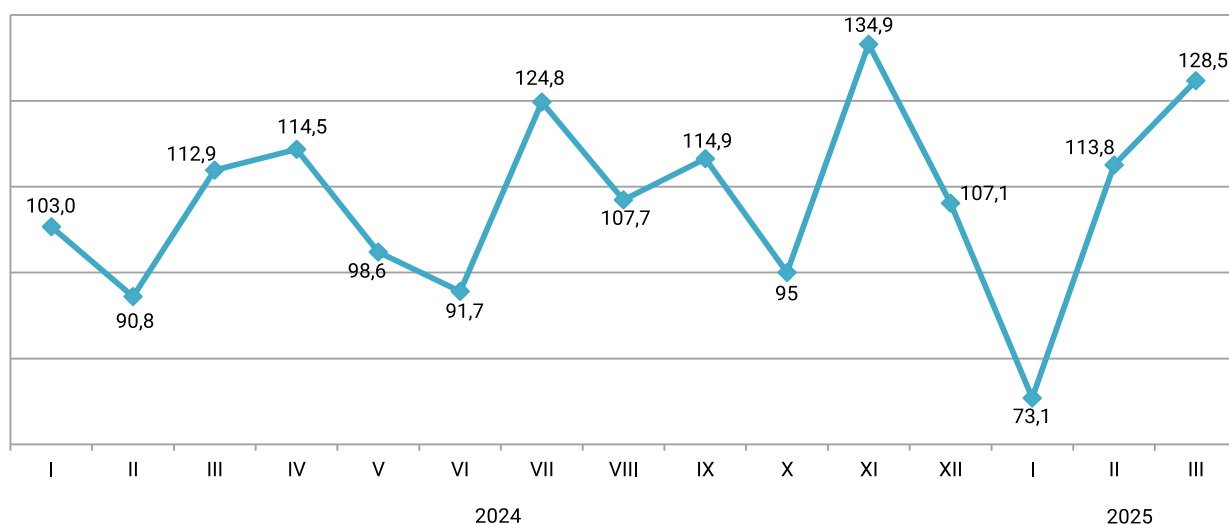


In January-March 2025, the total area of housing put into operation to January-March 2024 increased by 7,4% and amounted to 3729,1 thousand square meters, of which in multi-apartment buildings – by 10,3% (2495,4 thousand square meters), of individual residential buildings – by 2,7% (1218,4 thousand square meters).

In the total volume of commissioned housing, the share of multi-apartment buildings was 66,9%, individual – 32,7%. The average actual cost of construction of 1 square meter of total housing area increased by 9,9%.

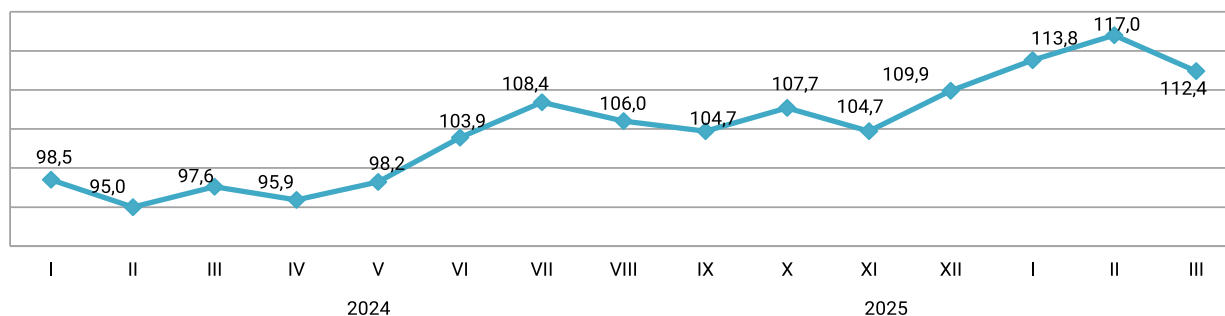

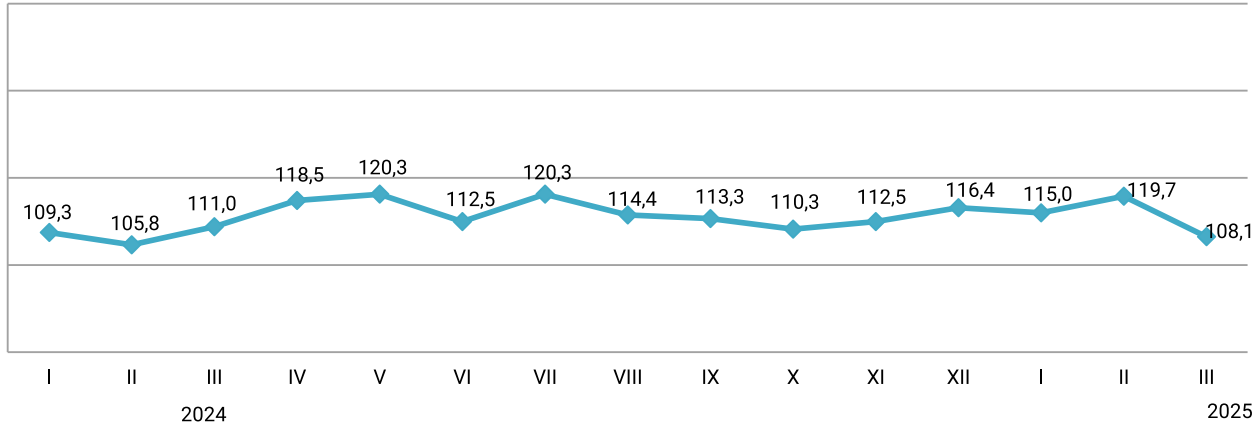

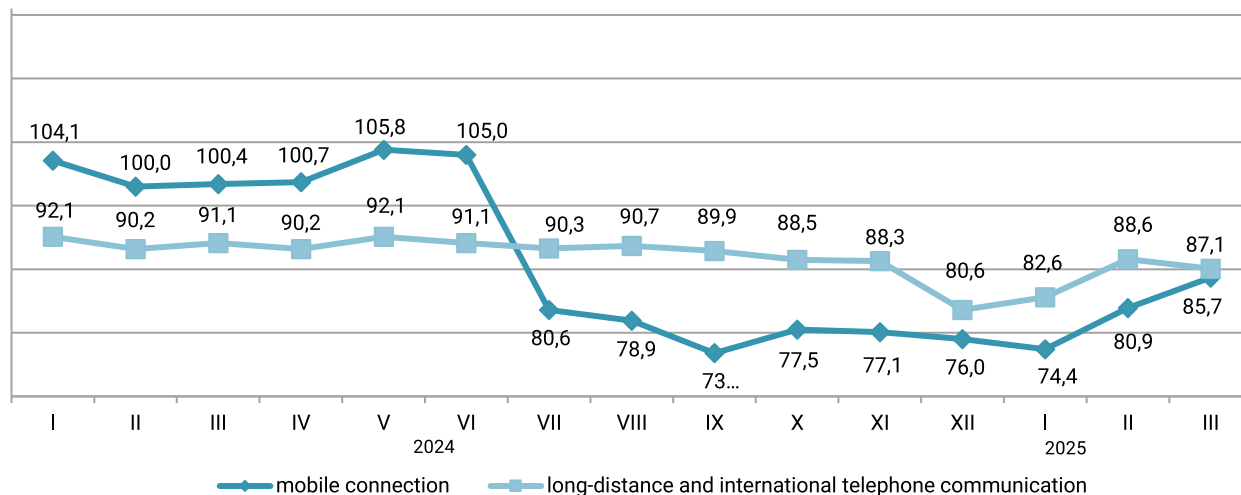

3.11 Statistics of communications

3.12 Statistics of enterprises

In March, compared to February 2025, there is a slight increase in the number of registered legal entities (by 0.2%), compared to the corresponding period of the previous year, their number increased by 2.0%. At the same time, there is an increase in the number of operating legal entities - by 0.2%, compared to the corresponding period of the previous year, their number increased by 0.06%. Since the beginning of the year, by type of economic activity, the largest number of registered legal entities remains in the industry «Wholesale and retail trade; car and motorcycle repair», the share of which as of April 1, 2025, amounted to 27.1%. On the second place - "Construction" (13.3%), on the third - "Provision of other types of services" (10.1%). Together, the share of these three types of activities is 50.5% of all registered legal entities.
