2. Social indicators

2.1 Population size and migration

The population of the country as of April 1, 2025 amounted to 20333,5 thousand people, including urban population – 12833,1 thousand (63,1%), and rural population – 7500,4 thousand (35,9%) people.

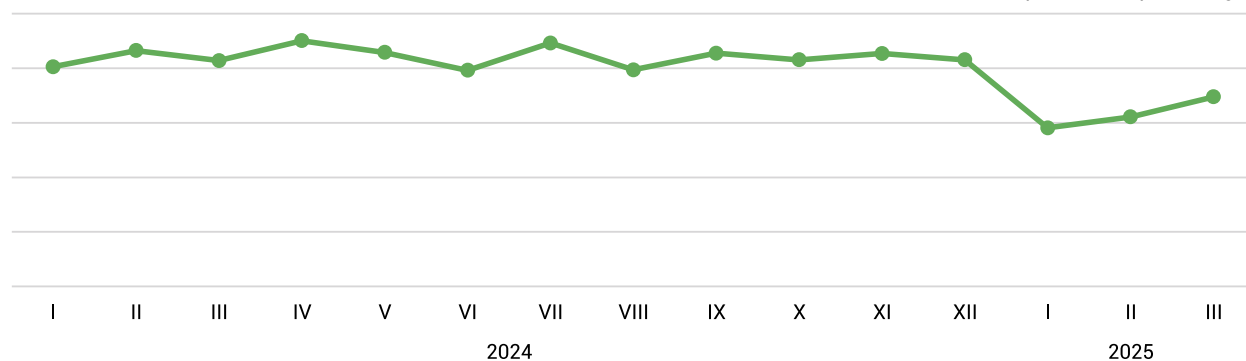
In March 2025, compared to March 2024, the number of arrivals in Kazakhstan decreased by 35,9%, while the number of departures from Kazakhstan decreased by 43,1%.

The main migration exchange of the country takes place with the CIS countries. The share of arrivals from the CIS countries and departures to these countries amounted to 82,0% and 68,9%, respectively.

The number of internal migrants increased by 18,7%. In terms of interregional migration, a positive net migration was recorded in 3 regions of the country: the cities of Astana (5427 people), Almaty (3233 people), and Shymkent (1151 people).

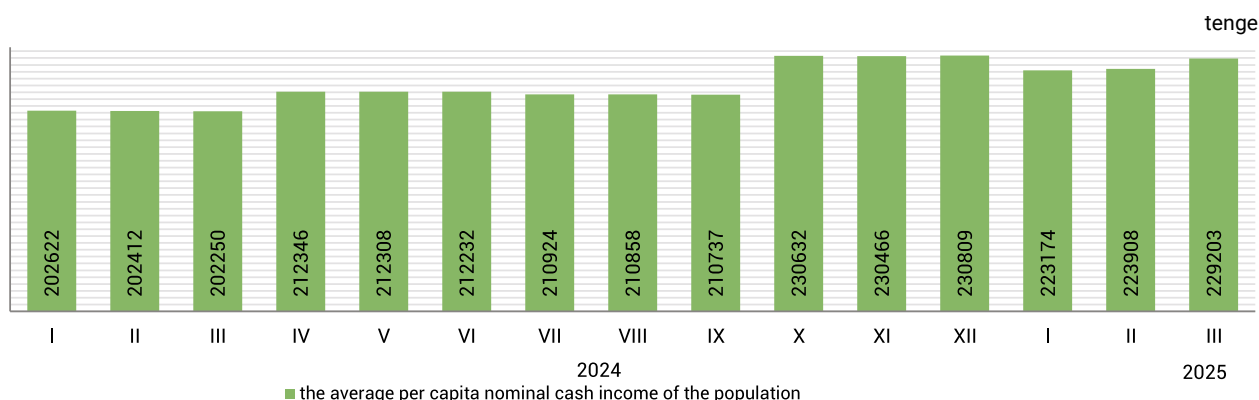

2.2 Income of the population

The average per capita nominal cash income of the population, according to an estimate in March 2025, amounted to 229203 tenge (preliminary data), which is 13.3% higher than in March 2024, real cash income for the specified period increased by 3%.

2.3 Employment of the population

The number of unemployed, determined according to the methodology of the ILO, in the I quarter of 2025¹⁾ amounted to 451,5 thousand people, the unemployment rate was 4,6%.

The employed population²⁾ amounted to 9283,5 thousand people, including employees – 7141 thousand people, individual entrepreneurs – 1760,5 thousand people, persons engaged in private practice – 17,3 thousand people, individuals, who are founders (participants) of business partnerships and founders, shareholders (participants) of joint-stock companies, as well as members of production cooperatives – 7,5 thousand people, independent workers – 357,2 thousand people.

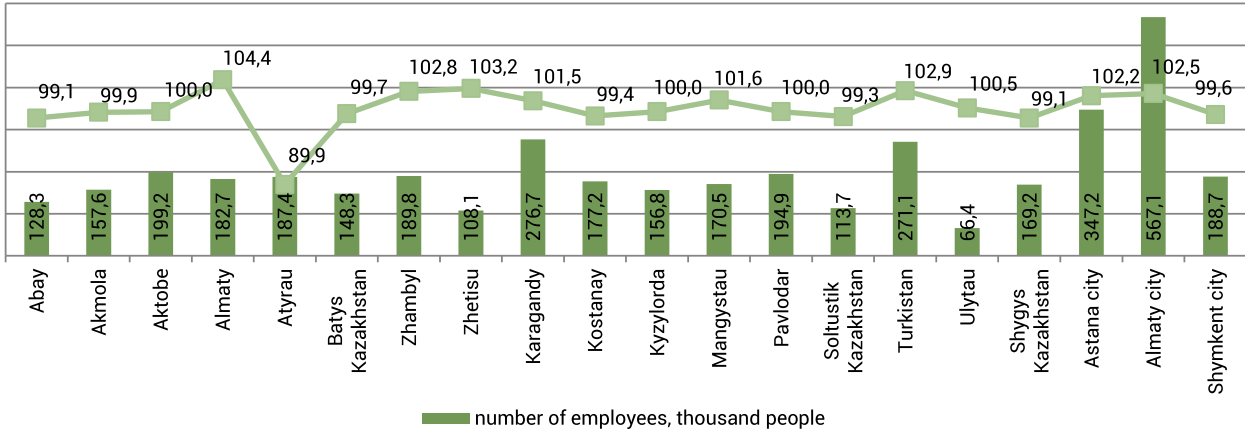

The number of employees at enterprises (organizations) in the I quarter of 2025³⁾ amounted to 4000,8 thousand people, of which at large and medium-sized enterprises – 2872,9 thousand people.

In the I quarter of 2025, 263,8 thousand people were hired by enterprises. 258,5 thousand people dropped out for various reasons. Worked by one employee 445,1 hours.

At the end of the I quarter of 2025, 59,0 thousand vacancies were not filled at enterprises (1,5% of the number of employees).

In the I quarter of 2025, the average monthly nominal salary amounted to 423133 tenge (excluding employees of small enterprises engaged in entrepreneurial activities). In the I quarter of 2025, the median salary was estimated to be 300307 tenge.

From January 1, 2025, the minimum wage is set at 85000 tenge.

3. Economic indicators

3.1 Statistics of prices

In April 2025, the monthly consumer price index was 1,2% (in March 2025 – 1,3%). Prices for paid services increased by 1,9%, food products – by 1,1%, non-food products – by 0,6%.

In the sphere of housing and communal services, tariffs for garbage removal increased by 4,5%. Bathhouses services rose in price by 5%, hairdressers and beauty salons – by 2,6%, catering services – by 2%. Prices for Internet communication services and cinemas increased by 4%, sanatoriums – by 3,8%, medical laboratories and X-ray rooms – by 2,5%, dental services – by 2,1%.

Among food products, prices increased for cabbage by 20,2%, beets – by 11,7%, bulb onions – by 11,5%, carrots – by 9,2%, potatoes, lemons – by 7,1%, olive oil – by 6,6%, grapes – by 6,5%, sweet peppers – by 5,9%, salted herring – by 4%, mutton – by 3,3%, beef, sugar – by 2,2%. A decrease in prices was noted for cucumbers by 14,3%, tomatoes – by 5%, oatmeal – by 4,3%, oranges – by 2%, rice – by 0,4%, eggs – by 0,3%.

An increase in prices in April this year was noted for a gold engagement ring by 2,3%, clothing and shoes – by 1%, medicines – by 0,5%. Diesel fuel rose in price by 1,1%.

In April 2025, compared with the previous month, the producer price index for agricultural products amounted to 100,2%, crop production – 101,3%, livestock products – 98,9%.

Prices for wheat, except durum wheat, increased by 1,9%, sunflower seeds – by 2,6%, dried lentils – by 1,4%, rapeseed – by 0,5%, and rice – decreased by 1,3%, durum wheat – by 0,4%, barley – by 0,2%.

An increase in prices was noted for cucumbers indoor crops increased by 3,5%, fodder crops – by 3,3%, potatoes – by 2,9%, carrots – by 1,4%, beets – by 0,6%.

Cattle rose in price by 1,6%, horses – by 1,2%, raw cow's milk – by 0,2%, and natural honey – fell in price by 5%, eggs – by 1,8%.

Prices of manufacturing enterprises for industrial products in April 2025 increase by 0,8% compared to the previous month. Metal ores prices were higher by 3,5%, coal – by 1,6%, oil – lower by 0,8%. Of petroleum products, gasoline rose in price by 2%, diesel fuel – by 1,6%, propane and butane liquefied – by 1,1%.

An increase in prices was noted for lead by 6,6%, zinc – by 5,8%, precious metals – by 4,6%, copper – by 2,8%, aluminum – by 0,7%.

From food products, sugar rose in price by 7,6%, vegetable oil – by 2,8%, poultry meat – by 1,3%, pasta – by 0,9%, livestock meat – by 0,8%, wheat flour fell in price by 1,5%.

In the service sector, tariffs for the transportation of goods by all modes of transport in April 2025 remained unchanged compared to the previous month, tariffs for communication services increased by 0,2%, tariffs for postal and courier services decreased by 0,1%.

In April 2025 compared to the previous month the price index in construction amounted to 100,6%. Prices for construction and installation work increased by – 0,6%, work and costs by 0,4%, machinery and equipment by 0,7%.

3.3 Gross Domestic Product

In the structure of GDP for January-December 2024, flash estimates, the production of goods amounted to 35,4%, the production of services – 58,4%. The main share in the production of GDP is occupied by industry – 25,7%.

According to the reporting data, in the sectoral structure of income formation for January-December 2024, compensation of employees in the production of goods and services amounted to 28,6% and 36%, respectively, the share of other taxes on production is 0,9% in the production of goods and 1,5% in the production of services, respectively, the share of gross operating surplus /gross mixed income was 70,5 % and 62,5%.

The Gross Domestic Product by final expenditure method in January-December 2024, according to preliminary data, amounted to 131622823,4 million tenge. Compared to the corresponding period last year, in real terms there is an increase in the final consumption expenditure component by 5,7% due to an increase in household final consumption expenditure by 6,7% and non-profit organizations serving households by 12,8%.

3.4 Investment statistics

In January-April 2025, the volume of investments in fixed capital amounted to 4374,7 billion tenge, which is 13,7% more than in January-April 2024.

The predominant sources of investment financing remain the own funds of economic entities, the volume of which in January-April 2025 amounted to 2897,7 billion tenge.

In January-April 2025, compared with January-April 2024, there is an increase costs for works on construction and capital repair of buildings and constructions by 27,6%.

A significant share of investments in fixed capital in January-April 2025 accounted for industry (39,5%) (including mining and quarrying – 18,7%, manufacturing industry – 12,7%), operations with real estate (20,9%), transport and warehousing (13,2%) and education (9,7%).

The volume of investments of large enterprises in January-April 2025 amounted to 1436,2 billion tenge.

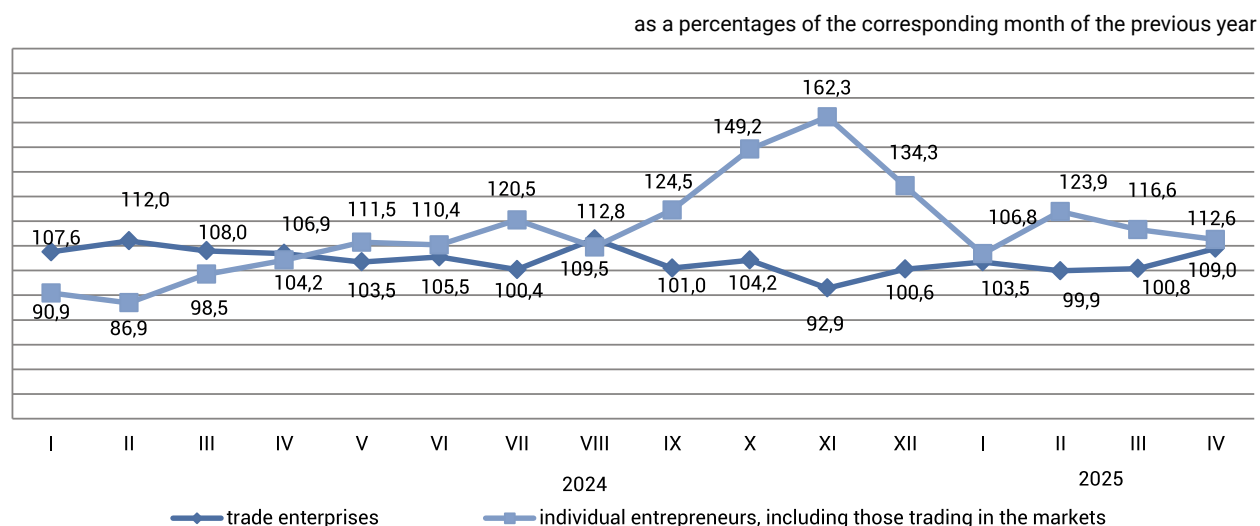
3.5 Statistics of domestic trade

The volume of retail trade in January-April 2025 amounted to 6205.8 billion tenge, which is 6.1% more than the corresponding period in 2024. Retail sales of goods by trading enterprises increased by 3.2%, individual entrepreneurs, including those trading in the markets, increased by 15.4% compared to January-April 2024.

As of May 1, 2025, the volume of commodity stocks of trading enterprises (for reporting enterprises) in retail trade amounted to 1575.9 billion tenge, in trading days - 63 days.

The share of food products in the total volume of retail trade is 28.5%, non-food products –71.5%. The volume of sales of food products compared to January-April 2024 increased by 4.4%, non-food products increased by 6.8%.

The volume of wholesale trade in January-April 2025 amounted to 13110.2 billion tenge, which is 7.4% more than the corresponding period in 2024. Non-food products and industrial and technical products (82.2%) prevail in the structure of wholesale trade.

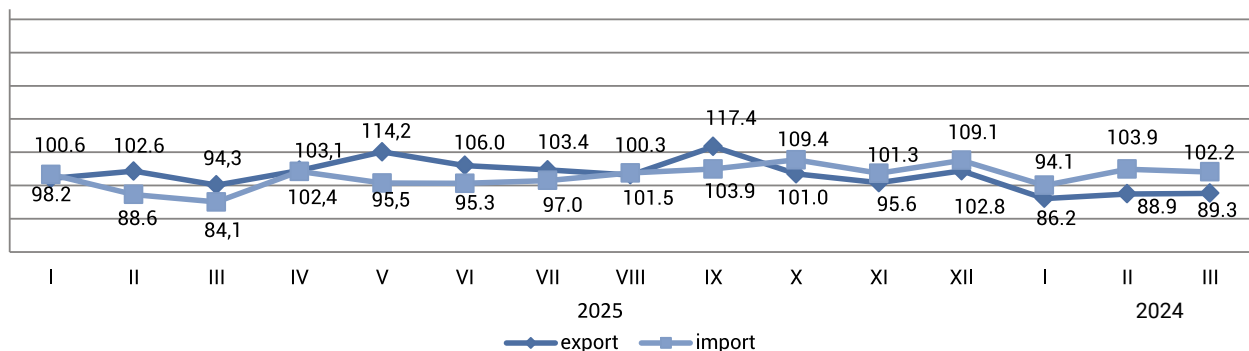

Foreign trade turnover in January-March 2025 amounted to 29,3 billion US dollars (decreased by 7% in nominal terms compared to January- March 2024) including exports – 16,4 billion US dollars (11,9% less) and imports – 12,9 billion US dollars (which corresponds to last year's level).

Exports with the EAEU countries amounted to 1988,1 million US dollars or 11,3% less than in January-March 2024, imports – 4013 million US dollars decreased by 3,6% compared to the corresponding period last year.

Out of the total output volume, agricultural formations account for 499614,2 million tenge or 49,8 percent of the total volume, including 40091,4 million tenge (74,1 percent) in crop production and 443357,3 million tenge (47,5 percent) in livestock breeding.

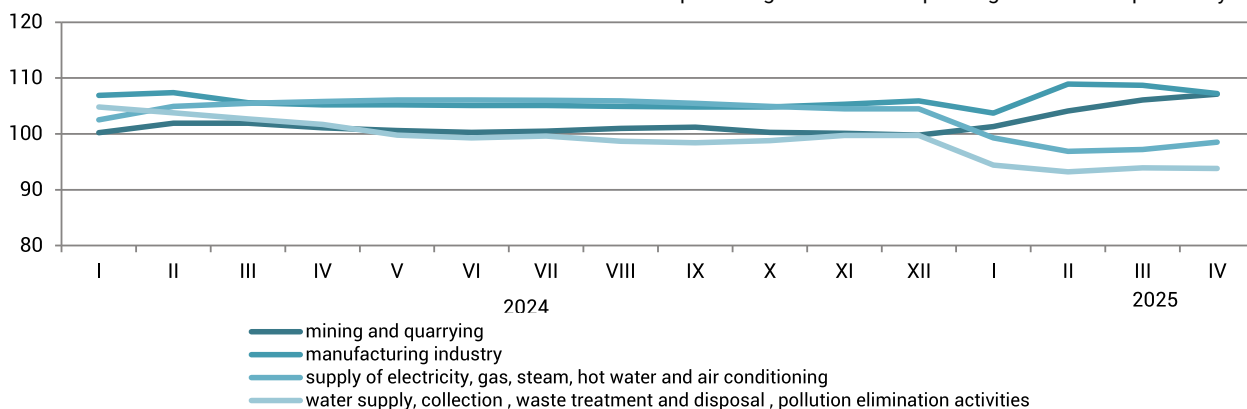

3.9 Statistics of building and housing construction

In January-April 2025, the volume of construction work increased by 16,2% and amounted to 1438,4 billion tenge.

The largest amount of work in January-April 2025 was performed on the construction of facilities (652,2 billion tenge), non-residential buildings (540,1 billion tenge) and residential buildings (246,2 billion tenge).

The volume of construction and installation work in January-April 2025 compared to January-April 2024 increased by 15,1% and amounted to 1253,5 billion tenge. The volume of construction work on major repairs increased by 21,3% and on current repairs by 27,5%.

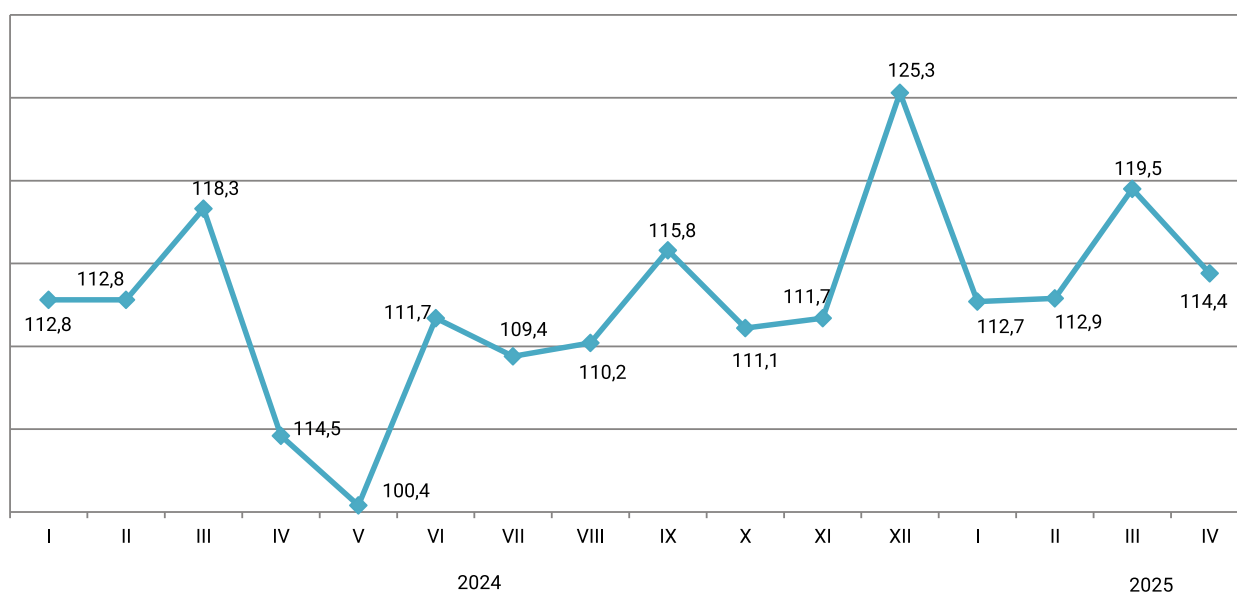
In January-April 2025, the construction of 10078 new buildings was completed, of which 9268 are residential and 810 are non-residential.

as a percentages of the corresponding month of the previous year



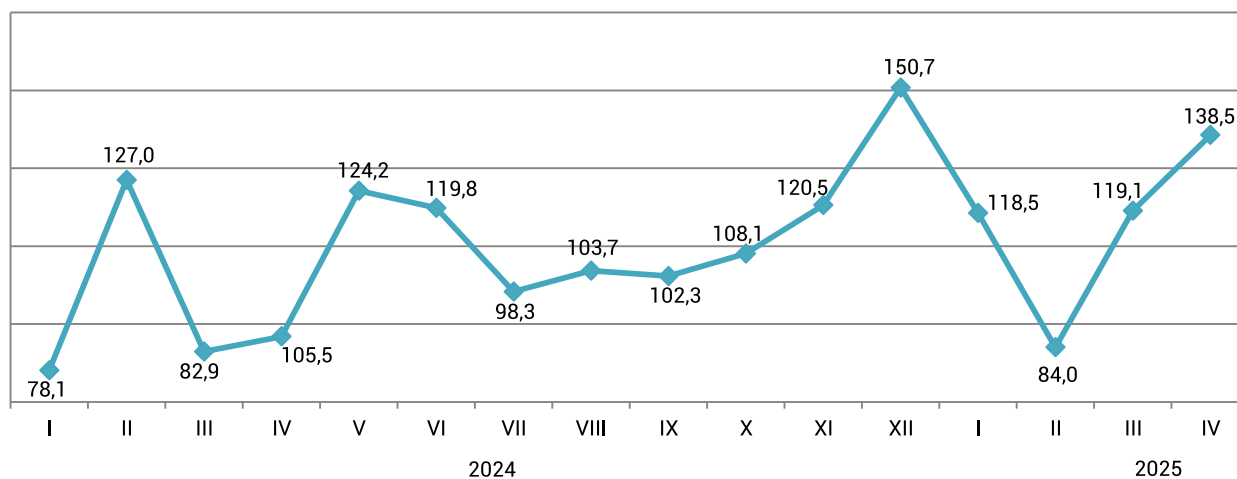

In January- April 2025, 877,2 billion tenge was allocated for housing construction. In the total volume of investments in fixed capital, the share of disbursed funds in housing construction amounted to 20%.

The main source of financing for housing construction in January-April 2025 is the own funds of developers, the share of which is 90,1%.

as a percentages of the corresponding month of the previous year

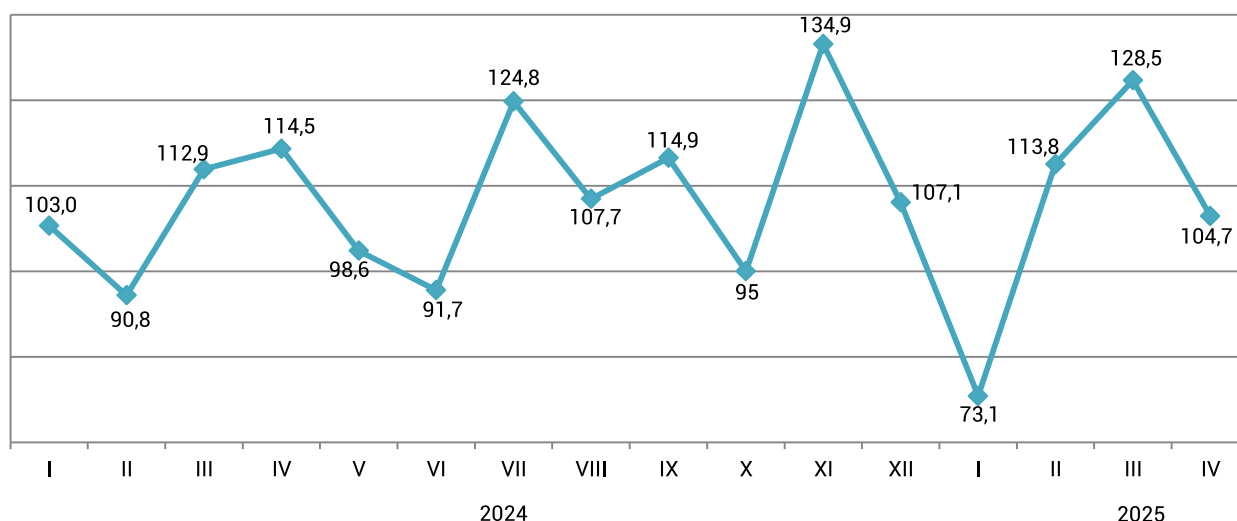


In January-April 2025, the total area of housing put into operation to January-April 2024 increased by 6,8% and amounted to 4882,3 thousand square meters, of which in multi-apartment buildings – by 8,7% (3197,7 thousand square meters), of individual residential buildings – by 3,6% (1664,3 thousand square meters).

In the total volume of commissioned housing, the share of multi-apartment buildings was 65,5%, individual – 34,1%. The average actual cost of construction of 1 square meter of total housing area increased by 13%.

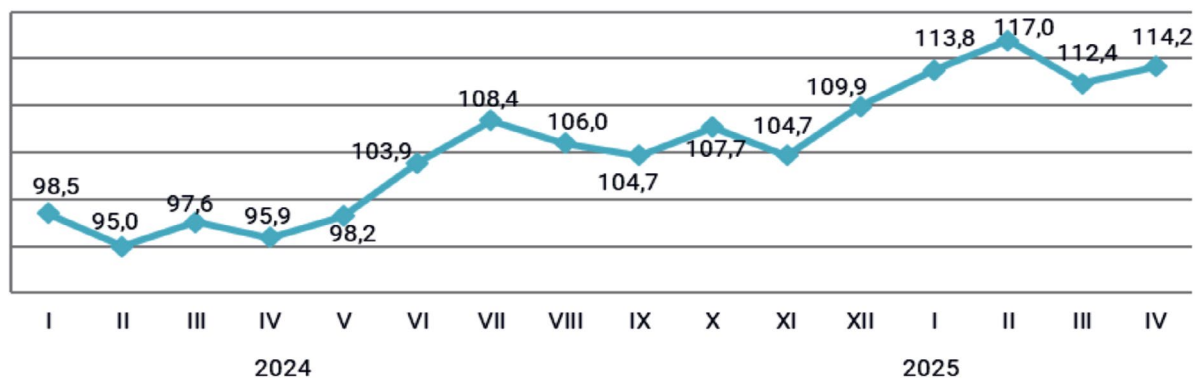

Cargo turnover

Cargo turnover for January-April 2025 increased by 14.3% from the level of the corresponding period of the previous year and amounted to 183.2 billion t-km. In January-April 2025 compared to January-April 2024 there is an increase in cargo turnover in rail transport (by 10.4%), pipeline transport (by 16.2%) and automobile (by 45.3%) transport.

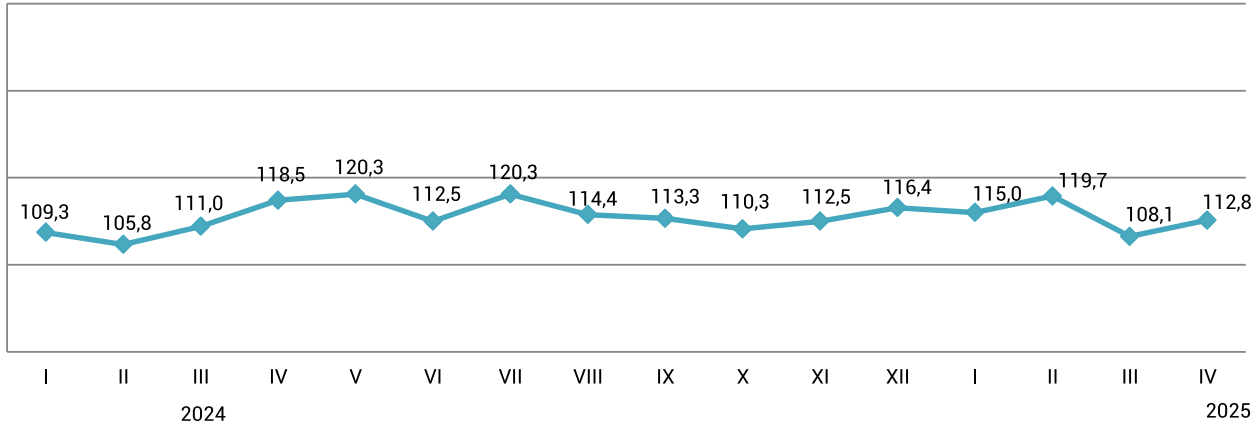

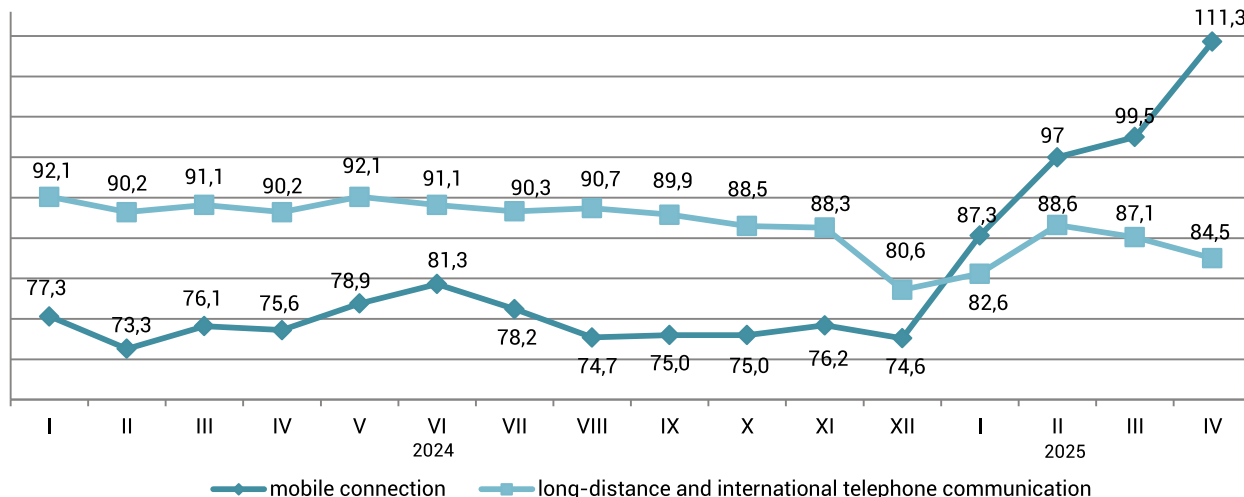

3.11 Statistics of communications

3.12 Statistics of enterprises

In April, compared to March 2025, there is a slight increase in the number of registered legal entities (by 0.4%), compared to the corresponding period of the previous year, their number increased by 2.2%. At the same time, there is an decrease in the number of operating legal entities - by 0.2%, compared to the corresponding period of the previous year, their number decreased by 0.2%. Since the beginning of the year, by type of economic activity, the largest number of registered legal entities remains in the industry «Wholesale and retail trade; car and motorcycle repair», the share of which as of May 1, 2025. amounted to 27.1%. On the second place – «Construction» (13.3%), on the third – «Provision of other types of services» (10%). Together, the share of these three types of activities is 50.5% of all registered legal entities.
