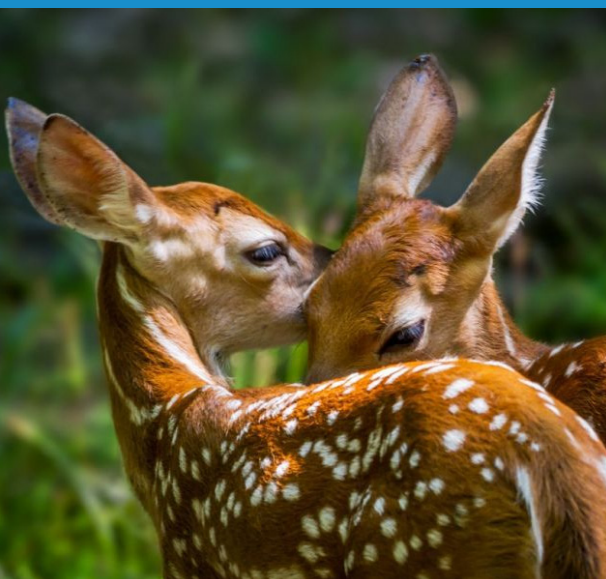

2. Social indicators

2.1 Population size and migration

The population of the country as of May 1, 2026 amounted to 20563 thousand people, including 13153,7 thousand (64,0%) urban residents and 7409,3 thousand (36,0%) rural residents.

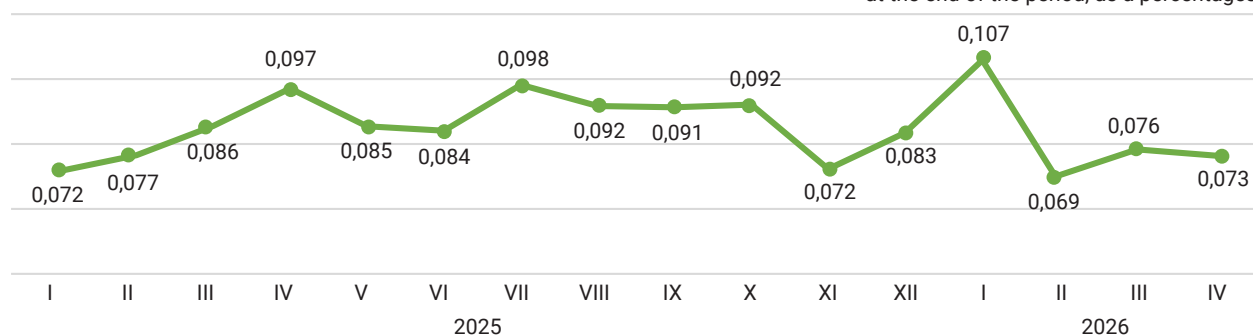
In January-April 2026, compared to January-April 2025, the number of arrivals to Kazakhstan decreased in -9,6%, while the number of departures from the country decreased in -22,3%.

The main migration exchange of the country occurs with the CIS member states, with the share of arrivals from and departures to these countries amounting to 70,3% and 60,0%, respectively.

The number of internal migrants increased by 7,8%. A positive net migration balance due to interregional movements was recorded in three regions of the country: the cities of Astana (22231 people), Almaty (6934 people), Shymkent (4687 people) and Almaty region (6613 people).

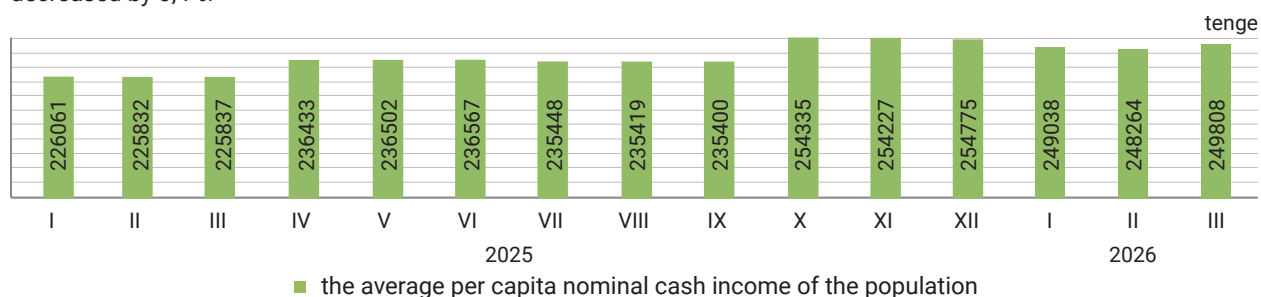

2.2 Income of the population

The average per capita nominal cash income of the population, according to an estimate in March 2026 amounted to 249808 tenge (preliminary data), which is 10,6% higher than in March 2025, real cash income for the specified period decreased by 0,4%.

2.3 Employment of the population

The number of unemployed, determined according to the methodology of the ILO, in the I quarter of 2026¹⁾ amounted to 446,1 thousand people, the unemployment rate was 4,5%.

The employed population²⁾ amounted to 9392,0 thousand people, including employees – 7290,4 thousand people, individual entrepreneurs – 1752,3 thousand people, persons engaged in private practice – 15,1 thousand people, individuals, who are founders (participants) of business partnerships and founders, shareholders (participants) of joint-stock companies, as well as members of production cooperatives – 7,6 thousand people, independent workers – 326,6 thousand people.

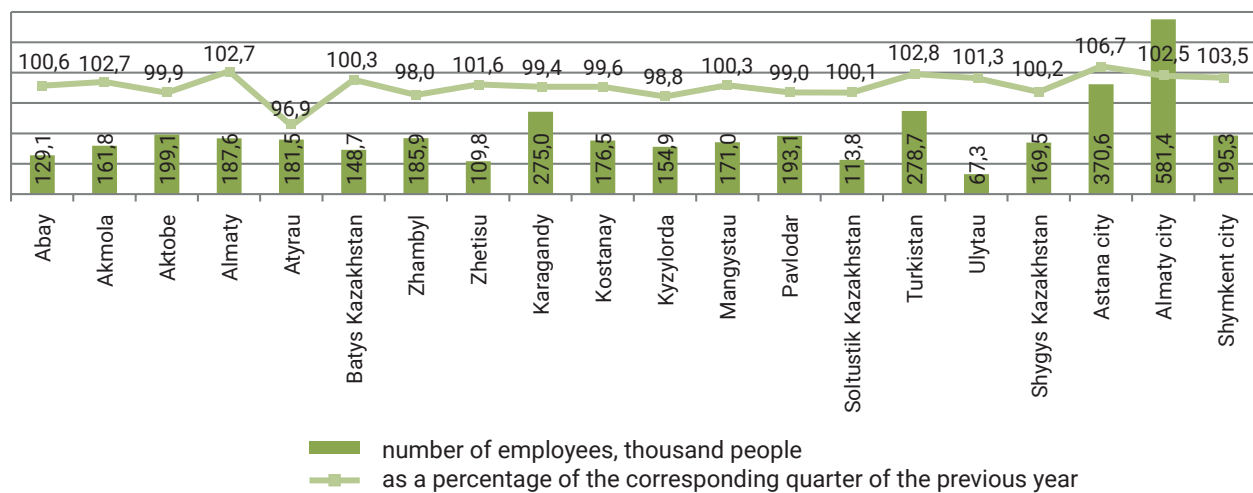

The number of employees at enterprises (organizations) in the IV quarter of 2025³⁾ amounted to 4050,3 thousand people, of which at large and medium-sized enterprises – 2915,9 thousand people.

In the I quarter of 2026 266,1 thousand people were hired by enterprises. 258,3 thousand people dropped out for various reasons. Worked by one employee 443,7 hours.

At the end of the I quarter of 2026, 59,3 thousand vacancies were not filled at enterprises (1,6% of the number of employees).

2.4 Remuneration of labor at enterprises and organizations*

In the I quarter of 2026, the average monthly nominal salary amounted to 461486 tenge (excluding employees of small enterprises engaged in entrepreneurial activities). In the I quarter of 2026, the median salary was estimated to be 339912 tenge.

From January 1, 2026, the minimum wage is set at 85000 tenge.

3. Economic indicators

3.1 Statistics of prices

In May 2026, the monthly consumer price index amounted to 100.7%. Paid services prices increased by 1.1%, non-food products – by 0.6%, food products – by 0.4%.

In the services sector, price increases were recorded for holiday in Turkey by 25.6%, air passenger transport services – by 6.9%, services of children's attractions – by 6.6%, swimming pool and theater services – by 5.8% each, clothes adjustment – by 4.8%, sewerage system services – by 4.7%, railway passenger transport services – by 2.9%, services of health resort organizations and internet and TV packages – by 2.7% each.

Among non-food products, price increases were observed for bicycles by 8.6%, kazans – by 8.2%, cameras – by 7.4%, hair straighteners, curling irons – by 6.9%, electric shavers – by 6%, condoms – by 5.7%, large tools – by 4.6%, cement – by 4.2%, cutlery – by 3.8%, modems, routers – by 3.7%. AI-92 gasoline became more expensive by 0.3%, diesel fuel – by 0.2%.

Among food products, prices increased for bulb onions by 30.2%, carrots – by 22%, potatoes – by 16.7%, grapes – by 10.9%, mutton – by 4.7%, sprats in oil – by 3.3%, apples – by 3.1%, salt – by 2.7%, salted and marinated mushrooms – by 1.7%, cognac – by 1.5%, gingerbread – by 1.4%.

A decrease in prices was recorded for cucumbers by 25.4%, white cabbage – by 25.3%, tomatoes – by 25.1%, zucchini – by 24.3%, eggplant – by 21.8%, bananas – by 8.7%, sweet pepper – by 8.3%, oranges – by 4.1%, processed cheeses – by 0.9%, spaghetti – by 0.8%.

In May 2026, compared to the previous month, the producer price index for agricultural products was 100.3%, for crop products – 100.3%, for livestock products – 100.2%.

Price increased were for dried peas – by 2%, potato – by 0.7%, wheat and wheat, except durum wheat - 0.6% each, millet – by 0.4%, barley and buckwheat by 0.2% each.

Price reduction were recorded at cucumbers in protected ground by 22.1%, indoor tomatoes – by 20.7%, flowers and flower buds, cut – by 3%, lentils, dried – by 0.6%, beetroot – by 0.4%, curly flax seeds by 0.2%.

Among livestock products, prices increased for sheep and pigs – by 1% each, horses – by 0.9%, cattle – by 0.4%, while prices for raw cow's milk decreased by 0.4% and eggs by 0.3%.

Prices of manufacturing enterprises for industrial products in May 2026 increased by 3.2% compared to the previous month. Oil prices were higher by 12.3%, coal – by 0.3%, metal ores – lower by 4.1%, natural gaz – by 1.3%. Of petroleum products, propane and butane liquefied rose in price by 15.5%, fuel oil – by 6.9%, gasoline fell in price by 2%.

An increase in prices was noted for precious metals by 8.7%, aluminum – by 6.5%, zinc – by 3.6%, rolled ferrous metals – by 1.6%, ferroalloys – by 1.2%.

From food products, grains rose in price by 3.1%, milk food – by 2.1%, fish – by 0.6%, pasta – by 0.4%, sugar fell in price by 2.2%, rice – by 1%.

In the service sector, tariffs for the transportation of goods by all modes of transport decreased by 0.6% in May 2026 compared to the previous month, tariffs for communication services increased by 0.5%, for postal and courier services remained unchanged.

In May 2026, compared to the previous month, the price index in construction was 102.7%. Prices for construction and installation works increased by 2.9%, other works and costs – by 2%, machinery and equipment decreased by 0.6%.

3.4 Investment statistics

In January-May 2026, the volume of investments in fixed capital amounted to 6742,3 billion tenge, which is 7% more than in January-May 2025.

The predominant sources of investment financing remain the own funds of economic entities, the volume of which in January-May 2026 amounted to 4543,4 billion tenge.

In January-May 2026, compared with January-May 2025, there is an increase costs for the purchase of machinery, equipment and vehicles and their capital repairs by 37%.

A significant share of investments in fixed capital in January-May 2026 accounted for industry (42,9%) (including mining and quarrying – 15%, manufacturing industry – 15,7%), operations with real estate (19,3%), transport and warehousing (16%) and agriculture, forestry and fisheries (5,5%).

The volume of investments of large enterprises in January-May 2026 amounted to 2174,1 billion tenge.

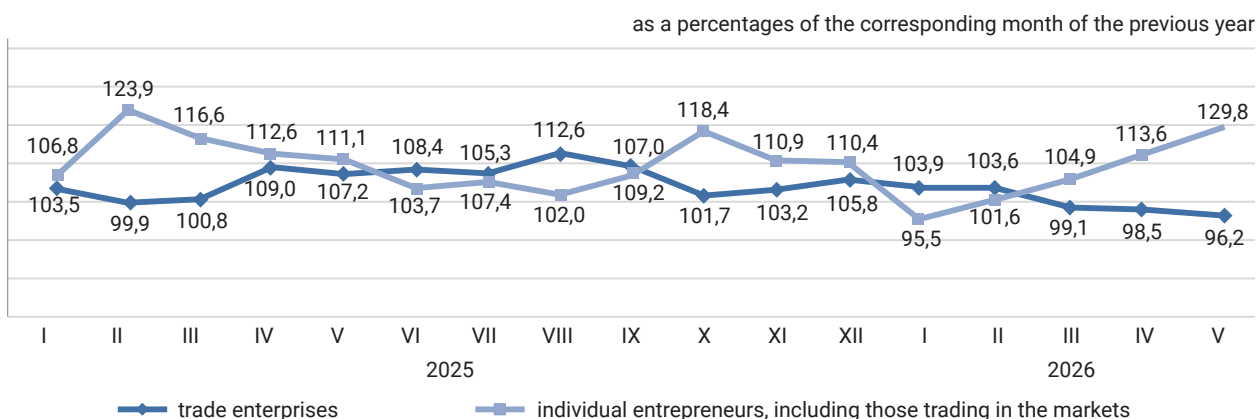
3.5 Statistics of domestic trade

The volume of retail trade in January-May 2026 amounted to 9016 billion tenge, which is 3,6% more than the corresponding period in 2025. Retail sales of goods by trading enterprises remained at the same level as last year, individual entrepreneurs, including those trading in the markets, increased by 14,4% compared to January-May 2025.

As of June 1, 2026, the volume of commodity stocks of trading enterprises (for reporting enterprises) in retail trade amounted to 1731,4 billion tenge, in trading days - 67 days.

The share of food products in the total volume of retail trade is 31,3%, non-food products – 68,7%. The volume of sales of food products compared to January-May 2025 increased by 10,7%, non-food products increased by 0,7%.

The volume of wholesale trade in January-May 2026 amounted to 19576,7 billion tenge, which is 6,5% more than the corresponding period in 2025. Non-food products and industrial and technical products (80,1%) prevail in the structure of wholesale trade.

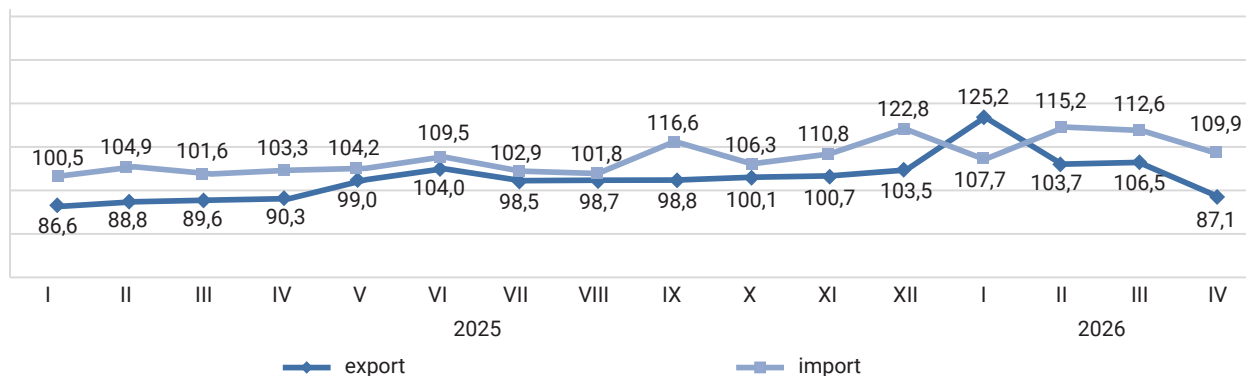

Foreign trade turnover in January-April 2026 amounted to 44,9 billion US dollars (increased by 7,9% in nominal terms compared to January-April 2025) including exports – 24 billion US dollars (5% more) and imports – 20,9 billion US dollars (increased by 11,3% than corresponding period last year).

Exports with the EAEU countries amounted to 2 713,8 million US dollars or 7,9% less than in January-April 2025, imports – 7 160,9 million US dollars increased by 24,1% compared to the corresponding period last year.

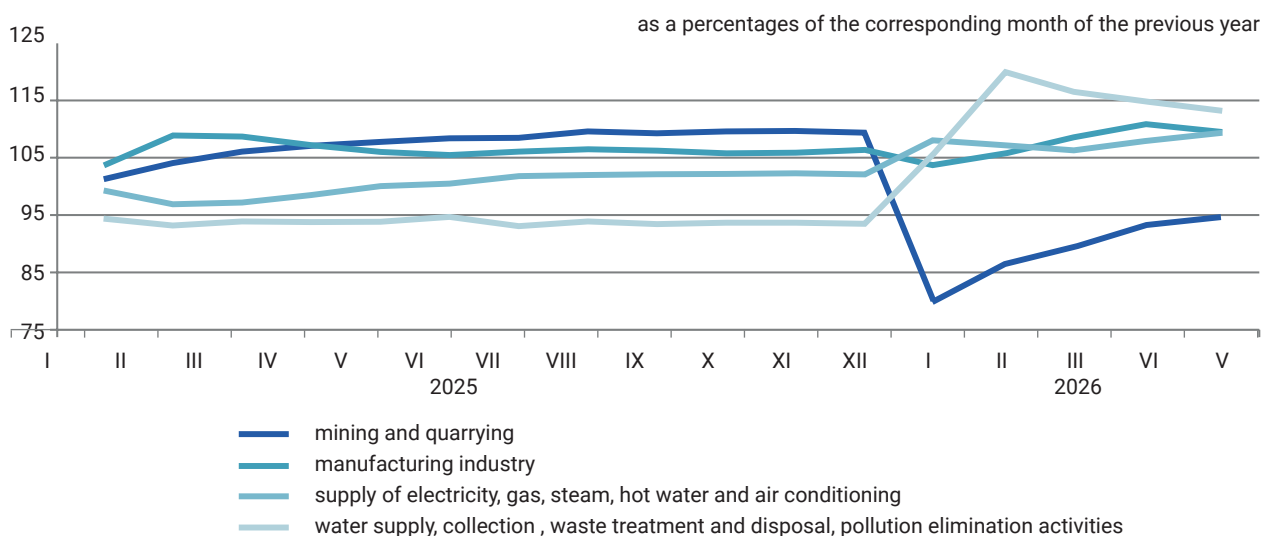

3.9 Statistics of building and housing construction

In January-May 2026, the volume of construction work increased by 13,4% and amounted to 2410 billion tenge.

The largest amount of work in January-May 2026 was performed on the construction of facilities (1352,2 billion tenge), non-residential buildings (695 billion tenge) and residential buildings (362,8 billion tenge).

The volume of construction and installation work in January-May 2026 compared to January-May 2025 increased by 11,6% and amounted to 2045,2 billion tenge. The volume of construction work on major repairs increased by 9,9% and on current repairs by 41,2%.

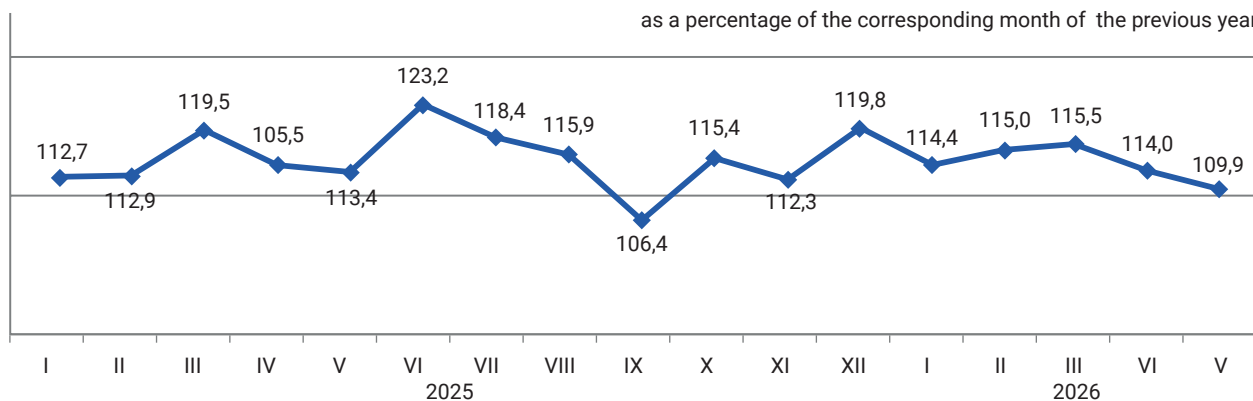
In January-May 2026, the construction of 12189 new buildings was completed, of which 11075 are residential and 1114 are non-residential.

as a percentage of the corresponding month of the previous year



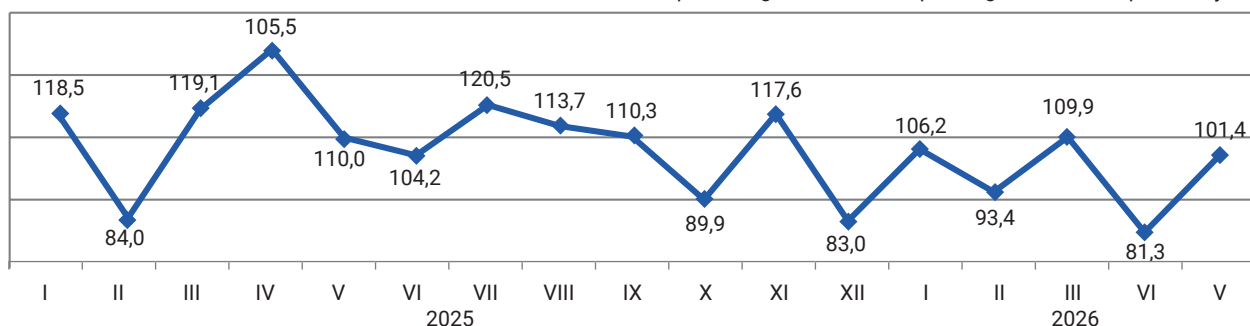

In January-May 2026, 1218,3 billion tenge was allocated for housing construction. In the total volume of investments in fixed capital, the share of disbursed funds in housing construction amounted to 18,1%.

The main source of financing for housing construction in January-May 2026 is the own funds of developers, the share of which is 94,6%.

as a percentages of the corresponding month of the previous year

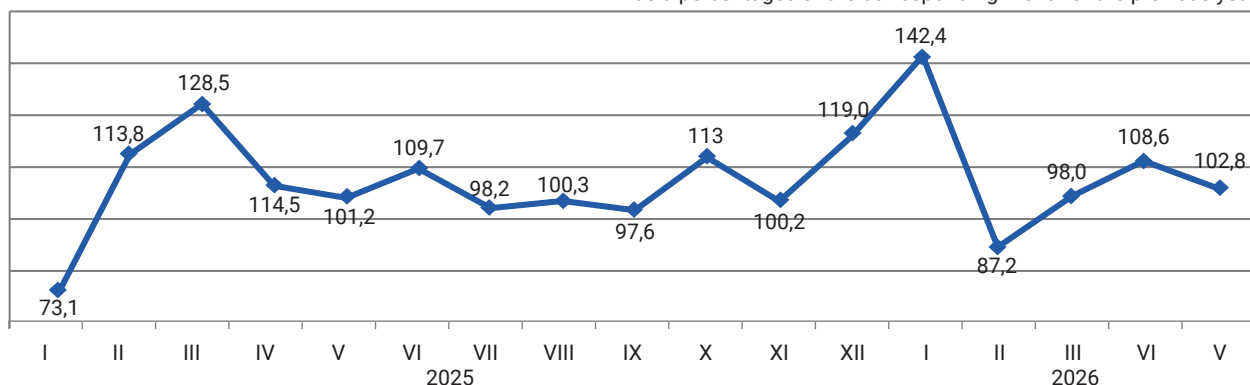


In January-May 2026, the total area of housing put into operation to January-May 2025 increased by 4,5% and amounted to 6293,4 thousand square meters, of which in multi-apartment buildings – by 9,6% (4223,1 thousand square meters). At the same time, the total area of commissioned individual residential buildings decreased by 3,6% (2050 thousand square meters).

In the total volume of commissioned housing, the share of multi-apartment buildings was 67,1%, individual – 32,6%. The average actual cost of construction of 1 square meter of total housing area increased by 3,1%.

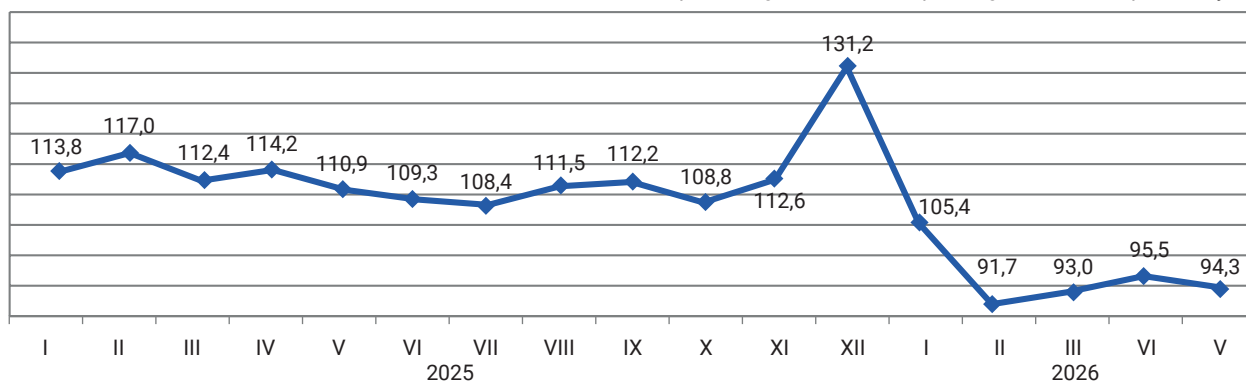

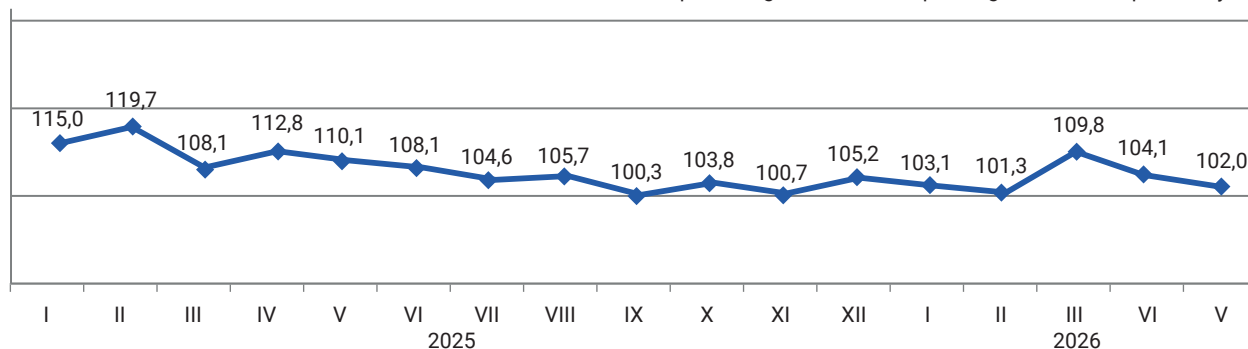

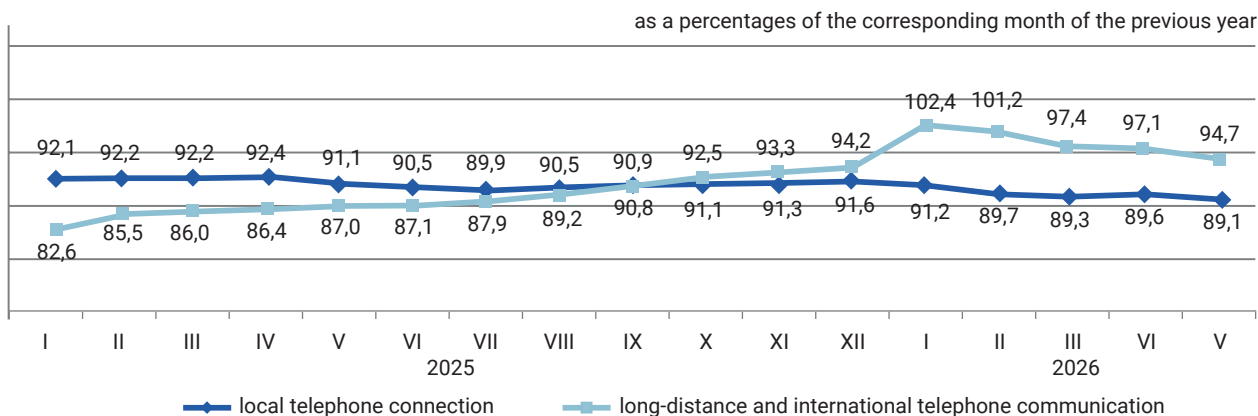

3.11 Statistics of communications

Growth rate for communication services in January-May 2026 compared to January-May 2025 amounted to 103,7%, of which 235,7% for mobile services*, 109,9% for other telecommunications services and 67,0% for Internet services.

3.12 Statistics of enterprises

In May, compared to April 2026, there is a slight increase in the number of registered legal entities (by 0,4%), compared to the corresponding period of the previous year, their number increased by 1,2%. At the same time, there is an increase in the number of operating legal entities - by 0,01%, compared to the corresponding period of the previous year, their number increased by 4,3%. Since the beginning of the year, by type of economic activity, the largest number of registered legal entities remains in the industry «Wholesale and retail trade; car and motorcycle repair», the share of which as of June 1, 2026. amounted to 26,4%. On the second place – «Construction» (13,4%), on the third – «Provision of other types of services» (9,9%). Together, the share of these three types of activities is 49,8% of all registered legal entities.
