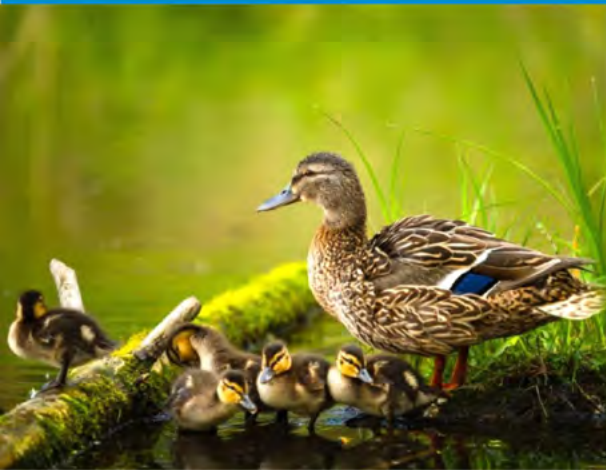

2. Social indicators

2.1 Population size and migration

The population of the country as of May 1, 2025 amounted to 20353,3 thousand people, including 12856,8 thousand urban residents (63,2%) and 7496,5 thousand rural residents (36,8%).

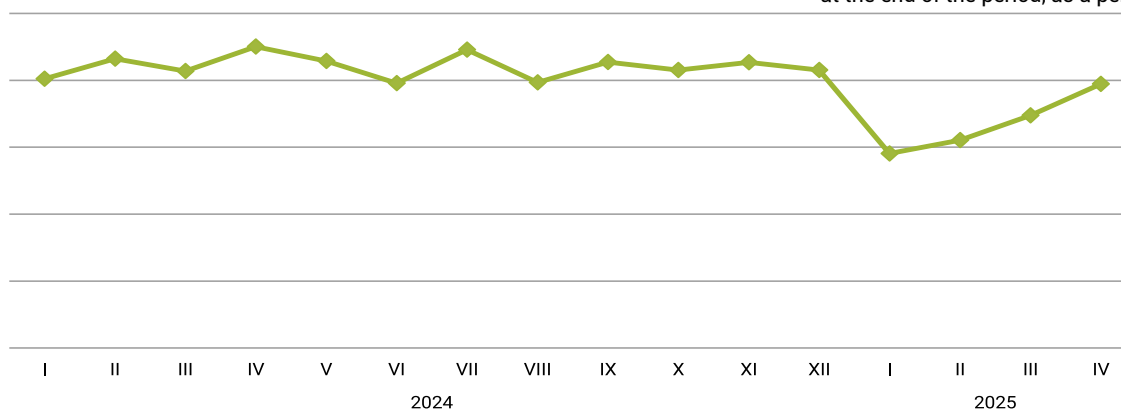
In April 2025, compared to April 2024, the number of arrivals to Kazakhstan increased by 29,7%, while the number of departures from the country decreased by 40,2%.

The main migration exchange of the country occurs with the CIS countries. The share of arrivals from CIS countries and departures to these countries amounted to 80,5% and 68,6%, respectively.

The number of internal migrants increased by 27,6%. Regarding interregional migration, a positive net migration balance was recorded in three regions: Astana city (5232 people), Shymkent city (4874 people), and Almaty city (2133 people).

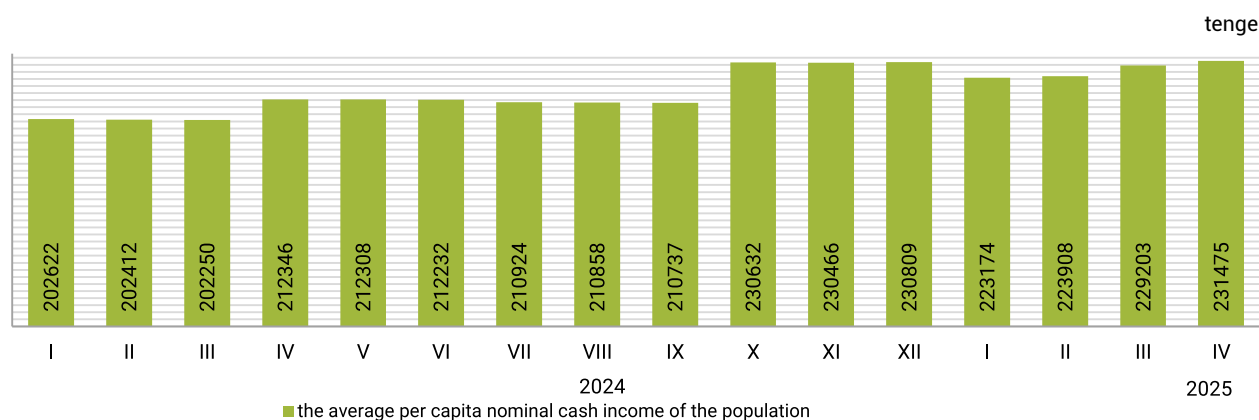

2.2 Income of the population

The average per capita nominal cash income of the population, according to an estimate in April 2025, amounted to 231475 tenge (preliminary data), which is 9% higher than in April 2024, real cash income for the specified period decreased by 1,5%.

2.3 Employment of the population

The number of unemployed, determined according to the methodology of the ILO, in the I quarter of 2025¹⁾ amounted to 451,5 thousand people, the unemployment rate was 4,6%.

The employed population²⁾ amounted to 9283,5 thousand people, including employees – 7141 thousand people, individual entrepreneurs – 1760,5 thousand people, persons engaged in private practice – 17,3 thousand people, individuals, who are founders (participants) of business partnerships and founders, shareholders (participants) of joint-stock companies, as well as members of production cooperatives – 7,5 thousand people, independent workers – 357,2 thousand people.

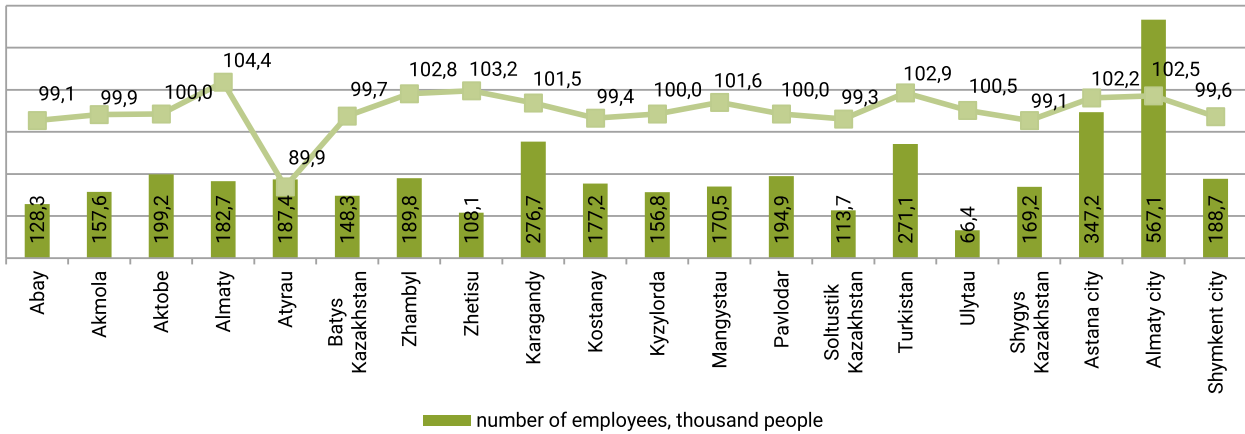

The number of employees at enterprises (organizations) in the I quarter of 2025³⁾ amounted to 4000,8 thousand people, of which at large and medium-sized enterprises – 2872,9 thousand people.

In the I quarter of 2025, 263,8 thousand people were hired by enterprises. 258,5 thousand people dropped out for various reasons. Worked by one employee 445,1 hours.

At the end of the I quarter of 2025, 59,0 thousand vacancies were not filled at enterprises (1,5% of the number of employees).

2.4 Remuneration of labor at enterprises and organizations*

In the I quarter of 2025, the average monthly nominal salary amounted to 423133 tenge (excluding employees of small enterprises engaged in entrepreneurial activities). In the I quarter of 2025, the median salary was estimated to be 300307 tenge.

From January 1, 2025, the minimum wage is set at 85000 tenge.

3. Economic indicators

3.1 Statistics of prices

In May 2025, the monthly consumer price index was 0,9% (in April 2025 – 1,2%). Prices for paid services increased by 1,3%, food products – by 0,9%, non-food products – by 0,6%.

In the sphere of housing and communal services, tariffs for cold water increased by 4,2%, water disposal – by 1,6%, gas transported through distribution networks – by 1,5%, electricity – by 1,4%. Treatment in a day hospital increased by 17,7%, air passenger transport services – by 14,2%, railway passenger transport services – by 2,1%, sanatorium services – by 2%.

Among food products, prices increased for bulb onions by 38,1%, carrots – by 24,3%, beets – by 16,9%, potatoes – by 10%, lemons – by 9,1%, apples – by 6,1%, pears – by 5,2%, grapes – by 5,1%, wheat bread made from premium flour – by 4,6%, salt – 3,2%, mutton, coffee – by 2,9%. A decrease in prices was noted for cucumbers by 37,1%, tomatoes – by 19,8%, cabbage – by 7,7%, bananas – by 5,7%, eggs – by 2,4%.

An increase in prices in May this year was noted for a gold engagement ring by 4,6%, construction materials – by 1,1%, clothing and shoes, personal goods – by 0,8% each. Diesel fuel rose in price by 1,2%, gasoline AI-98 – by 0,8%, gasoline AI-92 – by 0,5%.

In May 2025, compared to the previous month, the producer price index for agricultural products was 99,3%, crop products – 100,8%, livestock products – 97,6%.

Prices for sunflower seeds increased by 2,7%, barley – 1,4%, wheat, except for durum wheat by 1,2%, unhulled rice – by 0,9%, and lentils decreased by 1,4%.

There is an increase in prices for potatoes – by 3,9%, carrots – by 2%, beets – by 0,7%, and for greenhouse cucumbers – decreased by 31,6%, greenhouse tomatoes – by 15,8%.

Cattle and natural honey increased in price by 1,8%, horses and raw cow's milk by 0,7%, and eggs decreased in price by 4%.

Prices of manufacturing enterprises for industrial products in May 2025 decreased by 1,2% compared to the previous month. Oil prices were lower by 6,2%, metal ores – higher by 1,8%, natural gas – by 0,8%, coal – by 0,2%. Of petroleum products, gasoline rose in price by 1,8%, propane and butane liquefied – by 1,1%, fuel oil – by 0,7%.

A decrease in prices was noted for zinc by 7,5%, aluminum – by 5,8%, copper – by 1,7%, rolled ferrous metals – by 1%, precious metals – an increase by 8,1%.

From food products, vegetable oil rose in price by 3,3%, cereals – by 2,5%, livestock meat – by 1,4%, pasta – by 0,8%, poultry meat – by 0,6%, bread – by 0,4%, rice fell in price by 2,4%, wheat flour – by 1,4%.

In the service sector, tariffs for the transportation of goods by all modes of transport in May 2025 increased by 0,3% compared to the previous month, tariffs for postal and courier services decreased by 0,1%, and for communication services remained unchanged.

In May 2025 compared to the previous month the price index in construction amounted to 99,7%. Prices for construction and installation work decreased by – 0,3%, work and costs by 0,4%, machinery and equipment increased by 1,2%.

3.4 Investment statistics

In January-May 2025, the volume of investments in fixed capital amounted to 5952,4 billion tenge, which is 18,2% more than in January-May 2024.

The predominant sources of investment financing remain the own funds of economic entities, the volume of which in January-May 2025 amounted to 3905,6 billion tenge.

In January-May 2025, compared with January-May 2024, there is an increase costs for works on construction and capital repair of buildings and constructions by 29,6%.

A significant share of investments in fixed capital in January-May 2025 accounted for industry (40,1%) (including mining and quarrying – 17,7%, manufacturing industry – 13%), operations with real estate (20,7%), transport and warehousing (13,6%) and education (8,7%).

The volume of investments of large enterprises in January-May 2025 amounted to 1859,7 billion tenge.

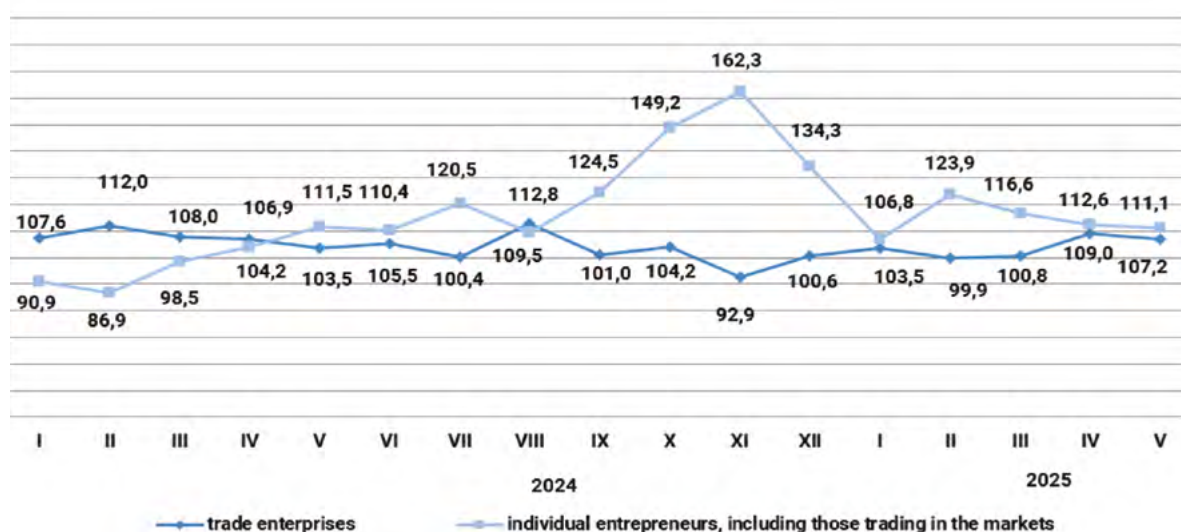
The volume of retail trade in January-May 2025 amounted to 7888,3 billion tenge, which is 6,5% more than the corresponding period in 2024. Retail sales of goods by trading enterprises increased by 4,1%, individual entrepreneurs, including those trading in the markets, increased by 14,5% compared to January-May 2024.

As of June 1, 2025, the volume of commodity stocks of trading enterprises (for reporting enterprises) in retail trade amounted to 1595 billion tenge, in trading days - 61 days.

The share of food products in the total volume of retail trade is 28,7%, non-food products – 71,3%. The volume of sales of food products compared to January-May 2024 increased by 3,5%, non-food products increased by 7,7%.

The volume of wholesale trade in January-May 2025 amounted to 16926,1 billion tenge, which is 8,3% more than the corresponding period in 2024. Non-food products and industrial and technical products (82,1%) prevail in the structure of wholesale trade.

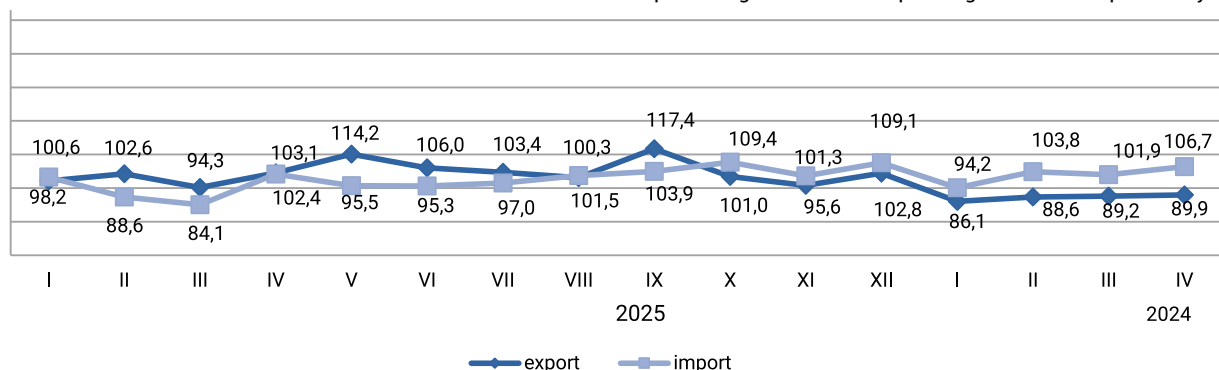

Foreign trade turnover in January-April 2025 amounted to 41,2 billion US dollars (decreased by 6% in nominal terms compared to January-April 2024) including exports – 22,7 billion US dollars (11,5% less) and imports – 18,4 billion US dollars (increased by 1,9% than corresponding period last year).

Exports with the EAEU countries amounted to 2804,0 million US dollars or 8,7% less than in January-April 2024, imports – 5607,1 million US dollars decreased by 0,8% compared to the corresponding period last year.

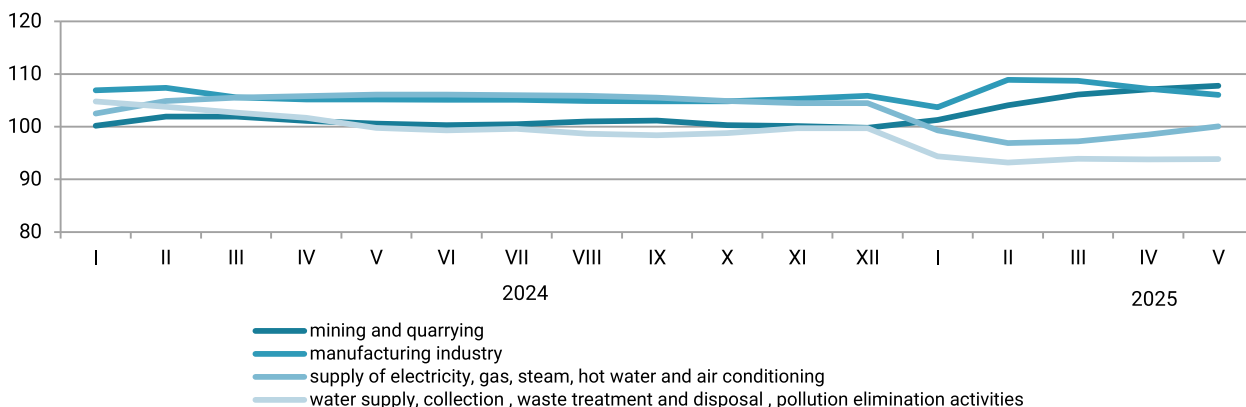

3.9 Statistics of building and housing construction

In January-May 2025, the volume of construction work increased by 15,4% and amounted to 2001 billion tenge.

The largest amount of work in January-May 2025 was performed on the construction of facilities (955,7 billion tenge), non-residential buildings (706,1 billion tenge) and residential buildings (339,2 billion tenge).

The volume of construction and installation work in January-May 2025 compared to January-May 2024 increased by 15,1% and amounted to 1725,4 billion tenge. The volume of construction work on major repairs increased by 12,3% and on current repairs by 23%.

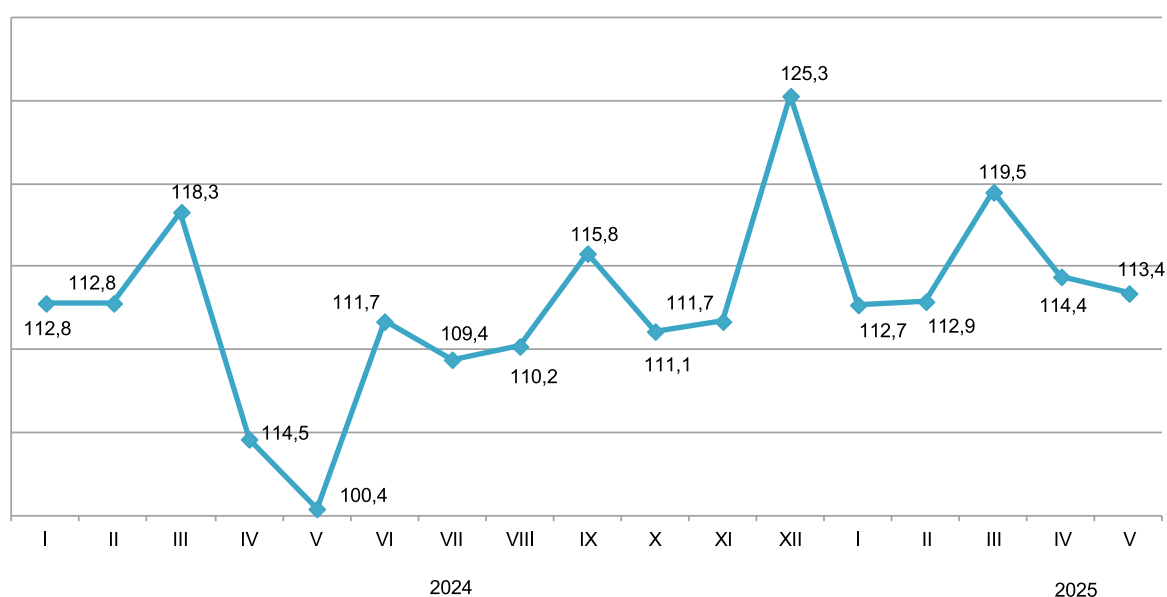
In January-May 2025, the construction of 13138 new buildings was completed, of which 12013 are residential and 1125 are non-residential.

as a percentages of the corresponding month of the previous year



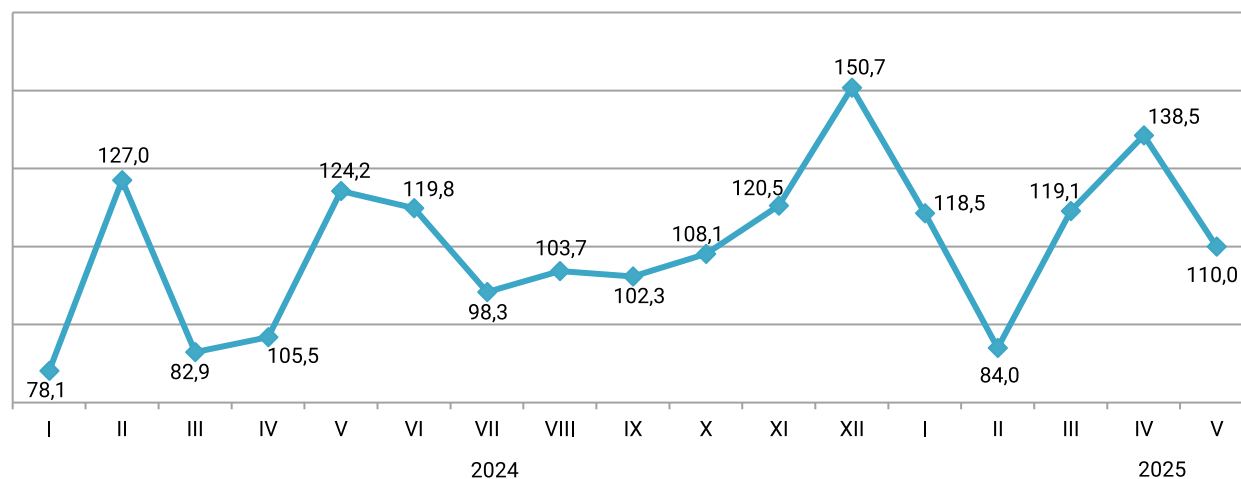

In January-May 2025, 1176,1 billion tenge was allocated for housing construction. In the total volume of investments in fixed capital, the share of disbursed funds in housing construction amounted to 19,8%.

as a percentages of the corresponding month of the previous year

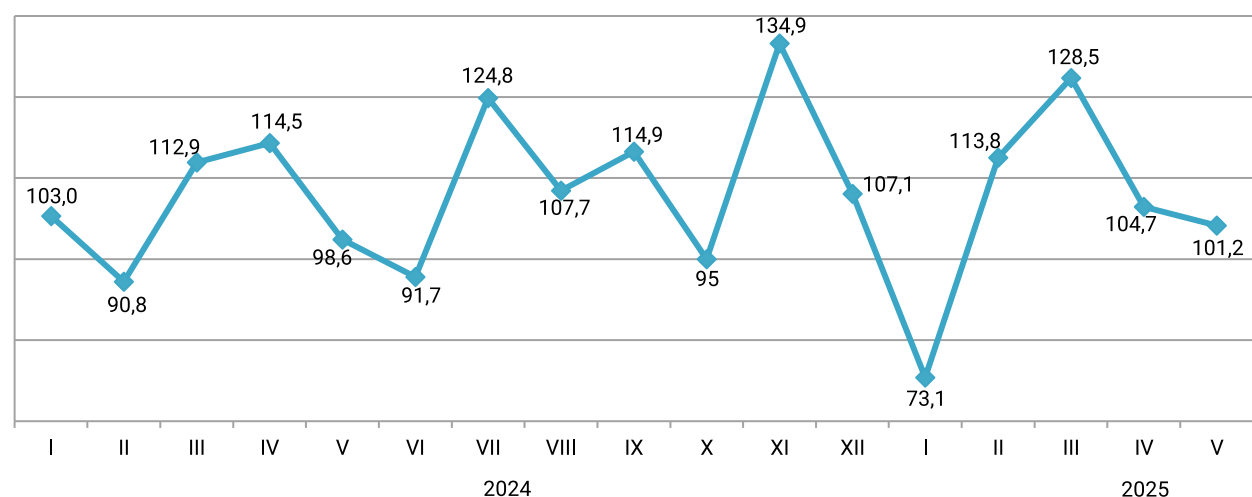


In January-May 2025, the total area of housing put into operation to January-May 2024 increased by 5,7% and amounted to 6021,3 thousand square meters, of which in multi-apartment buildings – by 7,5% (3854,7 thousand square meters), of individual residential buildings – by 2,1% (2126,7 thousand square meters).

In the total volume of commissioned housing, the share of multi-apartment buildings was 64%, individual – 35,3%. The average actual cost of construction of 1 square meter of total housing area increased by 12,9%.

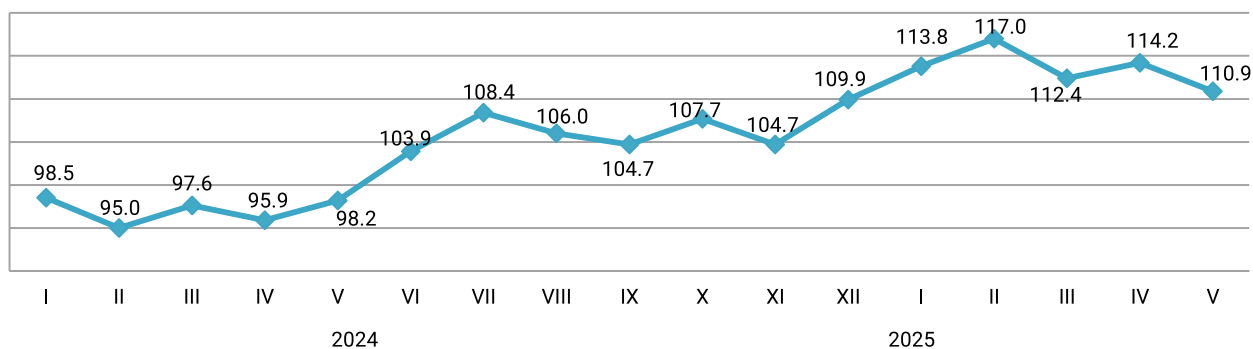

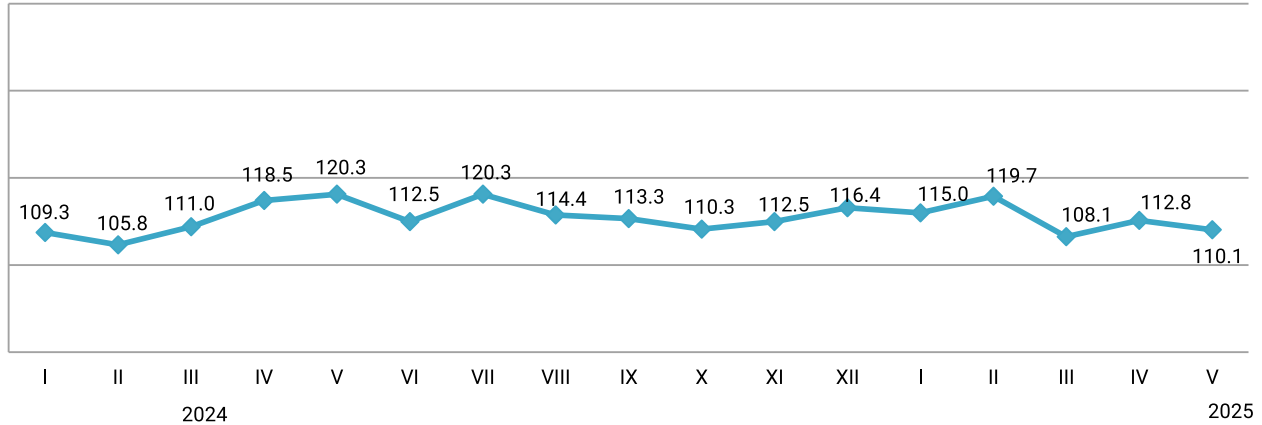

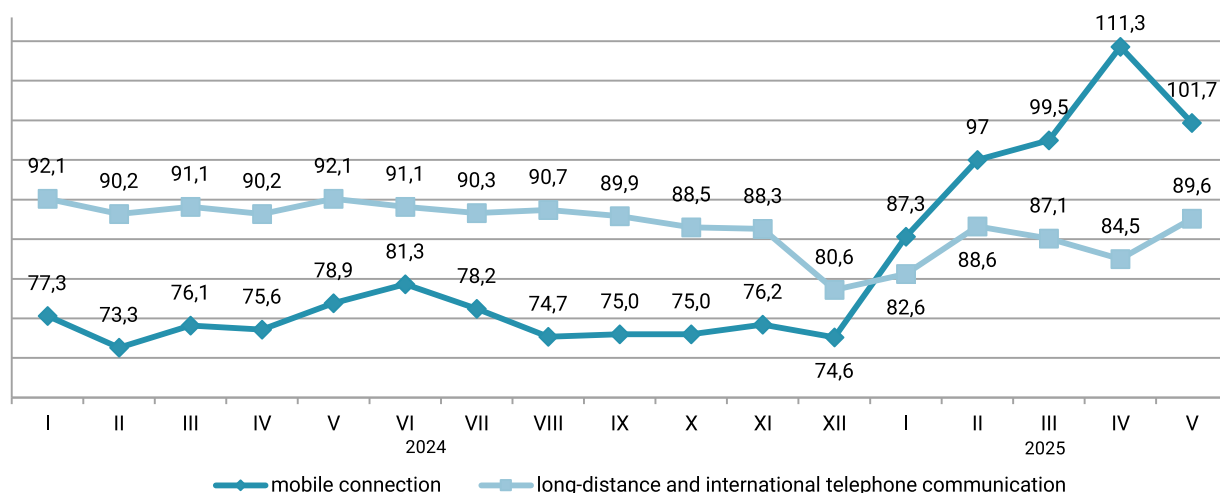

3.12 Statistics of enterprises

In May, compared to April 2025, there is a slight increase in the number of registered legal entities (by 0,4%), compared to the corresponding period of the previous year, their number increased by 2,3%. At the same time, there is an increase in the number of operating legal entities - by 0,07%, compared to the corresponding period of the previous year, their number increased by 0,7%. Since the beginning of the year, by type of economic activity, the largest number of registered legal entities remains in the industry «Wholesale and retail trade; car and motorcycle repair», the share of which as of June 1, 2025. amounted to 27%. On the second place – «Construction» (13,4%), on the third – «Provision of other types of services» (10,1%). Together, the share of these three types of activities is 50,5% of all registered legal entities.
