# Socio-economic development of the Republic of Kazakhstan in January-April 2023

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## 1 . Social indicators

### Population size and migration

The population of the country as of April 1, 2023 amounted to 19832.7 thousand people, including urban – 12259.5 thousand (61.8%), rural – 7573.3 thousand (38.2%) people.


In January-March 2023, compared to January-March 2022, the number of arrivals in Kazakhstan increased by 87%, the number of departures from Kazakhstan decreased by 49.6%.

The main migration exchange of the country takes place with the CIS countries. The share of arrivals from the CIS countries and departures to these countries amounted to 90% and 69.5%, respectively.

The number of migrants moving within the country decreased by 15.9%. In terms of interregional movements, a positive balance of population migration has developed in 3 regions of the country: the cities of Almaty (6782 people), Astana (6443 people) and Shymkent (241 people).


#### Changes in the rate of population growth

## Income of the population

The average per capita nominal cash income of the population, according to an estimate in march 2023, amounted to 167836 tenge (preliminary data), which is 17.9% higher than in march 2022, real cash income for the specified period decreased by 0.2%.


## Employment of the population

The number of employees at enterprises (organizations) in the I quarter of 2023 amounted to 3917.3 thousand people, of which at large and medium-sized enterprises - 2877.0 thousand people.

In the I quarter of 2023, 256.4 thousand people were hired by enterprises. 253.9 thousand people dropped out for various reasons. Worked by one employee 449.6 hours.

At the end of the I quarter of 2023, 52.3 thousand vacancies were not filled at enterprises (1.3% of the number of employees)

The number of unemployed, determined according to the methodology of the ILO, in the I quarter<sup>1)</sup> of 2023 amounted to 453.4 thousand people, the unemployment rate was 4.8%.

The employed population<sup>2)</sup> amounted to 9031.9 thousand people, including employees - 6900.4 thousand people, individual entrepreneurs - 1662.8 thousand people, persons engaged in private practice - 17.4 thousand people, individuals, who are founders (participants) of business partnerships and founders, shareholders (participants) of joint-stock companies, as well as members of production cooperatives - 13.5 thousand people, independent workers - 437.8 thousand people

From January 1, 2023, the minimum wage is set at 70000 tenge.

## 2. Economic indicators

### Statistics of prices

The consumer price index in April 2023 compared to March 2023 was 100.9%. Prices for non-food products increased by 1.3%, food products – by 0.9% and paid services – by 0.4%.

Among food products, an increase in prices was noted for cabbage by 4.7%, tomatoes – by 4.1%, grapes – by 3%, rice – by 2.7%, soft drinks – by 2.5%, ultra-pasteurized milk – by 2.4%, fresh fruits, chilled fish – by 2.2%, pasta, sweet pepper - 2.1% each, fermented dairy products, bananas – 1.7% each. Cucumbers fell by 11.4%, buckwheat – by 3.7%, sunflower oil – by 2.6%.

Among non-food products, diesel fuel prices increased by 16.1%, gasoline - by 9.7%. The increase in prices for detergents and cleaning products amounted to 1.4%, personal goods – 1.1%, dishes – 1%, household appliances – 0.9%.

The price level for air passenger transport services increased by 17.7%, hairdressers and beauty salons – by 1.5%, sanatoriums – by 1.1%.

In April 2023, compared with the previous month, the price index of producers of agricultural products amounted to 98.6%, crop production - 98.3%, livestock products – 99.3%. Wheat prices decreased by 3.8%, sunflower seeds - by 0.7%, dried peas – by 0.5%, and millet - increased by 1.5%, dried lentils - by 1.1%, rice - by 0.2%. Cucumbers of the closed ground fell in price by 5.4%, potatoes - by 0.6%, carrots - by 0.3%, and tomatoes of the closed ground - rose in price by 4.9%. A decrease in prices was noted for poultry meat by 3.5%, an increase – for pigs by 2%. Eggs fell in price by 1.9%, raw cow's milk rose in price by 0.8%.

Prices of manufacturing enterprises for industrial products in April 2023 decreased by 1.2% compared to the previous month. Prices for metal ores became lower by 3.1%, oil - by 1.9%, coal - by 1%. Of the oil products, fuel oil has risen in price by 7.9%. A decrease in prices was noted for zinc by 8%, ferroalloys - by 6.9%, aluminum - by 4.6%, lead - by 2.8%, rolled ferrous metals - by 2.6%, copper - by 2.5%, for precious metals - an increase of 7.8%. From food products, vegetable oil fell by 5.8%, wheat flour - by 5.1%, cereals - by 3%, sugar - 2%, poultry meat - by 1.6%, bread - by 1.4%, rice went up in price 4.9%, tea - by 2.6%.

In the service sector, communication tariffs in April 2023 compared to March 2023 increased by 0.8%, postal and courier services by 0.3%, tariffs for the carriage of goods by all modes of transport increased by 0.2%.

In April 2023, compared to the previous month, the price index in construction amounted to 100.4%, for construction and installation work - 100.5%, for machinery and equipment – 99%, for other work and costs – 99.3%.

## Gross domestic product

In the structure of GDP for January-March 2023, preliminary data, the production of goods amounted to 35.1%, the production of services - 55.9%. The main share in the production of GDP is occupied by industry - 29%, wholesale and retail trade; repair of cars and motorcycles - 16.2%.

## Statistics of investments

In January-April 2023, the volume of investments in fixed capital amounted to 3816.8 billion tenge, which is 18% more than in January-April 2022.

The predominant sources of investment financing remain the own funds of economic entities, the volume of which in January-April 2023 amounted to 3065.3 billion tenge.

In January-April 2023, compared with January-April 2022, there is an increase costs are for the construction and capital repair of buildings and constructions.

A significant share of investments in fixed capital in January-April 2023 accounted for mining and quarrying (37%), operations with real estate (20.9%), transport and warehousing (8.9%) and manufacturing industry (8.5%).

The volume of investments of large enterprises in January-April 2023 amounted to 1781.5 billion tenge.


The volume of retail trade in January-April 2023 amounted to 4825.9 billion tenge, which is 10.5% more than the corresponding period in 2022. Retail sales of goods by trading enterprises increased by 14%, individual entrepreneurs, including those trading in the markets, increased by 1.4% compared to January-April 2022

As of May 1, 2023, the volume of commodity stocks of trading enterprises (for reporting enterprises) in retail trade amounted to 1507.3 billion tenge, in trading days - 74 days.

The share of food products in the total volume of retail trade is 28.3%, non-food products - 71.7%. The volume of sales of food products compared to January-April 2022 decreased by 5.5%, non-food products increased by 18.7%.

The volume of wholesale trade in January-April 2023 amounted to 11330.2 billion tenge, or 11.4% more than the corresponding period in 2022. Non-food products and industrial and technical products (82.7%) prevail in the structure of wholesale trade.

as a percentage of the corresponding month of the previous year




## Statistics of foreign and mutual trade

According to SRCMF and BNS

Foreign trade turnover in January-March 2023 amounted to 32.7 billion US dollars (increased by 13.4% in nominal terms compared to January-March 2022), including exports –18.7 billion US dollars (2.1% less) and imports – 14 billion US dollars (increased by 43.8%).

Exports with the EAEU countries amounted to 2598.1 million US dollars, or 41.5% more than in January-March 2022, imports –4031 million US dollars, decreased by 1.8% compared to the corresponding period last year.



## Statistics of building and housing construction

In January-April 2023, the volume of construction work (services) amounted to 1015.1 billion tenge.

The largest amount of work in January-April 2023 was performed on the construction of non-residential buildings (437.3 billion tenge), facilities (423.4 billion tenge), and residential buildings (154.3 billion tenge).

The volume of construction and installation work in January-April 2023 compared to January-April 2022 increased by 16.4 and amounted to 899.5 billion tenge. The volume of construction work on capital repairs increased by 28.8% compared to the corresponding period last year, while on current repairs it decreased by 11.3%.


In January-April 2023, the construction of 10584 new buildings was completed, of which 9944 are residential and 640 are non-residential.

as a percentage of the corresponding month of the previous year




In January- April 2023, 768.2 billion tenge was allocated for housing construction. In the total volume of investments in fixed capital, the share of disbursed funds in housing construction amounted to 20.1%.

The main source of financing for housing construction in January- April 2023 is the own funds of developers, the share of which is 90.2%.

as a percentage of the corresponding month of the previous year




In January- April 2023, the total area of housing put into operation increased by 19.9% and amounted to 4329.4 thousand square meters, of which in multi-apartment buildings - by 35.2% (2474.8 thousand square meters). At the same time, the total area of individual houses put into operation decreased by 4.3% (1823 thousand sq.m.)

In the total volume of commissioned housing, the share of multi-apartment buildings was 57.2%, individual - 42.1%. The average actual cost of construction of 1 square meter of total housing area increased by 28.5%.

as a percentage of the corresponding month of the previous year



as a percentage of the corresponding month of the previous year







According to the Statistical Business Register, the largest number of operating individual entrepreneurs is concentrated in Almaty city (15.5%) of the total, Astana city (10.9%), Shymkent city (7.2%), Turkistan (8.4%), Almaty (6.4%) and Karaganda (5.2%) regions.

At the same time, a significant number of active peasant or farm enterprises were recorded in Turkistan (30.6%), Almaty (10.8%), Zhambyl (10%) and Zhetisu (7.6%) regions.
