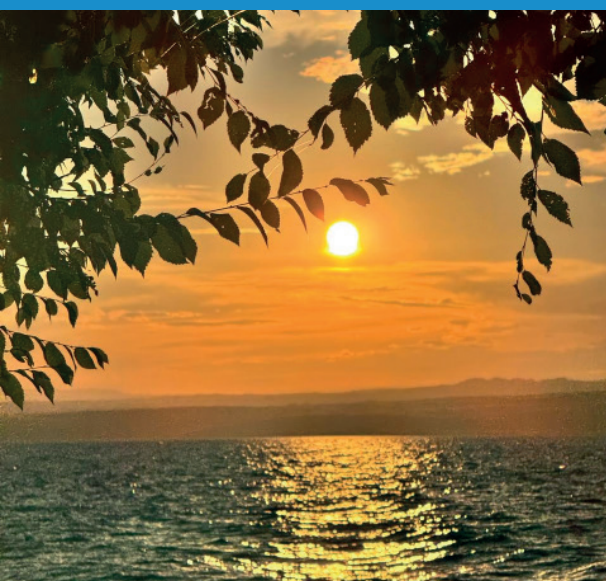

2. Social indicators

2.1 Population size and migration

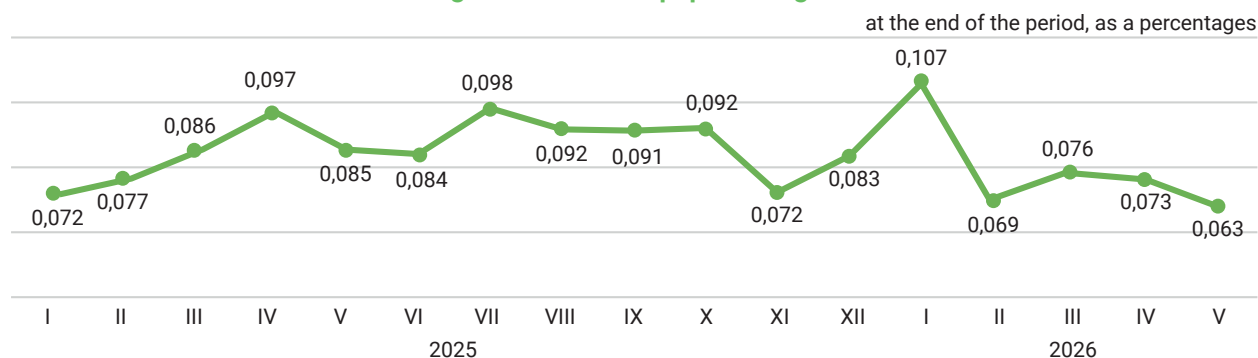
The population of the country as of June 1, 2026 amounted to 20576 thousand people, including 13168,5 thousand (64%) urban residents and 7407,5 thousand (36%) rural residents.

In January-May 2026, compared to January-May 2025, the number of arrivals to Kazakhstan decreased in 20,9%, while the number of departures from the country decreased in 29,5%.

The main migration exchange of the country occurs with the CIS member states, with the share of arrivals from and departures to these countries amounting to 70% and 62%, respectively.

The number of internal migrants increased by 4,6%. A positive net migration balance due to interregional movements was recorded in three regions of the country: the cities of Astana (26547 people), Almaty (9723 people), Shymkent (5687 people) and Almaty region (7103 people).

The average per capita nominal cash income of the population in I quarter 2026 amounted to 252619 tenge (preliminary data), which is 11,8% higher than in I quarter 2025, real cash income for the specified period increased by 0,1%.

2.3 Employment of the population

The number of unemployed, determined according to the methodology of the ILO, in the I quarter of 2026¹⁾ amounted to 446,1 thousand people, the unemployment rate was 4,5%.

The employed population²⁾ amounted to 9392,0 thousand people, including employees – 7290,4 thousand people, individual entrepreneurs – 1752,3 thousand people, persons engaged in private practice – 15,1 thousand people, individuals, who are founders (participants) of business partnerships and founders, shareholders (participants) of joint-stock companies, as well as members of production cooperatives – 7,6 thousand people, independent workers – 326,6 thousand people.

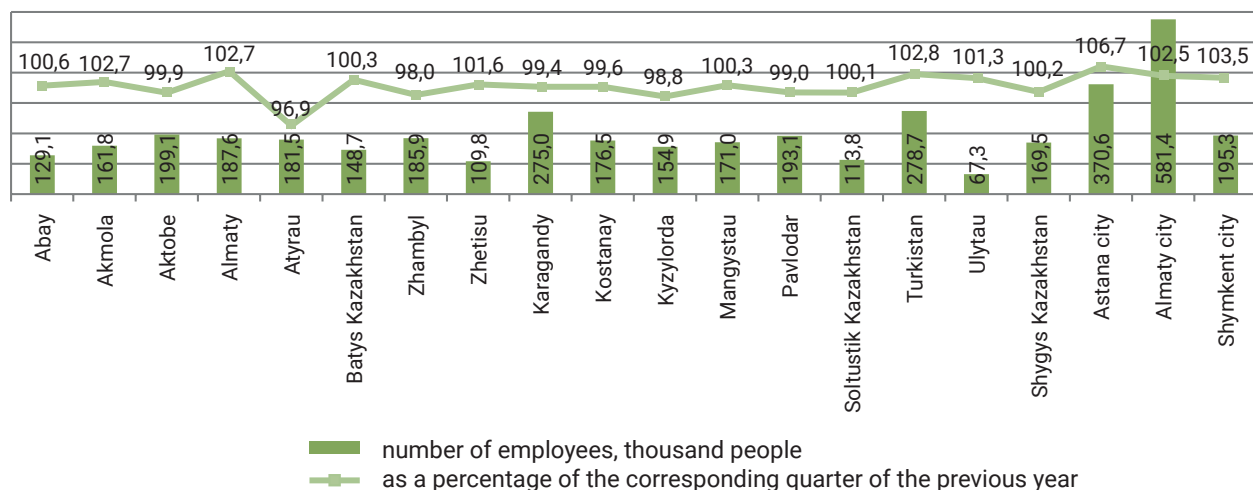

The number of employees at enterprises (organizations) in the IV quarter of 2025³⁾ amounted to 4050,3 thousand people, of which at large and medium-sized enterprises – 2915,9 thousand people.

In the I quarter of 2026 266,1 thousand people were hired by enterprises. 258,3 thousand people dropped out for various reasons. Worked by one employee 443,7 hours.

At the end of the I quarter of 2026, 59,3 thousand vacancies were not filled at enterprises (1,6% of the number of employees).

In the I quarter of 2026, the average monthly nominal salary amounted to 461486 tenge (excluding employees of small enterprises engaged in entrepreneurial activities). In the I quarter of 2026, the median salary was estimated to be 339912 tenge.

From January 1, 2026, the minimum wage is set at 85000 tenge.

3. Economic indicators

3.1 Statistics of prices

In June 2026, the monthly Consumer Price Index (CPI) stood at 100,8%. Prices for services increased by 1,1%, non-food goods – by 0,9%, and food products – by 0,6%.

In the services sector, prices increased for swimming pool services by 7,2%, children's amusement ride services – by 6,2%, international air passenger transport services – by 4,4%, hairdressing and beauty salon services – by 2,5%, personal care establishment services – by 2,1%, dwelling maintenance and repair services – by 1,4%, catering services – by 1,2%, railway passenger transport services – by 1,1%, and outpatient services – by 0,6%.

Among non-food goods, prices rose for household furniture by 2,9%, computers, laptops and tablets – by 2,4%, pharmaceutical products – by 1,3%, construction materials, clothing and footwear – by 1% each, personal hygiene products – by 0,9%, gold wedding rings – by 0,8%, and detergents and cleaning products by 0,7%. Prices for AI-92 gasoline increased – by 1,3%, diesel fuel – by 1%, and liquefied petroleum gas in cylinders – by 0,7%.

Among food products, prices increased for white cabbage by 31,4%, onions – by 20,9%, potatoes – by 10%, pears – by 8,3%, carrots – by 6,1%, grapes – by 4,4%, lamb – by 4,2%, cognac – by 4,1%, noodles – by 3,3%, granulated sugar – by 1,7%, butter – by 1,6%, sausages – by 1,2%, fish and seafood – by 1,1%, wheat flour and canned sweet corn – by 1,0% each, mayonnaise and sweetened condensed milk – by 0,8% each, and drinking milk and bone-in beef – by 0,7% each.

Price decreases were recorded for tomatoes by 14,4%, sweet peppers – by 12,6%, garlic – by 11,4%, beetroot – by 7,8%, eggs – by 3,8%, bananas – by 3,3%, and unsweetened condensed milk – by 1,9%.

In June 2026, compared to the previous month, the producer price index for agricultural products was 99,7%, for crop products – 100,7%, for livestock products – 97,3%.

Price increased were for cucumbers in protected ground by 26,1%, oats – by 2,7%, potato – by 2,5%, barley – by 1,9%, wheat and sunflower seeds – by 0,9% each, curly flax seeds – by 0,6%, millet – by 0,4% and feed grain crops – by 0,2%.

Price reduction were recorded at indoor tomatoes by 7,5%, flowers and flower buds, cut – by 3,1%, dried peas – by 3%, rapeseed seeds – by 1%, lentils dried – by 0,9% and hay – by 0,7%.

Among livestock products, prices increased for raw camel milk by 0,8%, pigs – by 0,6%, sheep – by 0,4%, horses and natural honey – by 0,2% each, while prices for eggs – by 9% and poultry – by 4%.

Prices of manufacturing enterprises for industrial products in June 2026 increased by 0,5% compared to the previous month. Metal ores prices were higher by 4,9%, natural gas – by 1,6%, coal – by 0,7%, oil lower by 1,6%. Of petroleum products, propane and butane liquefied rose in price by 1%, gasoline – by 0,8%.

An increase in prices was noted for led by 9,4%, zinc – by 5,6%, aluminum – by 5,1%, rolled ferrous metals – by 2,4%, copper – by 0,8%, ferroalloys decrease by 0,7%, precious metals – by 0,4%.

From food products, rice rose in price by 1,7%, flour – by 1,6%, fish – by 0,4%, tea – by 0,3%, sugar fell in price by 1,2%, pasta – by 0,2%.

In the service sector, tariffs for the transportation of goods by all modes of transport in June 2026 increased by 2,6% compared to the previous month, while tariffs for communication services and tariffs for postal and courier services remained unchanged.

In June 2026, compared to the previous month, the price index in construction was 101,2%. Prices for construction and installation works increased by 1,3%, other works and costs – by 1,9%, machinery and equipment decreased – by 0,3%.

3.3 Gross Domestic Product

In the structure of GDP for January-March 2026 (reported data) the production of goods amounted to 35,7%, the production of services – 56,5%. The main share in the production of GDP is occupied by industry – 28,5%, wholesale and retail trade; repair of cars and motorcycles – 16,9%.

According to reporting data, in the sectoral structure of income formation for January-March 2026, compensation of employees in the production of goods and services amounted to 24,5% and 33,4%, respectively, the share of other taxes on production is 2,7% in the production of goods and 1,8% in the production of services, respectively, the share of gross operating surplus /gross mixed income was 72,8 % and 64,8%.

The Gross Domestic Product calculated by the final expenditure method for January–March 2026 amounted to 33207500,2 million tenge. In comparison with the corresponding period of last year in real terms there is an increase in the component of final consumption expenditure: households – by 5,7%, government – by 12,8% and a decrease in non-profit organizations serving households – by 11,5%.

3.4 Investment statistics

In January-June 2026, the volume of investments in fixed capital amounted to 9512,1 billion tenge, which is 9,6% more than in January-June 2025.

The predominant sources of investment financing remain the own funds of economic entities, the volume of which in January-June 2026 amounted to 6544,4 billion tenge.

In January-June 2026, compared with January-June 2025, there is an increase costs for the purchase of machinery, quipment and vehicles and their capital repairs by 35,6%.

A significant share of investments in fixed capital in January-June 2026 accounted for industry (41,4%) (including mining and quarrying – 13,8%, manufacturing industry – 15%), operations with real estate (18,8%), transport and warehousing (15,9%) and agriculture, forestry and fisheries (6,2%).

The volume of investments of large enterprises in January-June 2026 amounted to 2857,1 billion tenge.

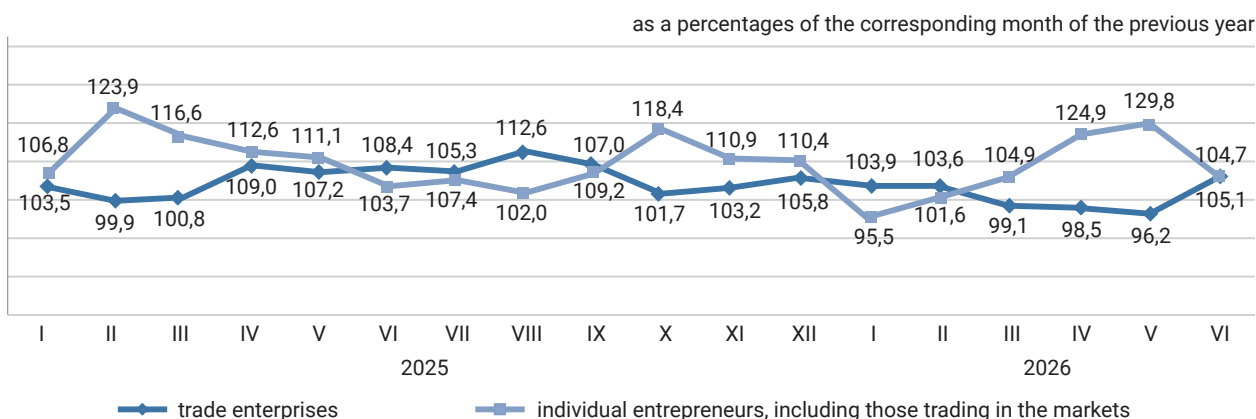
3.5 Statistics of domestic trade

The volume of retail trade in January-June 2026 amounted to 11532,5 billion tenge, which is 3,8% more than the corresponding period in 2025. Retail sales of goods by trading enterprises increased by 0,8%, individual entrepreneurs, including those trading in the markets, increased by 11,5% compared to January-June 2025.

As of July 1, 2026, the volume of commodity stocks of trading enterprises (for reporting enterprises) in retail trade amounted to 1724 billion tenge, in trading days - 61 days.

The share of food products in the total volume of retail trade is 32,3%, non-food products – 67,7%. The volume of sales of food products compared to January-June 2025 increased by 9,5%, non-food products increased by 1,3%.

The volume of wholesale trade in January-June 2026 amounted to 24485,5 billion tenge, which is 6,6% more than the corresponding period in 2025. Non-food products and industrial and technical products (79,5%) prevail in the structure of wholesale trade.

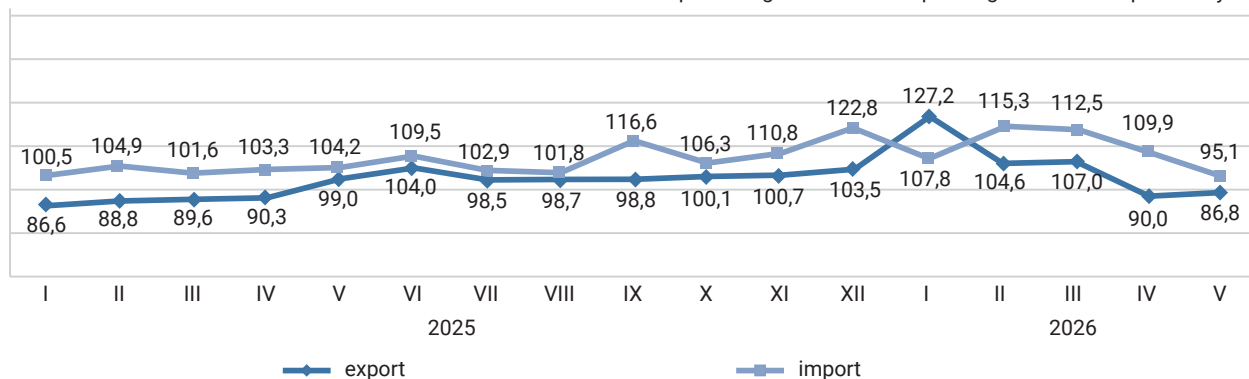

Foreign trade turnover in January-May 2026 amounted to 56,3 billion US dollars (increased by 4,3% in nominal terms compared to January-May 2025) including exports – 30,4 billion US dollars (1,6% more) and imports – 26 billion US dollars (increased by 7,7% than corresponding period last year).

Exports with the EAEU countries amounted to 3549,2 million US dollars or 7,1% less than in January-May 2025, imports – 8917,7 million US dollars increased by 20,6% compared to the corresponding period last year.

3.7 Statistics of agriculture, forestry, hunting and fisheries

Gross output of products (services) of agriculture, forestry and fisheries in January-June 2026 amounted to 2207,2 billion tenge, including crop production – 114,8 billion tenge, livestock – 2058,6 billion tenge, hunting – 1,0 billion tenge, forestry – 13,7 billion tenge, fisheries and aquaculture – 18,6 billion tenge, services in agriculture – 1,1 billion tenge.

Out of the total output volume, agricultural formations account for 1089,1 billion tenge or 49,3 percent of the total volume, including 29,7 billion tenge (26,0 percent) in crop production and 963,1 billion tenge (46,8 percent) in livestock breeding.

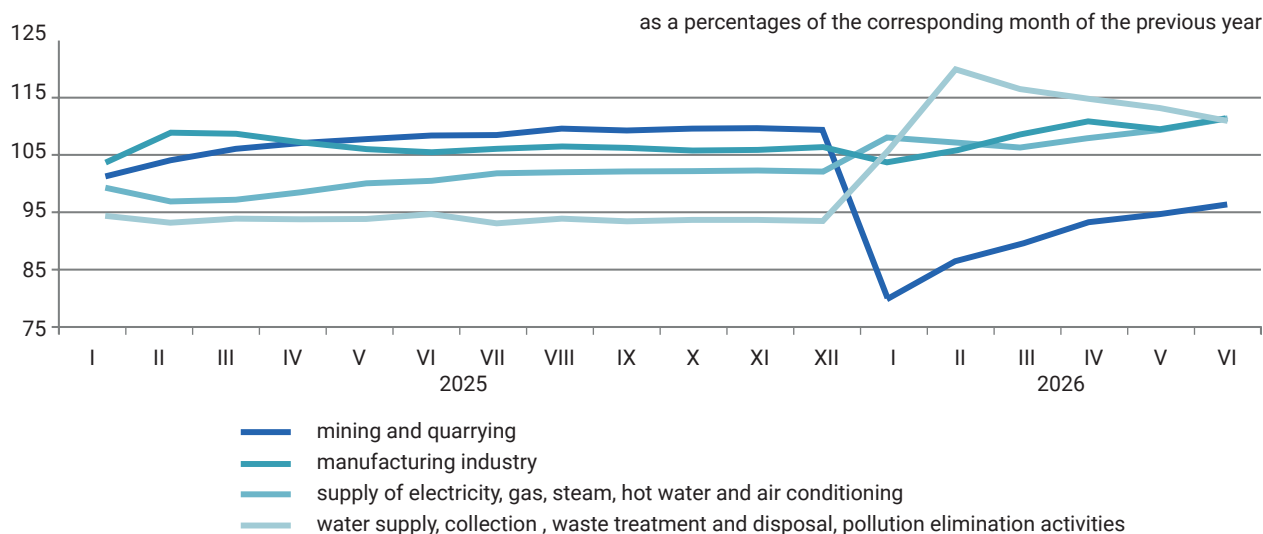

3.9 Statistics of building and housing construction

In January-June 2026, the volume of construction work increased by 15,2% and amounted to 4072,1 billion tenge.

The largest amount of work in January-June 2026 was performed on the construction of facilities (2199 billion tenge), non-residential buildings (1214,8 billion tenge) and residential buildings (658,3 billion tenge).

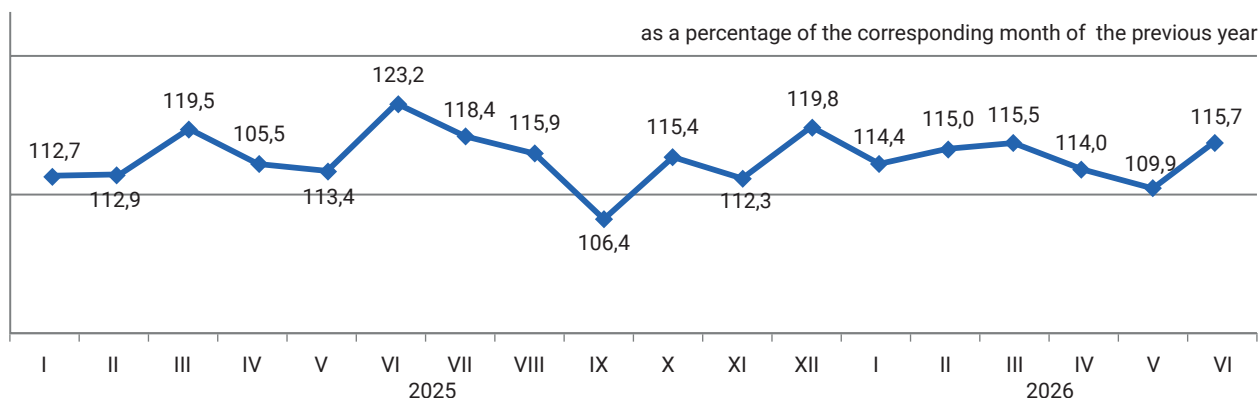

Indices of physical volume of construction



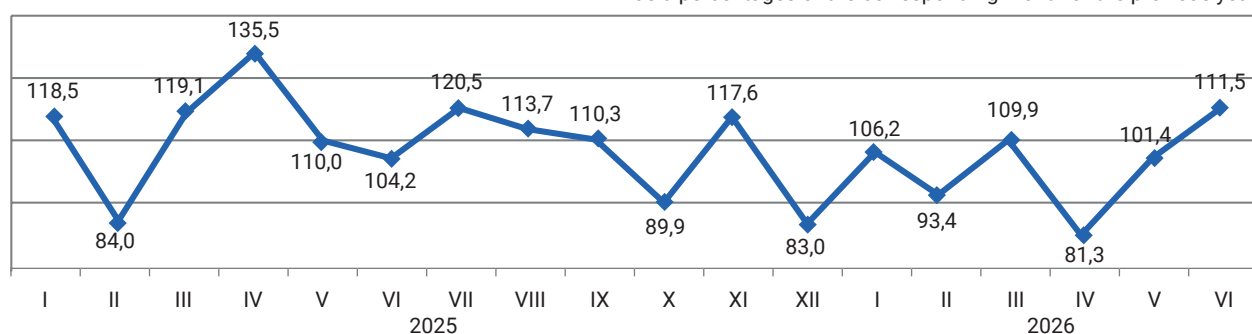

In January-June 2026, 1665,5 billion tenge was allocated for housing construction. In the total volume of investments in fixed capital, the share of disbursed funds in housing construction amounted to 17,5%.

The main source of financing for housing construction in January-June 2026 is the own funds of developers, the share of which is 94,5%.

as a percentages of the corresponding month of the previous year

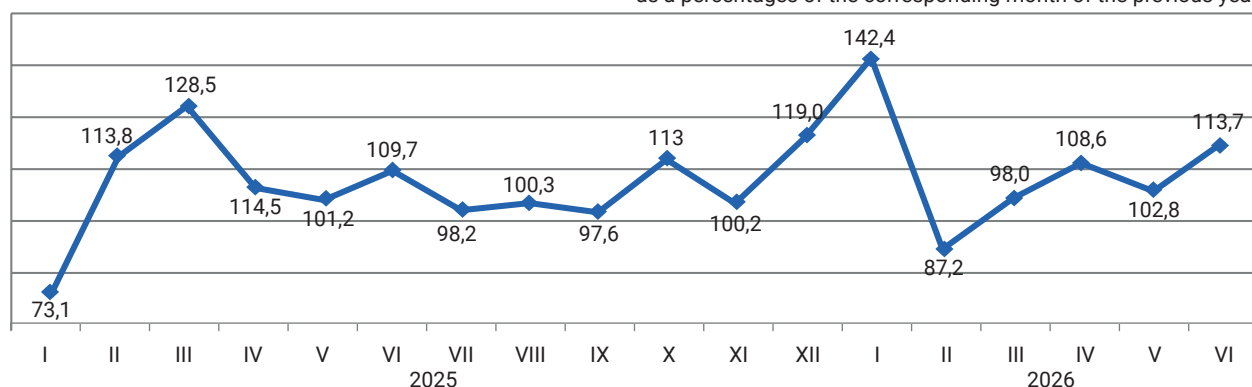


In January-June 2026, the total area of housing put into operation to January-June 2025 increased by 6,7% and amounted to 8466,7 thousand square meters, of which in multi-apartment buildings – by 13,2% (5754,6 thousand square meters). At the same time, the total area of commissioned individual residential buildings decreased by 2,4% (2689,9 thousand square meters).

In the total volume of commissioned housing, the share of multi-apartment buildings was 68%, individual – 31,8%. The average actual cost of construction of 1 square meter of total housing area increased by 4,1%.

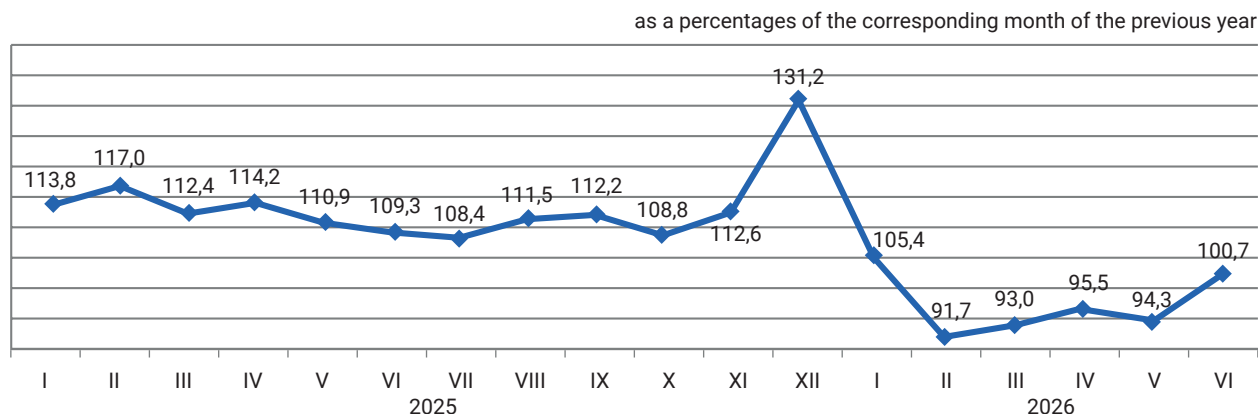

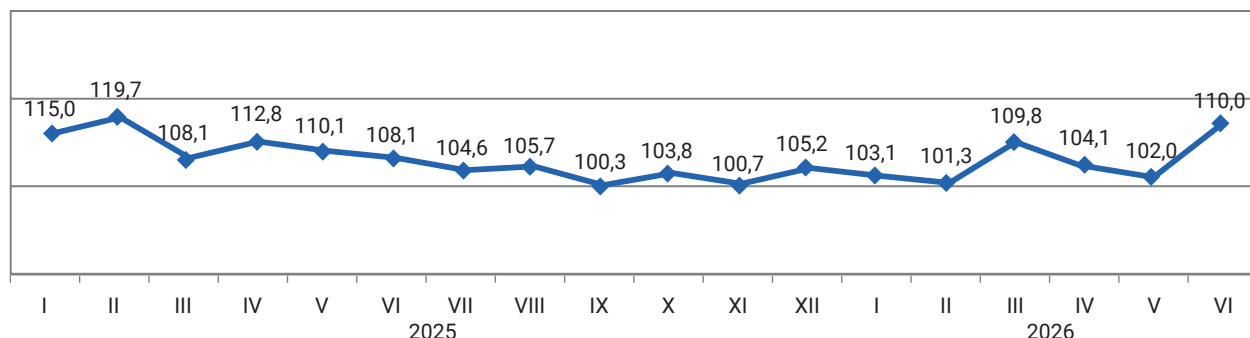

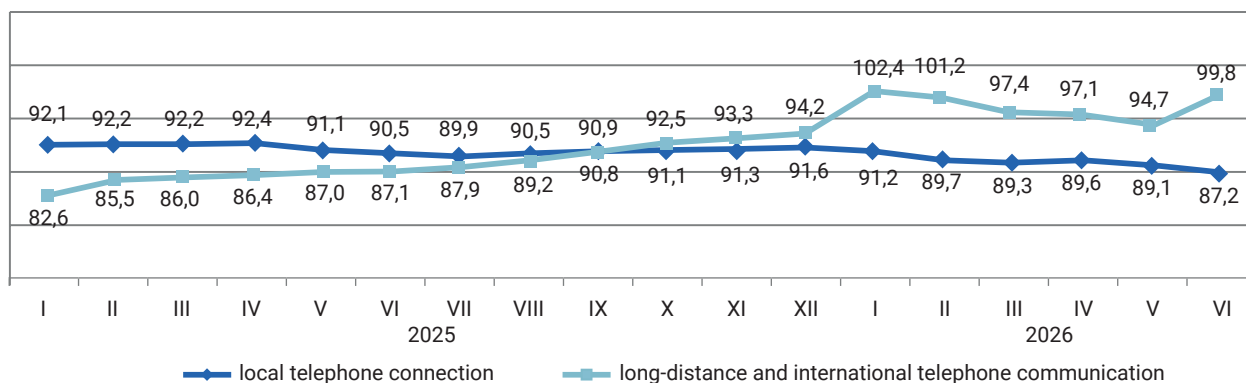

3.11 Statistics of communications

In June, compared to May 2026, there is a slight increase in the number of registered legal entities (by 0,4%), compared to the corresponding period of the previous year, their number increased by 1,2%. At the same time, there is an increase in the number of operating legal entities - by 0,4%, compared to the corresponding period of the previous year, their number increased by 4,3%. Since the beginning of the year, by type of economic activity, the largest number of registered legal entities remains in the industry «Wholesale and retail trade; car and motorcycle repair», the share of which as of July 1, 2026. amounted to 26,3%. On the second place – «Construction» (13,5%), on the third – «Provision of other types of services» (10%). Together, the share of these three types of activities is 49,8% of all registered legal entities.
