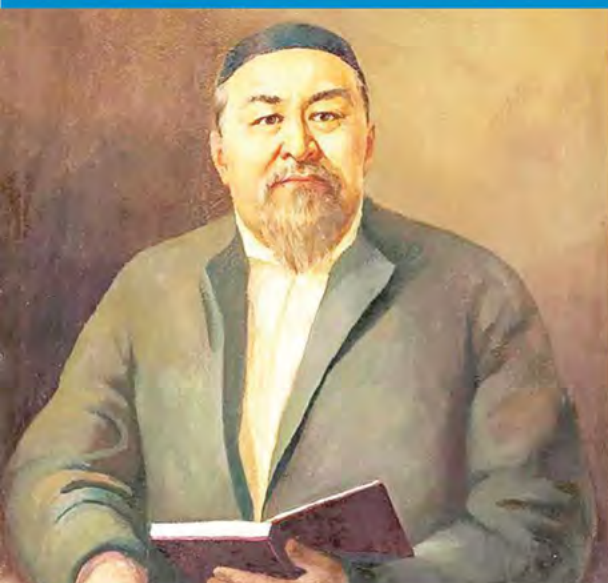

## 2. Social indicators

### 2.1 Population size and migration

The population of the country as of August 1, 2025 amounted to 20407,8 thousand people, including 12926,1 thousand (63,3%) urban residents and 7481,8 thousand (36,7%) rural residents.

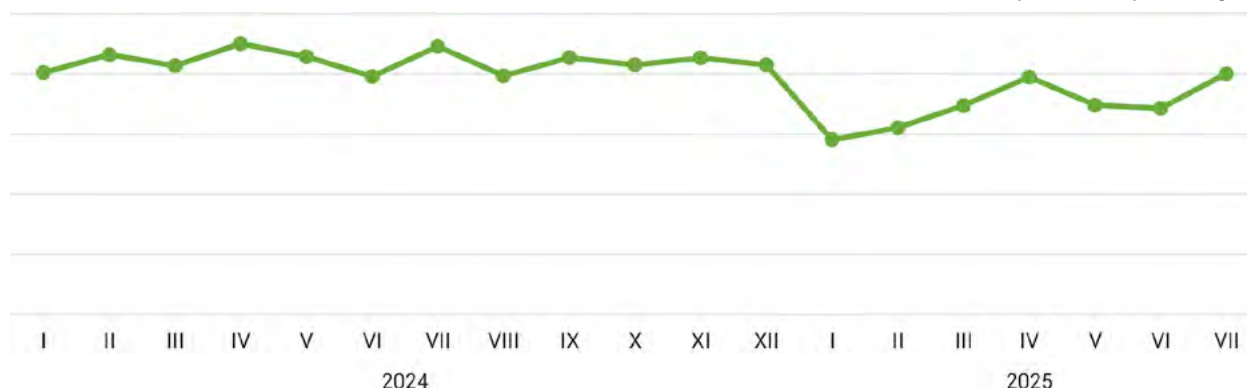
In January-July 2025, compared to January-July 2024, the number of arrivals to Kazakhstan decreased by 16%, while the number of departures from the country decreased by 41,8%.

The main migration exchange of the country occurs with the CIS member states, with the share of arrivals from and departures to these countries amounting to 82,8% and 74,5%, respectively.

The number of internal migrants increased by 22,1%. A positive net migration balance due to interregional movements was recorded in three regions of the country: the cities of Astana (10383 people), Almaty (3266 people), and Shymkent (1431 people).

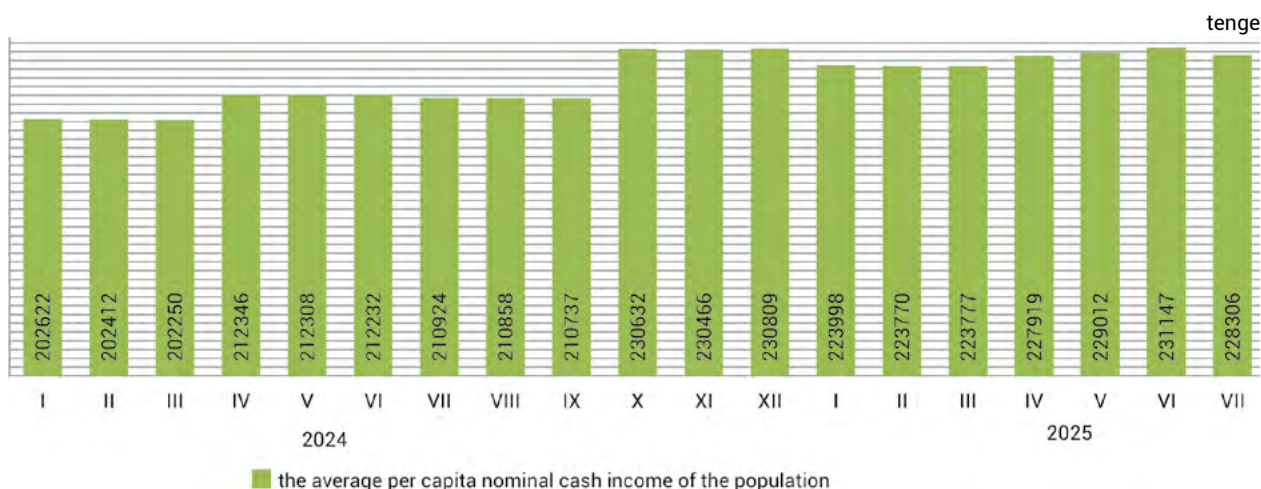

## 2.2 Income of the population

The average per capita nominal cash income of the population, according to an estimate in July 2025, amounted to 228 306 tenge (preliminary data), which is 8,2% higher than in July 2024, real cash income for the specified period decreased by 3,2%.

## 2.3 Employment of the population

The number of unemployed, determined according to the methodology of the ILO, in the II quarter of 2025<sup>1)</sup> amounted to 448,8 thousand people, the unemployment rate was 4,6%.

The employed population<sup>2)</sup> amounted to 9300,4 thousand people, including employees – 7139,3 thousand people, individual entrepreneurs – 1732,3 thousand people, persons engaged in private practice – 20,4 thousand people, individuals, who are founders (participants) of business partnerships and founders, shareholders (participants) of joint-stock companies, as well as members of production cooperatives – 25,6 thousand people, independent workers – 382,8 thousand people.

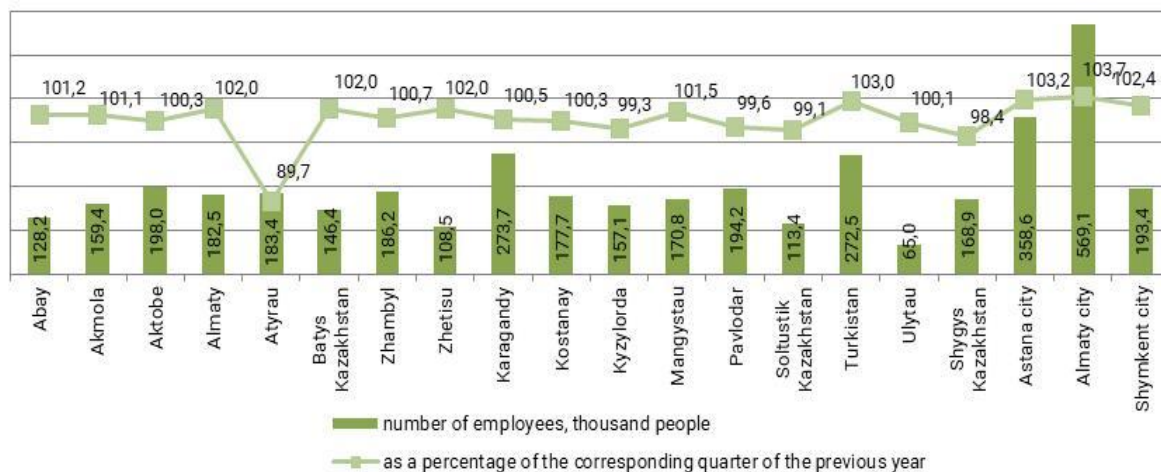

The number of employees at enterprises (organizations) in the II quarter of 2025<sup>3)</sup> amounted to 4007,0 thousand people, of which at large and medium-sized enterprises – 2873,0 thousand people.

In the II quarter of 2025, 242,2 thousand people were hired by enterprises. 258,2 thousand people dropped out for various reasons. Worked by one employee 460,2 hours.

At the end of the II quarter of 2025, 62,3 thousand vacancies were not filled at enterprises (1,6% of the number of employees).

## 2.4 Remuneration of labor at enterprises and organizations\*

In the II quarter of 2025, the average monthly nominal salary amounted to 448620 tenge (excluding employees of small enterprises engaged in entrepreneurial activities). In the II quarter of 2025, the median salary was estimated to be 316152 tenge.

From January 1, 2025, the minimum wage is set at 85000 tenge.

### 3. Economic indicators

#### 3.1 Statistics of prices

In August 2025, the monthly consumer price index increased to 1%. Prices for paid services by 1.4%, non-food products increased – by 1%, food products – by 0.5%.

In the field of paid services, the price level for gas transported through distribution networks increased by 24.1%, cargo transportation – by 6.7%, electricity – by 4.5%, travel by city bus – by 3.3%, rental of housing – by 2.3%.

Among the non-food products, a price increase was observed for school backpack by 6.9%, stationery – by 3%, baby clothing – by 2.9%, children's shoes – by 2.2%. Liquefied gas in cylinders increased in price by 6.5%, AI-92 petrol – by 2.7%, AI-95/96 petrol – by 1.4%, diesel fuel – by 1.2%.

Of the food products, prices increased for cucumbers by 12.2%, beef – by 3.7%, lamb – by 3.3%, meat products – by 2.9%, poultry meat – by 2.8%, coffee and lemons – by 2.6%, horse meat – by 2.5%, confectionery products – by 2.2%. Prices for onions decreased – by 25.9%, potatoes – by 21.9%, carrots – by 16.5%, beets – by 13.8%, tomatoes – by 13.7%, grapes – by 11.9%, cabbage – by 7.6%.

In August 2025, the producer price index for agricultural products was 107,0 compared to the previous month. Prices for crop products increased by 0.8%, and prices for livestock products increased by 15,3%.

Price increases were noted for carrots - by 10,3%, hay - by 6%, open-ground cucumbers - by 4,4%, greenhouse cucumbers - by 2,6%, safflower seeds, eggplants - by 1,9% each, peppers - by 1,3%, garlic - by 1%, melons - by 0,9%, wheat (except durum) - by 0,8%, sunflower seeds - by 0,7%.

Among livestock products, prices increased for eggs by 22,4%, pigs by 15,7%, poultry by 6,2%, sheep by 0,7%, horses and cattle by 0,4%.

Prices of manufacturing enterprises for industrial products in August 2025 increased by 2,2% compared to the previous month. Metal ores prices were higher by 5,6%, natural gas – by 3,2%, oil – by 2,9%, coal – by 0,6%. Of petroleum products, propane and butane liquefied rose in price by 5,5%, diesel fuel – by 1,4%, fuel oil fell in price by 1,1%.

An increase in prices was noted for zinc by 7,1%, aluminum – by 5,7%, lead – by 4,3%, precious metals – by 2,9%, copper – by 0,7%, for ferroalloys – a decrease by 1,9%, rolled ferrous metals – by 1,6%.

From food products, vegetable oil rose in price by 3%, wheat flour – by 2,1%, livestock meat – by 1,8%, rye flour – by 1,7%, poultry meat – by 1%, cereals – by 0,8%, sugar – 0,5%.

In the service sector, tariffs for the transportation of goods by all modes of transport in August 2025 increased by 0,7% compared to the previous month, tariffs for postal and courier services by 0,2%, and for communication services remained unchanged.

In August 2025, compared to the previous month, the price index in construction was 100,2%. Prices for construction and installation work increased by – 0,1%, machinery and equipment increased by 0,7%, other works and costs - by 1.7%.

### 3.4 Investment statistics

In January-August 2025, the volume of investments in fixed capital amounted to 11543,1 billion tenge, which is 14,3% more than in January-August 2024.

The predominant sources of investment financing remain the own funds of economic entities, the volume of which in January-August 2025 amounted to 7320,3 billion tenge.

In January-August 2025, compared with January-August 2024, there is an increase costs for works on construction and capital repair of buildings and constructions by 20,9%.

A significant share of investments in fixed capital in January-August 2025 accounted for industry (37,3%) (including mining and quarrying – 15,7%, manufacturing industry – 11%), operations with real estate (19,4%), transport and warehousing (18%) and education (7,3%).

The volume of investments of large enterprises in January-August 2025 amounted to 3592 billion tenge.

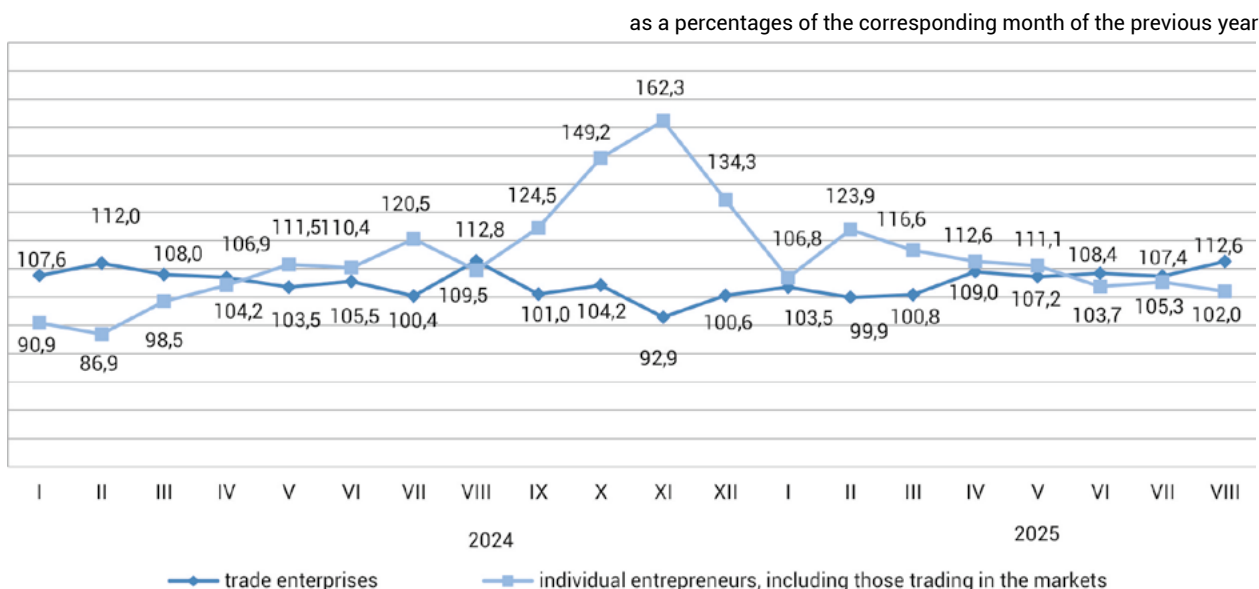
### 3.5 Statistics of domestic trade

The volume of retail trade in January-August 2025 amounted to 14805,9 billion tenge, which is 6,9% more than the corresponding period in 2024. Retail sales of goods by trading enterprises increased by 6,3%, individual entrepreneurs, including those trading in the markets, increased by 8,2% compared to January-August 2024.

As of September 1, 2025, the volume of commodity stocks of trading enterprises (for reporting enterprises) in retail trade amounted to 1588,2 billion tenge, in trading days - 56 days.

The share of food products in the total volume of retail trade is 31,9%, non-food products – 68,1%. The volume of sales of food products compared to January-August 2024 increased by 6,3%, non-food products increased by 7,2%.

The volume of wholesale trade in January-August 2025 amounted to 29901,5 billion tenge, which is 9,8% more than the corresponding period in 2024. Non-food products and industrial and technical products (81,8%) prevail in the structure of wholesale trade.

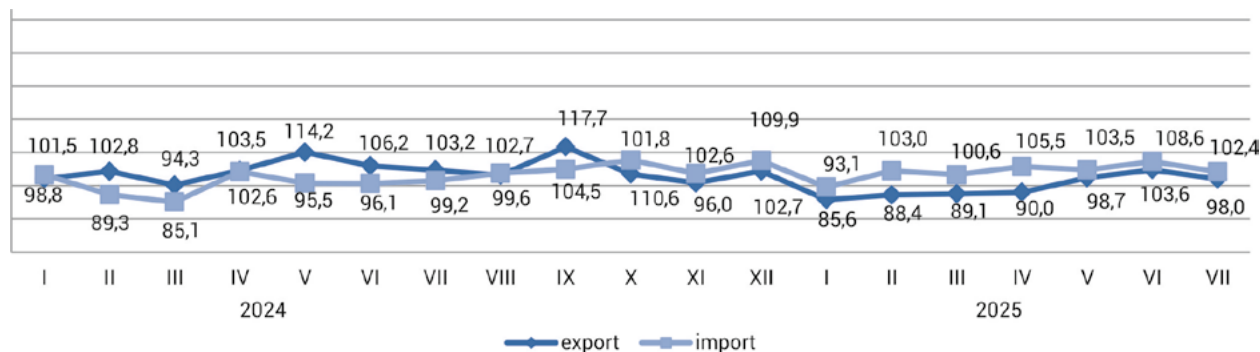

Foreign trade turnover in January-July 2025 amounted to 78,2 billion US dollars (decreased by 2,6% in nominal terms compared to January-July 2024) including exports – 43,6 billion US dollars (6,4% less) and imports – 34,6 billion US dollars (increased by 2,6% than corresponding period last year).

Exports with the EAEU countries amounted to 5525,7 million US dollars or 11% less than in January-July 2024, imports – 10699,5 million US dollars decreased by 1,7% compared to the corresponding period last year.

### 3.7 Statistics of agriculture, forestry, hunting and fisheries

Gross output of products (services) of agriculture, forestry and fisheries in January-August 2025 amounted to 3555,3 billion tenge, including crop production – 1254,1 billion tenge, livestock – 2262,3 billion tenge, hunting – 1,1 billion tenge, forestry – 15,4 billion tenge, fisheries and aquaculture – 18,5 billion tenge, services in agriculture – 3,8 billion tenge.

Out of the total output volume, agricultural formations account for 1995,9 billion tenge or 56,7 percent of the total volume, including 947 billion tenge (75,5 percent) in crop production and 1010 billion tenge (44,6 percent) in livestock breeding.

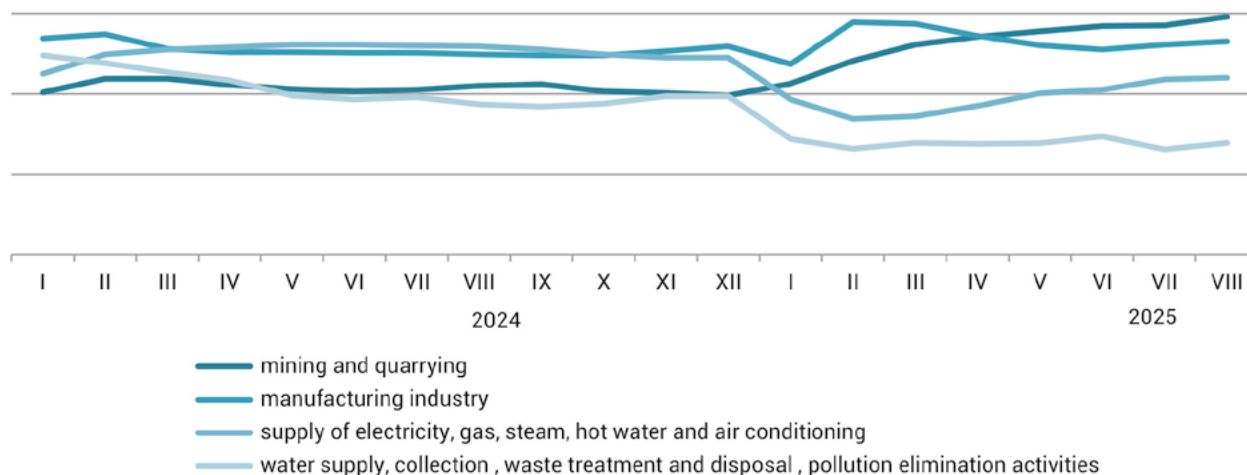

### 3.9 Statistics of building and housing construction

In January-August 2025, the volume of construction work increased by 18,1% and amounted to 4851 billion tenge.

The largest amount of work in January-August 2025 was performed on the construction of facilities (2561,6 billion tenge), non-residential buildings (1496,6 billion tenge) and residential buildings (792,8 billion tenge).

The volume of construction and installation work in January-August 2025 compared to January-August 2024 increased by 16,2% and amounted to 4016 billion tenge. The volume of construction work on major repairs increased by 19,5% and on current repairs by 36,8%.

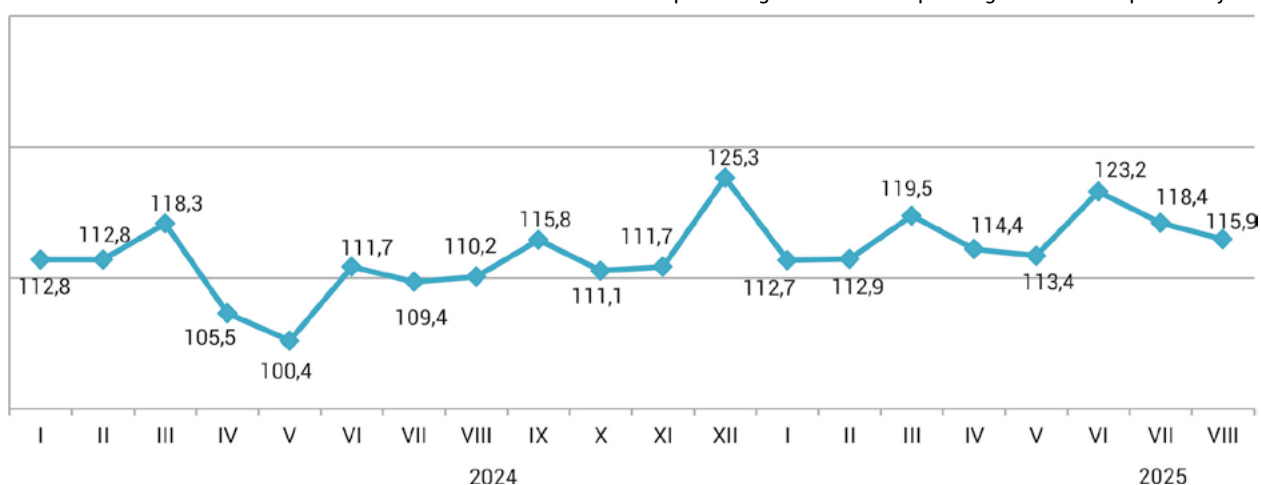
In January-August 2025, the construction of 24155 new buildings was completed, of which 22284 are residential and 1871 are non-residential.

as a percentages of the corresponding month of the previous year



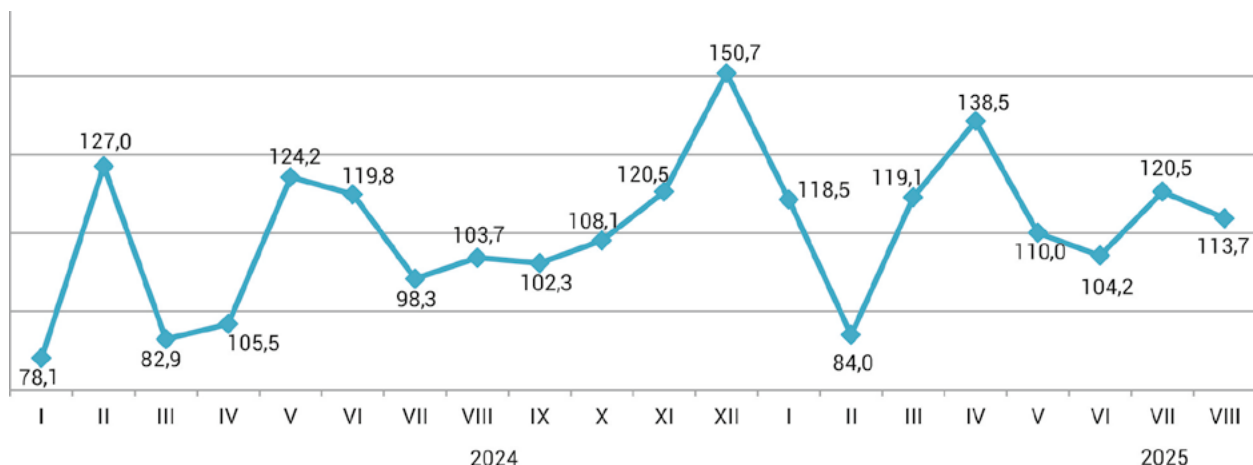

as a percentages of the corresponding month of the previous year

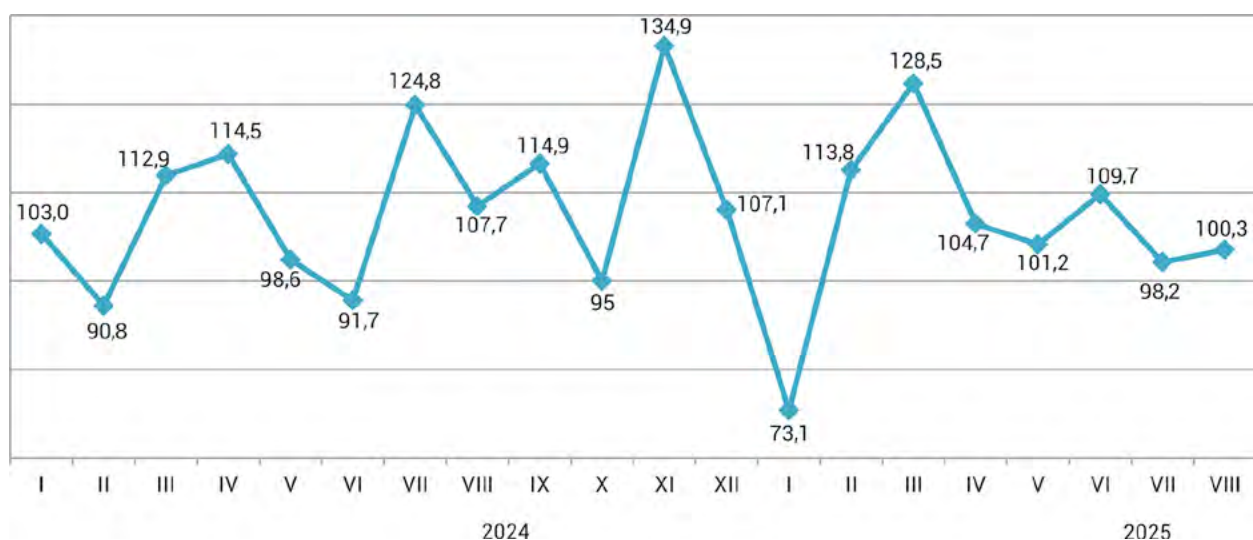


In January-August 2025, the total area of housing put into operation to January-August 2024 increased by 4,5% and amounted to 10935,3 thousand square meters, of which in multi-apartment buildings – by 5,8% (6897,6 thousand square meters), of individual residential buildings - by 1,3% (3936,3 thousand square meters).

In the total volume of commissioned housing, the share of multi-apartment buildings was 63,1%, individual – 36%. The average actual cost of construction of 1 square meter of total housing area increased by 12,3%.

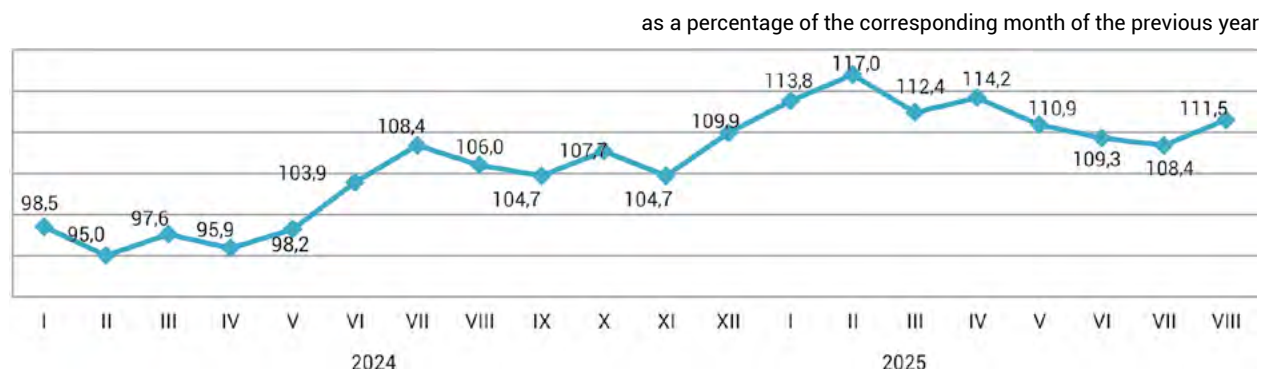

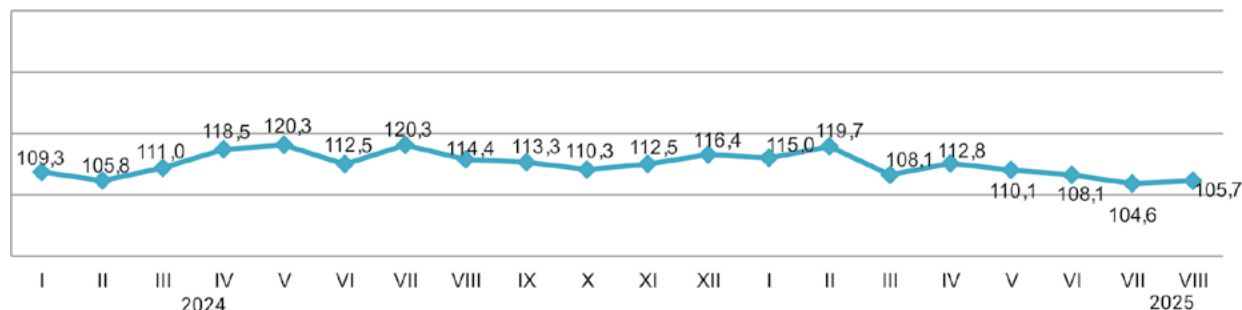

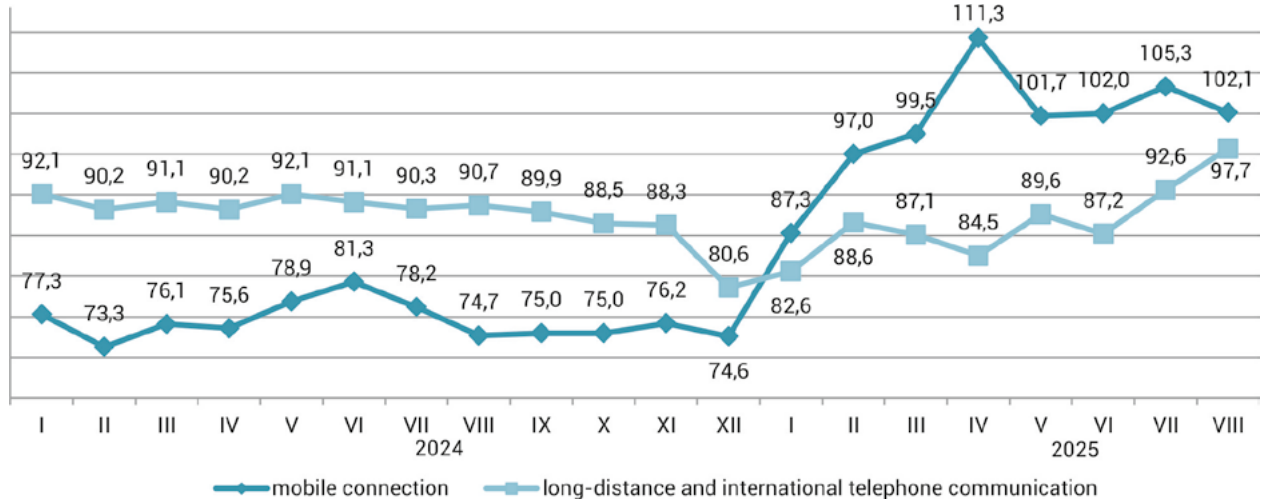

### 3.11 Statistics of communications

### 3.12 Statistics of enterprises

In August, compared to July 2025, there is a slight increase in the number of registered legal entities (by 0,4%), compared to the corresponding period of the previous year, their number increased by 2,3%. At the same time, there is an increase in the number of operating legal entities - by 0,4%, compared to the corresponding period of the previous year, their number increased by 2,1%. Since the beginning of the year, by type of economic activity, the largest number of registered legal entities remains in the industry «Wholesale and retail trade; car and motorcycle repair», the share of which as of September 1, 2025. amounted to 26,9%. On the second place – «Construction» (13,4%), on the third – «Provision of other types of services» (10,1%). Together, the share of these three types of activities is 50,5% of all registered legal entities.
