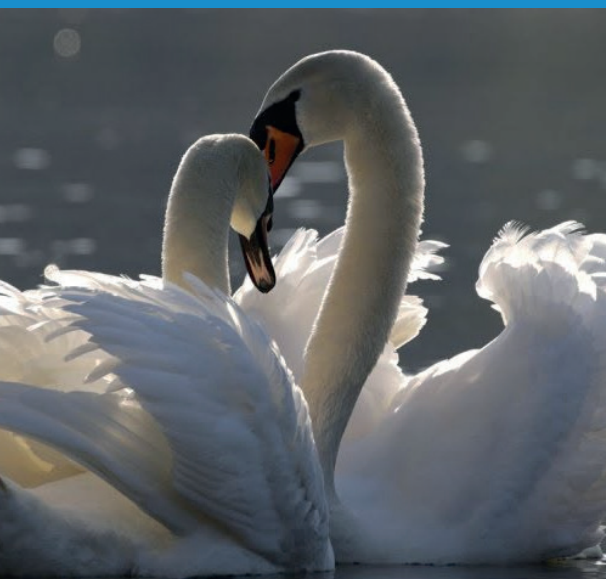

2. Social indicators

2.1 Population size and migration

The population of the country as of August 1, 2026 amounted to 20604,8 thousand people, including 13211,8 thousand (64,1%) urban residents and 7393,1 thousand (35,9%) rural residents.

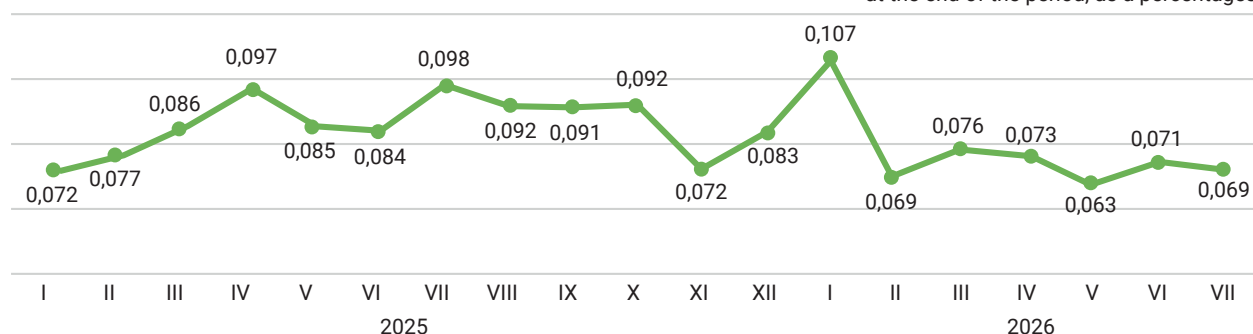
In January-July 2026, compared to January-July 2025, the number of arrivals to Kazakhstan decreased in 37,1%, while the number of departures from the country decreased in 37,5%.

The main migration exchange of the country occurs with the CIS member states, with the share of arrivals from and departures to these countries amounting to 69,5% and 63,6%, respectively.

The number of internal migrants increased by 4,6%. A positive net migration balance due to interregional movements was recorded in three regions of the country: the cities of Astana (38825 people), Almaty (19898 people), Shymkent (7450 people) and Almaty region (6861 people).

The average per capita nominal cash income of the population in I quarter 2026 amounted to 252619 tenge (preliminary data), which is 11,8% higher than in I quarter 2025, real cash income for the specified period increased by 0,1%.

2.3 Employment of the population

The number of unemployed, determined according to the methodology of the ILO, in the II quarter of 2026¹⁾ amounted to 444,6 thousand people, the unemployment rate was 4,5%.

The employed population²⁾ amounted to 9399,9 thousand people, including employees – 7253.3 thousand people, individual entrepreneurs – 1753,4 thousand people, persons engaged in private practice – 13,5 thousand people, individuals, who are founders (participants) of business partnerships and founders, shareholders (participants) of joint-stock companies, as well as members of production cooperatives – 6,7 thousand people, independent workers – 372,1 thousand people.

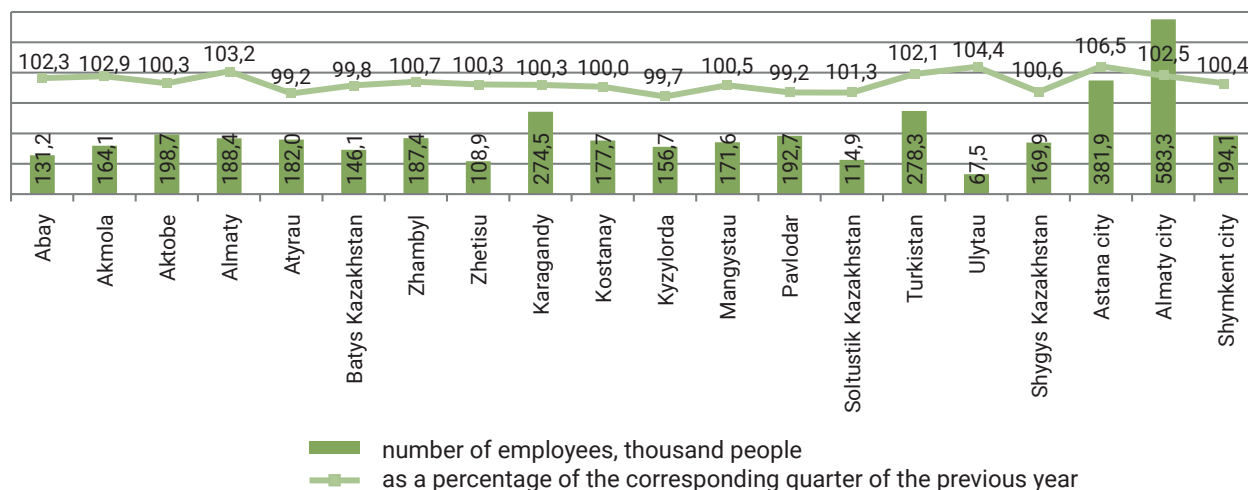

The number of employees at enterprises (organizations) in the I quarter of 2026³⁾ amounted to 4050,3 thousand people, of which at large and medium-sized enterprises – 2915,9 thousand people.

In the I quarter of 2026 266,1 thousand people were hired by enterprises. 258,3 thousand people dropped out for various reasons. Worked by one employee 443,7 hours.

At the end of the I quarter of 2026, 59,3 thousand vacancies were not filled at enterprises (1,6% of the number of employees).

In the II quarter of 2026, the average monthly nominal salary amounted to 486388 tenge (excluding employees of small enterprises engaged in entrepreneurial activities). In the II quarter of 2026, the median salary was estimated to be 348415 tenge.

From January 1, 2026, the minimum wage is set at 85000 tenge.

3. Economic indicators

3.1 Statistics of prices

In August 2026, the monthly Consumer Price Index (CPI) amounted to 100,6%. Prices for paid services increased by 1,2%, prices for non-food goods increased by 0,8%, while prices for food products decreased by 0,1%.

In the paid services sector, prices increased for gas transported through distribution networks by 29,5%, services of private educational organizations – by 5,7%, rent for comfortable housing – by 4,6%, car washing services – by 3%, bathhouse services (common hall) – by 2%, residential maintenance and repair services, services of preschool institutions and pedicure services – by 1,4% each, X-ray services and swimming pool services – by 1,3% each, hot water – by 1%, electricity and plumbing services – by 0,9% each, and services of child development centres by 0,7%.

Among non-food goods, price increases were recorded for school bags, school backpacks, modems and routers – by 4,6% each, hair dye – by 3,5%, stationery – by 3,2%, school uniforms – by 3,1%, medicines – by 2,3%, toothpaste – by 1,6%, cement and water-based paints – by 1,3% each, and household appliances by 1%.

Among food products, prices increased for oranges by 9%, kazy and shuzhyk – by 4,9%, canned green peas – by 3,7%, canned corn – by 1,9%, beef canned meat – by 1,6%, tomatoes – by 1,5%, smoked mackerel and bananas – by 1,4% each, eggs and green tea – by 1,1% each, and pasta – by 1%. Prices for tobacco products increased by 3%.

Price decreases were recorded for potatoes by 12,3%, sweet peppers – by 11,9%, cabbage – by 9,7%, grapes – by 8%, onions – by 7,7%, apples – by 5,1%, carrots – by 5,0%, lemons – by 4,7%, beets – by 3,6%, pears – by 1,8%, and cucumbers by 1,5%.

In August 2026, compared to the previous month, the producer price index for agricultural products was 100,5%, for crop products – 100,6%, and for livestock products – 100,2%.

Prices increased for melons by 15,4%, currants by 8,7%, watermelons by 3,3%, open-ground tomatoes by 0,9%, bulb onions by 0,7%, potatoes by 0,5%, and sunflower seeds by 0,4%.

Price decreases were recorded for table carrots by 5,7%, cucumbers in protected ground by 3,1%, dried lentils by 1,7%, curly flax seeds by 1,5%, plums by 1,2%, beetroot and indoor tomatoes by 1,1%, headed cabbage by 0,9%, barley by 0,6%.

Among livestock products, prices increased for eggs by 1,3%, horses by 0,7%, and sheep by 0,3%, while prices for pigs decreased by 0,5%, and raw cow's milk and cattle decreased by 0,1% each.

Prices of manufacturing enterprises for industrial products in August 2026 were lower by 1,2% compared to the previous month. Oil was lower by 3,5%, coal – by 1,2%, natural gas increase by 2,4%, metal ores – by 0,3%. Of petroleum products mazut fell in price by 3,8%, gasoline rose in price by 0,7%, diesel fuel – by 0,6%.

A decrease in prices was noted for aluminum by 9,1%, lead – by 7,7%, precious metals – by 3,6%, zinc – by 0,7%, rolled ferrous metals increase in prices by 4,3%, ferroalloys – by 0,5%.

From food products, poultry meat fell in price by 1,8%, pasta – by 0,9%, fish – by 0,3%, dairy products and rice – by 0,2%, sugar rose in price by 1,7%, vegetable oil – by 0,6%, wheat flour – by 0,5%, cereals – by 0,4%, meat – by 0,2%.

In the service sector, tariffs for the transportation of goods by all modes of transport in August 2026 decreased by 0,4% compared to the previous month, while tariffs for communication services and tariffs for postal and courier services remained unchanged.

In August 2026, compared to the previous month, the construction price index was 101,7%. Prices for other works and costs increased by 3,2%, prices for construction and installation works increased by 1,7%, while prices for machinery and equipment decreased by 0,3%.

3.3 Gross Domestic Product

In the structure of GDP for January-June 2026 (flash estimates) the production of goods amounted to 36,4%, the production of services – 55,4%. The main share in the production of GDP is occupied by industry – 28,6%, wholesale and retail trade; repair of cars and motorcycles – 16,5%.

According to reporting data, in the sectoral structure of income formation for January-March 2026, compensation of employees in the production of goods and services amounted to 24,5% and 33,4%, respectively, the share of other taxes on production is 2,7% in the production of goods and 1,8% in the production of services, respectively, the share of gross operating surplus /gross mixed income was 72,8 % and 64,8%.

3.4 Investment statistics

In January-August 2026, the volume of investments in fixed capital amounted to 13505,7 billion tenge, which is 8,1% more than in January-August 2025.

The predominant sources of investment financing remain the own funds of economic entities, the volume of which in January-August 2026 amounted to 9013,6 billion tenge.

In January-August 2026, compared with January-August 2025, there is an increase costs for the purchase of machinery, equipment and vehicles and their capital repairs by 28,2%.

A significant share of investments in fixed capital in January-August 2026 accounted for industry (40,6%) (including mining and quarrying – 13,9%, manufacturing industry – 14,1%), operations with real estate (18,9%), transport and warehousing (17,6%) and agriculture, forestry and fisheries (5,6%).

The volume of investments of large enterprises in January- August 2026 amounted to 4046,1 billion tenge.

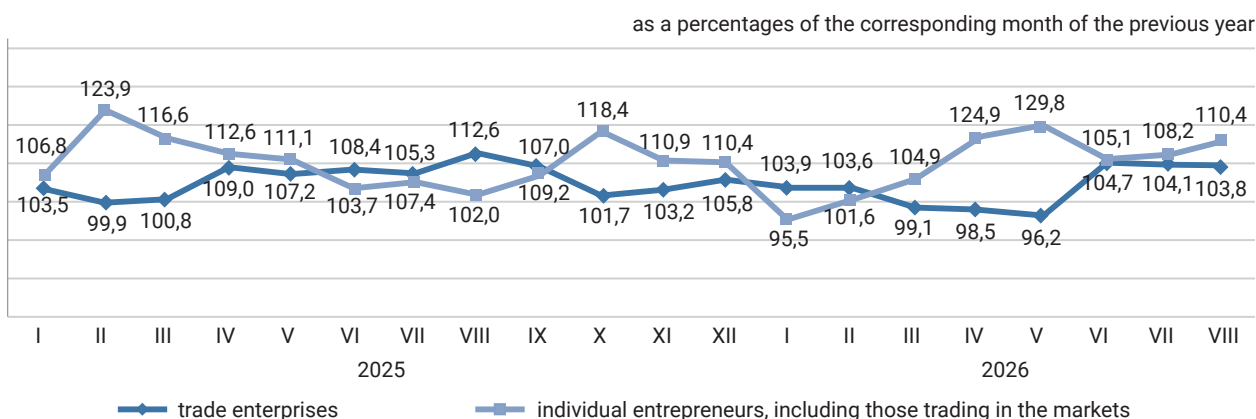
3.5 Statistics of domestic trade

The volume of retail trade in January-August 2026 amounted to 17028,6 billion tenge, which is 4,5% more than the corresponding period in 2025. Retail sales of goods by trading enterprises increased by 1,7%, individual entrepreneurs, including those trading in the markets, increased by 10,6% compared to January-August 2025.

As of September 1, 2026, the volume of commodity stocks of trading enterprises (for reporting enterprises) in retail trade amounted to 1666,6 billion tenge, in trading days - 59 days.

The share of food products in the total volume of retail trade is 34,1%, non-food products – 65,9%. The volume of sales of food products compared to January-August 2025 increased by 10%, non-food products increased by 1,8%.

The volume of wholesale trade in January-August 2026 amounted to 34688,4 billion tenge, which is 6,7% more than the corresponding period in 2025. Non-food products and industrial and technical products (79,8%) prevail in the structure of wholesale trade.

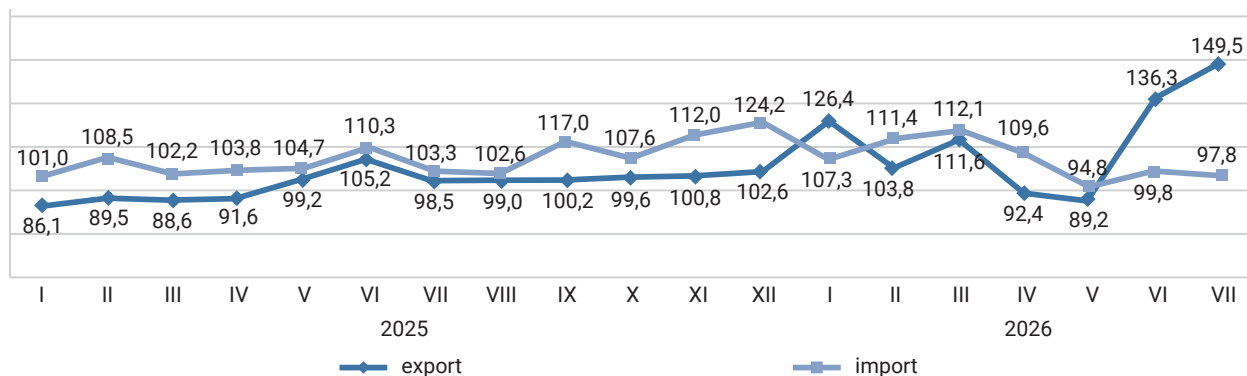

Foreign trade turnover in January-July 2026 amounted to 87,7 billion US dollars (increased by 10,7% in nominal terms compared to January-July 2025) including exports – 50,9 billion US dollars (15,8% more) and imports – 36,8 billion US dollars (increased by 4,3% than corresponding period last year).

Exports with the EAEU countries amounted to 5 806,1 million US dollars or 1,5% more than in January-July 2025, imports – 12 344,0 million US dollars increased by 11,5% compared to the corresponding period last year.

3.7 Statistics of agriculture, forestry, hunting and fisheries

Gross output of products (services) of agriculture, forestry and fisheries in January-August 2026 amounted to 4376,5 billion tenge, including crop production – 1549,5 billion tenge, livestock – 2777,7 billion tenge, hunting – 1,4 billion tenge, forestry – 18,2 billion tenge, fisheries and aquaculture – 24,8 billion tenge, services in agriculture – 4,9 billion tenge.

Out of the total output volume, agricultural formations account for 2558,7 billion tenge or 58,5 percent of the total volume, including 1218,2 billion tenge (78,6 percent) in crop production and 1291,2 billion tenge (46,5 percent) in livestock breeding.

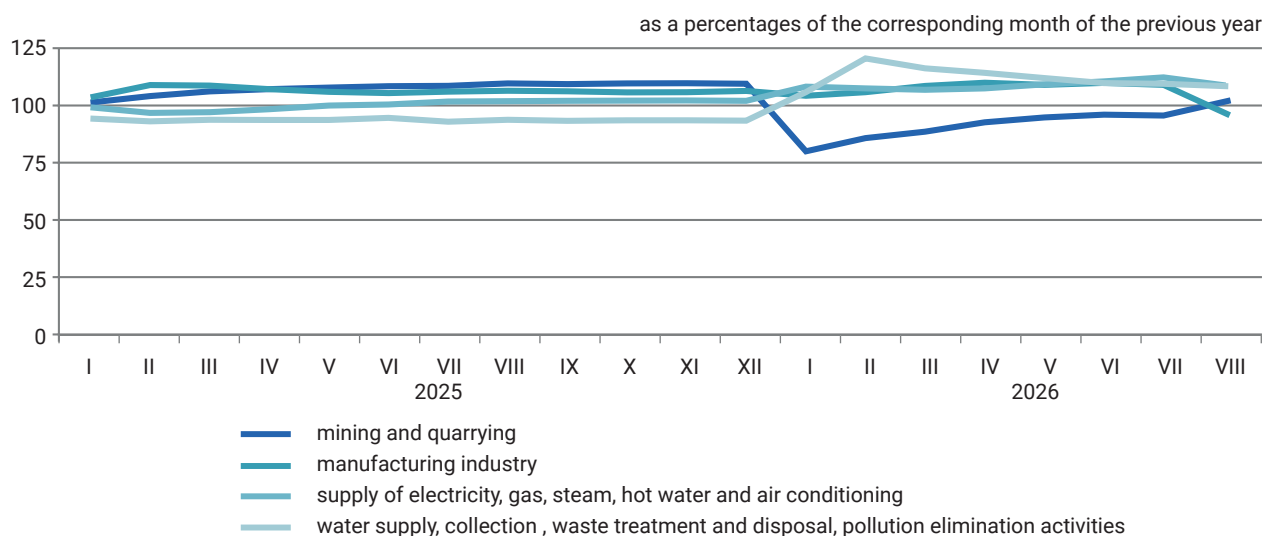

3.9 Statistics of building and housing construction

In January-August 2026, the volume of construction work increased by 15,6% and amounted to 6089,4 billion tenge.

The largest amount of work in January-August 2026 was performed on the construction of facilities (3321 billion tenge), non-residential buildings (1809,9 billion tenge) and residential buildings (958,5 billion tenge).

The volume of construction and installation work in January-August 2026 compared to January-August 2025 increased by 15,2% and amounted to 5020,4 billion tenge. The volume of construction work on major repairs increased by 22% and on current repairs by 12,9%.

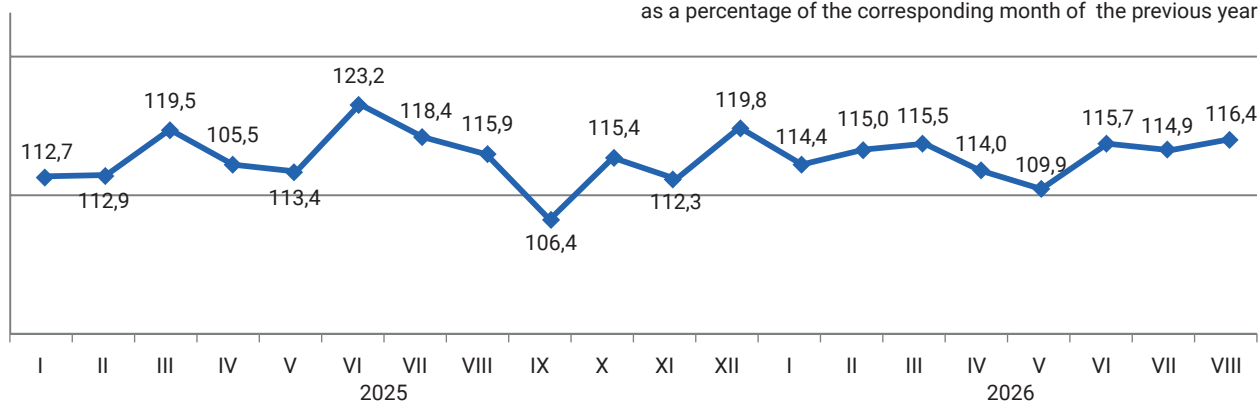
In January-August 2026, the construction of 22699 new buildings was completed, of which 20730 are residential and 1969 are non-residential.

as a percentage of the corresponding month of the previous year



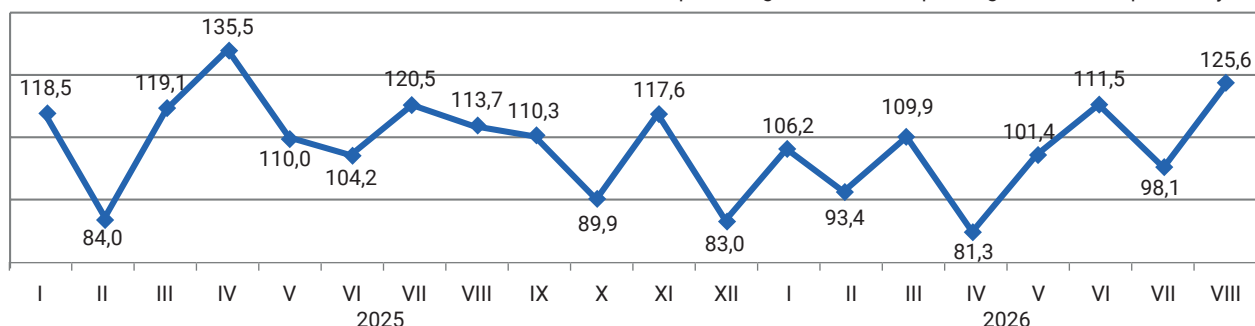

as a percentages of the corresponding month of the previous year

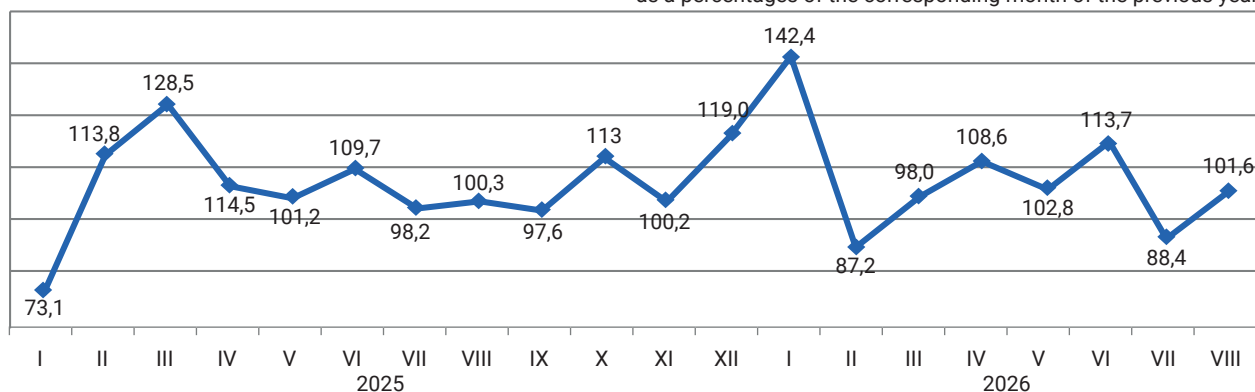


In January-August 2026, the total area of housing put into operation to January-August 2025 increased by 3,6% and amounted to 11326,1 thousand square meters, of which in multi-apartment buildings – by 8,7% (7500,4 thousand square meters). At the same time, the total area of commissioned individual residential buildings decreased by 3,9% (3783,7 thousand square meters).

In the total volume of commissioned housing, the share of multi-apartment buildings was 66,2%, individual – 33,4%. The average actual cost of construction of 1 square meter of total housing area increased by 5,5%.

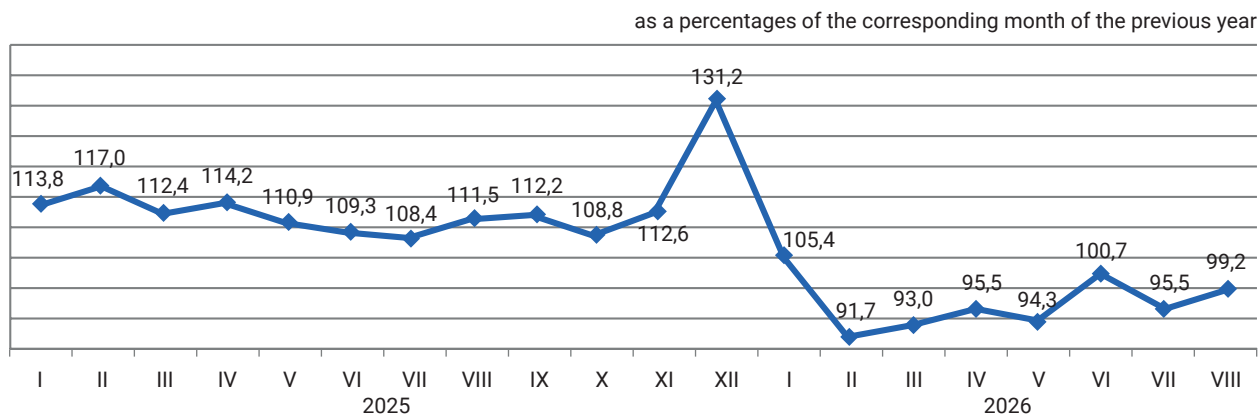

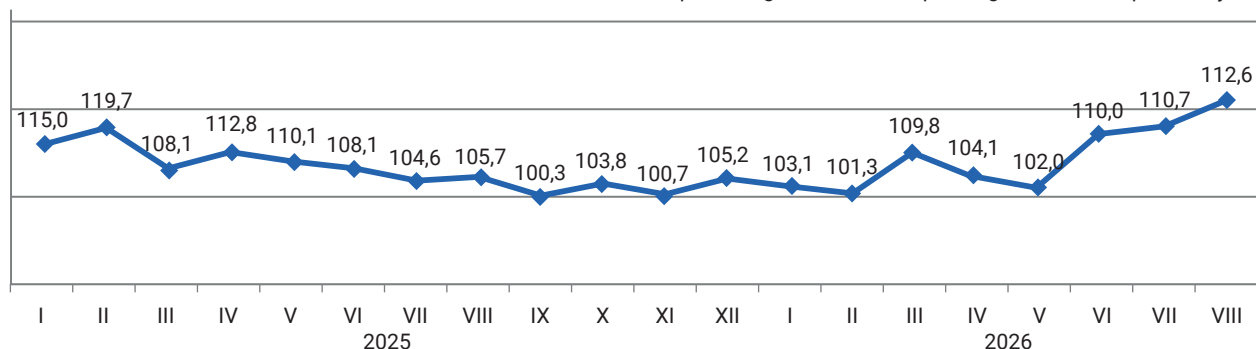

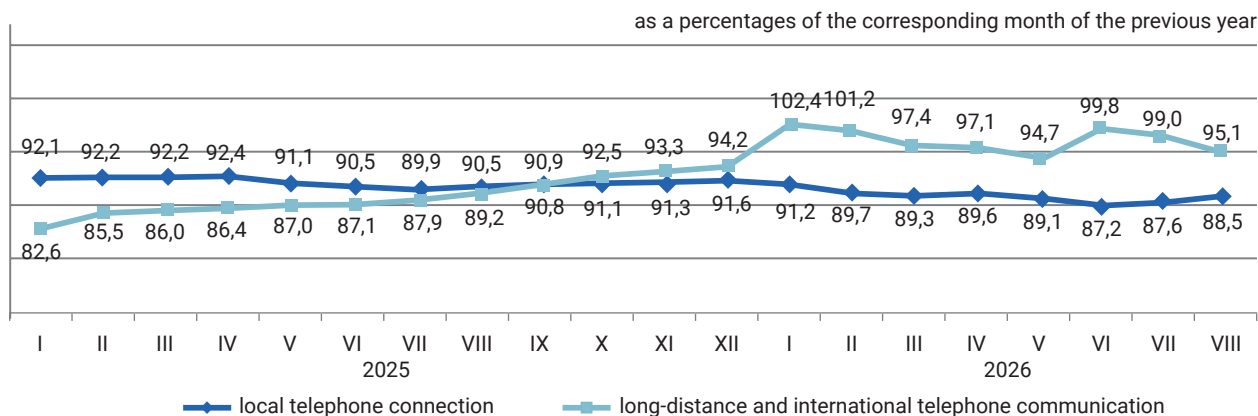

3.11 Statistics of communications

Indices of the physical volume for communication services in January-August 2026 compared to January-August 2025 amounted to 104,4%, of which 245,0% for mobile services¹⁾, 111,1% for other telecommunications services and 65,4% for Internet services.

3.12 Statistics of enterprises

In August, compared to July 2026, there is a slight increase in the number of registered legal entities (by 0,5%), compared to the corresponding period of the previous year, their number increased by 1,4%. At the same time, there is an increase in the number of operating legal entities - by 1,1%, compared to the corresponding period of the previous year, their number increased by 5,1%. Since the beginning of the year, by type of economic activity, the largest number of registered legal entities remains in the industry «Wholesale and retail trade; car and motorcycle repair», the share of which as of September 1, 2026. amounted to 26,2%. On the second place – «Construction» (13,6%), on the third – «Provision of other types of services» (10%). Together, the share of these three types of activities is 49,8% of all registered legal entities.
