2. Social indicators

2.1 Population size and migration

The population of the country as of September 1, 2025 amounted to 20426,6 thousand people, including 12953,8 thousand (63,4%) urban residents and 7472,8 thousand (36,6%) rural residents.

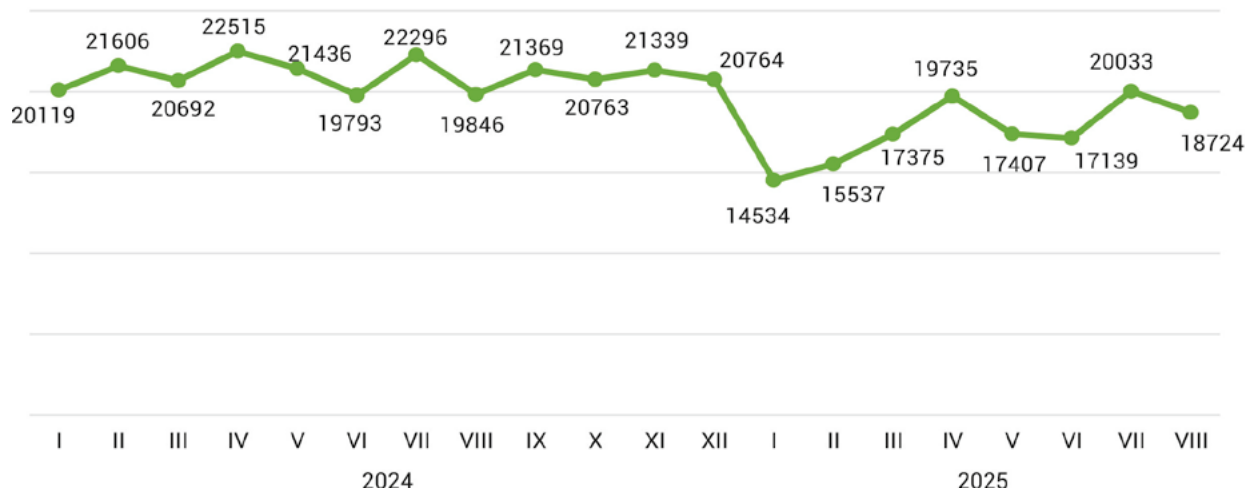
In January-August 2025, compared to January-August 2024, the number of arrivals to Kazakhstan decreased by 11,4%, while the number of departures from the country decreased by 40,7%.

The main migration exchange of the country occurs with the CIS member states, with the share of arrivals from and departures to these countries amounting to 82,8% and 74,1%, respectively.

The number of internal migrants increased by 24,8%. A positive net migration balance due to interregional movements was recorded in three regions of the country: the cities of Astana (58153 people), Almaty (25138 people), Shymkent (13160 people) and Almaty region(6471 people).

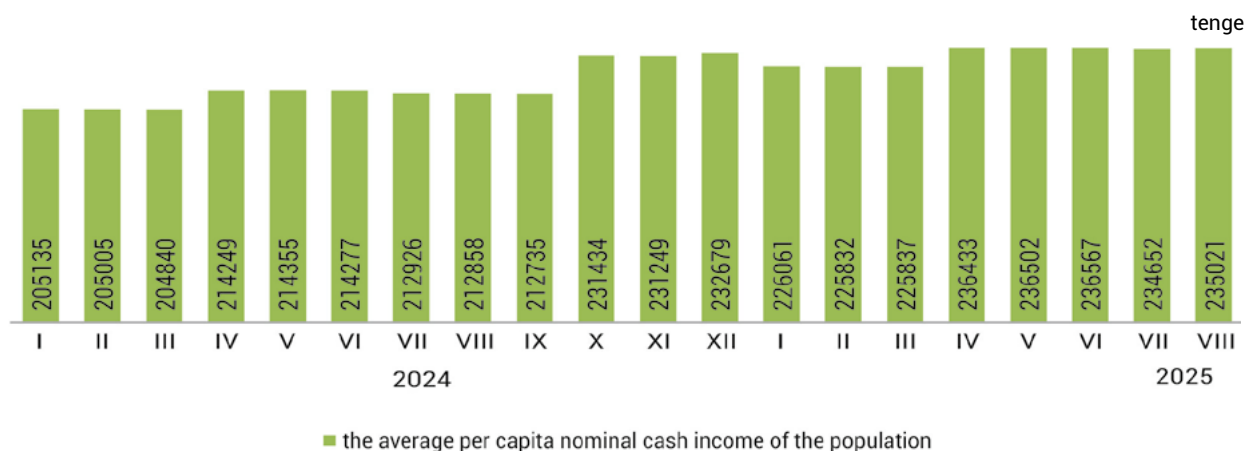

2.2 Income of the population

The average per capita nominal cash income of the population, according to an estimate in August 2025, amounted to 235021 tenge (preliminary data), which is 10,4% higher than in August 2024, real cash income for the specified period decreased by 1,6%.

2.3 Employment of the population

The number of unemployed, determined according to the methodology of the ILO, in the II quarter of 2025¹⁾ amounted to 448,8 thousand people, the unemployment rate was 4,6%.

The employed population²⁾ amounted to 9300,4 thousand people, including employees – 7139,3 thousand people, individual entrepreneurs – 1732,3 thousand people, persons engaged in private practice – 20,4 thousand people, individuals, who are founders (participants) of business partnerships and founders, shareholders (participants) of joint-stock companies, as well as members of production cooperatives – 25,6 thousand people, independent workers – 382,8 thousand people.

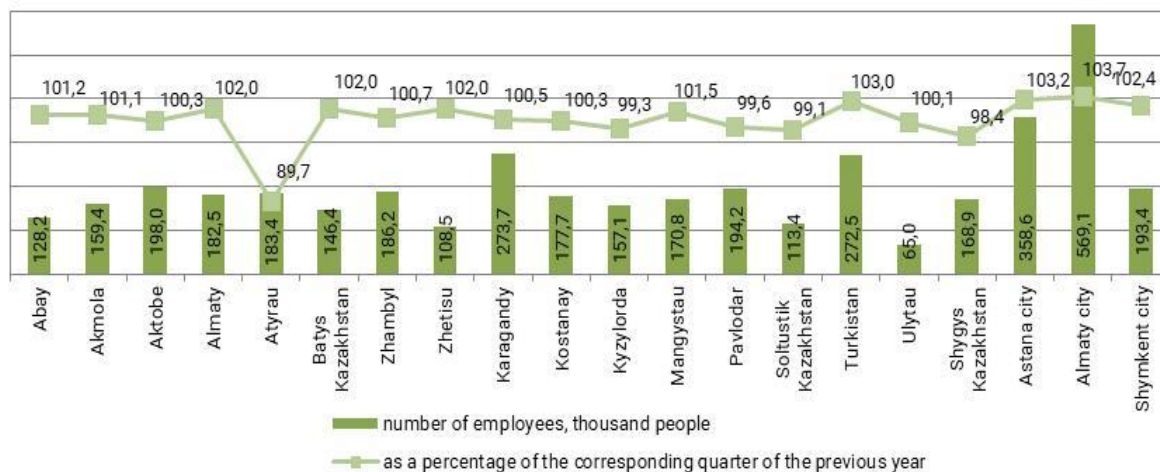

The number of employees at enterprises (organizations) in the II quarter of 2025³⁾ amounted to 4007,0 thousand people, of which at large and medium-sized enterprises – 2873,0 thousand people.

In the II quarter of 2025, 242,2 thousand people were hired by enterprises. 258,2 thousand people dropped out for various reasons. Worked by one employee 460,2 hours.

At the end of the II quarter of 2025, 62,3 thousand vacancies were not filled at enterprises (1,6% of the number of employees).

2.4 Remuneration of labor at enterprises and organizations*

In the II quarter of 2025, the average monthly nominal salary amounted to 448620 tenge (excluding employees of small enterprises engaged in entrepreneurial activities). In the II quarter of 2025, the median salary was estimated to be 316152 tenge.

From January 1, 2025, the minimum wage is set at 85000 tenge.

3. Economic indicators

3.1 Statistics of prices

In September 2025, the monthly consumer price index was 1,1%. Prices for non-food products increased by 1,5%, paid services – by 1,0%, food products – by 0,9%.

Of the food products, price increases for cucumbers by 8,7%, chocolate – by 4,8%, small-piece semi-finished meat products – by 4,5%, cream – by 4,3%, beef – by 3,6%, eggs – by 3,5%, horse meat – by 2,9%, chickens – by 2,2%.

Price decreases for onions by 15,6%, cauliflower – by 14,7%, potatoes – by 10,3%, beets – by 9,5%, white cabbage – by 9,3%, carrots – by 9,0%.

Among the non-food products, a increase was observed for floor clothes dryer by 6,2%, electric kettle – by 6,1%, TV – by 5,4%, gold engagement ring – by 4,3%, medicines – by 2,0%, clothing – by 1,0%. Fuel prices increased for AI-92 gasoline by 3,7%, AI-95/96 gasoline – by 2,4%, diesel fuel – by 1,9%, AI-98 gasoline – by 0,8%.

In the field of paid services, the price level for vocational secondary education increased by 11,9%, higher education – by 10,8%, services of private educational organizations – by 8,2%, holidays in Turkey – by 4,5%, housing and communal services – by 0,8%.

In September 2025, compared to the previous month, the producer price index for agricultural products was 103,1%, for crop products 100,9%, and for livestock products 105,8%.

Prices for safflower seeds increased by 13,5%, peppers - by 8,7%, barley - by 4,9%, rye - by 4,8%, greenhouse cucumbers - by 4,4%, watermelons - by 3,2%, fodder crops - by 2,2%, fresh grapes - by 2%, and onions - by 1,7%.

Prices for carrots decreased by 4,7%, potatoes - by 2,3%, uncooked rice - by 1,3%, and table beets - by 1,1%.

Among the products of animal husbandry, prices increased for eggs by 7,6%, cattle – by 3,1%, poultry – by 2,2% and raw cow's milk – by 0,9%.

Prices of manufacturing enterprises for industrial products in September 2025 increase by 0,2% compared to the previous month. Coal prices were lower by 1,4%, metal ores – by 0,8%, natural gas – by 0,7%, oil – by 0,2%. Of petroleum products propane and butane liquefied rose in price by 4,8%, gasoline – by 1%, diesel fuel fell in price by 1,7%.

An increase in prices was noted for zinc by 3,9%, precious metals – by 3,7%, ferroalloys– by 1,9%, aluminum – by 0,3%, rolled ferrous metals prices were lower by 1,3%, lead – by 0,6%, copper – by 0,4%.

From food products, livestock meat rose in price by 3%, dairy products and pasta – by 1%, cereals– by 0,9%, rye flour and poultry meat – by 0,7%, tea – by 0,4%, sugar – by 0,3%, wheat flour fell in price by 3,4%.

In the service sector, postal and courier service rates decreased by 0,1% in September 2025 compared to the previous month, while rates for cargo transportation and communication services remained unchanged.

In September 2025, compared to the previous month, the price index in construction was 100,2%. Prices for construction and installation work increased by 0,2%, machinery and equipment - by 0,5%, other works and costs decreased by 0,4%.

3.3 Gross Domestic Product

In the structure of GDP for January-June 2025 (reported data) the production of goods amounted to 35,6%, the production of services – 57,3%. The main share in the production of GDP is occupied by industry – 28,2%, wholesale and retail trade; repair of cars and motorcycles – 16,4%.

According to the reporting data, in the sectoral structure of income formation for January-June 2025, compensation of employees in the production of goods and services amounted to 27,8% and 38,8%, respectively, the share of other taxes on production is 2,6% in the production of goods and 2% in the production of services, respectively, the share of gross operating surplus /gross mixed income was 69,6 % and 59,2%.

The Gross domestic product calculated by the final expenditure method for January–June 2025 amounted to 59746438,2 million tenge. In comparison with the corresponding period of last year in real terms there is an increase in the component of final consumption expenditure: households – by 9,8%, government administration – by 8%, and a decrease in non-profit organizations serving households – by(- 9,3%).

3.4 Investment statistics

In January-September 2025, the volume of investments in fixed capital amounted to 13795,7 billion tenge, which is 13,5% more than in January-September 2024.

The predominant sources of investment financing remain the own funds of economic entities, the volume of which in January-September 2025 amounted to 8697,8 billion tenge.

In January-September 2025, compared with January-September 2024, there is an increase costs for works on construction and capital repair of buildings and constructions by 18,8%.

A significant share of investments in fixed capital in January-September 2025 accounted for industry (37,2%) (including mining and quarrying – 15,2%, manufacturing industry – 10,7%), operations with real estate (19,1%), transport and warehousing (18,2%), education (6,9%) and agriculture, forestry and fisheries (5,7%).

The volume of investments of large enterprises in January-September 2025 amounted to 4281 billion tenge.

3.5 Statistics of domestic trade

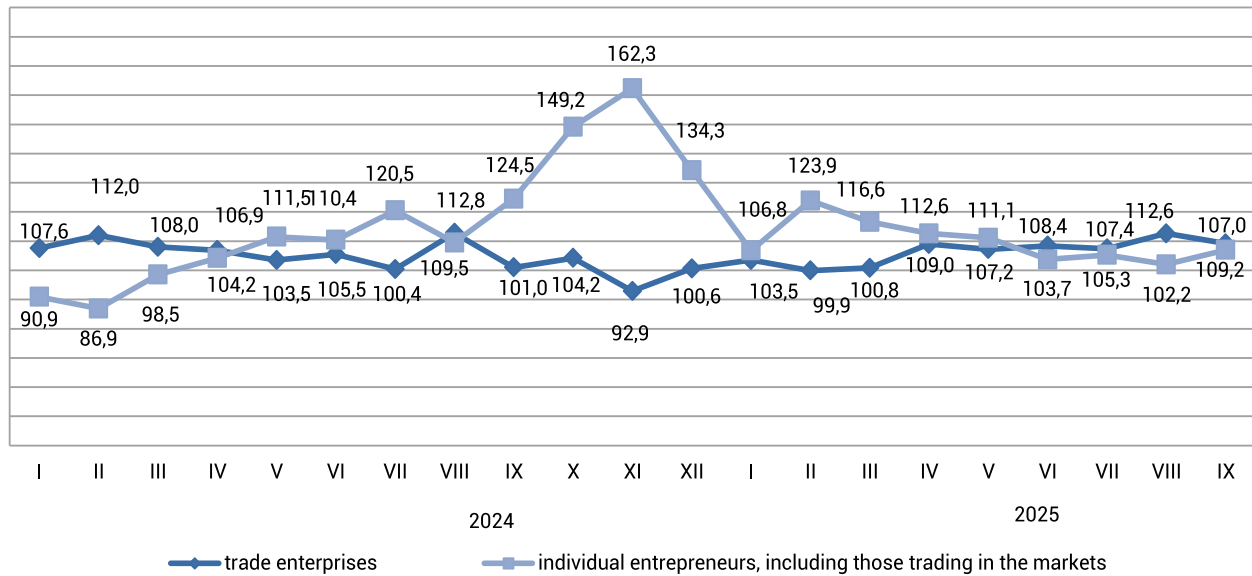
The volume of retail trade in January-September 2025 amounted to 17442,7 billion tenge, which is 7,1% more than the corresponding period in 2024. Retail sales of goods by trading enterprises increased by 6,7%, individual entrepreneurs, including those trading in the markets, increased by 8,1% compared to January-September 2024.

As of October 1, 2025, the volume of commodity stocks of trading enterprises (for reporting enterprises) in retail trade amounted to 1562,8 billion tenge, in trading days - 59 days.

The share of food products in the total volume of retail trade is 32,8%, non-food products – 67,2%. The volume of sales of food products compared to January-September 2024 increased by 6,6%, non-food products increased by 7,4%.

The volume of wholesale trade in January-September 2025 amounted to 35046,6 billion tenge, which is 9,6% more than the corresponding period in 2024. Non-food products and industrial and technical products (81,9%) prevail in the structure of wholesale trade.

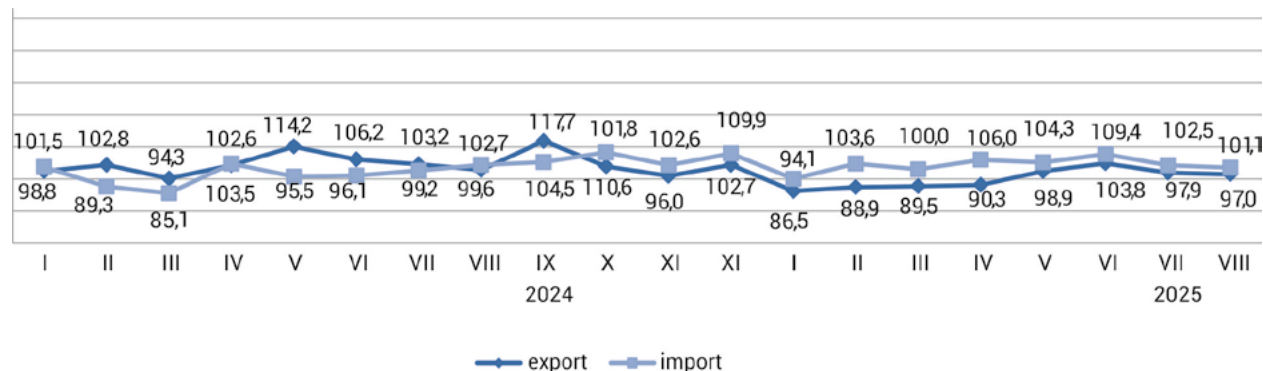

Foreign trade turnover in January-August 2025 amounted to 90,2 billion US dollars (decreased by 2,1% in nominal terms compared to January-August 2024) including exports – 50,2 billion US dollars (5,7% less) and imports – 40,1 billion US dollars (increased by 2,8% than corresponding period last year).

Exports with the EAEU countries amounted to 6492,8 million US dollars or 9,3% less than in January-August 2024, imports – 12679,5 million US dollars decreased by 0,2% compared to the corresponding period last year.

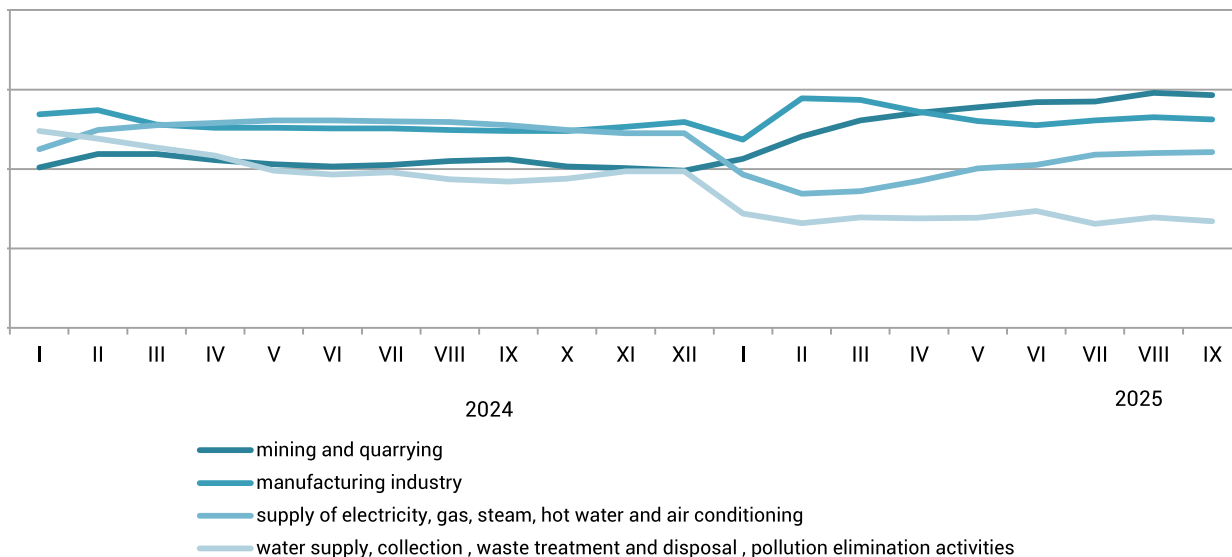

3.9 Statistics of building and housing construction

In January-September 2025, the volume of construction work increased by 14,9% and amounted to 6441,3 billion tenge.

The largest amount of work in January-September 2025 was performed on the construction of facilities (3426,3 billion tenge), non-residential buildings (1988,3 billion tenge) and residential buildings (1026,6 billion tenge).

The volume of construction and installation work in January-September 2025 compared to January-September 2024 increased by 13% and amounted to 5249,4 billion tenge. The volume of construction work on major repairs increased by 19,7% and on current repairs by 29,6%.

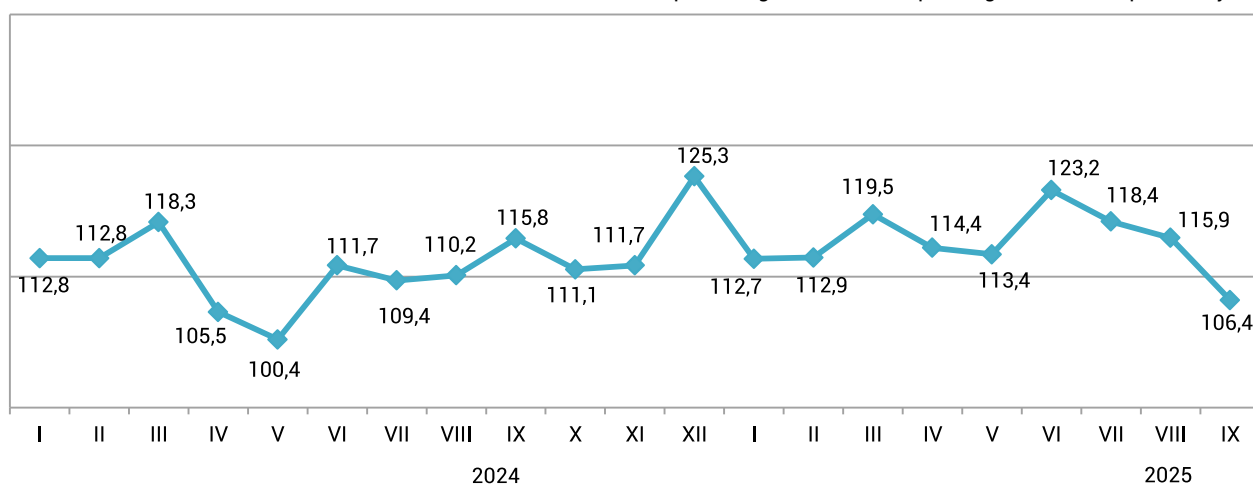
In January-September 2025, the construction of 28771 new buildings was completed, of which 26483 are residential and 2288 are non-residential.

as a percentages of the corresponding month of the previous year



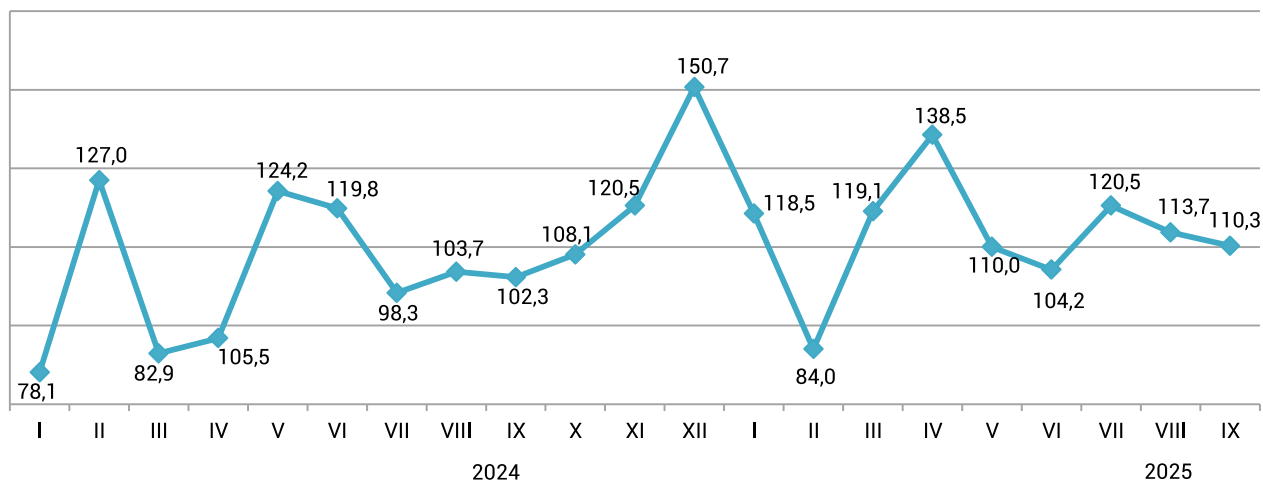

In January-September 2025, 2494,8 billion tenge was allocated for housing construction. In the total volume of investments in fixed capital, the share of disbursed funds in housing construction amounted to 18,1%.

The main source of financing for housing construction in January-September 2025 is the own funds of developers, the share of which is 90,8%.

as a percentages of the corresponding month of the previous year

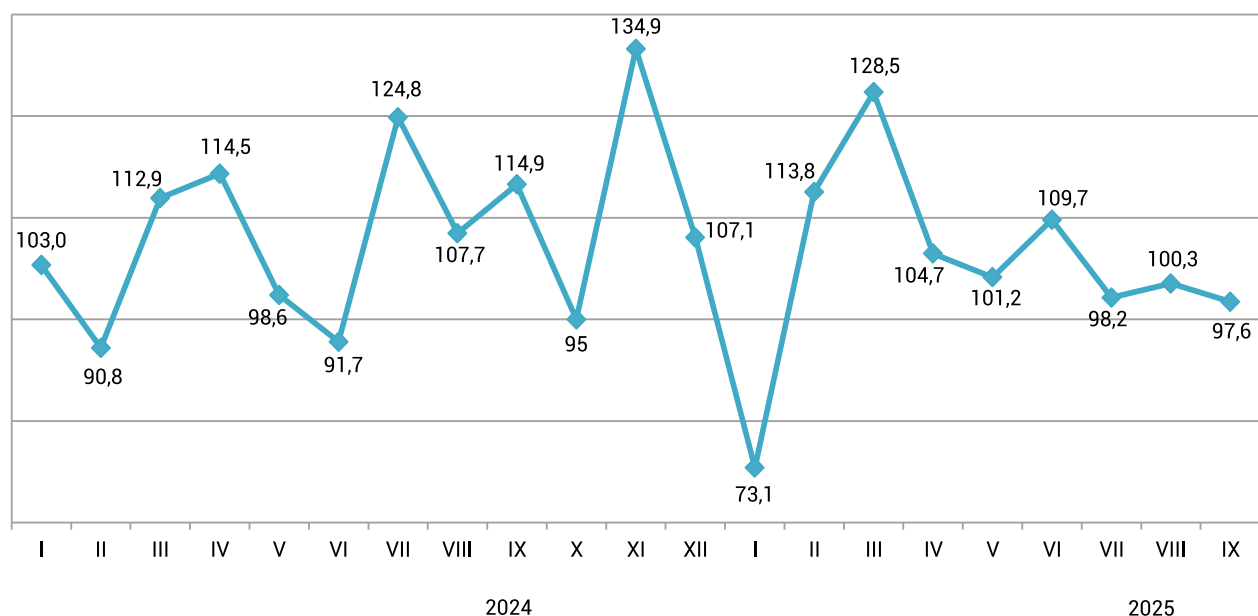


In January-September 2025, the total area of housing put into operation to January-September 2024 increased by 3,4% and amounted to 12851,4 thousand square meters, of which in multi-apartment buildings – by 6,2% (8072,2 thousand square meters). At the same time, the total area of commissioned individual residential buildings decreased by 0,9% (4666 thousand square meters).

In the total volume of commissioned housing, the share of multi-apartment buildings was 62,8%, individual – 36,3%. The average actual cost of construction of 1 square meter of total housing area increased by 14,6%.

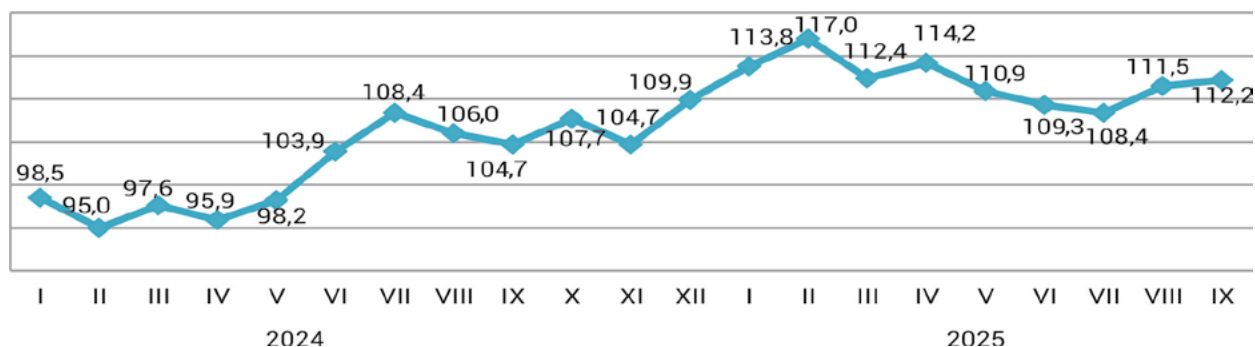

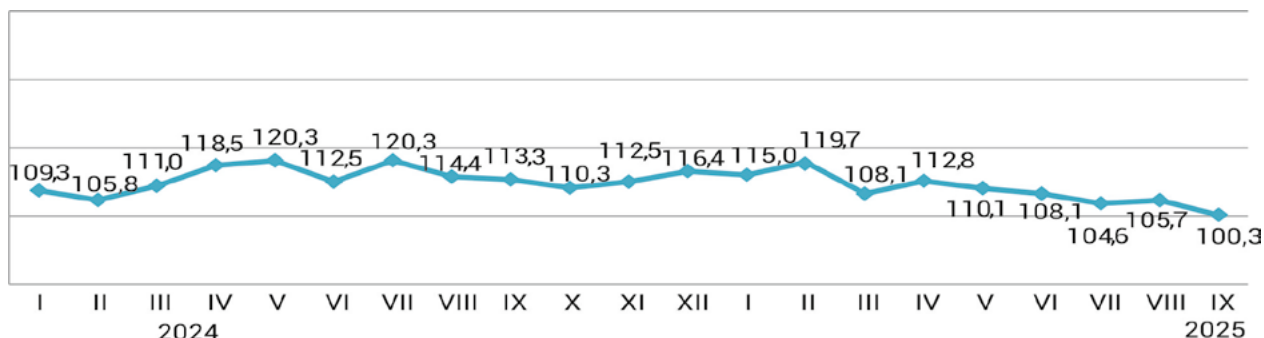

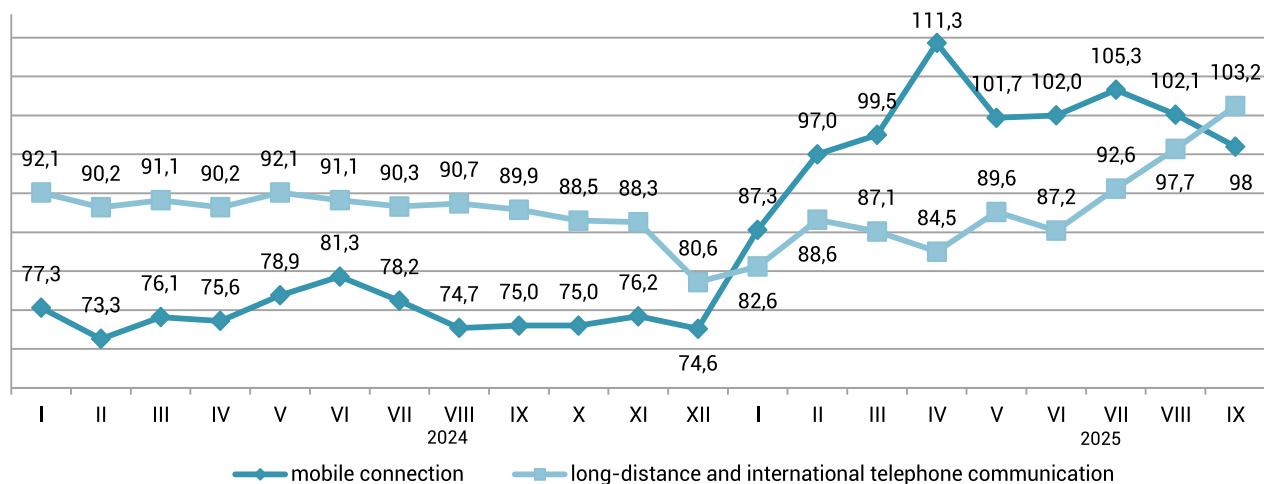

In September, compared to August 2025, there is a slight increase in the number of registered legal entities (by 0,4%), compared to the corresponding period of the previous year, their number increased by 2,4%. At the same time, there is an increase in the number of operating legal entities - by 0,6%, compared to the corresponding period of the previous year, their number increased by 2,6%. Since the beginning of the year, by type of economic activity, the largest number of registered legal entities remains in the industry «Wholesale and retail trade; car and motorcycle repair», the share of which as of October 1, 2025. amounted to 26,9%. On the second place – «Construction» (13,4%), on the third – «Provision of other types of services» (10,1%). Together, the share of these three types of activities is 50,4% of all registered legal entities.
