2. Social indicators

2.1 Population size and migration

The population of the country as of June 1, 2025 amounted to 20370,7 thousand people, including 12877,4 thousand (63,2%) urban and 7493,3 thousand (36,8%) rural residents.

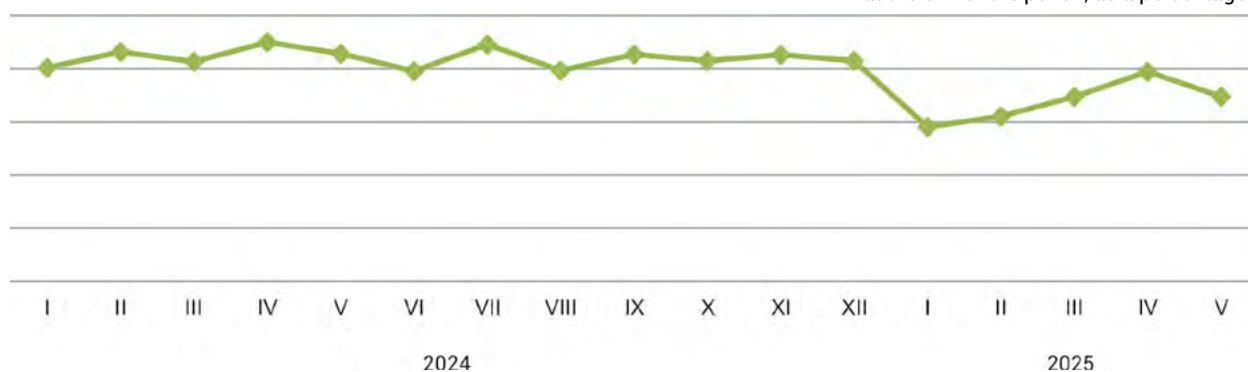
In May 2025, compared to May 2024, the number of arrivals to Kazakhstan decreased by 32,8%, while the number of departures from Kazakhstan decreased by 30,0%.

The main migration exchange of the country occurs with CIS member states. The share of those arriving from CIS countries and those departing to these countries accounted for 81,4% and 72,7%, respectively.

The number of internal migrants decreased by 44,7%. A positive net migration balance based on interregional movements was recorded in three regions of the country: Astana city (6136 people), Almaty city (2927 people), and Shymkent city (1232 people).

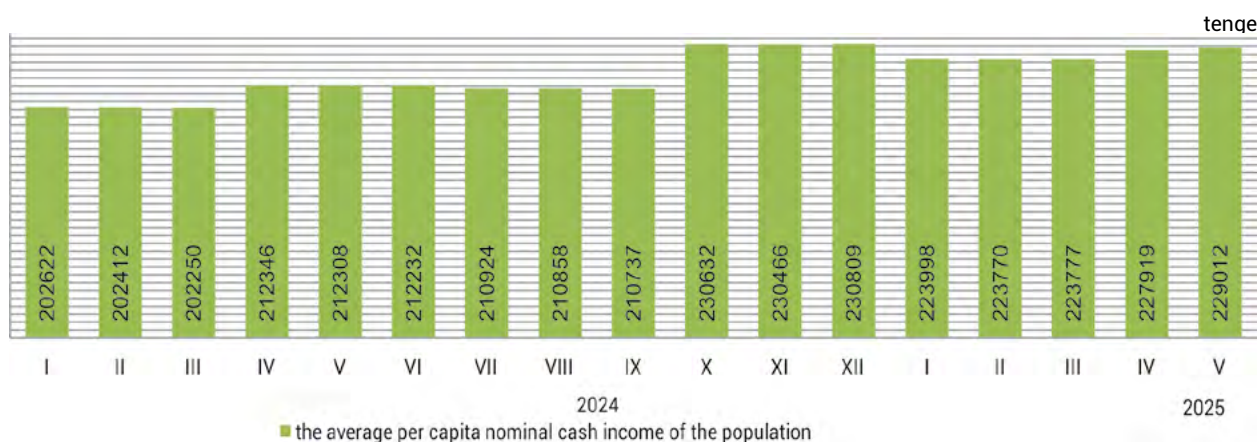

2.2 Income of the population

The average per capita nominal cash income of the population, according to an estimate in May 2025, amounted to 229012 tenge (preliminary data), which is 7,9% higher than in May 2024, real cash income for the specified period decreased by 3,1%.

2.3 Employment of the population

The number of unemployed, determined according to the methodology of the ILO, in the I quarter of 2025¹⁾ amounted to 451,5 thousand people, the unemployment rate was 4,6%.

The employed population²⁾ amounted to 9283,5 thousand people, including employees – 7141 thousand people, individual entrepreneurs – 1760,5 thousand people, persons engaged in private practice – 17,3 thousand people, individuals, who are founders (participants) of business partnerships and founders, shareholders (participants) of joint-stock companies, as well as members of production cooperatives – 7,5 thousand people, independent workers – 357,2 thousand people.

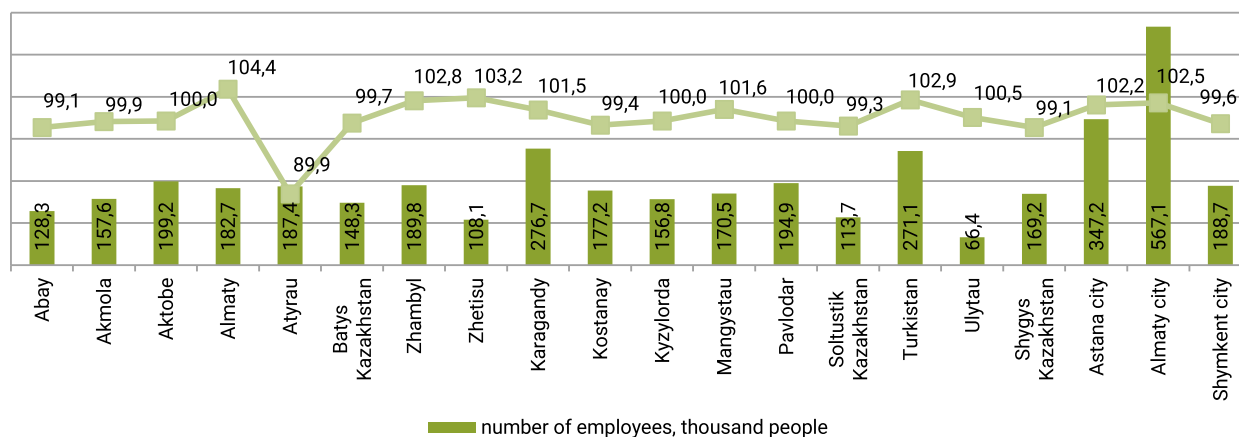

The number of employees at enterprises (organizations) in the I quarter of 2025³⁾ amounted to 4000,8 thousand people, of which at large and medium-sized enterprises – 2872,9 thousand people.

In the I quarter of 2025, 263,8 thousand people were hired by enterprises. 258,5 thousand people dropped out for various reasons. Worked by one employee 445,1 hours.

At the end of the I quarter of 2025, 59,0 thousand vacancies were not filled at enterprises (1,5% of the number of employees).

In the I quarter of 2025, the average monthly nominal salary amounted to 423133 tenge (excluding employees of small enterprises engaged in entrepreneurial activities). In the I quarter of 2025, the median salary was estimated to be 300307 tenge.

From January 1, 2025, the minimum wage is set at 85000 tenge.

3. Economic indicators

3.1 Statistics of prices

In June 2025, the monthly consumer price index slowed down and amounted to 0.8% (in May 2025 – 0.9%). Prices for food products, non-food products – by 0.9% each, paid services increased – by 0.8%.

Among food products, prices increased for carrots 23.9%, lemons – by 11%, apples, grapes – by 8.8% each, bulb onions – by 7.7%, processed cheeses – by 3.3%, potatoes – by 2.7%, pears – by 2.6%, frozen fish – by 2.3%, unsalted butter – by 1.8%, beef – by 1.7%, sunflower oil – by 1.6%. A decrease in prices was noted for cucumbers by 19.5%, cabbage – by 18.1%, tomatoes – by 15%, garlic – by 8.4%, bananas – by 3.4%, eggs – by 3%.

An increase in prices in June this year was noted for appliances: refrigerators by 10.2%, kitchen stove – by 6.5%, freezer – by 4.8%. Gasoline AI-92 rose in price by 1.7%, diesel fuel – by 1.5%.

In the sphere of housing and communal services, tariffs for water disposal increased by 8.7%, garbage removal – by 2.1%, electricity – by 1.4%. Air passenger transport services increased by 8.7%, travel by taxi – by 4.7%, sanatorium services – by 2.9%.

In June 2025, compared to the previous month, the producer price index for agricultural products was 98,2%, crop products – 100,6%, livestock products – 95,1%.

Prices for sunflower seeds increased by 1,6%, unhulled rice by 1,4%, lentils by 0,9%, barley, wheat by 0,7%.

Prices for greenhouse cucumbers increased by 7,3%, beets by 2,6%, while greenhouse tomatoes decreased by 11,3%, potatoes by 1,9%, and cabbage by 1,2%.

In livestock products, prices for eggs decreased by 7,7%, while prices for cattle increased by 2%.

Prices of manufacturing enterprises for industrial products in June 2025 decreased by 0,6% compared to the previous month. Oil prices were lower by 3,3%, metal ores – by 1,2%, natural gas – by 0,5%, coal prices were higher by 0,9%. Of petroleum products, gasoline rose in price by 2,6%, propane and butane liquefied fell in price by 2,9%.

An decrease in prices was noted for lead by 6,6%, aluminum – by 3,4%, zinc – by 2,5%, for copper – a increase by 6,2%, precious metals – by 2%, ferroalloys – by 0,5%.

From food products, vegetable oil rose in price by 2,6%, poultry meat – by 1,3%, cereals and wheat flour – by 0,7%, dairy products – by 0,5%, pasta – by 0,3%.

In the service sector, tariffs for the transportation of goods by all modes of transport in June 2025 increased by 5,1% compared to the previous month, tariffs for communication services increased by 0,9%, tariffs for postal and courier services decreased by 0,1%.

In June 2025 compared to the previous month the price index in construction amounted to 100,4%. Prices for construction and installation work increased by – 0,4%, machinery and equipment by 0,5%, other work and costs reminded at the level of the previous month.

3.3 Gross Domestic Product

In the structure of GDP for January-March 2025, reported data, the production of goods amounted to 34,9%, the production of services – 58,5%. The main share in the production of GDP is occupied by industry – 28,2%, wholesale and retail trade; repair of cars and motorcycles – 16,6%.

According to the reporting data, in the sectoral structure of income formation for January-March 2025, compensation of employees in the production of goods and services amounted to 23,8% and 35%, respectively, the share of other taxes on production is 2,9% in the production of goods and 2% in the production of services, respectively, the share of gross operating surplus /gross mixed income was 73,3 % and 63%.

The Gross domestic product calculated by the final expenditure method for January – March 2025 amounted to 29663100,3 million tenge. In comparison with the corresponding period of last year in real terms there is an increase in the component of final consumption expenditure: households – by 6,6%, government administration – by 0,9%, and a decrease in non-profit organizations serving households – by (-3,7%).

3.4 Investment statistics

In January-June 2025, the volume of investments in fixed capital amounted to 8175,7 billion tenge, which is 19,3% more than in January-June 2024.

The predominant sources of investment financing remain the own funds of economic entities, the volume of which in January-June 2025 amounted to 5285,1 billion tenge.

In January-June 2025, compared with January-June 2024, there is an increase costs for works on construction and capital repair of buildings and constructions by 27,2%.

A significant share of investments in fixed capital in January-June 2025 accounted for industry (38,8%) (including mining and quarrying – 16,2%, manufacturing industry – 12,4%), operations with real estate (19,8%), transport and warehousing (15,5%) and education (7,5%).

The volume of investments of large enterprises in January-June 2025 amounted to 2495 billion tenge.

3.5 Statistics of domestic trade

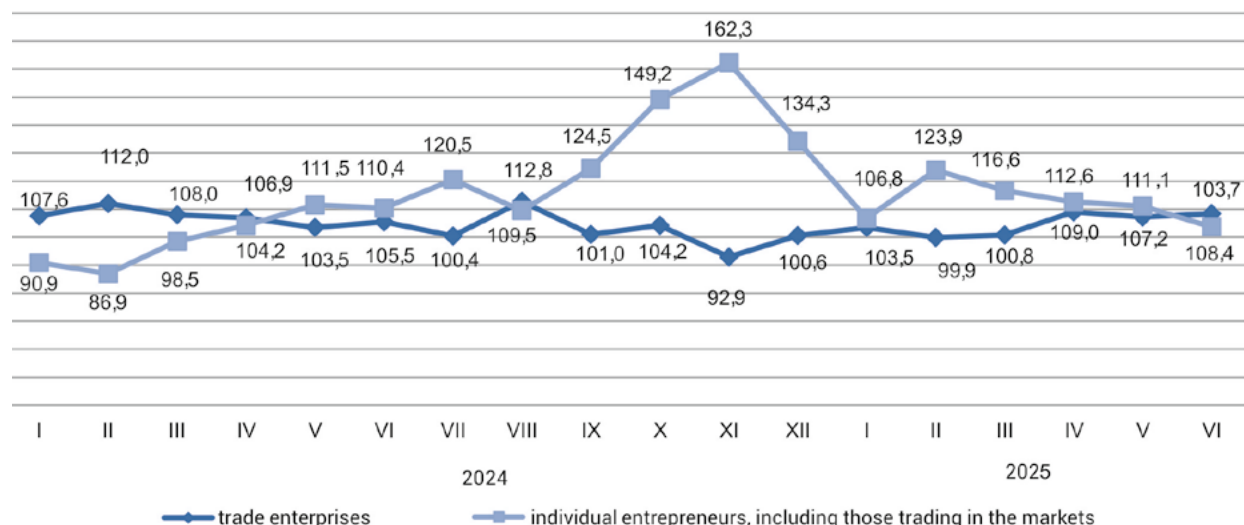
The volume of retail trade in January-June 2025 amounted to 10074,7 billion tenge, which is 6,6% more than the corresponding period in 2024. Retail sales of goods by trading enterprises increased by 4,9%, individual entrepreneurs, including those trading in the markets, increased by 11,3% compared to January-June 2024.

As of July 1, 2025, the volume of commodity stocks of trading enterprises (for reporting enterprises) in retail trade amounted to 1580,8 billion tenge, in trading days - 62 days.

The share of food products in the total volume of retail trade is 30,1%, non-food products – 69,9%. The volume of sales of food products compared to January-June 2024 increased by 4,8%, non-food products increased by 7,3%.

The volume of wholesale trade in January-June 2025 amounted to 21171,8 billion tenge, which is 9,2% more than the corresponding period in 2024. Non-food products and industrial and technical products (82%) prevail in the structure of wholesale trade.

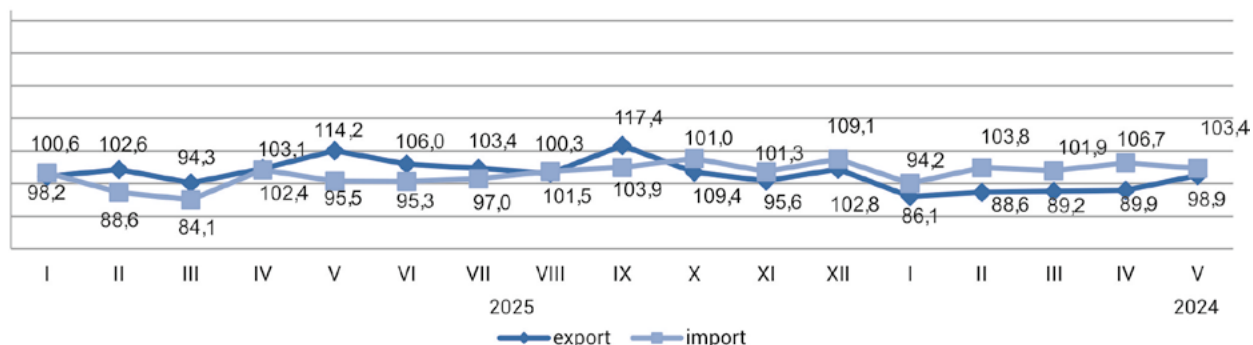

Foreign trade turnover in January-May 2025 amounted to 53,5 billion US dollars (decreased by 4,5% in nominal terms compared to January-May 2024) including exports – 29,8 billion US dollars (9,2% less) and imports – 23,8 billion US dollars (increased by 2,2% than corresponding period last year).

Exports with the EAEU countries amounted to 3654,1 million US dollars or 13,2% less than in January-May 2024, imports – 7184,4 million US dollars decreased by 0,5% compared to the corresponding period last year.

Gross output of products (services) of agriculture, forestry and fisheries in January-June 2025 amounted to 1792,1 billion tenge, including crop production – 105,1 billion tenge, livestock – 1659,8 billion tenge, hunting – 0,8 billion tenge, forestry – 11,6 billion tenge, fisheries and aquaculture – 13,9 billion tenge, services in agriculture – 0,9 billion tenge.

Out of the total output volume, agricultural formations account for 845,4 billion tenge or 47,2 percent of the total volume, including 77,4 billion tenge (73,6 percent) in crop production and 740,8 billion tenge (44,6 percent) in livestock breeding.

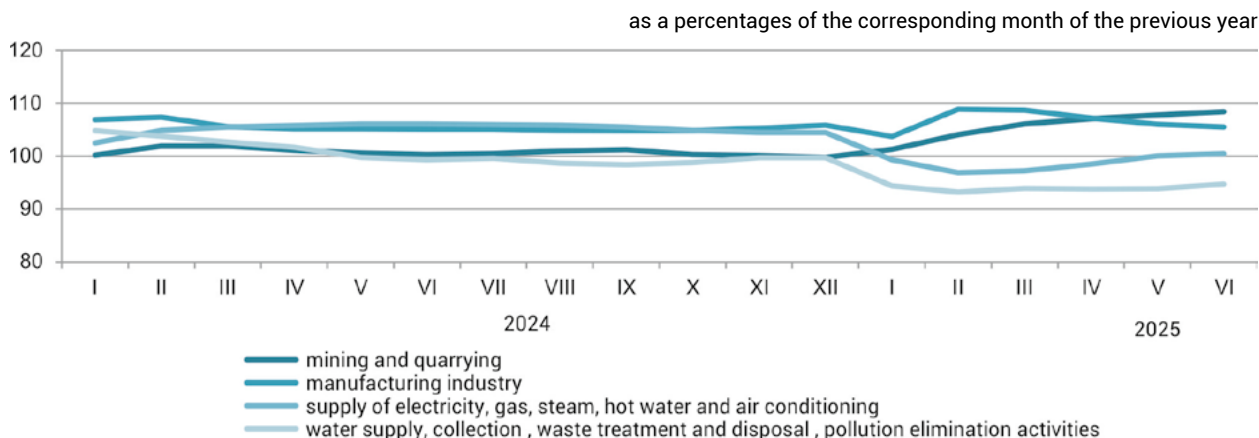

3.9 Statistics of building and housing construction

In January-June 2025, the volume of construction work increased by 18,4% and amounted to 3312,9 billion tenge.

The largest amount of work in January-June 2025 was performed on the construction of facilities (1685,6 billion tenge), non-residential buildings (1036,5 billion tenge) and residential buildings (590,8 billion tenge).

The volume of construction and installation work in January-June 2025 compared to January-June 2024 increased by 17,7% and amounted to 2808,9 billion tenge. The volume of construction work on major repairs increased by 12% and on current repairs by 34,4%.

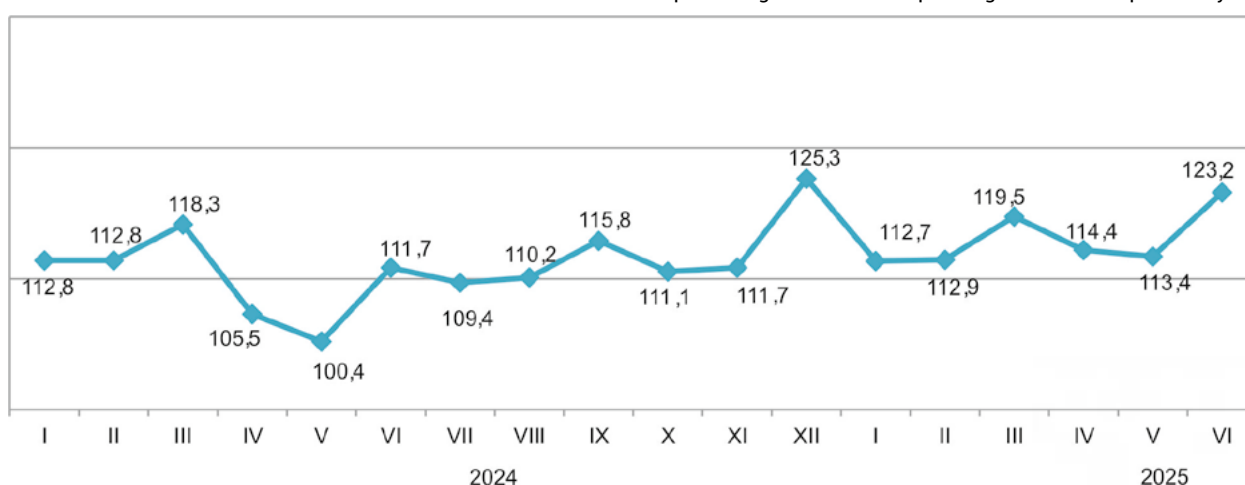
In January-June 2025, the construction of 17174 new buildings was completed, of which 15673 are residential and 1501 are non-residential.

In January-June 2025, 1545,1 billion tenge was allocated for housing construction. In the total volume of investments in fixed capital, the share of disbursed funds in housing construction amounted to 18,9%.

The main source of financing for housing construction in January-June 2025 is the own funds of developers, the share of which is 91,1%.

as a percentages of the corresponding month of the previous year

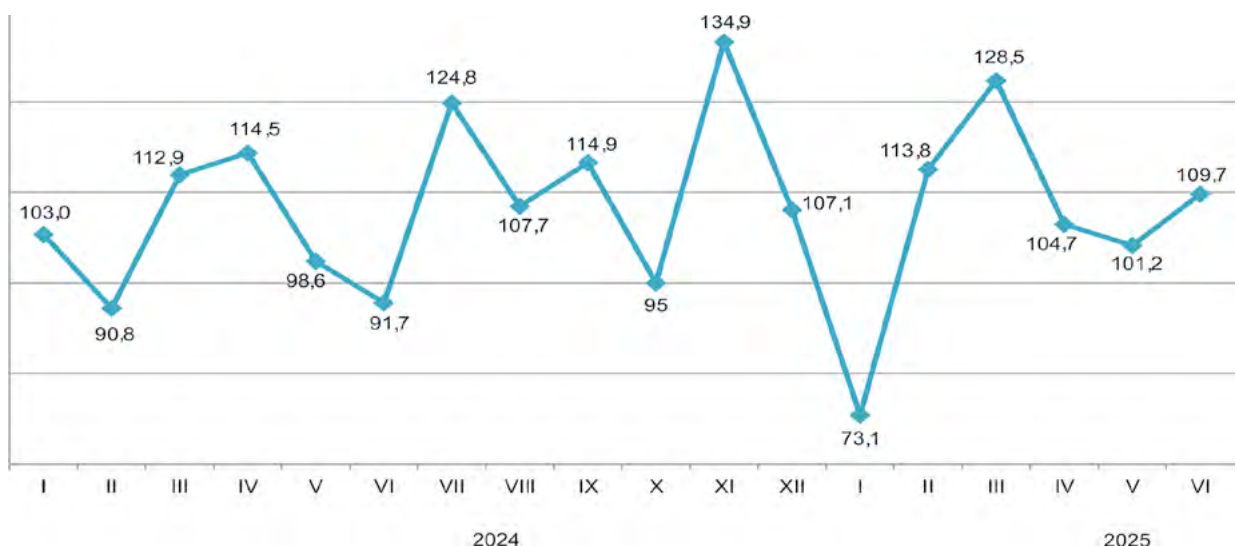


In January-June 2025, the total area of housing put into operation to January-June 2024 increased by 6,6% and amounted to 7933,4 thousand square meters, of which in multi-apartment buildings – by 11,1% (5083 thousand square meters). At the same time, the total area of commissioned individual residential buildings decreased by 2,6% (2755,2 thousand square meters).

In the total volume of commissioned housing, the share of multi-apartment buildings was 64,1%, individual – 34,7%. The average actual cost of construction of 1 square meter of total housing area increased by 11,5%.

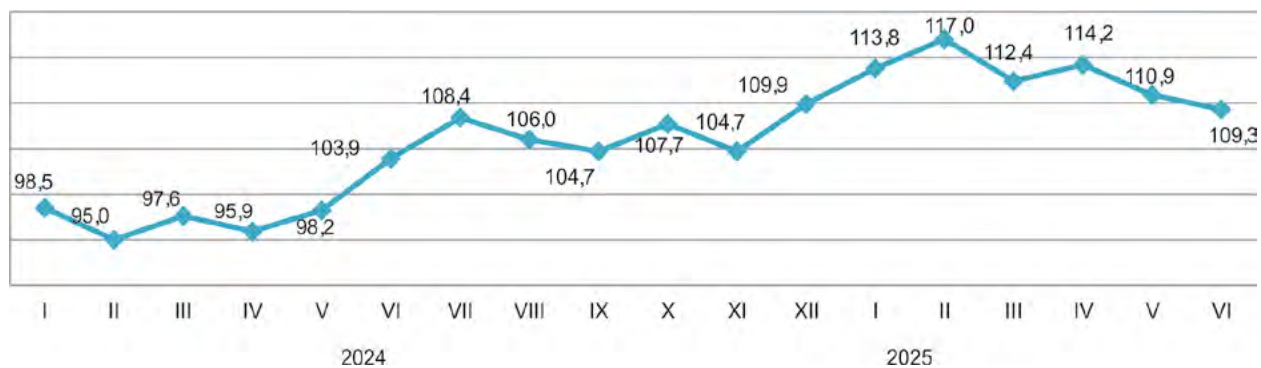

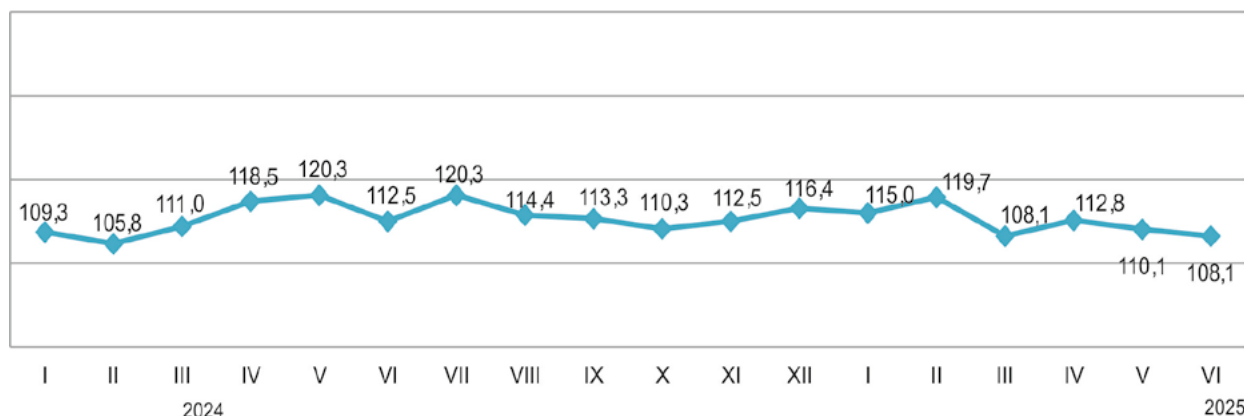

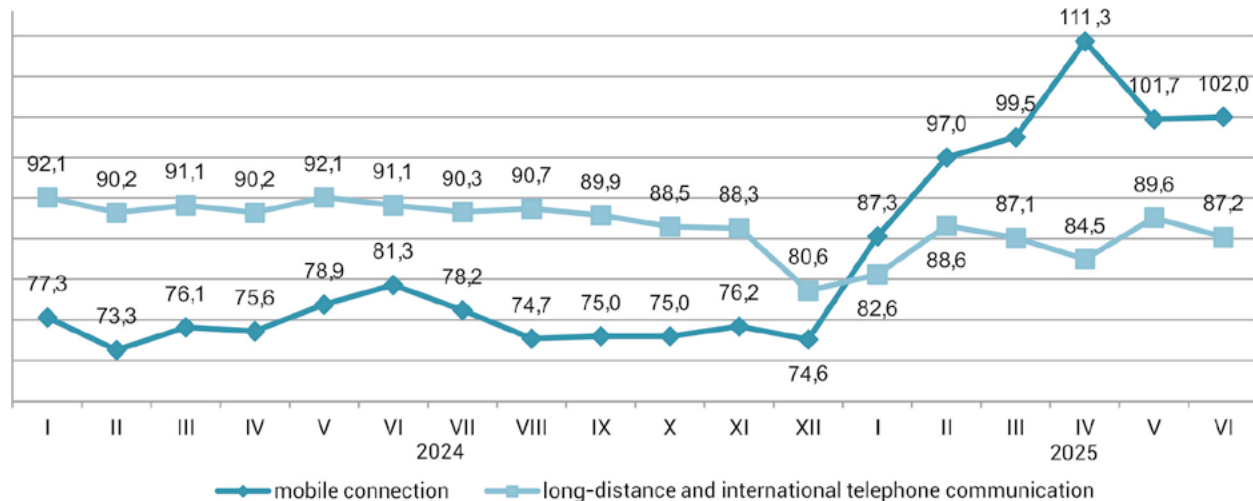

3.12 Statistics of enterprises

In June, compared to May 2025, there is a slight increase in the number of registered legal entities (by 0,3%), compared to the corresponding period of the previous year, their number increased by 2,4%. At the same time, there is an increase in the number of operating legal entities - by 0,4%, compared to the corresponding period of the previous year, their number increased by 1%. Since the beginning of the year, by type of economic activity, the largest number of registered legal entities remains in the industry «Wholesale and retail trade; car and motorcycle repair», the share of which as of July 1, 2025. amounted to 27%. On the second place – «Construction» (13,4%), on the third – «Provision of other types of services» (10,1%). Together, the share of these three types of activities is 50,5% of all registered legal entities.
