2. Social indicators

2.1 Population size and migration

The population of the country as of July 1, 2025 amounted to 20387,8 thousand people, including 12899,4 thousand (63,3%) urban residents and 7488,4 thousand (36,7%) rural residents.

In January-June 2025, compared to January-June 2024, the number of arrivals to Kazakhstan decreased by 21%, while the number of departures from the country decreased by 49,5%.

The main migration exchange of the country occurs with the CIS member states, with the share of arrivals from and departures to these countries amounting to 80,6% and 83,4%, respectively.

The number of internal migrants increased by 20,6%. A positive net migration balance due to interregional movements was recorded in three regions of the country: the cities of Astana (7874 people), Almaty (3149 people), and Shymkent (1524 people).

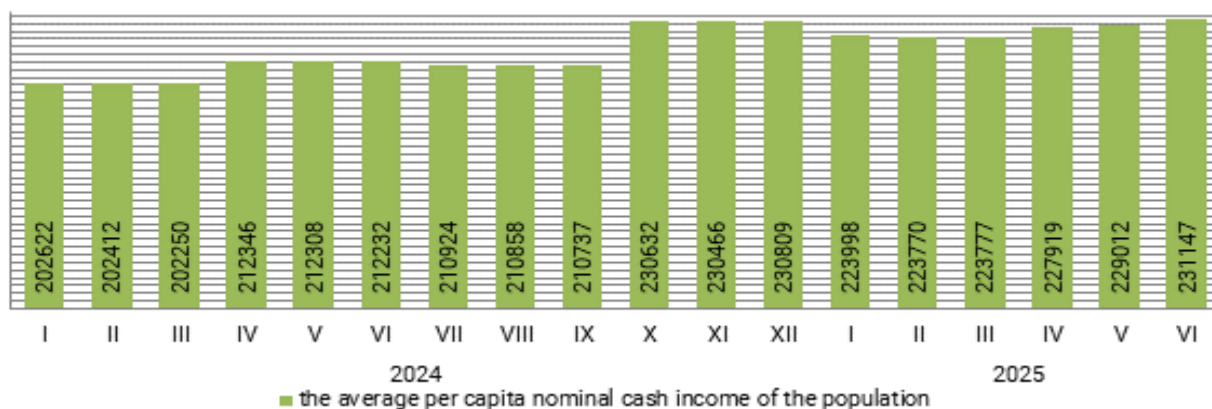

2.2 Income of the population

The average per capita nominal cash income of the population, according to an estimate in June 2025, amounted to 231147 tenge (preliminary data), which is 8,9% higher than in June 2024, real cash income for the specified period decreased by 2,6%.

2.3 Employment of the population

The number of unemployed, determined according to the methodology of the ILO, in the II quarter of 2025¹⁾ amounted to 448,8 thousand people, the unemployment rate was 4,6%.

The employed population²⁾ amounted to 9300,4 thousand people, including employees – 7139,3 thousand people, individual entrepreneurs – 1732,3 thousand people, persons engaged in private practice – 20,4 thousand people, individuals, who are founders (participants) of business partnerships and founders, shareholders (participants) of joint-stock companies, as well as members of production cooperatives – 25,6 thousand people, independent workers – 382,8 thousand people.

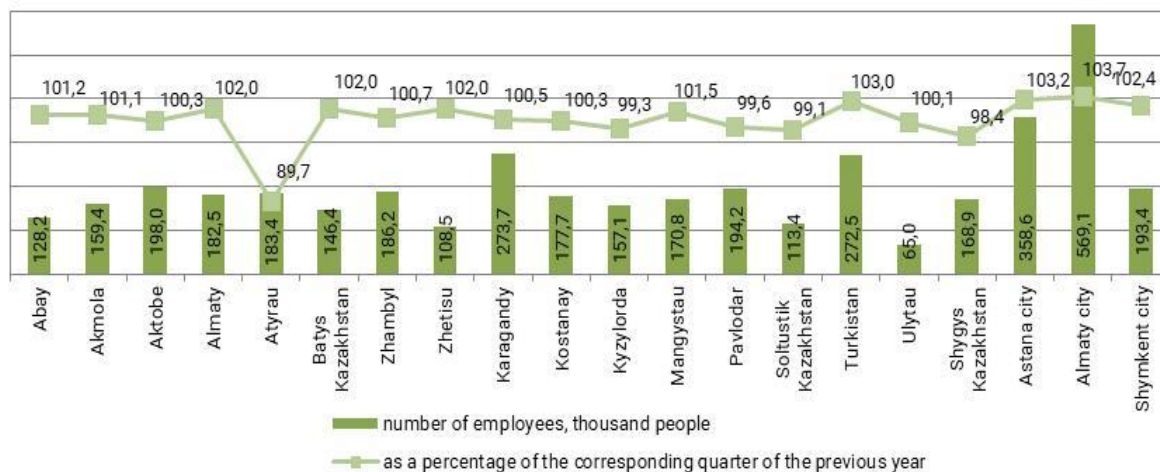

The number of employees at enterprises (organizations) in the II quarter of 2025³⁾ amounted to 4007,0 thousand people, of which at large and medium-sized enterprises – 2873,0 thousand people.

In the II quarter of 2025, 242,2 thousand people were hired by enterprises. 258,2 thousand people dropped out for various reasons. Worked by one employee 460,2 hours.

At the end of the II quarter of 2025, 62,3 thousand vacancies were not filled at enterprises (1,6% of the number of employees).

2.4 Remuneration of labor at enterprises and organizations*

In the II quarter of 2025, the average monthly nominal salary amounted to 448620 tenge (excluding employees of small enterprises engaged in entrepreneurial activities). In the II quarter of 2025, the median salary was estimated to be 316152 tenge.

From January 1, 2025, the minimum wage is set at 85000 tenge.

3. Economic indicators

3.1 Statistics of prices

In July 2025, the monthly consumer price index slowed down and amounted to 0.7% (in June 2025 – 0.8%). Prices for non-food products increased by 0.8%, food products – by 0.7%, paid services – by 0.5%.

Price increases in July were recorded for certain types of appliances: an ironing board by 6.2%, a floor clothes dryer – by 5.4%, a microwave – by 3.7%, and a TV – by 3.6%. Petrol prices increased by 1.6%. Diesel fuel prices increased – 1.2%.

Among food products, prices increased for white cabbage by 12.6%, lemons – by 8.5%, sliced loaf – by 4.4%, beef boneless – by 3.3%, lamb with bones – by 3%, sunflower oil – by 2.8%, pears – by 2.6%. Price decreases were observed for tomatoes by 14.7%, sweet peppers – by 11.2%, cucumbers – by 10.5%, carrots – by 7.9%, potatoes – by 7.3%, grapes – by 5.2%, garlic – by 5.1%.

In the service sector, prices increased for cargo transportation by 3.3%, swimming pool services – by 3.2%, gym services – by 2.8%. Subscription fee for Internet access by 2%.

In July 2025, compared to the previous month, the producer price index for agricultural products was 99.5%, crop products – 101.2%, livestock products – 97.3%.

Prices for potatoes increased by 2.2%, lentils by 1.9%, oilseeds by 1.8%, wheat by 1.5%, and buckwheat by 1.1%.

Prices for greenhouse cucumbers decreased by 4%, greenhouse tomatoes by 2.6%, and carrots by 1%.

Among livestock products, egg prices decreased by 5.3%, while poultry prices increased by 5.4%, horse prices increased by 1.8%, and cattle prices increased by 1.4%.

Prices of manufacturing enterprises for industrial products in July 2025 increased by 2.1% compared to the previous month. Oil prices were higher by 3.9%, natural gas – by 2%, coal – by 1%, metal ores – by 0.9%. Of petroleum products, gasoline rose in price by 2.2%, diesel fuel – by 1.9%.

An increase in prices was noted for lead by 4.8%, precious metals – by 3.8%, zinc – by 2.8%, copper – by 2.1%, aluminum – by 2%, rolled ferrous metals – by 1.3%.

From food products, wheat flour rose in price by 2.9%, poultry meat – by 1.1%, sugar fell in price by 1%.

In the service sector, tariffs for the transportation of goods by all modes of transport in July 2025 increased by 4.6% compared to the previous month, while tariffs for communication services and tariffs for postal and courier services remained unchanged.

In July 2025, compared to the previous month, the price index in construction was 100.0%. Prices for construction and installation works remained at the level of the previous month, machinery and equipment increased by 0.7%, other works and costs - by 0.2%.

3.2 Short-term economic indicator

The short-term economic indicator for January-July 2025 compared to January-July 2024 amounted to 109,3%.

The calculation of the short-term economic indicator is carried out to ensure efficiency and is based on changes in output indices for basic sectors: agriculture, industry, construction, trade, transport and communications, accounting for over 60% of GDP.

3.3 Gross Domestic Product

In the structure of GDP for 2024, updated data, the production of goods amounted to 35,9%, the production of services – 58%. The main share in the production of GDP is occupied by industry – 26,1%, wholesale and retail trade; repair of cars and motorcycles – 19%.

According to the reporting data, in the sectoral structure of income formation for 2024, compensation of employees in the production of goods and services amounted to 28,6% and 35,8%, respectively, the share of other net taxes on production is 0,9% in the production of goods and 1,5% in the production of services, respectively, the share of gross operating surplus /gross mixed income was 70,5 % and 62,7%.

3.4 Investment statistics

In January-July 2025, the volume of investments in fixed capital amounted to 9921,3 billion tenge, which is 16,1% more than in January-July 2024.

The predominant sources of investment financing remain the own funds of economic entities, the volume of which in January-July 2025 amounted to 6347,3 billion tenge.

In January-July 2025, compared with January-July 2024, there is an increase costs for works on construction and capital repair of buildings and constructions by 21,3%.

A significant share of investments in fixed capital in January-July 2025 accounted for industry (37,5%) (including mining and quarrying – 15,7%, manufacturing industry – 11,6%), operations with real estate (19,6%), transport and warehousing (17,5%) and education (7,4%).

The volume of investments of large enterprises in January-July 2025 amounted to 3056 billion tenge.

3.5 Statistics of domestic trade

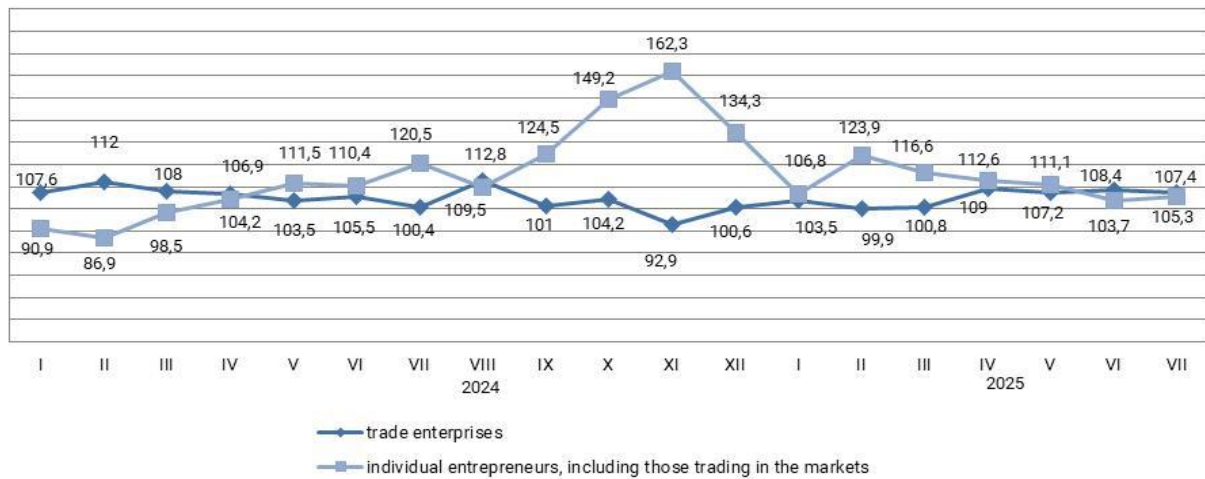
The volume of retail trade in January-July 2025 amounted to 12345,2 billion tenge, which is 6,6% more than the corresponding period in 2024. Retail sales of goods by trading enterprises increased by 5,3%, individual entrepreneurs, including those trading in the markets, increased by 9,9% compared to January-July 2024.

As of August 1, 2025, the volume of commodity stocks of trading enterprises (for reporting enterprises) in retail trade amounted to 1606,2 billion tenge, in trading days - 59 days.

The share of food products in the total volume of retail trade is 30,8%, non-food products – 69,2%. The volume of sales of food products compared to January-July 2024 increased by 6,5%, non-food products increased by 6,7%.

The volume of wholesale trade in January-July 2025 amounted to 25212,3 billion tenge, which is 9,5% more than the corresponding period in 2024. Non-food products and industrial and technical products (81,7%) prevail in the structure of wholesale trade.

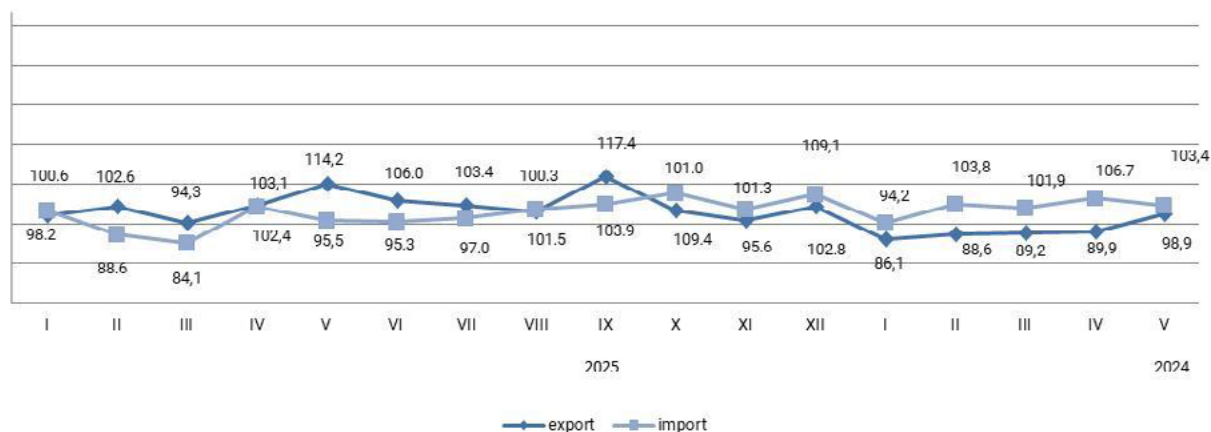

Foreign trade turnover in January-June 2025 amounted to 66 billion US dollars (decreased by 3,1% in nominal terms compared to January-June 2024) including exports – 36,8 billion US dollars (7,1% less) and imports – 29,1 billion US dollars (increased by 2,6% than corresponding period last year).

Exports with the EAEU countries amounted to 4537,6 million US dollars or 14,1% less than in January-June 2024, imports – 8915,2 million US dollars decreased by 2,8% compared to the corresponding period last year.

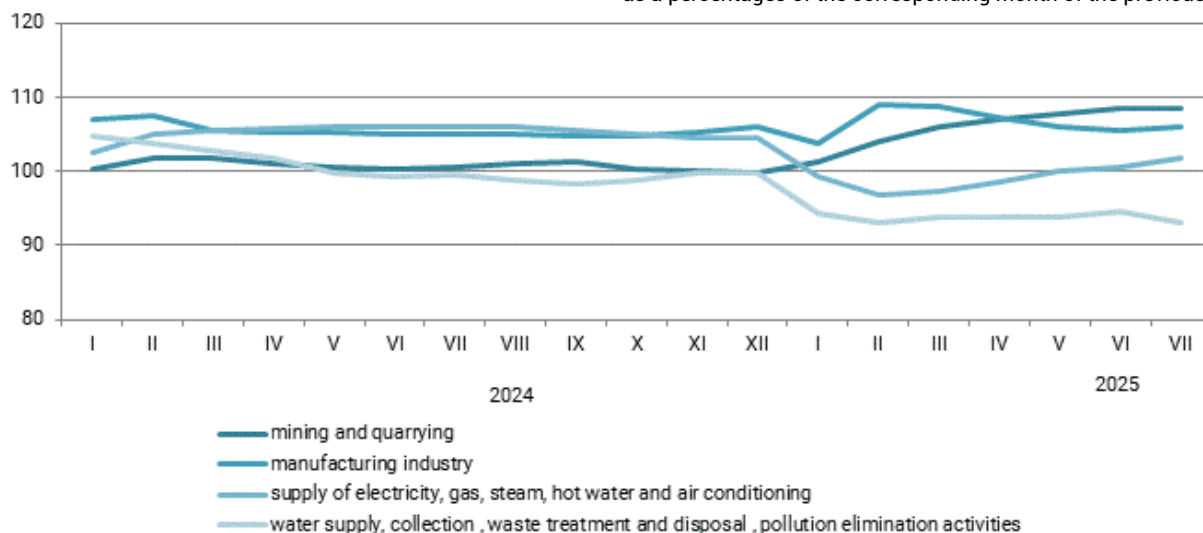

3.9 Statistics of building and housing construction

In January-July 2025, the volume of construction work increased by 18,5% and amounted to 4073,6 billion tenge.

The largest amount of work in January-July 2025 was performed on the construction of facilities (2126,5 billion tenge), non-residential buildings (1264,6 billion tenge) and residential buildings (682,6 billion tenge).

The volume of construction and installation work in January-July 2025 compared to January-July 2024 increased by 17,1% and amounted to 3401,2 billion tenge. The volume of construction work on major repairs increased by 15,3% and on current repairs by 38,4%.

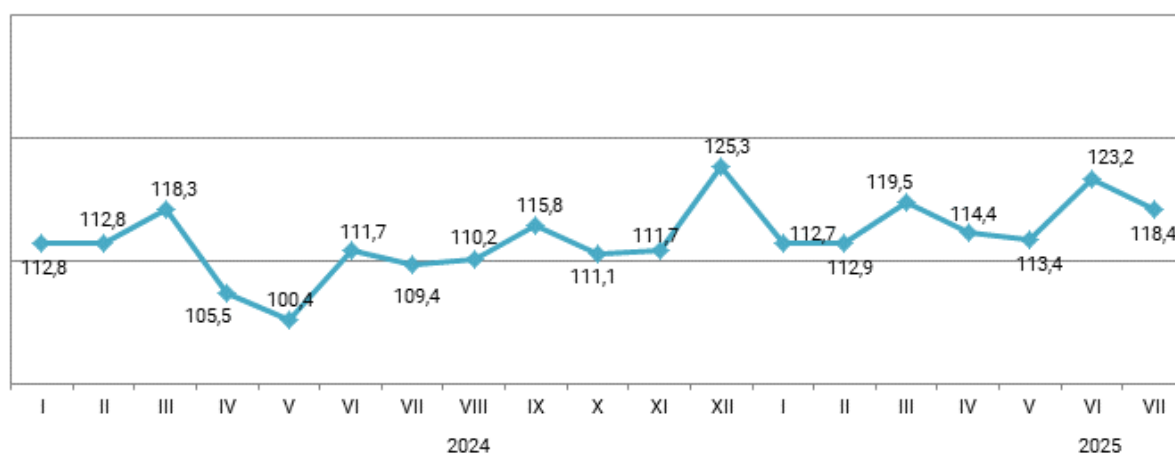
In January-July 2025, the construction of 20464 new buildings was completed, of which 18782 are residential and 1682 are non-residential.

as a percentages of the corresponding month of the previous year



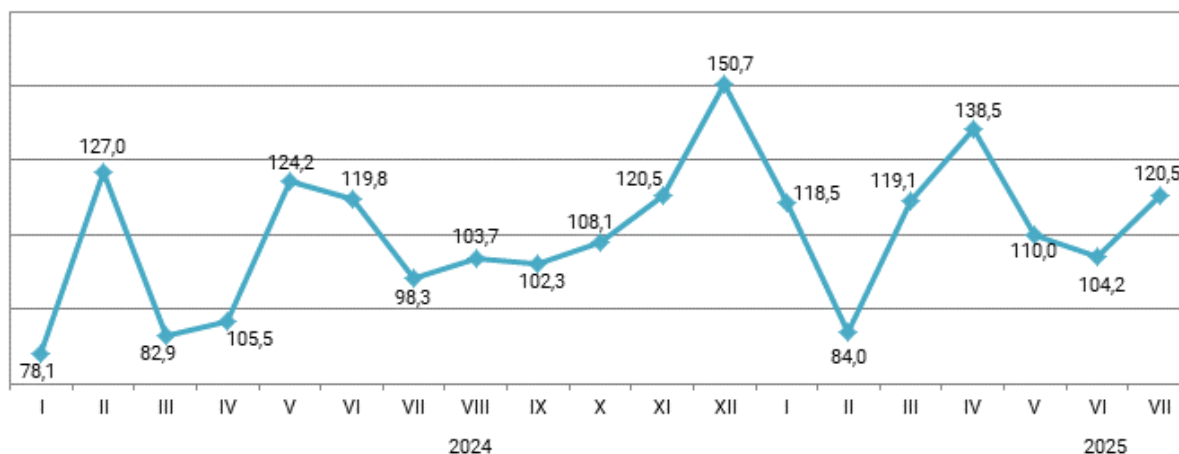

In January-July 2025, 1845 billion tenge was allocated for housing construction. In the total volume of investments in fixed capital, the share of disbursed funds in housing construction amounted to 18,6%.

The main source of financing for housing construction in January-July 2025 is the own funds of developers, the share of which is 90,8%.

as a percentages of the corresponding month of the previous year

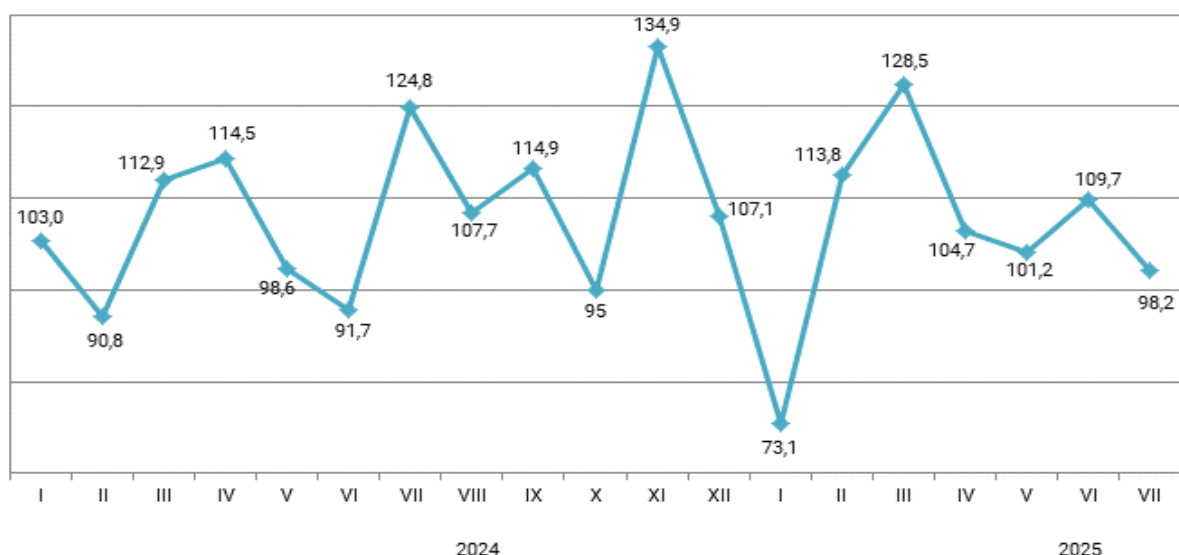


In January-July 2025, the total area of housing put into operation to January-July 2024 increased by 5,2% and amounted to 9380,7 thousand square meters, of which in multi-apartment buildings – by 7,7% (5995,5 thousand square meters). At the same time, the total area of commissioned individual residential buildings decreased by 0,4% (3285 thousand square meters).

In the total volume of commissioned housing, the share of multi-apartment buildings was 63,9%, individual – 35%. The average actual cost of construction of 1 square meter of total housing area increased by 11,5%.

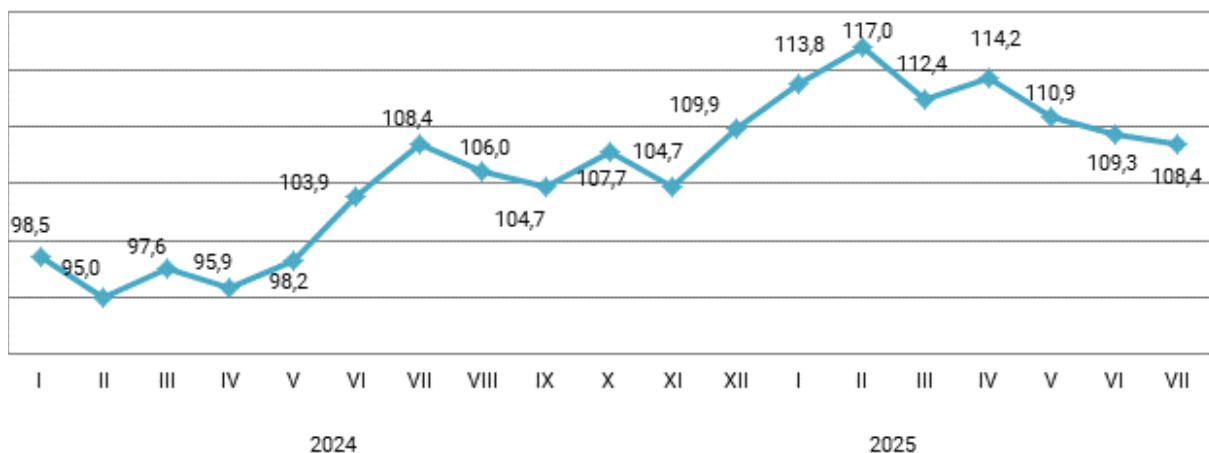

3.10 Statistics of transport

Cargo turnover

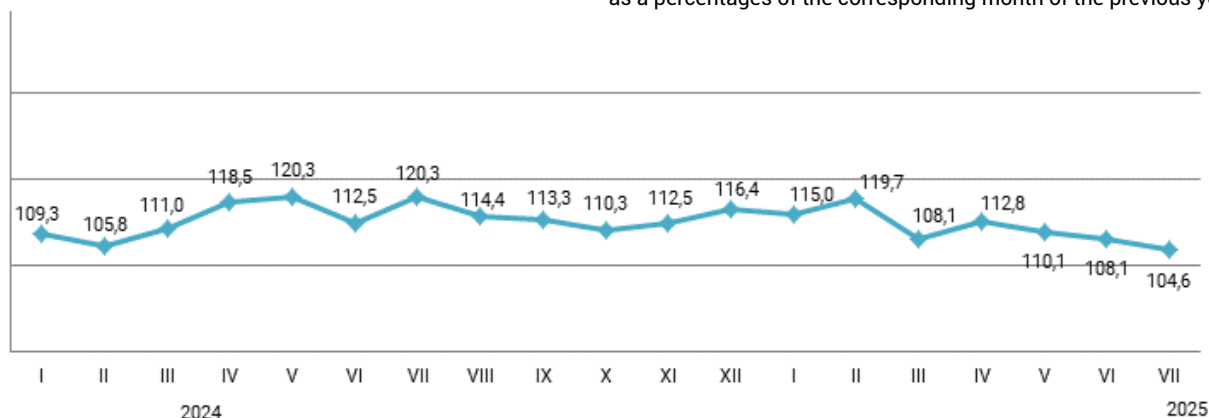

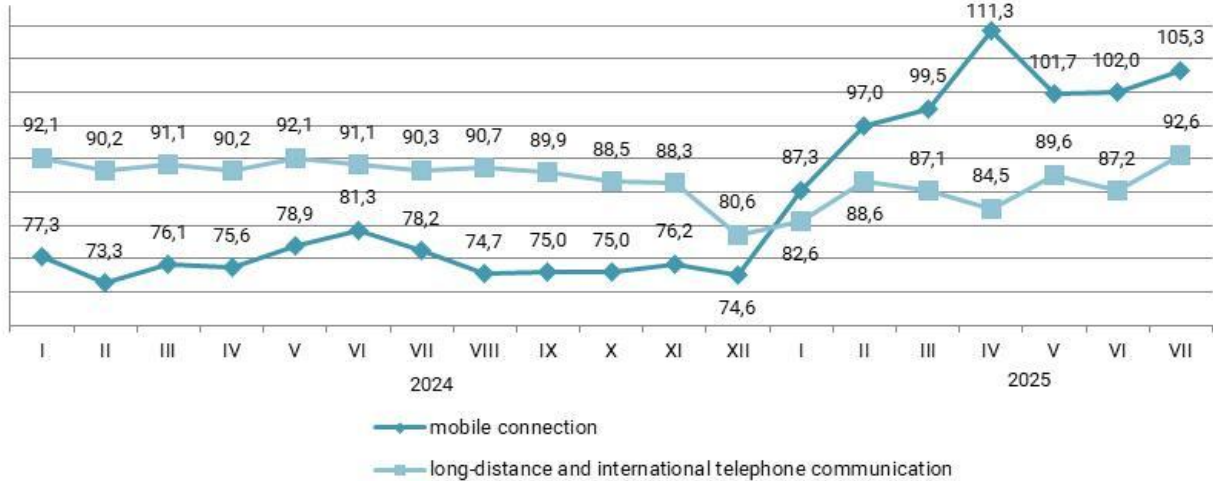

3.11 Statistics of communications

3.12 Statistics of enterprises

In July, compared to June 2025, there is a slight increase in the number of registered legal entities (by 0,4%), compared to the corresponding period of the previous year, their number increased by 2,4%. At the same time, there is an increase in the number of operating legal entities - by 0,4%, compared to the corresponding period of the previous year, their number increased by 1,5%. Since the beginning of the year, by type of economic activity, the largest number of registered legal entities remains in the industry «Wholesale and retail trade; car and motorcycle repair», the share of which as of August 1, 2025. amounted to 27%. On the second place – «Construction» (13,4%), on the third – «Provision of other types of services» (10,1%). Together, the share of these three types of activities is 50,5% of all registered legal entities.
