## 2. Social indicators

### 2.1 Population size and migration

The population of the country as of October 1, 2025 amounted to 20445,2 thousand people, including 12974,8 thousand (63,5%) urban residents and 7470,4 thousand (36,5%) rural residents.

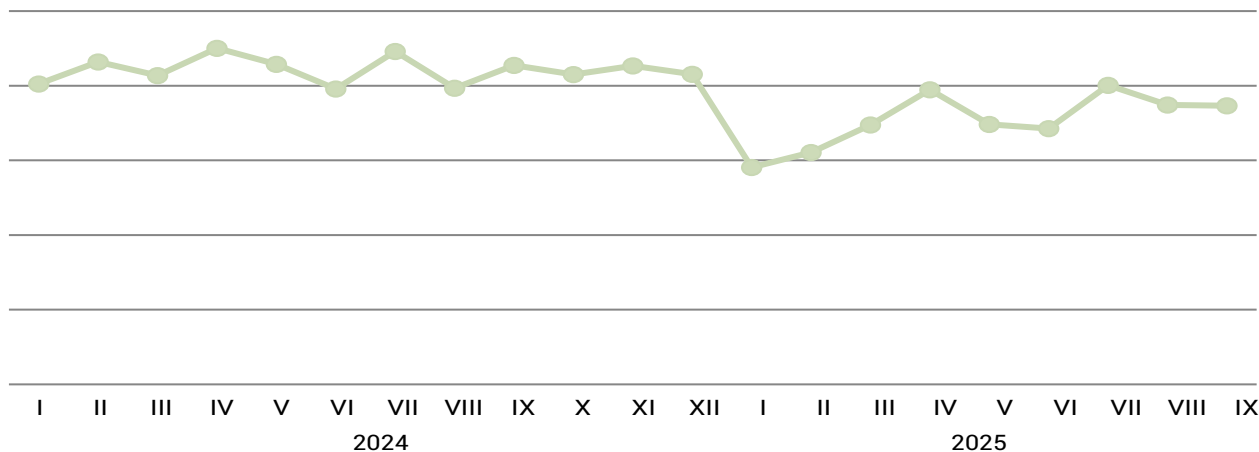
In January-September 2025, compared to January-September 2024, the number of arrivals to Kazakhstan decreased by 20,6%, while the number of departures from the country decreased by 41,4%.

The main migration exchange of the country occurs with the CIS member states, with the share of arrivals from and departures to these countries amounting to 82,7% and 73,2%, respectively.

The number of internal migrants increased by 22,8%. A positive net migration balance due to interregional movements was recorded in three regions of the country: the cities of Astana (67252 people), Almaty (27833 people), Shymkent (13066 people) and Almaty region (8041 people).

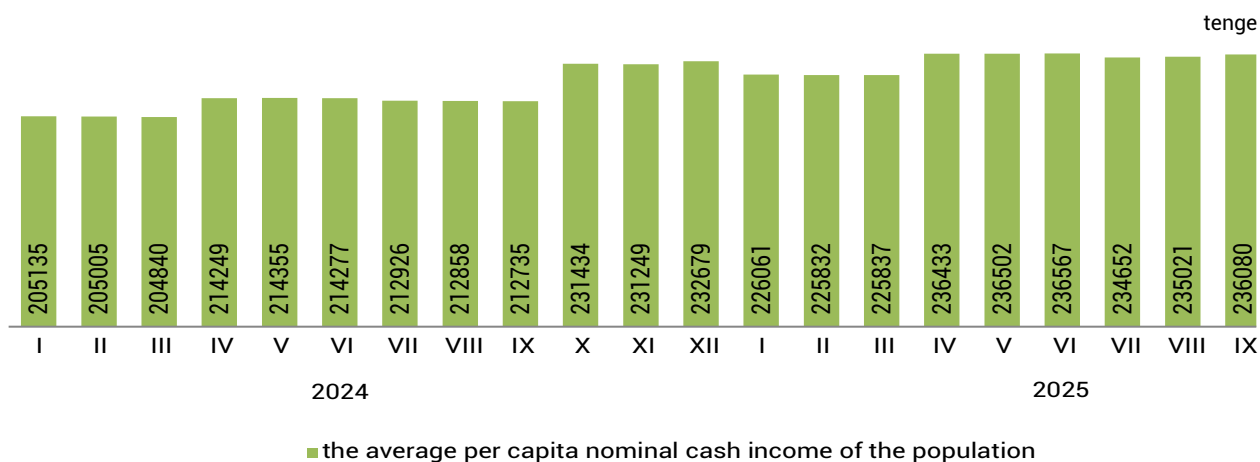

## 2.2 Income of the population

The average per capita nominal cash income of the population, according to an estimate in September 2025, amounted to 236080 tenge (preliminary data), which is 11,0% higher than in September 2024, real cash income for the specified period decreased by 1,7%.

## 2.3 Employment of the population

The number of unemployed, determined according to the methodology of the ILO, in the III quarter of 2025<sup>1)</sup> amounted to 448,6 thousand people, the unemployment rate was 4,6%.

The employed population<sup>2)</sup> amounted to 9330,1 thousand people, including employees – 7155,4 thousand people, individual entrepreneurs – 1733,9 thousand people, persons engaged in private practice – 22,2 thousand people, individuals, who are founders (participants) of business partnerships and founders, shareholders (participants) of joint-stock companies, as well as members of production cooperatives – 1,25 thousand people, independent workers – 406,1 thousand people.

The number of employees at enterprises (organizations) in the III quarter of 2025<sup>3)</sup> amounted to 3997,5 thousand people, of which at large and medium-sized enterprises – 2868,1 thousand people.

In the III quarter of 2025, 295,9 thousand people were hired by enterprises. 299,9 thousand people dropped out for various reasons. Worked by one employee 467,6 hours.

At the end of the III quarter of 2025, 63,9 thousand vacancies were not filled at enterprises (1,6% of the number of employees).

## 2.4 Remuneration of labor at enterprises and organizations\*

In the III quarter of 2025, the average monthly nominal salary amounted to 429368 tenge (excluding employees of small enterprises engaged in entrepreneurial activities). In the III quarter of 2025, the median salary was estimated to be 302584 tenge.

From January 1, 2025, the minimum wage is set at 85000 tenge.

### 3. Economic indicators

#### 3.1 Statistics of prices

In October 2025, the monthly consumer price index was 0,5%. Prices for non-food products increased by 1,2%, food products – by 1%, paid services – decreased by 0,8%.

Among the non-food products, a increase was observed for floor clothes dryer by 5,3%, jewelry – by 5%, umbrella – by 4,2%, fur coat – by 3,3%, medicines – by 2,8%, electric heater – by 2,5%. Fuel prices increased for gasoline by 2,8%, diesel fuel – by 2,4%.

Of the food products, price increases for tomatoes by 15,8%, red caviar – by 9,8%, cucumbers – by 7,4%, mackerel – by 5%, rye-wheat bread – by 4%, dumplings, manti, khinkali – by 3,6%, kiwi – by 3,1%, minced meat – by 3%, coffee – by 1,8%.

In the field of paid services, the price level for theater services increased by 10,1%, laminate laying – by 7,1%, door lock replacement – by 4,1%, foreign language courses – by 4%, tire fitting services – by 2,9%, holidays in Dubai – by 2,7%, dental prosthetics – by 2,5%, public catering services – by 2%.

Price decreases for cold water by 40%, gas transported – by 10,7% communal services – by 9%, travel insurance – by 6%, heating – by 0,2%.

In October 2025, compared to the previous month, the producer price index for agricultural products was 102,1%, for crop products 100,6%, and for livestock products 103,7%.

Price increases were recorded for fresh grapes by 31,6%, greenhouse tomatoes – by 23,5%, corn (maize) – by 8,3%, pome fruits – by 7,9%, fruits and berries – by 6,7%, peppers – by 4,5%, safflower seeds – by 4,1%, greenhouse cucumbers – by 3,6%, garlic – by 3,4%, cabbage – by 2,7% and rapeseed – by 1,6%.

Prices for paddy rice decreased by 9,1%, dried lentils – by 5,5%, carrots – by 2,5%, rye – by 2,1%, and potatoes by 2%.

Among livestock products, prices increased for domestic poultry by 4,5%, eggs – by 4,1%, cattle – by 3,7% and raw cow's milk – by 1,3%.

Prices of manufacturing enterprises for industrial products in October 2025 increase by 1,2% compared to the previous month. Coal prices were higher by 1,2%, natural gas and metal ores – by 1%, oil – lower by 1,3%. Of petroleum products, gasoline rose in price by 6,3%, diesel fuel – by 4,6%, propane and butane liquefied – by 4,2%, fuel oil fell in price by 1,4%.

An increase in prices was noted for precious metals by 10,8%, aluminum – by 2,9%, ferroalloys – by 2,5%, zinc – by 2,2%, rolled ferrous metals – by 1,1%, copper – by 0,5%, lead prices were lower by 0,9%.

From food products, cereals rose in price by 3,6%, livestock meat – by 2,6%, rye flour – by 1,7%, poultry meat – by 1,2%, dairy products – by 0,9%, vegetable oil – by 0,8%, pasta – by 0,6%, wheat flour – by 0,4%, rice fell in price by 2,8%, sugar – by 2,5%.

In the service sector, tariffs for the transportation of goods by all modes of transport in October 2025 decreased by 3,0% compared to the previous month, while tariffs for communication services and tariffs for postal and courier services remained unchanged.

In October 2025, compared to the previous month, the price index in construction was 100,5%. Prices for construction and installation work increased by 0,5%, machinery and equipment – by 0,3%, other works and costs – by 0,6%.

### 3.4 Investment statistics

In January-October 2025, the volume of investments in fixed capital amounted to 15955,8 billion tenge, which is 13,1% more than in January-October 2024.

The predominant sources of investment financing remain the own funds of economic entities, the volume of which in January-October 2025 amounted to 10032,6 billion tenge.

In January-October 2025, compared with January-October 2024, there is an increase costs for works on construction and capital repair of buildings and constructions by 17,1%.

A significant share of investments in fixed capital in January-October 2025 accounted for industry (38,2%) (including mining and quarrying – 15,2%, manufacturing industry – 10,6%), operations with real estate (18,7%), transport and warehousing (18,1%), education (6,5%) and agriculture, forestry and fisheries (5,4%).

The volume of investments of large enterprises in January-October 2025 amounted to 5055,4 billion tenge.

### 3.5 Statistics of domestic trade

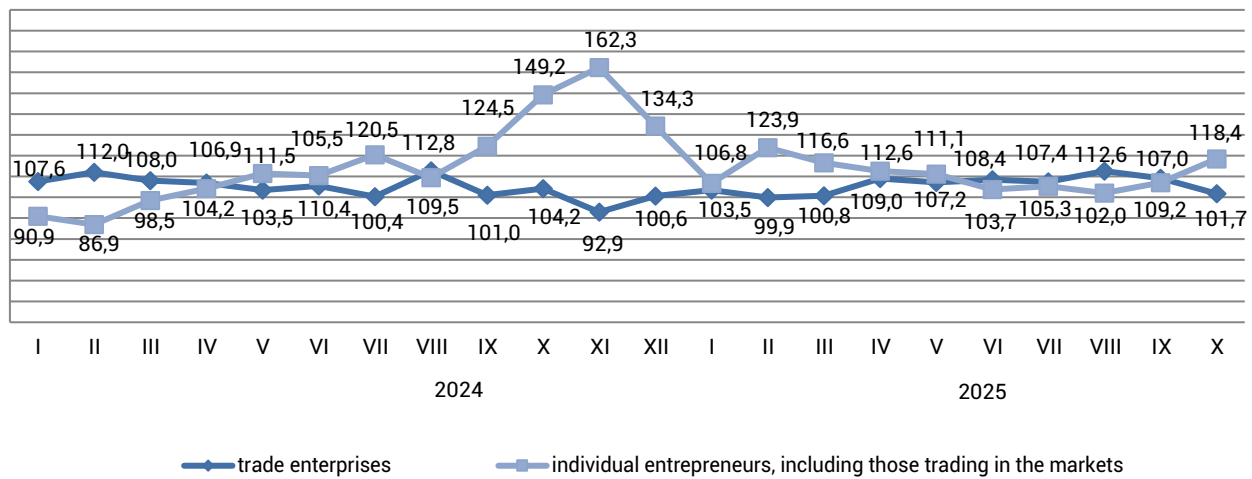
The volume of retail trade in January-October 2025 amounted to 20040,7 billion tenge, which is 7,4% more than the corresponding period in 2024. Retail sales of goods by trading enterprises increased by 6,2%, individual entrepreneurs, including those trading in the markets, increased by 9,9% compared to January-October 2024.

As of November 1, 2025, the volume of commodity stocks of trading enterprises (for reporting enterprises) in retail trade amounted to 1588 billion tenge, in trading days - 61 days.

The share of food products in the total volume of retail trade is 32,9%, non-food products – 67,1%. The volume of sales of food products compared to January-October 2024 increased by 7,5%, non-food products increased by 7,3%.

The volume of wholesale trade in January-October 2025 amounted to 40468,3 billion tenge, which is 9,7% more than the corresponding period in 2024. Non-food products and industrial and technical products (82%) prevail in the structure of wholesale trade.

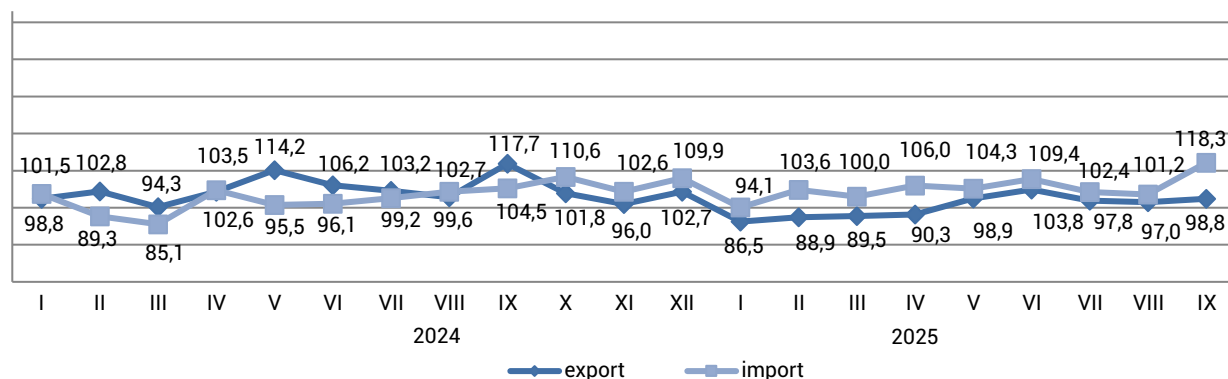

Foreign trade turnover in January-September 2025 amounted to 103,4 billion US dollars (decreased by 1,1% in nominal terms compared to January-September 2024) including exports – 57,5 billion US dollars (5,1% less) and imports – 45,9 billion US dollars (increased by 4,5% than corresponding period last year).

Exports with the EAEU countries amounted to 7307,1 million US dollars or 9,8% less than in January-September 2024, imports – 14428,4 million US dollars increased by 0,2% compared to the corresponding period last year.

Gross output of products (services) of agriculture, forestry and fisheries in January-October 2025 amounted to 8110,6 billion tenge, including crop production – 5080,4 billion tenge, livestock – 2975,9 billion tenge, hunting – 1,4 billion tenge, forestry – 19,3 billion tenge, fisheries and aquaculture – 23,2 billion tenge, services in agriculture – 10,4 billion tenge.

Out of the total output volume, agricultural formations account for 5510,3 billion tenge or 67,9 percent of the total volume, including 4100,2 billion tenge (80,7 percent) in crop production and 1355,8 billion tenge (45,6 percent) in livestock breeding.

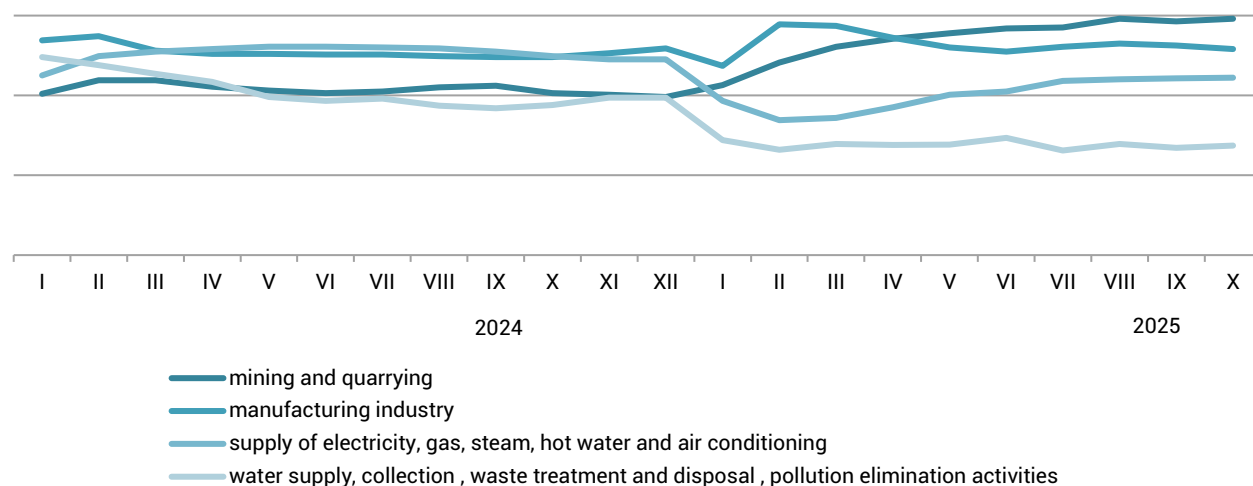

### 3.9 Statistics of building and housing construction

In January-October 2025, the volume of construction work increased by 15,1% and amounted to 7263,2 billion tenge.

The largest amount of work in January-October 2025 was performed on the construction of facilities (3902,6 billion tenge), non-residential buildings (2215,8 billion tenge) and residential buildings (1144,7 billion tenge).

The volume of construction and installation work in January-October 2025 compared to January-October 2024 increased by 13,2% and amounted to 5890,5 billion tenge. The volume of construction work on major repairs increased by 16,1% and on current repairs by 32%.

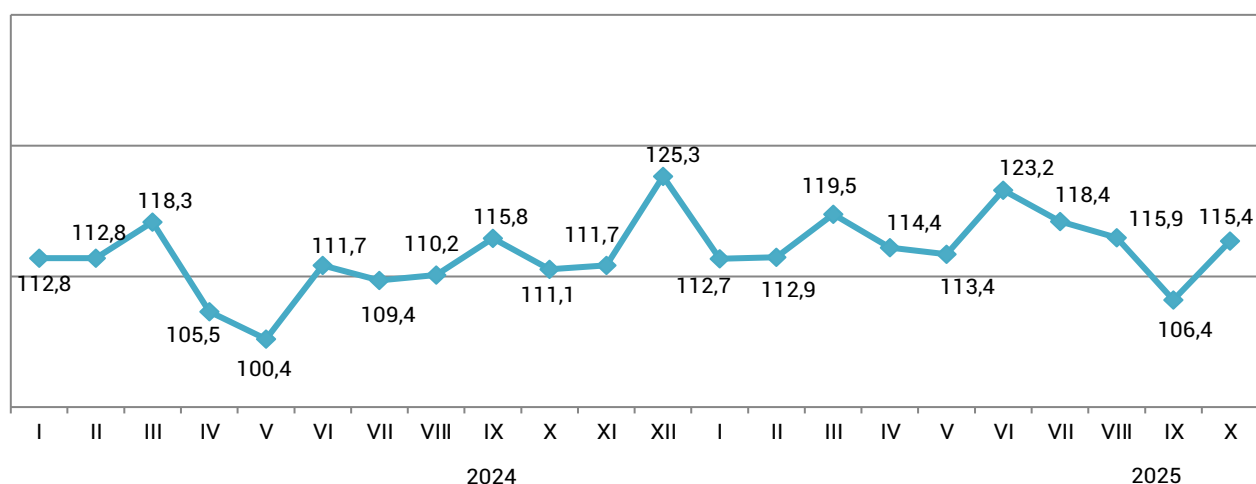
In January-October 2025, the construction of 32500 new buildings was completed, of which 29877 are residential and 2623 are non-residential.

as a percentages of the corresponding month of the previous year



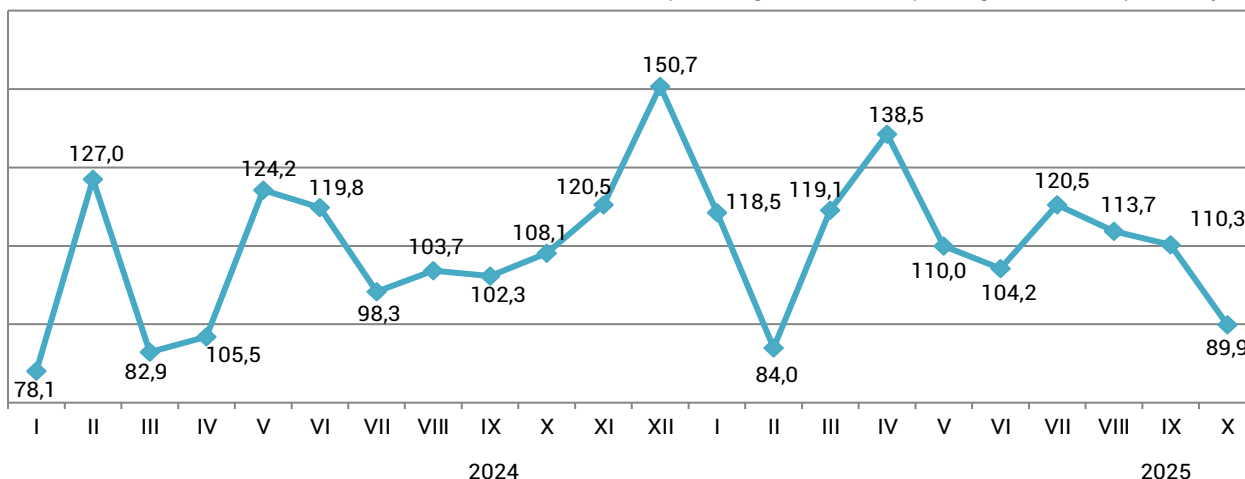

In January-October 2025, 2818,8 billion tenge was allocated for housing construction. In the total volume of investments in fixed capital, the share of disbursed funds in housing construction amounted to 17,7%.

The main source of financing for housing construction in January-October 2025 is the own funds of developers, the share of which is 90,8%.

as a percentages of the corresponding month of the previous year

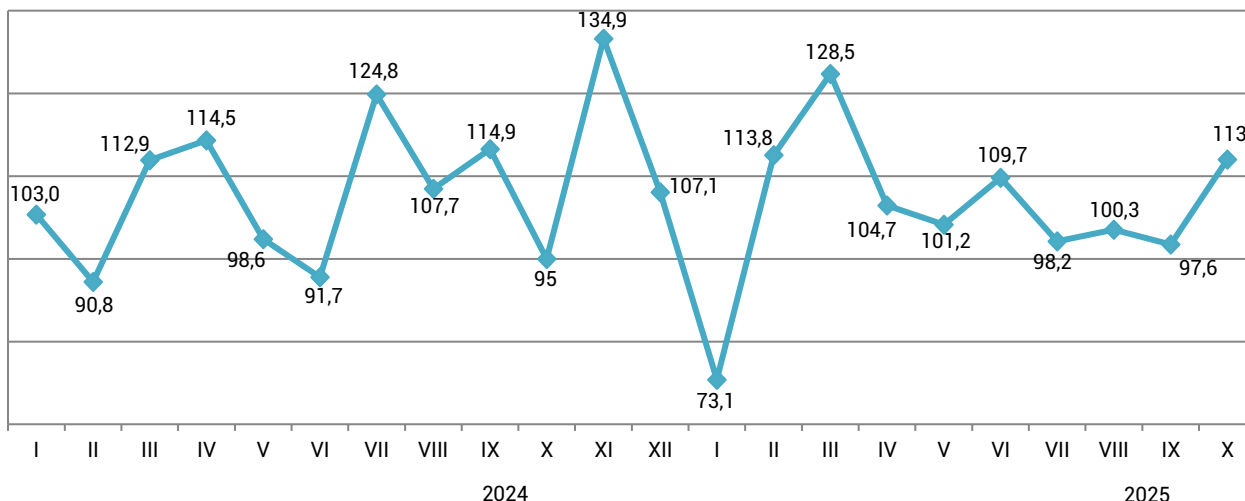


In January-October 2025, the total area of housing put into operation to January-October 2024 increased by 4,5% and amounted to 14611 thousand square meters, of which in multi-apartment buildings – by 8,6% (9279 thousand square meters). At the same time, the total area of commissioned individual residential buildings decreased by 2,1% (5204,7 thousand square meters).

In the total volume of commissioned housing, the share of multi-apartment buildings was 63,5%, individual – 35,6%. The average actual cost of construction of 1 square meter of total housing area increased by 11%.

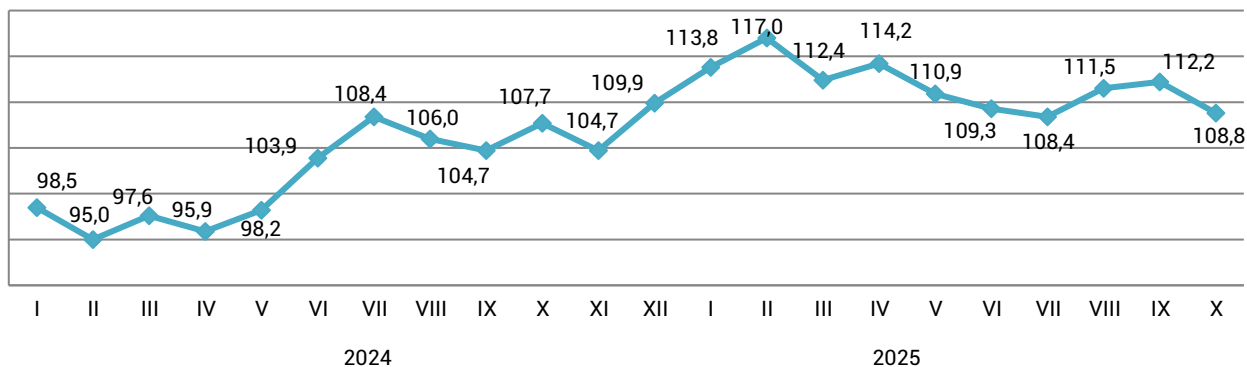

## 3.10 Statistics of transport

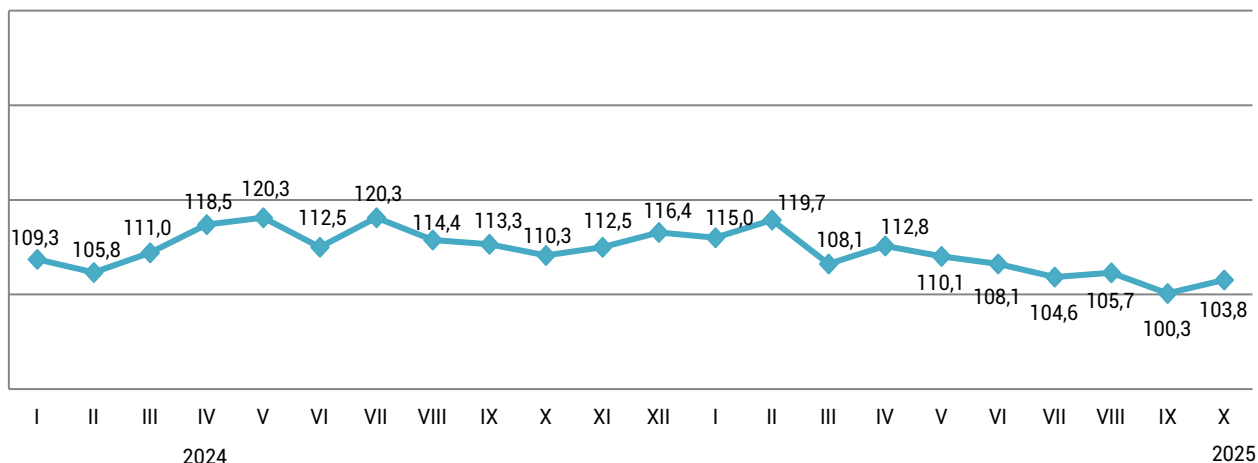

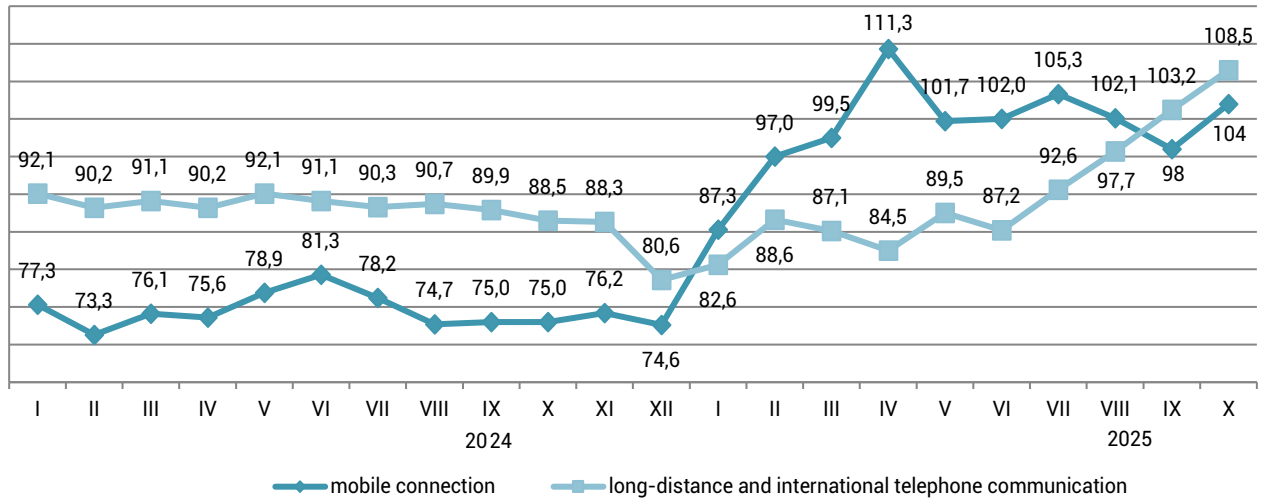

### 3.11 Statistics of communications

### 3.12 Statistics of enterprises

In October, compared to September 2025, there is a slight increase in the number of registered legal entities (by 0,3%), compared to the corresponding period of the previous year, their number increased by 2,6%. At the same time, there is an increase in the number of operating legal entities - by 0,6%, compared to the corresponding period of the previous year, their number increased by 2,1%. Since the beginning of the year, by type of economic activity, the largest number of registered legal entities remains in the industry «Wholesale and retail trade; car and motorcycle repair», the share of which as of November 1, 2025. amounted to 26,9%. On the second place – «Construction» (13,4%), on the third – «Provision of other types of services» (10,1%). Together, the share of these three types of activities is 50,3% of all registered legal entities.
