## 2. Social indicators

### 2.1 Population size and migration

The population of the country as of November 1, 2025 amounted to 20464,1 thousand people, including 12995,9 thousand (63,5%) urban residents and 7468,2 thousand (36,5%) rural residents.

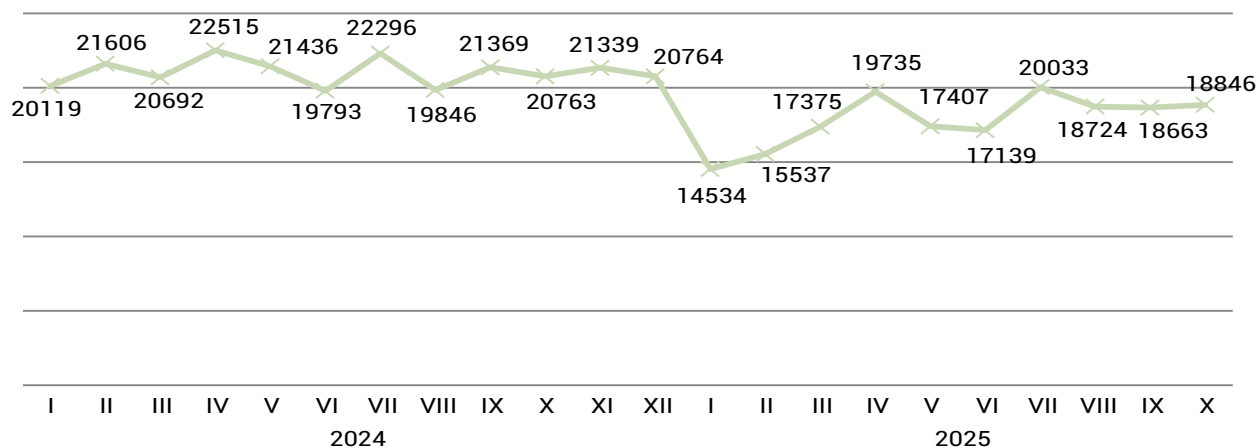
In January-October 2025, compared to January- October 2024, the number of arrivals to Kazakhstan decreased by 18%, while the number of departures from the country decreased by 40,7%.

The main migration exchange of the country occurs with the CIS member states, with the share of arrivals from and departures to these countries amounting to 82,6% and 73,2%, respectively.

The number of internal migrants increased by 18,1%. A positive net migration balance due to interregional movements was recorded in three regions of the country: the cities of Astana (74957 people), Almaty (30604 people), Shymkent (14049 people) and Almaty region (9317 people).

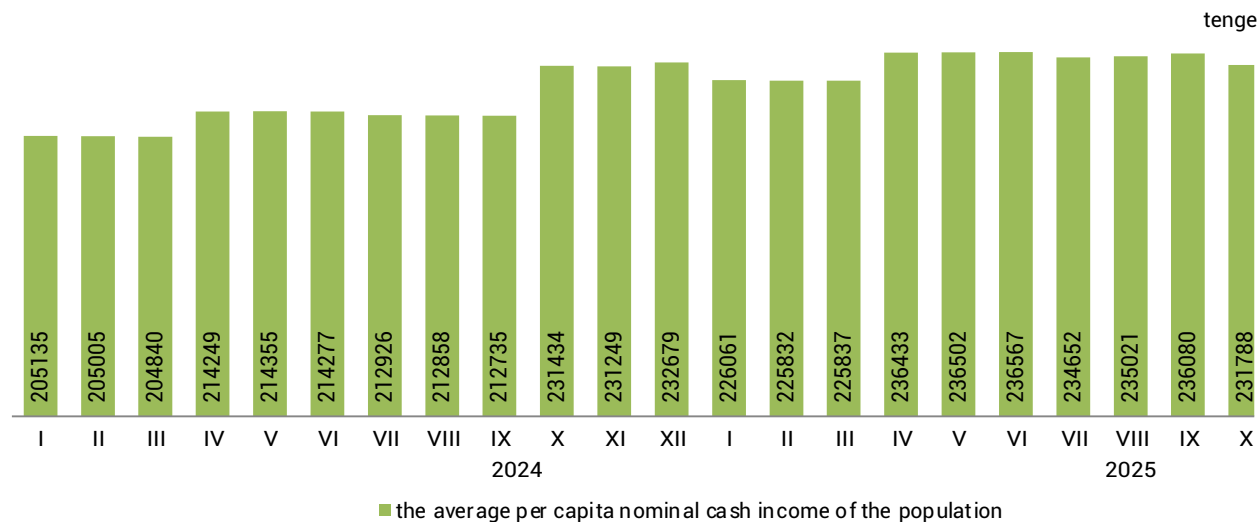

## 2.2 Income of the population

The average per capita nominal cash income of the population, according to an estimate in October 2025, amounted to 231788 tenge (preliminary data), which is 0,2% higher than in October 2024, real cash income for the specified period decreased by 11,0%.

## 2.3 Employment of the population

The number of unemployed, determined according to the methodology of the ILO, in the III quarter of 2025<sup>1)</sup> amounted to 448,6 thousand people, the unemployment rate was 4,6%.

The employed population<sup>2)</sup> amounted to 9330,1 thousand people, including employees – 7155,4 thousand people, individual entrepreneurs – 1733,9 thousand people, persons engaged in private practice – 22,2 thousand people, individuals, who are founders (participants) of business partnerships and founders, shareholders (participants) of joint-stock companies, as well as members of production cooperatives – 1,25 thousand people, independent workers – 406,1 thousand people.

The number of employees at enterprises (organizations) in the III quarter of 2025<sup>3)</sup> amounted to 3997,5 thousand people, of which at large and medium-sized enterprises – 2868,1 thousand people.

In the III quarter of 2025, 295,9 thousand people were hired by enterprises. 299,9 thousand people dropped out for various reasons. Worked by one employee 467,6 hours.

At the end of the III quarter of 2025, 63,9 thousand vacancies were not filled at enterprises (1,6% of the number of employees).

## 2.4 Remuneration of labor at enterprises and organizations\*

In the III quarter of 2025, the average monthly nominal salary amounted to 429368 tenge (excluding employees of small enterprises engaged in entrepreneurial activities). In the III quarter of 2025, the median salary was estimated to be 302584 tenge.

From January 1, 2025, the minimum wage is set at 85000 tenge.

### 3. Economic indicators

#### 3.1 Statistics of prices

In November 2025, the monthly consumer price index was 0,8%. Prices for food products increased by 1%, non-food products – by 0,9%, paid services – by 0,3%.

Of the food products, price increases for cucumbers by 33,7%, tomatoes – by 28%, sweet peppers – by 5,2%, cauliflower – by 5,1%, cold smoked mackerel – by 3,3%, peanuts and potatoes – by 2,7%, halva – by 2,4%, alcohol drinks – by 1,2%.

Prices decreased for white cabbage – by 2,5%, carrots – by 2%, beets – by 1,4%, sugar – by 1,3%, oranges – by 1%.

Among the non-food products, a increase was observed for smartphones by 5,4%, telephone sets – by 4,7%, engagement rings – by 4,1%, floor-standing clothes dryers – by 3%, electric kettles – by 2,8%, batteries – by 2,7%, medicines – by 1%.

In the area of paid services, prices increased for air transport by 7,4%, theater services – by 6,9%, tire fitting services – by 5,6%, rent for comfortable housing– by 3%, installation/reinstallation the operating systems – by 2,8%, foreign language courses – by 2,6%, holidays in Dubai – by 2,2%, laying tiles – by 1,9%.

In November 2025, compared to the previous month, the producer price index for agricultural products was 101,9%, for crop products – 101,6%, and for livestock products – 102,3%.

Price increases were recorded for greenhouse cucumbers by 26,3%, cotton (whether or not ginned) - by 14,2%, greenhouse tomatoes – by 10,7%, potato - by 1,7%, pome fruits – by 1,2% and fruits and berries – by 1%.

Prices for paddy corn for silage by 11,8%, sugar beet – by 4,6%, rice – by 1,9% and millet – by 1,8%.

Among livestock products, prices increased for domestic poultry by 3,8%, eggs – by 2,5%, raw cow's milk – by 1,9%, cattle – by 1%, also pigs decreased by 3,3%.

Prices of manufacturing enterprises for industrial products in November 2025 decreased by 0,3% compared to the previous month. Oil prices were lower by 3,7%, natural gas – by 2,5%, coal – by 0,6%, metal ores prices were higher by 2%. Of petroleum products, diesel fuel rose in price by 2,2%, propane and butane liquefied – by 2,1%, gasoline fell in price by 1%, fuel oil – by 0,3%.

An increase in prices was noted for zinc by 3,8%, precious metals – by 3,5%, aluminum – by 2,9%, ferroalloys– by 1,1%, copper – by 1%, for lead – a decrease by 2,5%, rolled ferrous metals – by 1,5%.

From food products, poultry meat rose in price by 3,3%, vegetable oil – by 2,1%, livestock meat – by 1,2%, bread – by 1,1%, pasta – by 0,9%, dairy products– by 0,6%, rice fell in price by 3,8%, sugar – by 1,1%.

In the service sector, tariffs for the transportation of goods by all modes of transport in November 2025 increased by 0,1% compared to the previous month, tariffs for postal and courier services decreased by 0,1%, and for communication services remained unchanged.

In November 2025, compared to the previous month, the price index in construction was 100,1%. Prices for construction and installation work and other works and costs increased by 0,1%, machinery and equipment reminded at the level of the previous month.

### 3.4 Investment statistics

In January-November 2025, the volume of investments in fixed capital amounted to 18513,2 billion tenge, which is 13,3% more than in January-November 2024.

The predominant sources of investment financing remain the own funds of economic entities, the volume of which in January-November 2025 amounted to 11602,3 billion tenge.

In January-November 2025, compared with January-November 2024, there is an increase costs for works on construction and capital repair of buildings and constructions by 18,2%.

A significant share of investments in fixed capital in January-November 2025 accounted for industry (38,8%) (including mining and quarrying – 14,9%, manufacturing industry – 10,9%), operations with real estate (18,8%), transport and warehousing (17,7%), education (6,1%) and agriculture, forestry and fisheries (5,1%).

The volume of investments of large enterprises in January-November 2025 amounted to 5749 billion tenge.

### 3.5 Statistics of domestic trade

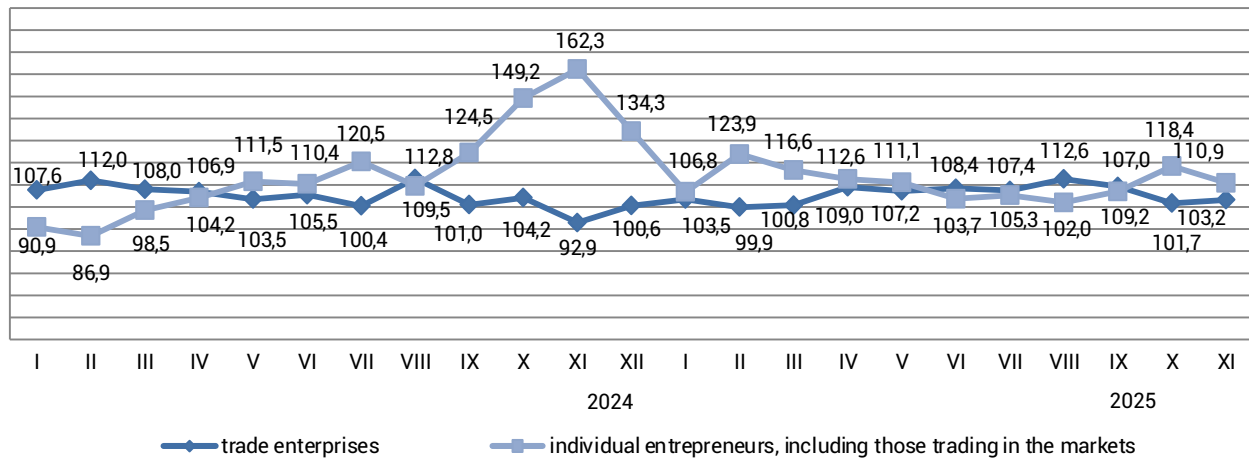
The volume of retail trade in January-November 2025 amounted to 22861,7 billion tenge, which is 7,3% more than the corresponding period in 2024. Retail sales of goods by trading enterprises increased by 5,8%, individual entrepreneurs, including those trading in the markets, increased by 10,1% compared to January-November 2024.

As of December 1, 2025, the volume of commodity stocks of trading enterprises (for reporting enterprises) in retail trade amounted to 1669,4 billion tenge, in trading days - 61 days.

The share of food products in the total volume of retail trade is 32,9%, non-food products – 67,1%. The volume of sales of food products compared to January-November 2024 increased by 7,9%, non-food products increased by 7%.

The volume of wholesale trade in January-November 2025 amounted to 46644,2 billion tenge, which is 9,4% more than the corresponding period in 2024. Non-food products and industrial and technical products (82,1%) prevail in the structure of wholesale trade.

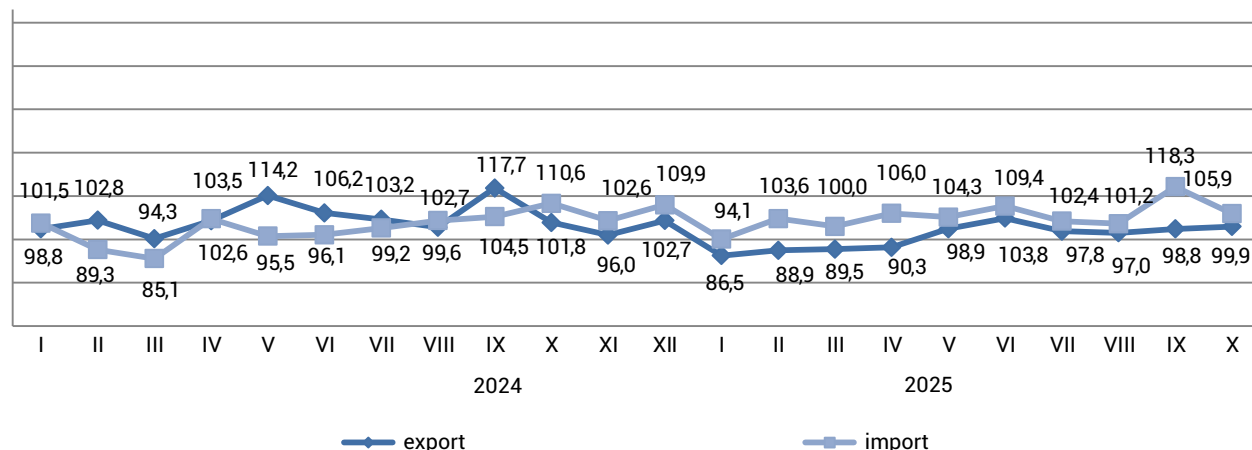

Foreign trade turnover in January-October 2025 amounted to 116,3 billion US dollars (decreased by 0,7% in nominal terms compared to January-October 2024) including exports – 64,6 billion US dollars (4,6% less) and imports – 51,7 billion US dollars (increased by 4,7% than corresponding period last year).

Exports with the EAEU countries amounted to 8187 million US dollars or 9,7% less than in January-October 2024, imports – 16330,7 million US dollars increased by 0,7% compared to the corresponding period last year.

Gross output of products (services) of agriculture, forestry and fisheries in January-November 2025 amounted to 9198,8 billion tenge, including crop production – 5823,6 billion tenge, livestock – 3315,1 billion tenge, hunting – 1,6 billion tenge, forestry – 21,2 billion tenge, fisheries and aquaculture – 25,5 billion tenge, services in agriculture – 11,8 billion tenge.

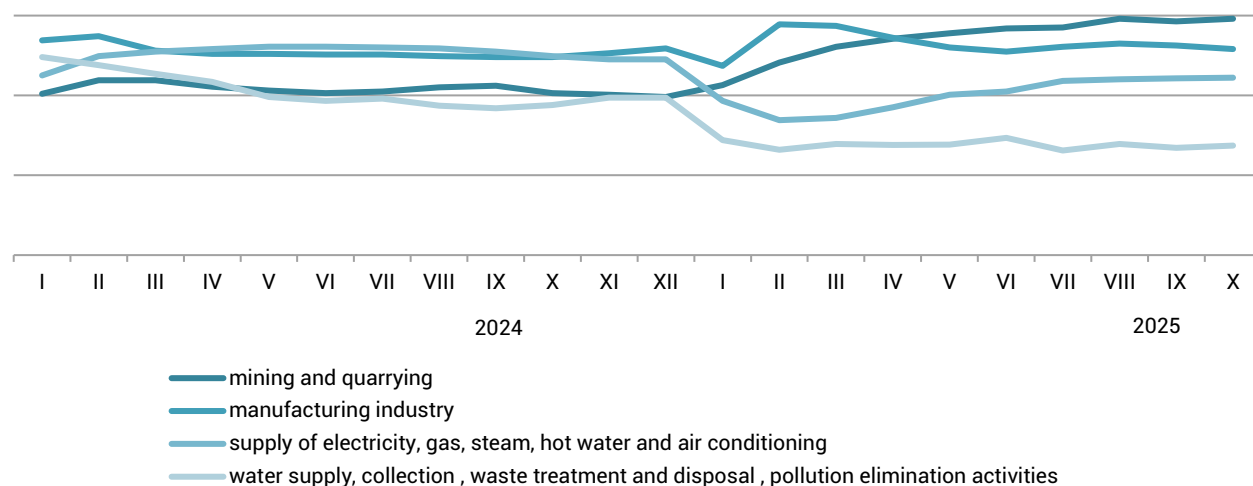

### 3.9 Statistics of building and housing construction

In January-November 2025, the volume of construction work increased by 14,7% and amounted to 8141,5 billion tenge.

The largest amount of work in January-November 2025 was performed on the construction of facilities (4368,3 billion tenge), non-residential buildings (2507,1 billion tenge) and residential buildings (1266,2 billion tenge).

The volume of construction and installation work in January-November 2025 compared to January-November 2024 increased by 12,8% and amounted to 6579 billion tenge. The volume of construction work on major repairs increased by 17,3% and on current repairs by 31,4%.

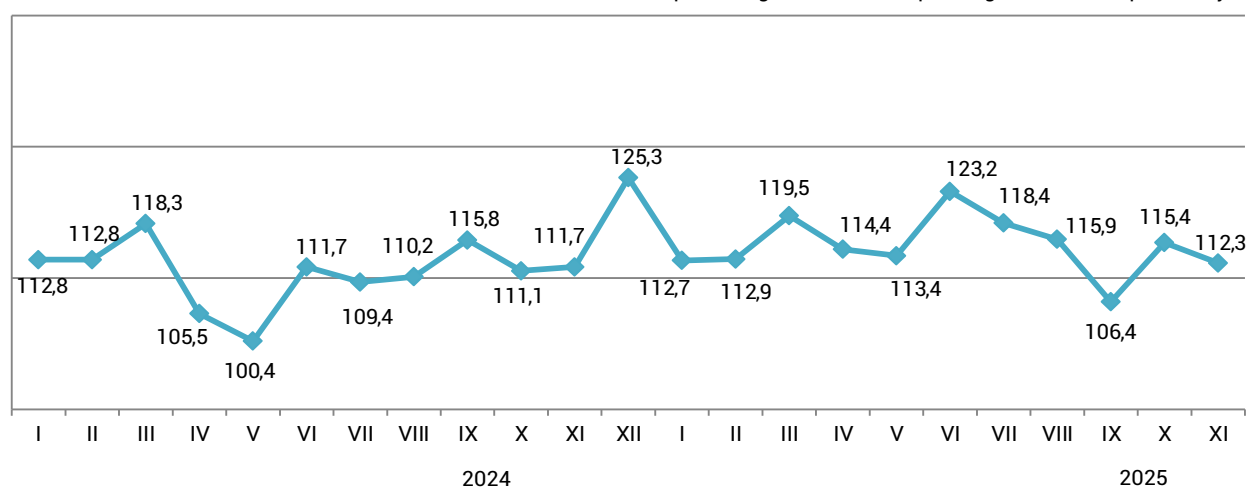
In January-November 2025, the construction of 36904 new buildings was completed, of which 33881 are residential and 3023 are non-residential.

as a percentages of the corresponding month of the previous year



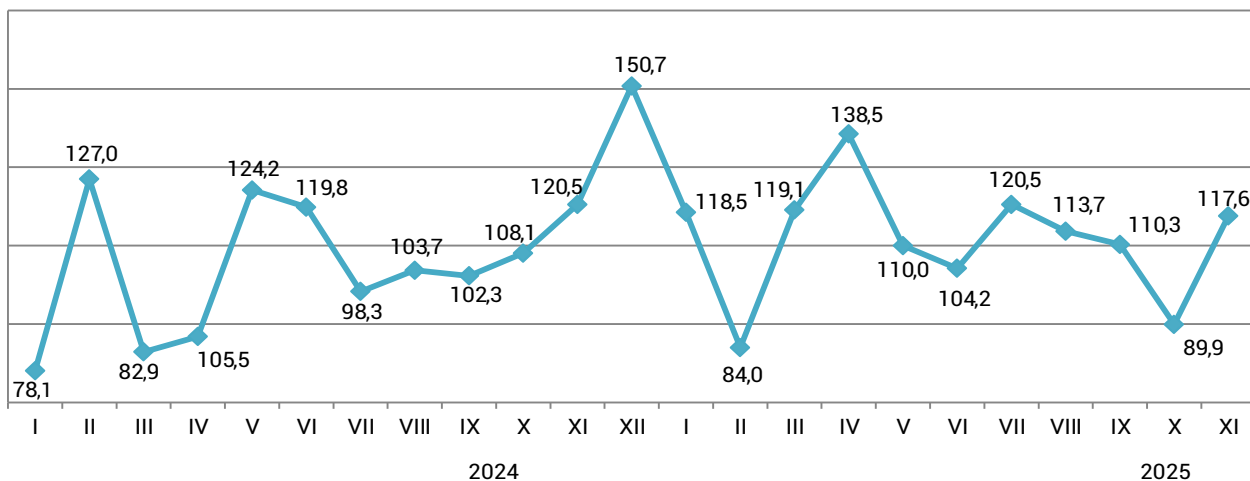

In January-November 2025, 3256,1 billion tenge was allocated for housing construction. In the total volume of investments in fixed capital, the share of disbursed funds in housing construction amounted to 17,6%.

The main source of financing for housing construction in January-November 2025 is the own funds of developers, the share of which is 91,4%.

as a percentages of the corresponding month of the previous year

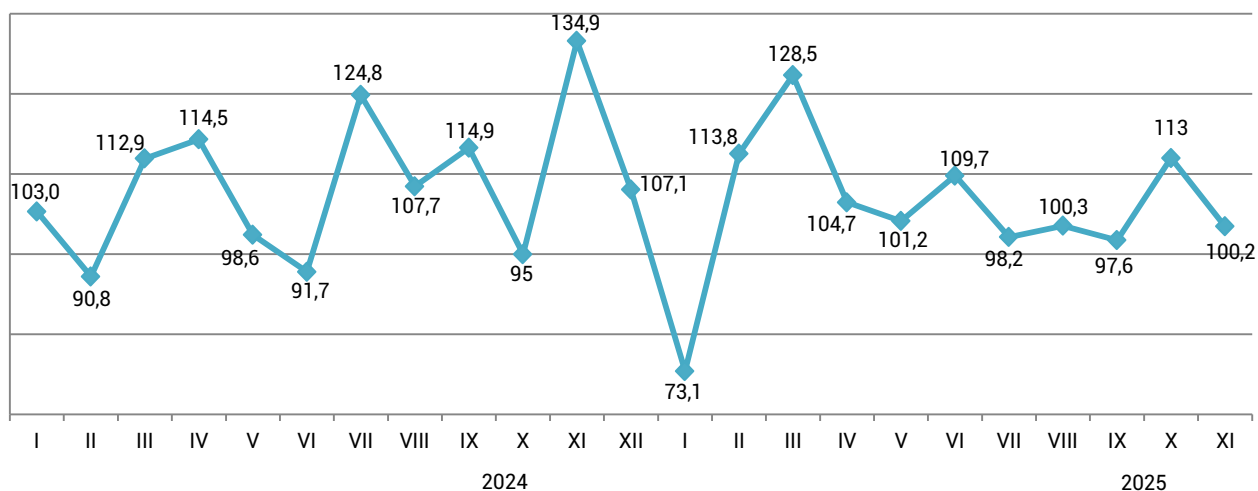


In January-November 2025, the total area of housing put into operation to January-November 2024 increased by 3,9% and amounted to 16949 thousand square meters, of which in multi-apartment buildings – by 7,4% (10948,2 thousand square meters). At the same time, the total area of commissioned individual residential buildings decreased by 1,8% (5863 thousand square meters).

In the total volume of commissioned housing, the share of multi-apartment buildings was 64,6%, individual – 34,6%. The average actual cost of construction of 1 square meter of total housing area increased by 11,6%.

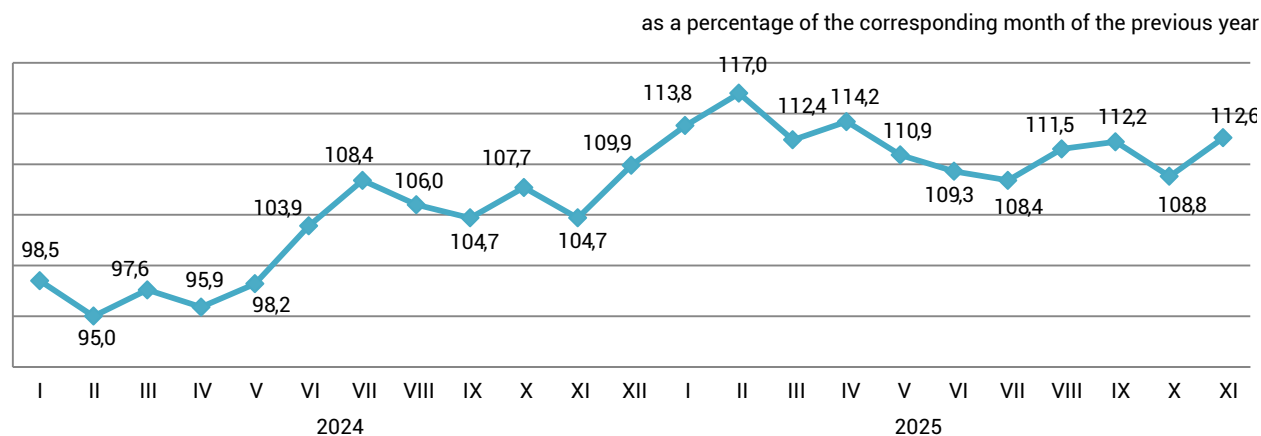

#### Cargo turnover

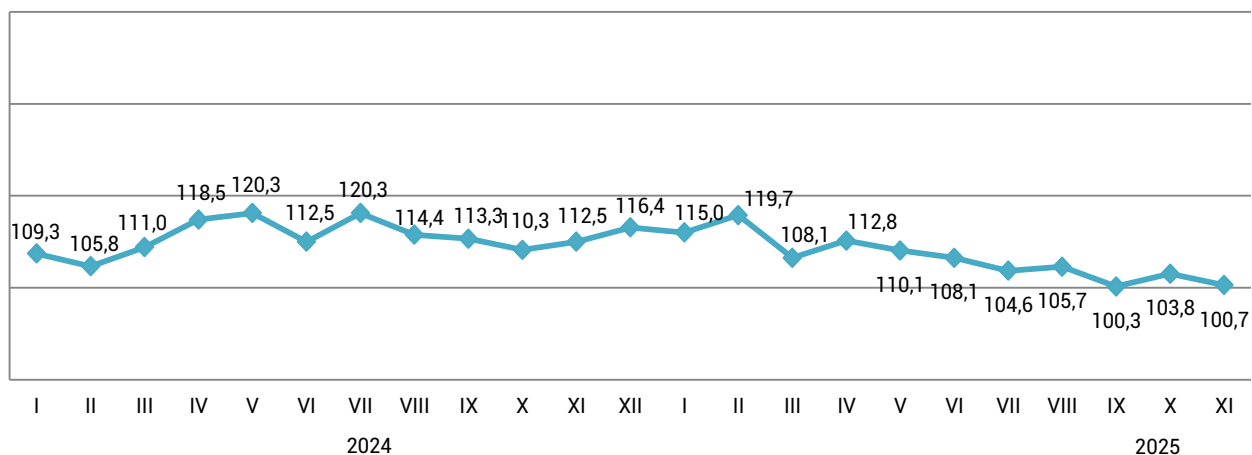

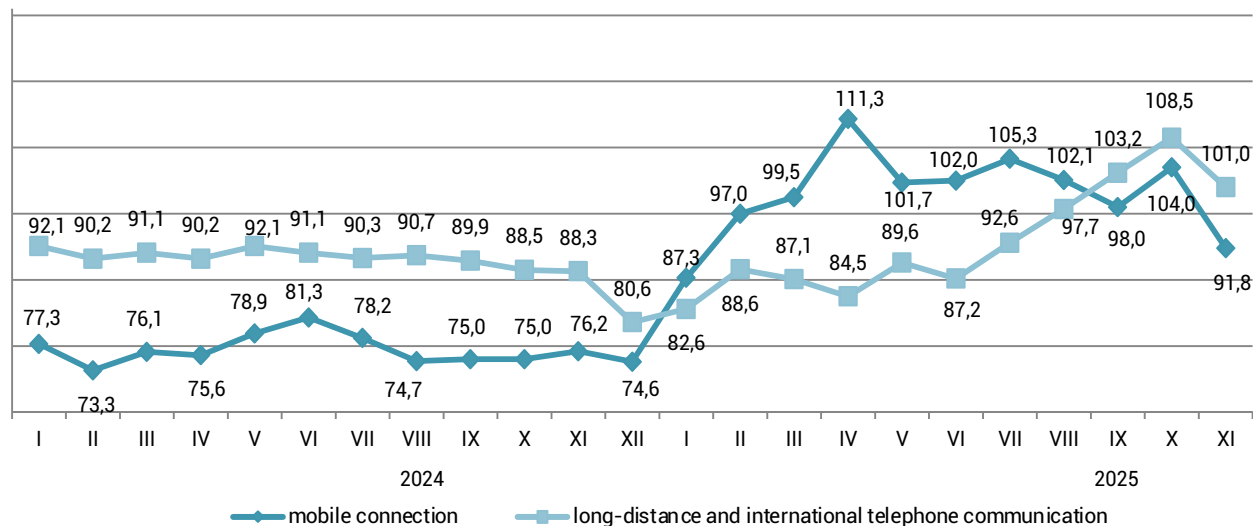

### 3.11 Statistics of communications

Indices of the physical volume for communication services in January-November 2025 compared to January-November 2024 amounted to 103.8%, of which 113.4% for Internet services, 99.6% for mobile services and 86.8% for other telecommunications services.

### 3.12 Statistics of enterprises

In November, compared to October 2025, there is a slight decrease in the number of registered legal entities (by 0,3%), compared to the corresponding period of the previous year, their number increased by 2,6%. At the same time, there is an increase in the number of operating legal entities - by 1%, compared to the corresponding period of the previous year, their number increased by 3,4%. Since the beginning of the year, by type of economic activity, the largest number of registered legal entities remains in the industry «Wholesale and retail trade; car and motorcycle repair», the share of which as of December 1, 2025. amounted to 26,8%. On the second place – «Construction» (13,4%), on the third – «Provision of other types of services» (10%). Together, the share of these three types of activities is 50,2 % of all registered legal entities.
