## 2. Social indicators

### 2.1 Population size and migration

The population of the country as of December 1, 2025 amounted to 20478,9 thousand people, including 13013,1 thousand (63,5%) urban residents and 7465,8 thousand (36,5%) rural residents.

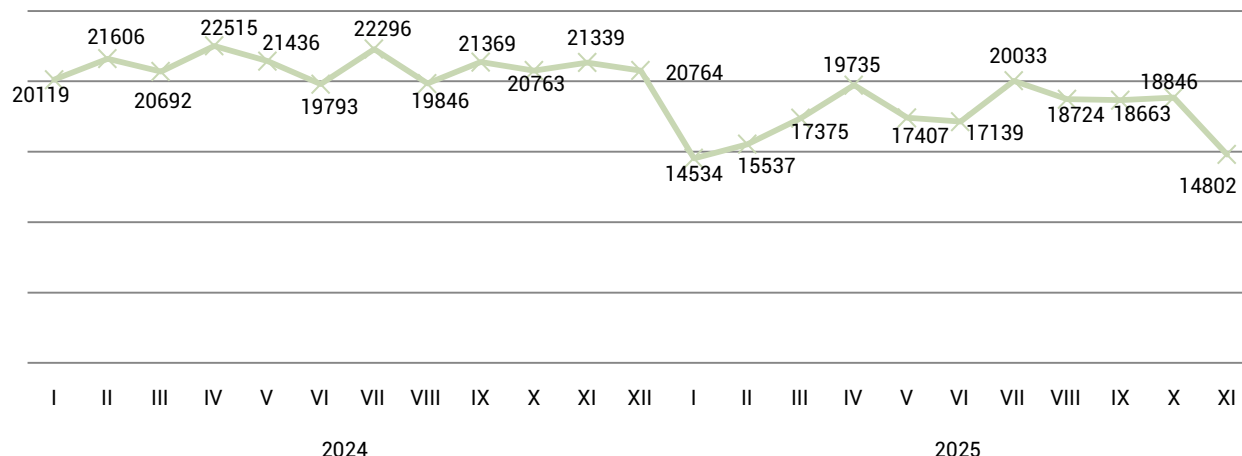
In January-November 2025, compared to January- November 2024, the number of arrivals to Kazakhstan decreased by 20,7%, while the number of departures from the country decreased by 40,6%.

The main migration exchange of the country occurs with the CIS member states, with the share of arrivals from and departures to these countries amounting to 82,2% and 72,5%, respectively.

The number of internal migrants increased by 14,7%. A positive net migration balance due to interregional movements was recorded in three regions of the country: the cities of Astana (81741 people), Almaty (32135 people), Shymkent (14348 people) and Almaty region (10432 people).

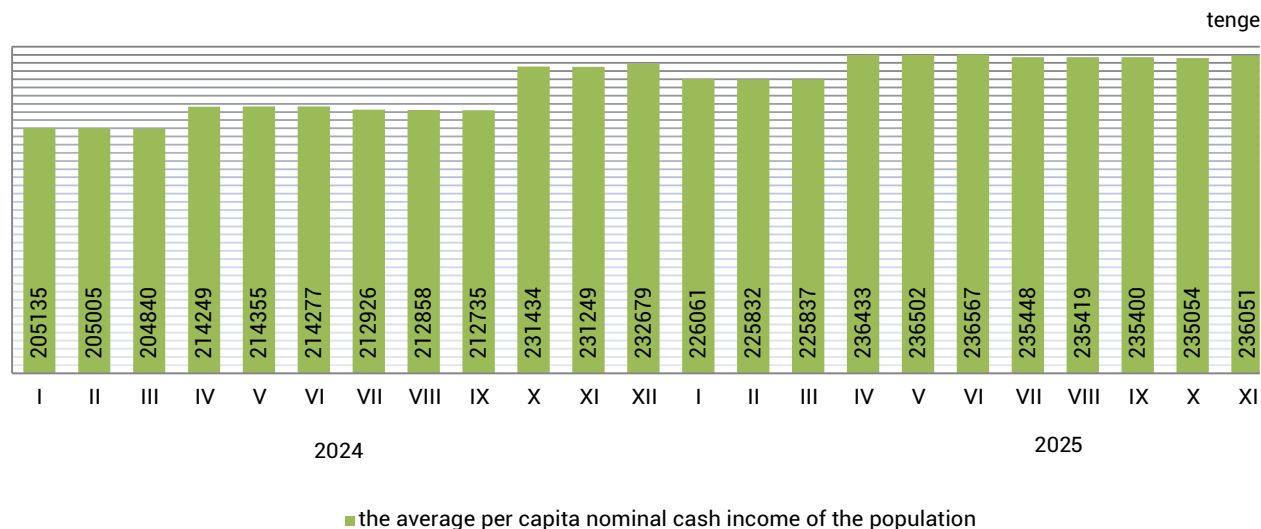

## 2.2 Income of the population

The average per capita nominal cash income of the population, according to an estimate in November 2025, amounted to 236051 tenge (preliminary data), which is 2,1% higher than in November 2024, real cash income for the specified period decreased by 9,2%.

## 2.3 Employment of the population

The number of unemployed, determined according to the methodology of the ILO, in the III quarter of 2025<sup>1)</sup> amounted to 448,6 thousand people, the unemployment rate was 4,6%.

The employed population<sup>2)</sup> amounted to 9330,1 thousand people, including employees – 7155,4 thousand people, individual entrepreneurs – 1733,9 thousand people, persons engaged in private practice – 22,2 thousand people, individuals, who are founders (participants) of business partnerships and founders, shareholders (participants) of joint-stock companies, as well as members of production cooperatives – 1,25 thousand people, independent workers – 406,1 thousand people.

The number of employees at enterprises (organizations) in the III quarter of 2025<sup>3)</sup> amounted to 3997,5 thousand people, of which at large and medium-sized enterprises – 2868,1 thousand people.

In the III quarter of 2025, 295,9 thousand people were hired by enterprises. 299,9 thousand people dropped out for various reasons. Worked by one employee 467,6 hours.

At the end of the III quarter of 2025, 63,9 thousand vacancies were not filled at enterprises (1,6% of the number of employees).

## 2.4 Remuneration of labor at enterprises and organizations\*

In the III quarter of 2025, the average monthly nominal salary amounted to 429368 tenge (excluding employees of small enterprises engaged in entrepreneurial activities). In the III quarter of 2025, the median salary was estimated to be 302584 tenge.

From January 1, 2025, the minimum wage is set at 85000 tenge.

### 3. Economic indicators

#### 3.1 Statistics of prices

In December 2025, the monthly consumer price index was 100,9%. Prices for food products increased by 1,2%, non-food products – by 0,7%, and paid services – by 0,6%.

Among food products, price increases were recorded for fresh vegetables – by 8,6%, minced meat – by 2,6%, hard cheeses – by 1,8%, sausages and meat products, sour cream, fresh fruit – by 1,6% each, fresh or chilled fish – by 1,2%, dairy products – by 1,1%, black tea – by 1%, poultry meat – by 0,9%, pasta and flour-based confectionery products – by 0,8% each.

For non-food goods, price growth was recorded for large household appliances – by 1,9%, other medical products – by 1,5%, personal care goods – by 1,1%, clothing and footwear, furniture, detergents and cleaning products – by 0,7% each, Gasoline AI-98 increased by 2%, gasoline AI-95 – by 2,1%.

In the paid services sector, prices increased for cinema services – by 2,9%, bathhouse visits – by 2,1%, taxi fares – by 1,8%, hairdressing and beauty salon services, passenger railway transport services, as well as general blood tests – by 1% each.

In December 2025, compared to the previous month, the producer price index for agricultural products was 100,2%, for crop products – 100,4%, for livestock products – 99,9%.

Price increases were recorded for greenhouse cucumbers by 17,7%, flowers and flower buds – by 9,3%, oats – by 2,5%, corn (maize) – by 2%, potato – by 1,8%, sunflower seeds – by 1,5%, beetroot – by 0,9%, wheat, except durum wheat – by 0,8%, feed grain crops – by 0,6%, buckwheat – by 0,3%, lentils dried and safflower seeds by 0,2%.

Price reduction were recorded at indoor tomatoes - by 14,9%, rice unhulled – by 2,2%, curly flax seeds – by 1,2%, carrot canteen – by 1,1%, soybeans – by 0,9%, rapeseed seeds – by 0,8%, sugar beet – by 0,5%, buld onions and dried peas by 0,4%.

Among livestock products, prices increased for raw cow`s milk by 1,2%, horses – by 1,1%, sheeps – by 0,6% and cattle by 0,3%.

Prices of manufacturing enterprises for industrial products in December 2025 decreased by 1,1% compared to the previous month. Oil prices were lower by 2,8%, metal ores – by 1,9%, natural gas – by 1,6%, coal – higher by 0,7%. Of petroleum products, diesel fuel fell in price by 1,5%, gasoline – by 0,8%, propane and butane liquefied – by 0,3%, fuel oil rose in price by 0,6%.

An increase in prices was noted for aluminum by 2,7%, copper – by 1,7%, for ferroalloys – a decrease by 1,9%, zinc – by 1,8%, precious metals – by 1,3%, lead – by 0,9%.

From food products, cereals rose in price by 4%, poultry meat – by 1,2%, dairy products and pasta - by 0,7%, vegetable oil – by 0,5%, sugar fell in price by 3,6%, rice – by 2,4%.

In the service sector, tariffs for the transportation of goods by all modes of transport in December 2025 decreased by 0,1% compared to the previous month, while tariffs for communication services and tariffs for postal and courier services remained unchanged.

In December 2025, compared to the previous month, the price index in construction was 100%. Prices for machinery and equipment increased by 0,4%, other works and costs - by 0,7%, construction and installation work remained unchanged

### 3.4 Investment statistics

In January-December 2025, the volume of investments in fixed capital amounted to 22730,6 billion tenge, which is 13% more than in 2024.

The predominant sources of investment financing remain the own funds of economic entities, the volume of which in January-December 2025 amounted to 13965,9 billion tenge.

In January-December 2025, compared with 2024, there is an increase costs for works on construction and capital repair of buildings and constructions by 12,7%.

A significant share of investments in fixed capital in January-December 2025 accounted for industry (39,8%) (including mining and quarrying – 14,1%, manufacturing industry – 12,3%), operations with real estate (18%), transport and warehousing (17,8%), education (5,6%) and agriculture, forestry and fisheries (5,1%).

The volume of investments of large enterprises in January- December 2025 amounted to 7075 billion tenge.

### 3.5 Statistics of domestic trade

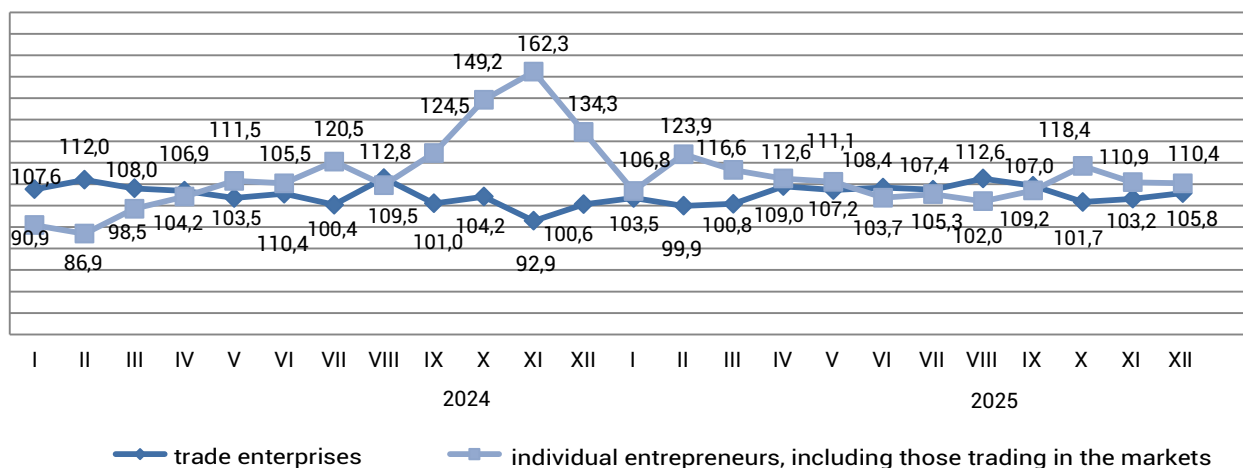
The volume of retail trade in January-December 2025 amounted to 26392 billion tenge, which is 7,5% more than the corresponding period in 2024. Retail sales of goods by trading enterprises increased by 5,9%, individual entrepreneurs, including those trading in the markets, increased by 10,3% compared to January- December 2024.

As of January 1, 2026, the volume of commodity stocks of trading enterprises (for reporting enterprises) in retail trade amounted to 1616,7 billion tenge, in trading days - 52 days.

The share of food products in the total volume of retail trade is 33,1%, non-food products – 66,9%. The volume of sales of food products compared to January- December 2024 increased by 7,8%, non-food products increased by 7,3%.

The volume of wholesale trade in January-December 2025 amounted to 53503,9 billion tenge, which is 9,5% more than the corresponding period in 2024. Non-food products and industrial and technical products (82,1%) prevail in the structure of wholesale trade.

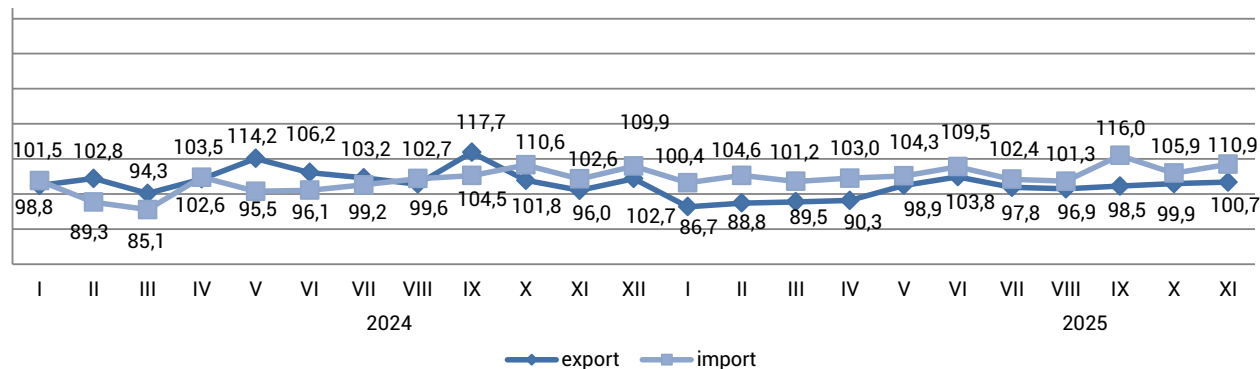

Foreign trade turnover in January-November 2025 amounted to 128,8 billion US dollars (decreased by 0,1% in nominal terms compared to January-November 2024) including exports – 71,1 billion US dollars (4,2% less) and imports – 57,7 billion US dollars (increased by 5,5% than corresponding period last year).

Exports with the EAEU countries amounted to 8878,8 million US dollars or 11% less than in January-November 2024, imports – 18387,3 million US dollars increased by 2,4% compared to the corresponding period last year.

Gross output of products (services) of agriculture, forestry and fisheries in January-December 2025 amounted to 9818,3 billion tenge, including crop production – 5921,7 billion tenge, livestock – 3832,2 billion tenge, hunting – 1,7 billion tenge, forestry – 23,1 billion tenge, fisheries and aquaculture – 27,8 billion tenge, services in agriculture – 11,8 billion tenge.

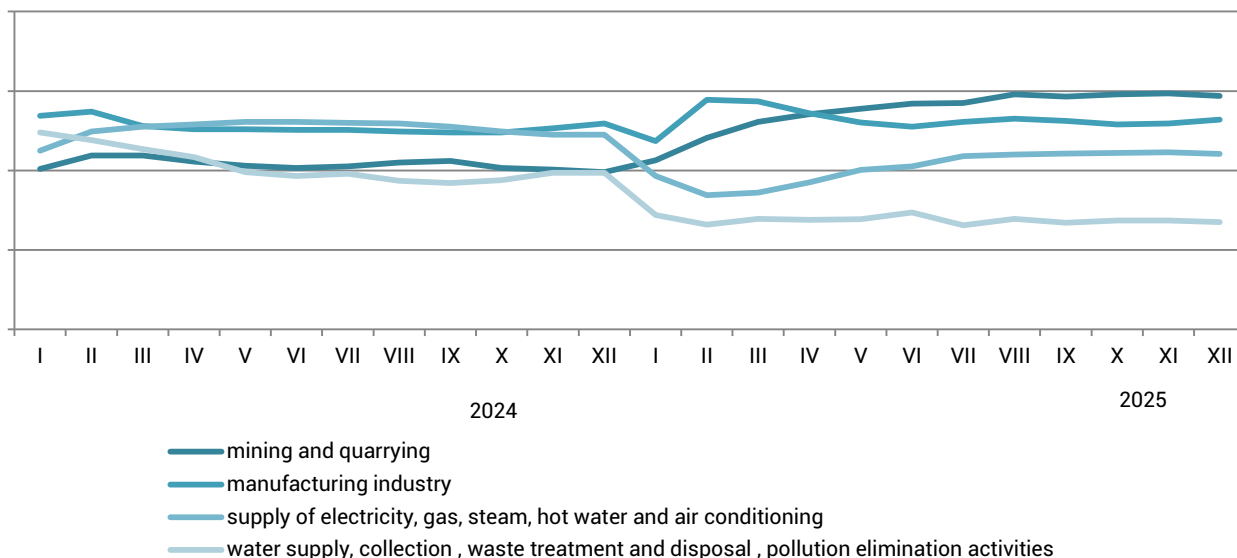

### 3.9 Statistics of building and housing construction

In January-December 2025, the volume of construction work increased by 15,9% and amounted to 10704,8 billion tenge.

The largest amount of work in January-December 2025 was performed on the construction of facilities (5708,4 billion tenge), non-residential buildings (3318 billion tenge) and residential buildings (1678,3 billion tenge).

The volume of construction and installation work in January-December 2025 compared to 2024 increased by 13,6% and amounted to 8691,6 billion tenge. The volume of construction work on major repairs increased by 19,9% and on current repairs by 34,7%.

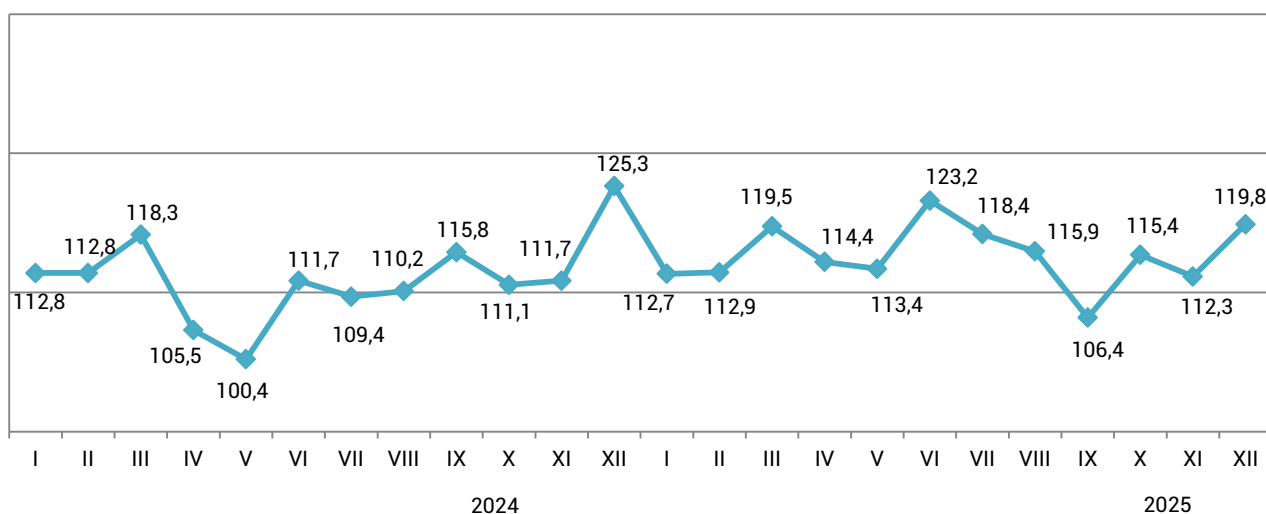
In January-December 2025, the construction of 42959 new buildings was completed, of which 37219 are residential and 5740 are non-residential.

as a percentages of the corresponding month of the previous year



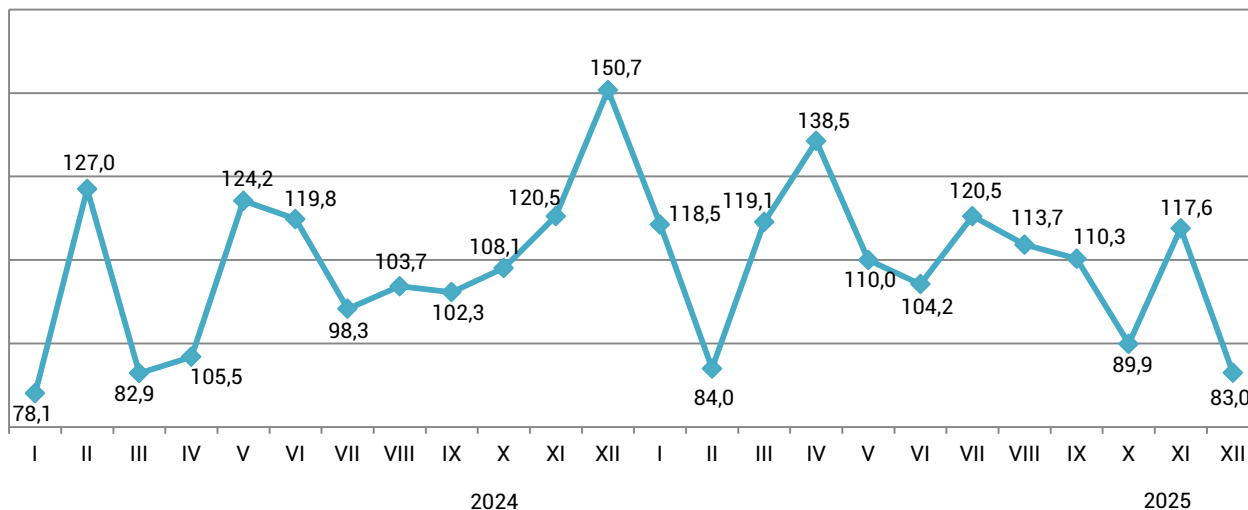

In January-December 2025, 3794,5 billion tenge was allocated for housing construction. In the total volume of investments in fixed capital, the share of disbursed funds in housing construction amounted to 16,7%.

The main source of financing for housing construction in January-December 2025 is the own funds of developers, the share of which is 91,7%.

as a percentages of the corresponding month of the previous year

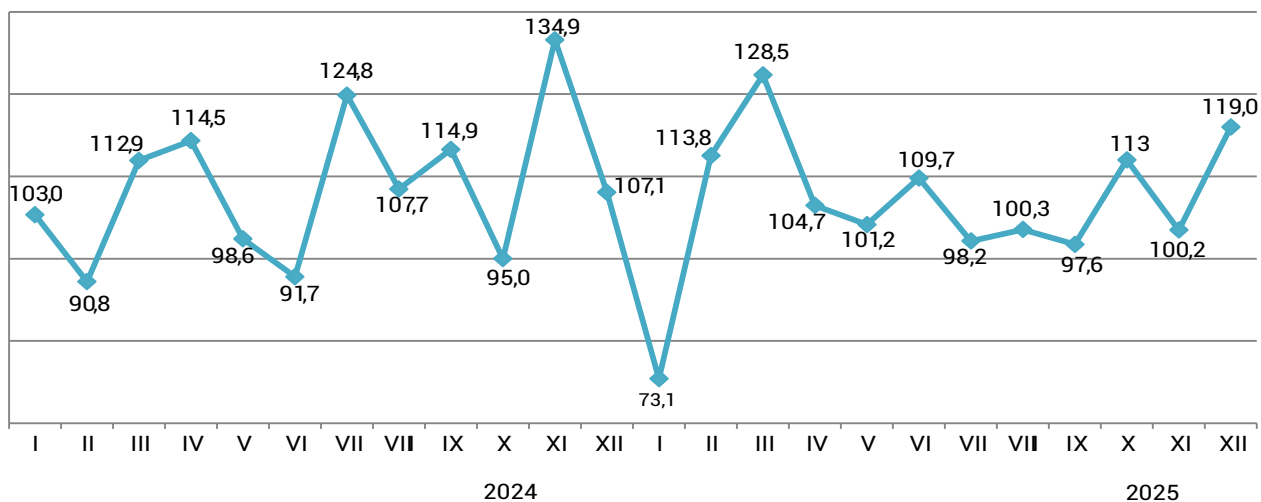


In January-December 2025, the total area of housing put into operation to 2024 increased by 5,1% and amounted to 20099,1 thousand square meters, of which in multi-apartment buildings – by 10% (13523,7 thousand square meters). At the same time, the total area of commissioned individual residential buildings decreased by 3,4% (6416,2 thousand square meters).

In the total volume of commissioned housing, the share of multi-apartment buildings was 67,3%, individual – 31,9%. The average actual cost of construction of 1 square meter of total housing area increased by 8,6%.

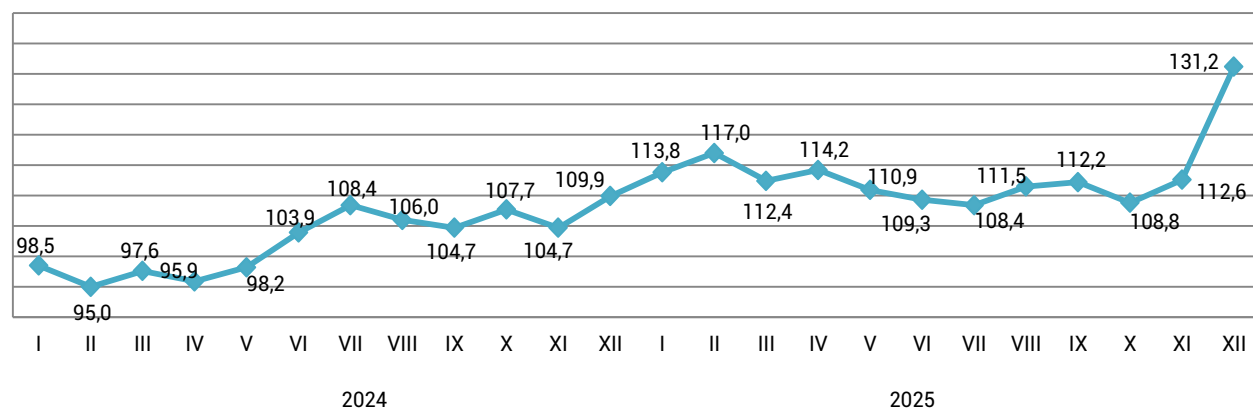

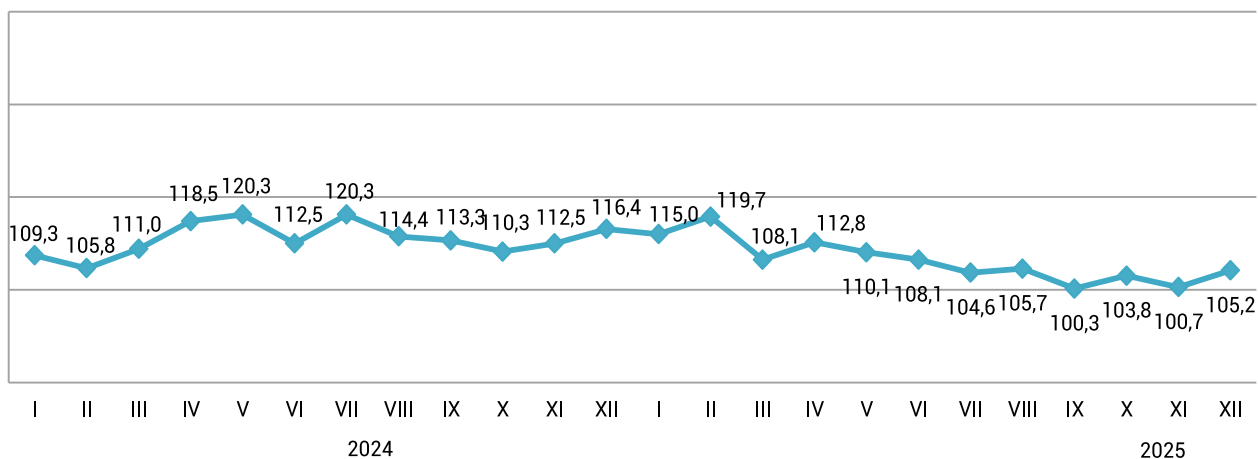

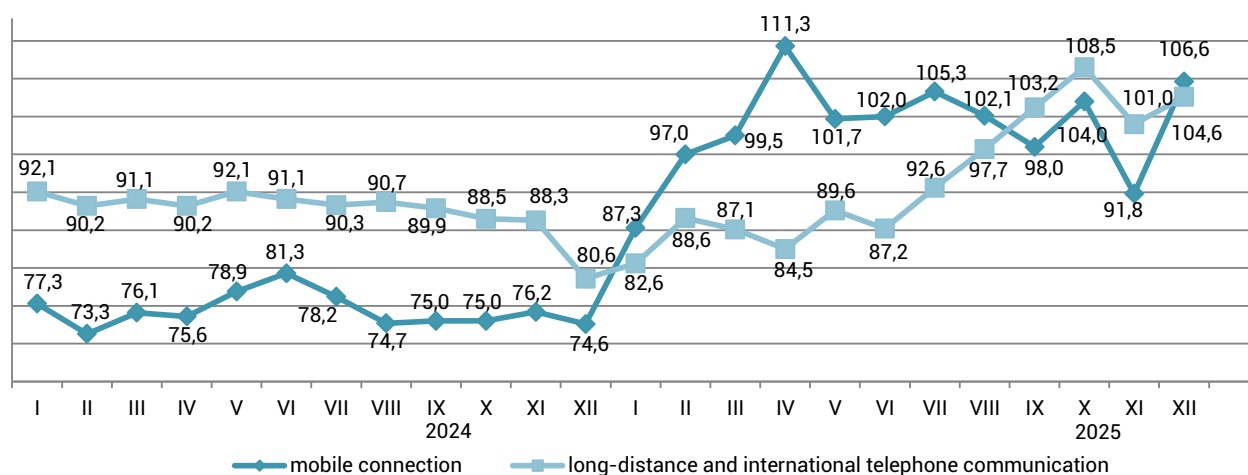

### 3.11 Statistics of communications

### 3.12 Statistics of enterprises

In December, compared to November 2025, there is a slight decrease in the number of registered legal entities (by 0,4%), compared to the corresponding period of the previous year, their number increased by 2,5%. At the same time, there is an decrease in the number of operating legal entities - by 0,4%, compared to the corresponding period of the previous year, their number increased by 2,5%. Since the beginning of the year, by type of economic activity, the largest number of registered legal entities remains in the industry «Wholesale and retail trade; car and motorcycle repair», the share of which as of January 1, 2026. amounted to 26,7%. On the second place – «Construction» (13,4%), on the third – «Provision of other types of services» (9,9%). Together, the share of these three types of activities is 50% of all registered legal entities.
