2. Social indicators

2.1 Population size and migration

The population of the country as of February 1, 2026 amounted to 20518 thousand people, including 13106,4 thousand (63,9%) urban residents and 7411,6 thousand (36,1%) rural residents.

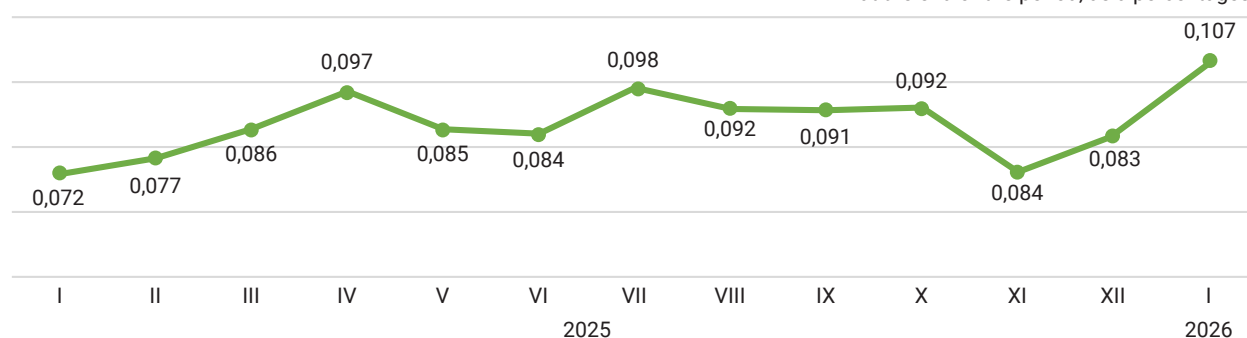
In January 2026, compared to January 2025, the number of arrivals to Kazakhstan increased in 9,3% times, while the number of departures from the country increased in 3,3% times.

The main migration exchange of the country occurs with the CIS member states, with the share of arrivals from and departures to these countries amounting to 8,4% and 15,2%, respectively.

The number of internal migrants increased by 7,3%. A positive net migration balance due to interregional movements was recorded in three regions of the country: the cities of Astana (8210 people), Almaty (2343 people), Shymkent (2276 people) and Almaty region (1209 people).

2.2 Employment of the population

The number of unemployed, determined according to the methodology of the ILO, in the IV quarter of 2025¹⁾ amounted to 445,7 thousand people, the unemployment rate was 4,6%.

The employed population²⁾ amounted to 9278,9 thousand people, including employees – 7142,1 thousand people, individual entrepreneurs – 1746,2 thousand people, persons engaged in private practice – 26,2 thousand people, individuals, who are founders (participants) of business partnerships and founders, shareholders (participants) of joint-stock companies, as well as members of production cooperatives – 14,1 thousand people, independent workers – 350,3 thousand people.

3. Economic indicators

3.1 Statistics of prices

In February 2026, the monthly consumer price index was 101,1%. Prices for food products increased by 1,3%, for paid services – by 1%, for non–food products – by 0,9%.

Among food products, prices increased for tomatoes by 12,2%, carrots by 6,2%, potatoes by 3,8%, brined cheeses by 3,4%, chocolate by 3,3%, cabbage and grapes by 3,0% each, fish by 2,5%, sour cream by 2,2%, apples by 1,8%, sunflower oil by 1,3%, and butter by 1,2%. Tobacco products rose by 4,3%, while alcoholic beverages increased by 3,8%.

In the services sector, holiday travel increased by 9,2%, regulated utility services by 3,7%, air transport services by 3,4%, cinema and hotel services by 2,2% each, healthcare services by 1,4%, taxi services by 1,0%, and catering services by 0,6%.

Among non-food products, prices increased for televisions by 7,3%, vacuum cleaners by 5,6%, cooktops by 3,1%, personal hygiene products by 1,8%, detergents and cleaning products by 1,2%, modems and routers by 1,0%, and medicines by 0,7%. Prices for AI-95 gasoline increased by 1,4%, while automotive gas rose by 0,4%.

In February 2026, compared to the previous month, the producer price index for agricultural products was 100,3%, for crop products – 100%, for livestock products – 101%.

Price increased were for cucumbers in protected ground – by 15,2%, indoor tomatoes – by 5,7%, carrots – by 3,5%, corn (maize) – 3,4%, potato – by 2,5%, safflower seeds – by 2,4%, beetroot – by 2,3%, oats and buckwheat by 1,1%.

Price reduction were recorded at flowers and flower buds, cut – by 15,1%, millet – by 2,8%, lentils, dried – by 2%, curly flax seeds – by 0,9%, rice, unhulled – by 0,8%, bulb onions – by 0,6% and rapeseed seeds by 0,5%.

Among livestock products, prices increased for poultry by 2,7%, sheep – by 1,2%, raw cow's milk – by 1%, horses – by 0,8%, cattle – by 0,3%, raw camel milk by 0,3%, and for pigs by – 1,3%, eggs decreased by 0,7%.

Prices of manufacturing enterprises for industrial products in February 2026 increased by 2,1% compared to the previous month. Prices metal ores increased by 2,3%, oil – by 0,3%, natural gas lower by 1,3%, coal – by 0,3%. Of petroleum products, diesel fuel increased by 0,7%, fuel oil lower by 3,8%, gasoline – by 1,7%.

An increase in prices was noted for precious metals by 8,8%, aluminum – by 5,7%, copper – by 3,8%, zinc – by 0,9%, rolled ferrous metals lower by 0,7%, lead and ferroalloys – by 0,2%.

From food products, sugar increased in price by 6,9%, pasta – by 2,5%, livestock meat – by 1,7%, bread – by 1,5%, tea – by 0,3%, dairy products – by 0,2%, rice lower in price by 2%, vegetable oil – by 0,5%.

In the service sector, tariffs for the transportation of goods by all modes of transport in February 2026 decreased by 1,3% compared to the previous month, while tariffs for communication services and tariffs for postal and courier services remained unchanged.

In February 2026, compared to the previous month, the price index in construction was 98,2%. Prices for other works and costs decreased by 3%, construction and installation works - by 1,9%, while for machinery and equipment remained unchanged.

The short-term economic indicator for January-February 2026 compared to January-February 2025 amounted to 100,2%. The calculation of the short-term economic indicator is carried out to ensure efficiency and is based on changes in output indices for basic sectors: agriculture, industry, construction, trade, transport and communications, accounting for over 60% of GDP.

3.3 Gross Domestic Product

In the structure of GDP for January-December 2025 (flash estimates) the production of goods amounted to 36,1%, the production of services – 57,7%. The main share in the production of GDP is occupied by industry – 26,3%, wholesale and retail trade; repair of cars and motorcycles – 19,2%.

3.4 Investment statistics

In January-February 2026, the volume of investments in fixed capital amounted to 1984,7 billion tenge, which is 0,2% more than in January-February 2025.

The predominant sources of investment financing remain the own funds of economic entities, the volume of which in January-February 2026 amounted to 1 393,1 billion tenge.

In January-February 2026, compared with January-February 2025, there is an increase costs for the purchase of machinery, equipment and vehicles and their capital repairs by 48%.

A significant share of investments in fixed capital in January-February 2026 accounted for industry (44,2%) (including mining and quarrying – 17,5%, manufacturing industry – 14,3%), operations with real estate (20,8%), transport and warehousing (13,4%) and agriculture, forestry and fisheries 3,5%.

The volume of investments of large enterprises in January-February 2026 amounted to 693,7 billion tenge.

3.5 Statistics of domestic trade

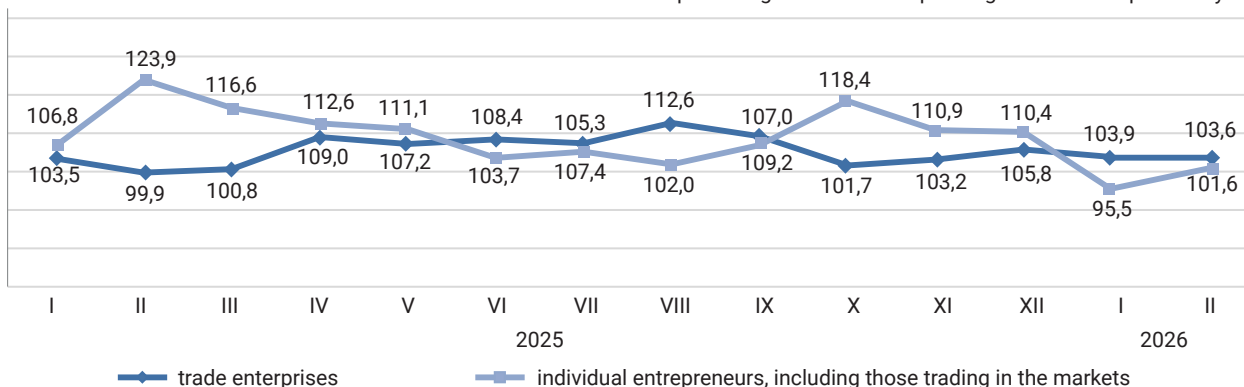
The volume of retail trade in January-February 2026 amounted to 3164,1 billion tenge, which is 2,6% more than the corresponding period in 2025. Retail sales of goods by trading enterprises increased by 3,7%, individual entrepreneurs, including those trading in the markets, decreased by 1% compared to January-February 2025.

As of March 1, 2026, the volume of commodity stocks of trading enterprises (for reporting enterprises) in retail trade amounted to 1727,6 billion tenge, in trading days - 77 days.

The share of food products in the total volume of retail trade is 29,6%, non-food products – 70,4%. The volume of sales of food products compared to January-February 2025 increased by 9,1%, non-food products increased by 0,2%.

The volume of wholesale trade in January- February 2026 amounted to 6540,4 billion tenge, which is 3,8% more than the corresponding period in 2025. Non-food products and industrial and technical products (78,1%) prevail in the structure of wholesale trade.

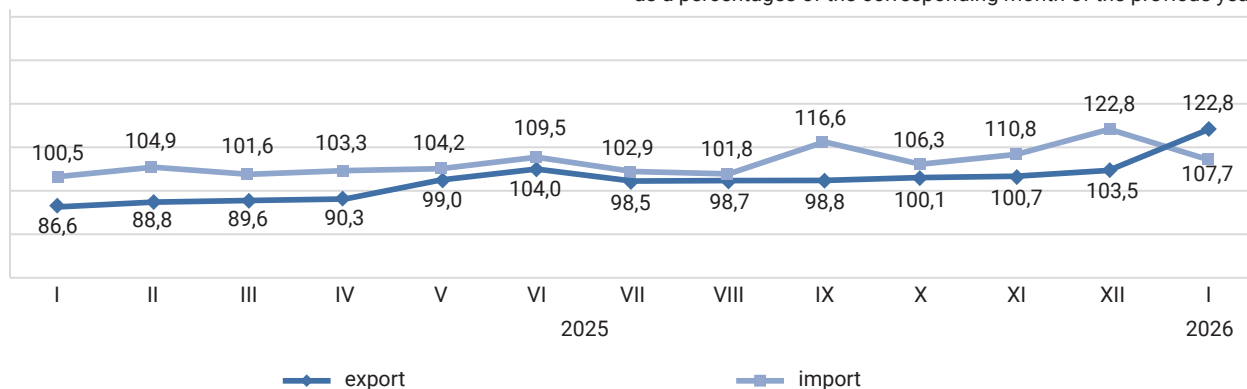

Foreign trade turnover in January 2026 amounted to 11 billion US dollars (increased by 15,9% in nominal terms compared to January 2025) including exports – 6,3 billion US dollars (22,8% more) and imports – 4,7 billion US dollars (increased by 7,7% than corresponding period last year).

Exports with the EAEU countries amounted to 681,6 million US dollars or 3,5% more than in January 2025, imports – 1476 million US dollars increased by 21,8% compared to the corresponding period last year.

Gross output of products (services) of agriculture, forestry and fisheries in January-February 2026 amounted to 535275,0 million tenge, including crop production – 35736,9 million tenge, livestock – 490745,8 million tenge, hunting – 283,3 million tenge, forestry – 3853,1 million tenge, fisheries and aquaculture – 4633,7 million tenge, services in agriculture – 22,2 million tenge.

Out of the total output volume, agricultural formations account for 279570,2 million tenge or 52,2 percent of the total volume, including 29725,0 million tenge (83,2 percent) in crop production and 241052,9 million tenge (49,1 percent) in livestock breeding.

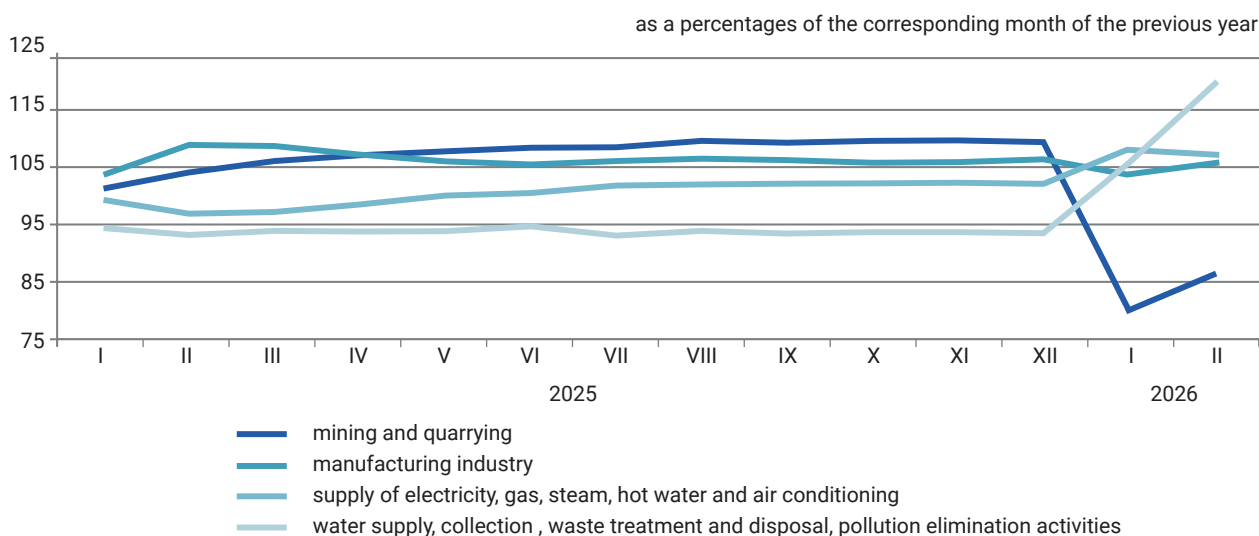

3.9 Statistics of building and housing construction

In January-February 2026, the volume of construction work increased by 14,5% and amounted to 495,6 billion tenge.

The largest amount of work in January-February 2026 was performed on the construction of facilities (297 billion tenge), non-residential buildings (128 billion tenge) and residential buildings (70,6 billion tenge).

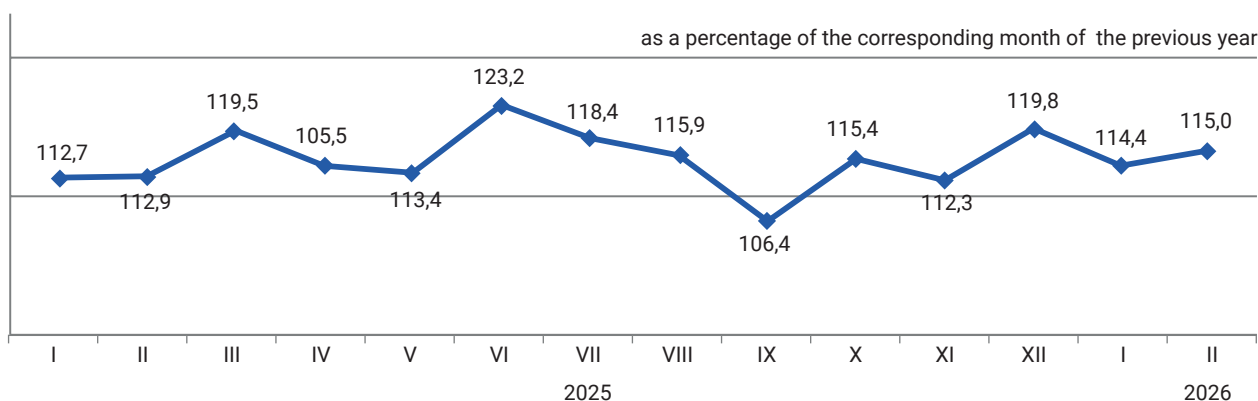
The volume of construction and installation work in January-February 2026 compared to January-February 2025 increased by 12,6% and amounted to 431,1 billion tenge. The volume of construction work on major repairs decreased by 16,8% and on current repairs increased by 2,3 once.

In January-February 2026, the construction of 4550 new buildings was completed, of which 4163 are residential and 387 are non-residential.

The following social and cultural facilities were put into operation:

- secondary school – 15;
- preschool organizations – 7;
- ambulatory polyclinic organizations – 1.

Indices of physical volume of construction



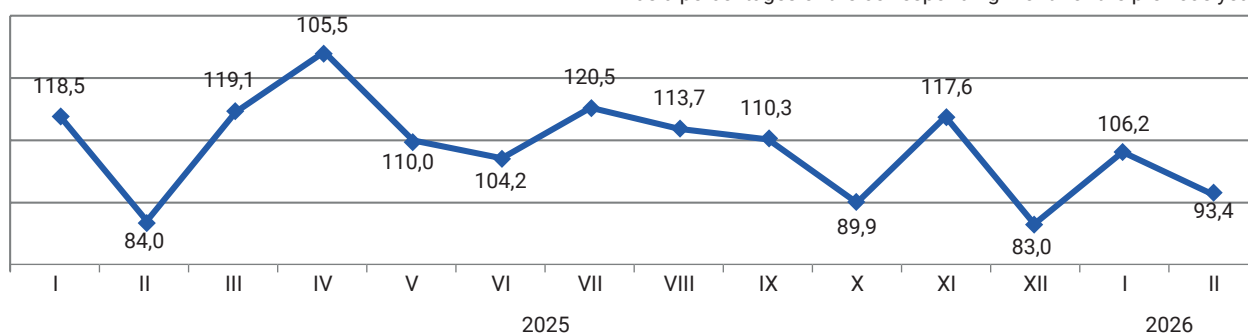

In January-February 2026, 379,1 billion tenge was allocated for housing construction. In the total volume of investments in fixed capital, the share of disbursed funds in housing construction amounted to 19,1%.

The main source of financing for housing construction in January-February 2026 is the own funds of developers, the share of which is 97%.

as a percentages of the corresponding month of the previous year

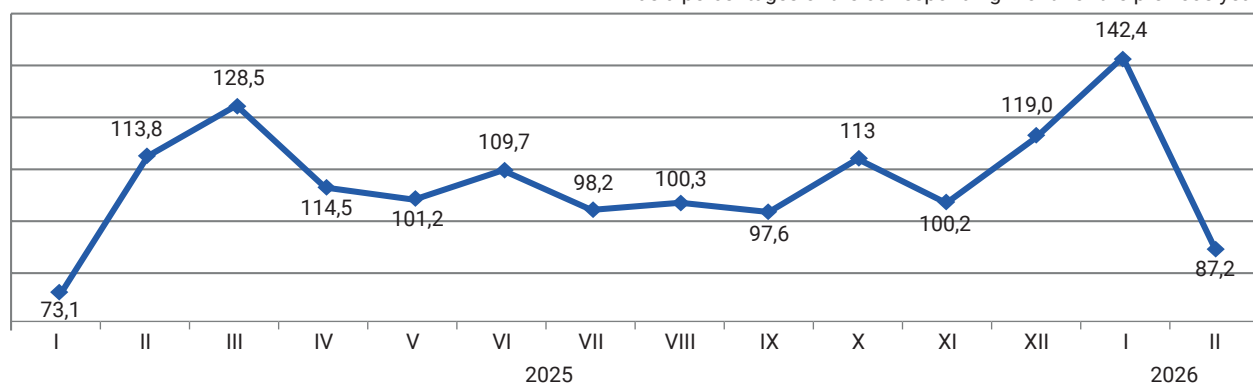


In January-February 2026, the total area of housing put into operation to January-February 2025 increased by 9,1% and amounted to 2108,6 thousand square meters, of which in multi-apartment buildings – by 12,2% (1363,8 thousand square meters), individual residential buildings - by 3,5% (738 thousand square meters).

In the total volume of commissioned housing, the share of multi-apartment buildings was 64,7%, individual – 35%. The average actual cost of construction of 1 square meter of total housing area amounted to 224,2 thousand tenge.

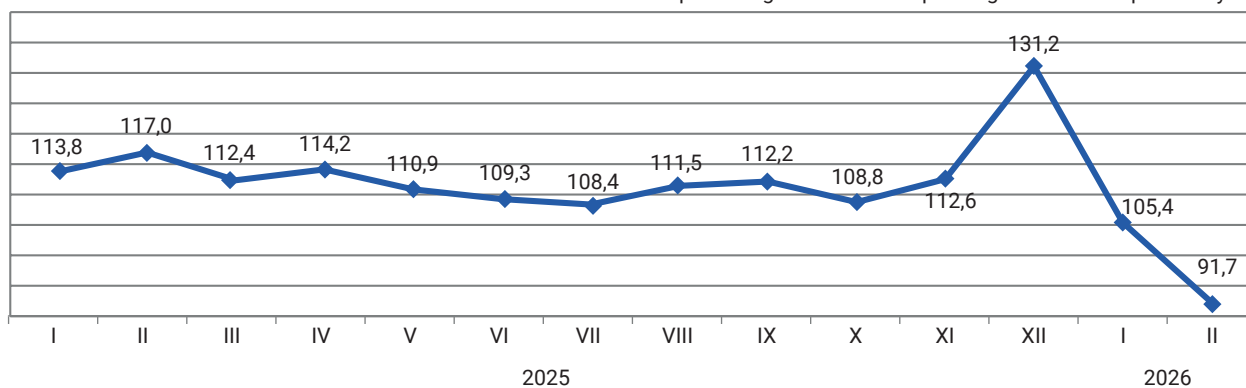

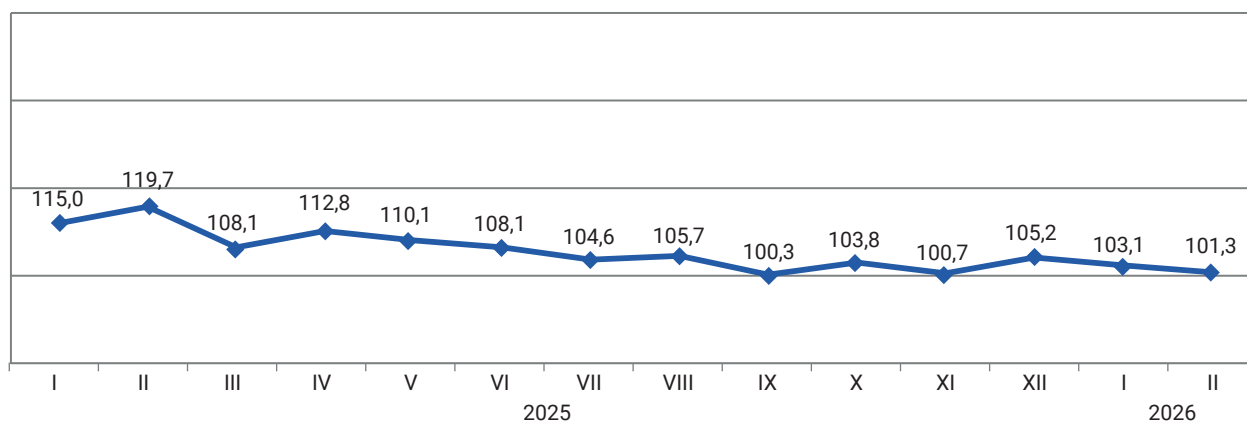

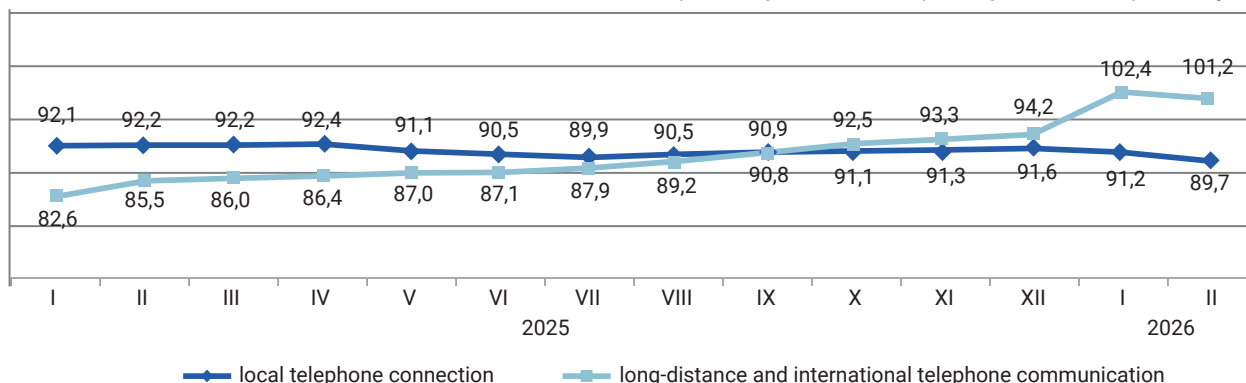

3.11 Statistics of communications

Indices of the physical volume for communication services in January-February 2026 compared to January-February 2025 amounted to 103,8%, of which 239,5% for mobile services*, 108,6% for other telecommunications services and 68,6% for Internet services.

3.12 Statistics of enterprises

In February, compared to January 2026, there is a slight increase in the number of registered legal entities (by 0,1%), compared to the corresponding period of the previous year, their number increased by 2,5%. At the same time, there is an increase in the number of operating legal entities - by 0,3%, compared to the corresponding period of the previous year, their number increased by 3,9%. Since the beginning of the year, by type of economic activity, the largest number of registered legal entities remains in the industry «Wholesale and retail trade; car and motorcycle repair», the share of which as of March 1, 2026. amounted to 26,7%. On the second place – «Construction» (13,4%), on the third – «Provision of other types of services» (9,9%). Together, the share of these three types of activities is 49,9% of all registered legal entities.
