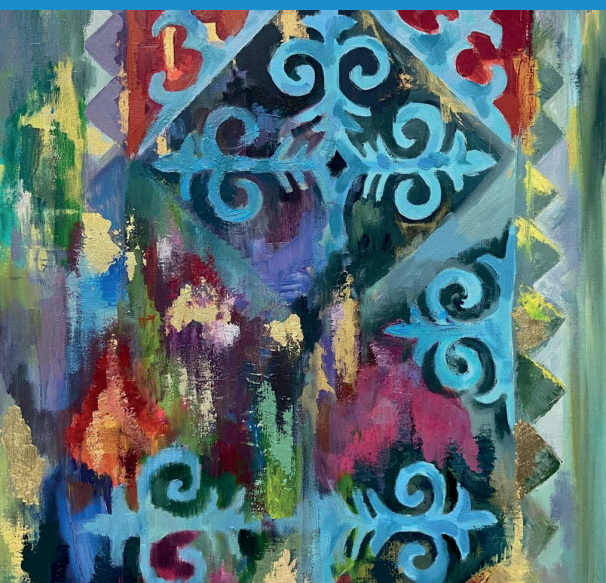

2. Social indicators

2.1 Population size and migration

The population of the country as of July 1, 2026 amounted to 20590,6 thousand people, including 13190,6 thousand (64,1%) urban residents and 7400,0 thousand (35,9%) rural residents.

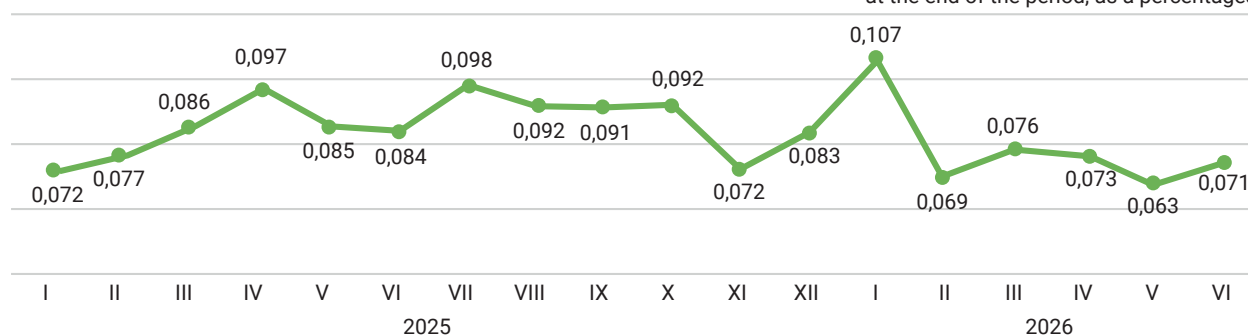
In January-June 2026, compared to January-June 2025, the number of arrivals to Kazakhstan decreased in 28,9%, while the number of departures from the country decreased in 34,3%.

The main migration exchange of the country occurs with the CIS member states, with the share of arrivals from and departures to these countries amounting to 69,6% and 64,3%, respectively.

The number of internal migrants increased by 6,6%. A positive net migration balance due to interregional movements was recorded in three regions of the country: the cities of Astana (32665 people), Almaty (15490 people), Shymkent (6477 people) and Almaty region (6312 people).

The average per capita nominal cash income of the population in I quarter 2026 amounted to 252619 tenge (preliminary data), which is 11,8% higher than in I quarter 2025, real cash income for the specified period increased by 0,1%.

2.3 Employment of the population

The number of unemployed, determined according to the methodology of the ILO, in the II quarter of 2026¹⁾ amounted to 444,6 thousand people, the unemployment rate was 4,5%.

The employed population²⁾ amounted to 9399,9 thousand people, including employees – 7253.3 thousand people, individual entrepreneurs – 1753,4 thousand people, persons engaged in private practice – 13,5 thousand people, individuals, who are founders (participants) of business partnerships and founders, shareholders (participants) of joint-stock companies, as well as members of production cooperatives – 6,7 thousand people, independent workers – 372,1 thousand people.

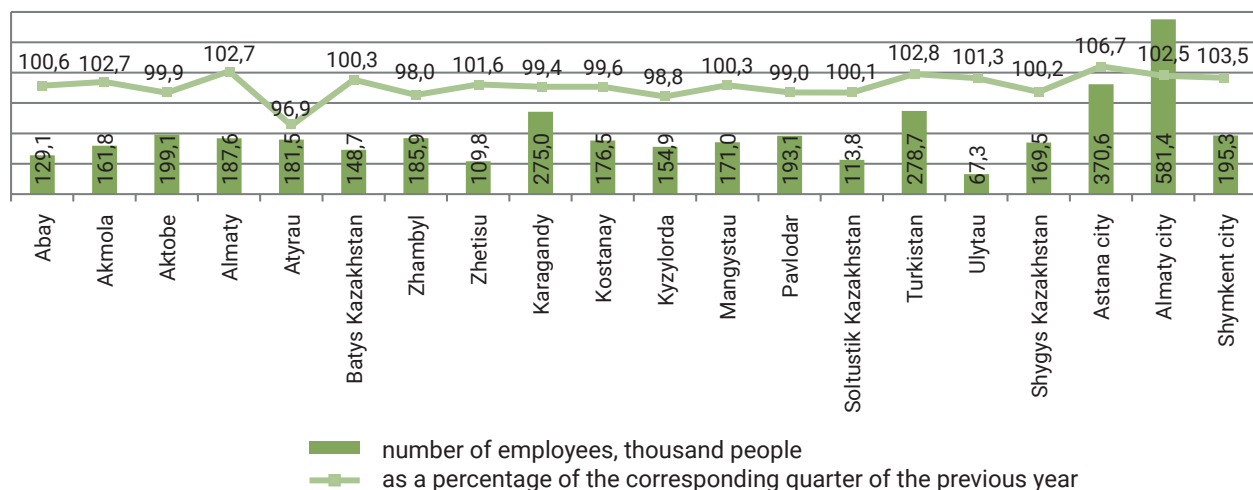

The number of employees at enterprises (organizations) in the I quarter of 2026³⁾ amounted to 4050,3 thousand people, of which at large and medium-sized enterprises – 2915,9 thousand people.

In the I quarter of 2026 266,1 thousand people were hired by enterprises. 258,3 thousand people dropped out for various reasons. Worked by one employee 443,7 hours.

At the end of the I quarter of 2026, 59,3 thousand vacancies were not filled at enterprises (1,6% of the number of employees).

In the I quarter of 2026, the average monthly nominal salary amounted to 461486 tenge (excluding employees of small enterprises engaged in entrepreneurial activities). In the I quarter of 2026, the median salary was estimated to be 339912 tenge.

From January 1, 2026, the minimum wage is set at 85000 tenge.

3. Economic indicators

3.1 Statistics of prices

In July 2026, the monthly consumer price index stood at – 100,6%, Prices for non-food goods and paid services rose by – 0,7% each, foods prices increased by 0,4%.

Among non-food products, prices increased for books by 16,9%, children's bicycles by 10,2%, cutlery by 3,9%, freezers by 3,0%, medicines, televisions and shower gel by 1,8% each, construction materials by 1,0%, shampoo by 0,7%, and clothing and footwear by 0,6%, The price of AI-92 gasoline increased by 1,7%, diesel fuel by 1,1%, liquefied gas in cylinders by 0,9%, and AI-98 gasoline by 0,7%.

Prices for domestic air passenger transport services increased by 3,8%, sanatorium and resort services by 2,1%, rent for well-equipped housing and housing maintenance and repair services by 1,7%, intercity bus fares and holidays in Turkey by 1,4% each, hairdressing and beauty salon services by 1,0%, and dental services by 0,7%, Among utility services, electricity tariffs increased by 2,2% and waste collection charges by 1,6%.

Cabbage became more expensive by 11,4%, onions by 5,3%, granulated sugar by 4,2%, mutton and pasta by 2,3% each, still beverages by 1,8%, butter by 1,7%, horse meat by 1,4%, fruit and vegetable juices and fresh and chilled fish by 1,2% each, energy drinks by 1,0%, cottage cheese and sunflower oil by 0,9% each, minced meat by 0,8%, and chicken, kefir and black tea by 0,6% each.

Prices decreased for cucumbers by 22,6%, tomatoes by 17,7%, eggplants by 16,1%, carrots by 5,3%, bananas by 4,0%, lemons by 2,6%, and eggs by 1,4%.

In July 2026, compared to the previous month, the producer price index for agricultural products was 100%, for crop products – 100,4%, for livestock products – 99,1%.

Price increased were for raspberries by 4%, melons – by 2,7%, eggplant – by 2,6%, open ground tomatoes – by 2%, open ground cucumbers – by 1,9%, buckwheat – by 1,8%, peppers and carrots – by 1,1% each, wheat – by 0,6%, sunflower seeds and feed grain crops – by 0,5% each.

Price reduction were recorded at indoor tomatoes by 25,7%, cucumbers in protected ground – by 22,4%, apricots – by 4,2%, lentils, dried – by 1,1%, potato – by 0,9%, beetroot – by 0,5% and curly flax seeds – by 0,4%.

Among livestock products, prices increased for wool shorn from sheep and goats, unwashed (including washed with fleece) by 43,7%, pigs – by 1,6%, poultry – by 0,3%, sheep – by 0,2%, while prices for eggs decreased – by 6,9%, raw camel milk – by 0,7% and raw cow's milk – by 0,4%.

Prices of manufacturing enterprises for industrial products in July 2026 were lower by 4,9% compared to the previous month. Oil was lower by 13,4%, metal ores – by 1,6%, natural gaz increase by 5,2%, coal – by 0,2%. Of petroleum products, propane and butane liquefied rose in price by 1,9%, mazut – by 0,7%, gasoline – by 0,2%.

A decrease in prices was noted for aluminum by 9,2%, precious metals – by 7,1%, lead – by 4,9%, rolled ferrous metals – by 2,3%, copper – by 0,4%, ferroalloys – by 0,3%, zinc – by 0,2%.

From food products, flour fell in price by 1,6%, fish – by 0,8%, meat – by 0,7%, vegetable oil rose in price by 2,7%, chicken meat – by 1,8%, pasta – by 0,8%, bread – by 0,2%.

In the service sector, tariffs for the transportation of goods by all modes of transport in July 2026 decreased by 1,7% compared to the previous month, while tariffs for communication services and tariffs for postal and courier services remained unchanged.

In July 2026, compared to the previous month, the price index in construction was 99,5%. Prices for construction and installation works decreased by 0,5%, other works and costs – by 0,6%, machinery and equipment increased by 0,1%.

3.3 Gross Domestic Product

In the structure of GDP for January-June 2026 (flash estimates) the production of goods amounted to 36,4%, the production of services – 55,4%. The main share in the production of GDP is occupied by industry – 28,6%, wholesale and retail trade; repair of cars and motorcycles – 16,5%.

According to reporting data, in the sectoral structure of income formation for January-March 2026, compensation of employees in the production of goods and services amounted to 24,5% and 33,4%, respectively, the share of other taxes on production is 2,7% in the production of goods and 1,8% in the production of services, respectively, the share of gross operating surplus /gross mixed income was 72,8 % and 64,8%.

3.4 Investment statistics

In January-July 2026, the volume of investments in fixed capital amounted to 11464,2 billion tenge, which is 7,7% more than in January-July 2025.

The predominant sources of investment financing remain the own funds of economic entities, the volume of which in January-July 2026 amounted to 7767,1 billion tenge.

In January-July 2026, compared with January-July 2025, there is an increase costs for the purchase of machinery, equipment and vehicles and their capital repairs by 29,8%.

A significant share of investments in fixed capital in January-July 2026 accounted for industry (41,6%) (including mining and quarrying – 14%, manufacturing industry – 14,7%), operations with real estate (18,6%), transport and warehousing (17%) and agriculture, forestry and fisheries (5,7%).

The volume of investments of large enterprises in January-July 2026 amounted to 3491,6 billion tenge.

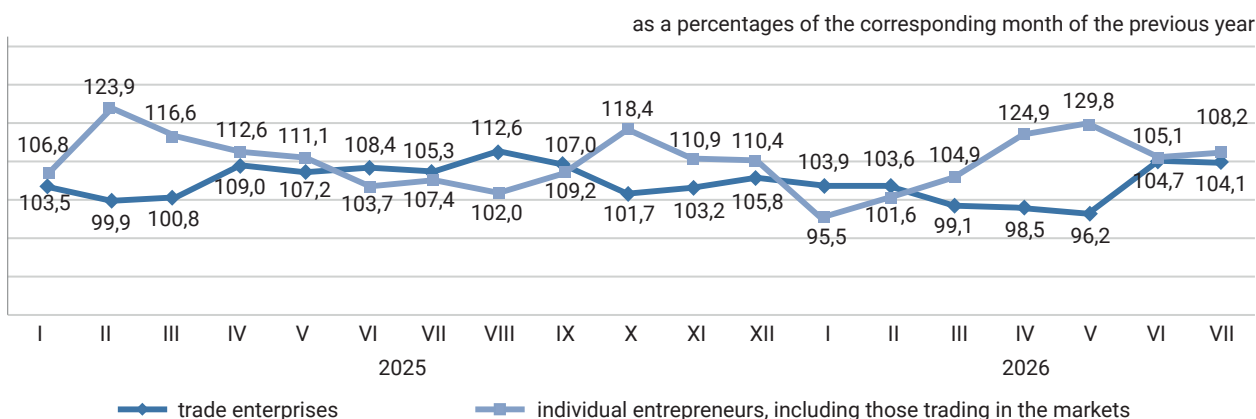
3.5 Statistics of domestic trade

The volume of retail trade in January-July 2026 amounted to 14163,2 billion tenge, which is 4,1% more than the corresponding period in 2025. Retail sales of goods by trading enterprises increased by 1,4%, individual entrepreneurs, including those trading in the markets, increased by 10,7% compared to January-July 2025.

As of August 1, 2026, the volume of commodity stocks of trading enterprises (for reporting enterprises) in retail trade amounted to 1657,1 billion tenge, in trading days - 60 days.

The share of food products in the total volume of retail trade is 33,1%, non-food products – 66,9%. The volume of sales of food products compared to January-July 2025 increased by 10%, non-food products increased by 1,4%.

The volume of wholesale trade in January-July 2026 amounted to 29147,3 billion tenge, which is 6,7% more than the corresponding period in 2025. Non-food products and industrial and technical products (79,8%) prevail in the structure of wholesale trade.

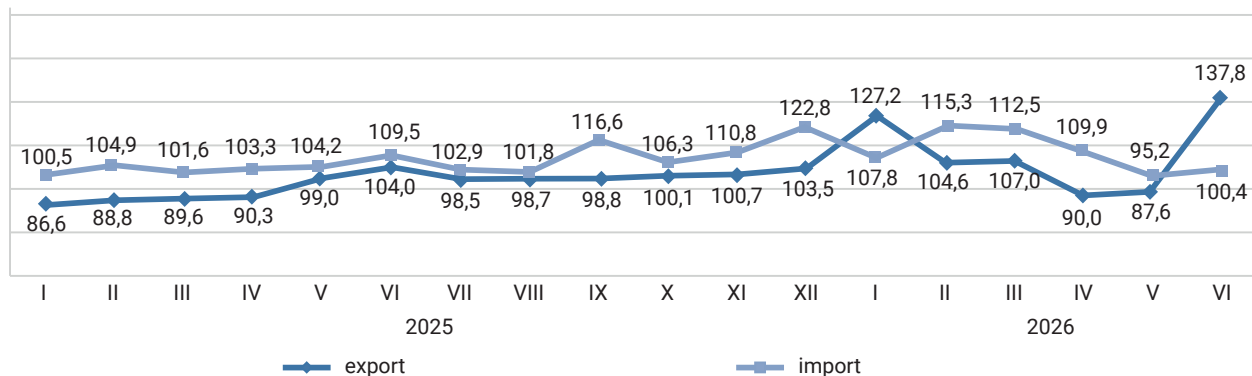

Foreign trade turnover in January-June 2026 amounted to 71,8 billion US dollars (increased by 7,2% in nominal terms compared to January-June 2025) including exports – 40,3 billion US dollars (8,6% more) and imports – 31,5 billion US dollars (increased by 5,4% than corresponding period last year).

Exports with the EAEU countries amounted to 4 559,9 million US dollars or 3,5% less than in January-June 2025, imports – 10610,0 million US dollars increased by 15% compared to the corresponding period last year.

3.7 Statistics of agriculture, forestry, hunting and fisheries

Gross output of products (services) of agriculture, forestry and fisheries in January-July 2026 amounted to 2959,4 billion tenge, including crop production – 496,2 billion tenge, livestock – 2421,9 billion tenge, hunting – 1,2 billion tenge, forestry – 16 billion tenge, fisheries and aquaculture – 21,7 billion tenge, services in agriculture – 2,5 billion tenge.

Out of the total output volume, agricultural formations account for 1545,5 billion tenge or 52,2 percent of the total volume, including 375,2 billion tenge (75,6 percent) in crop production and 1129,1 billion tenge (46,6 percent) in livestock breeding.

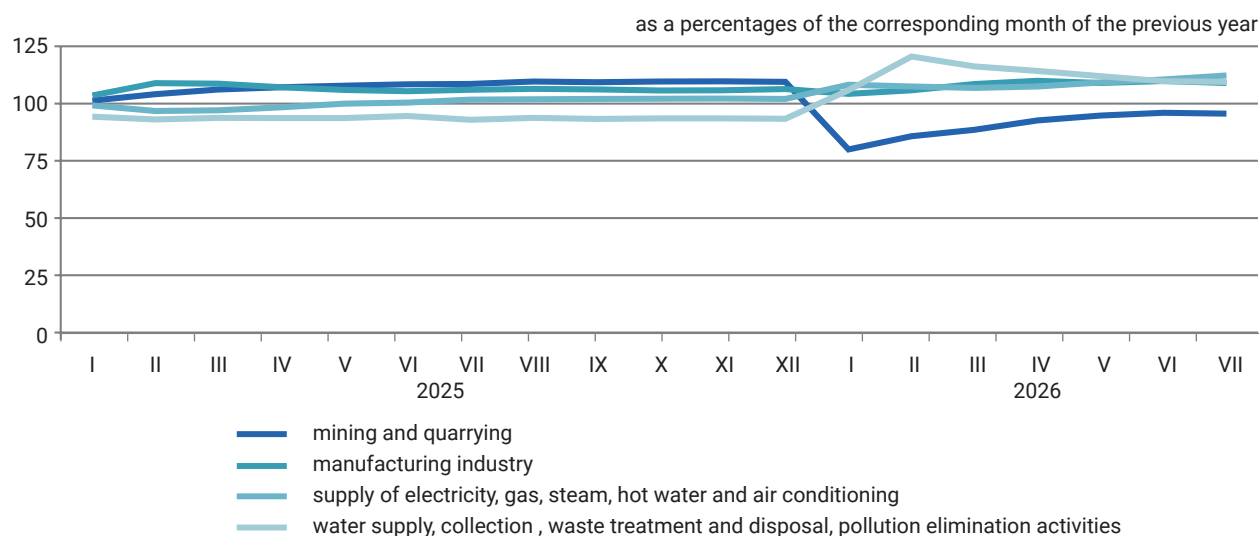

3.9 Statistics of building and housing construction

In January-July 2026, the volume of construction work increased by 15,3% and amounted to 5061,1 billion tenge.

The largest amount of work in January-July 2026 was performed on the construction of facilities (2733,6 billion tenge), non-residential buildings (1502,5 billion tenge) and residential buildings (825 billion tenge).

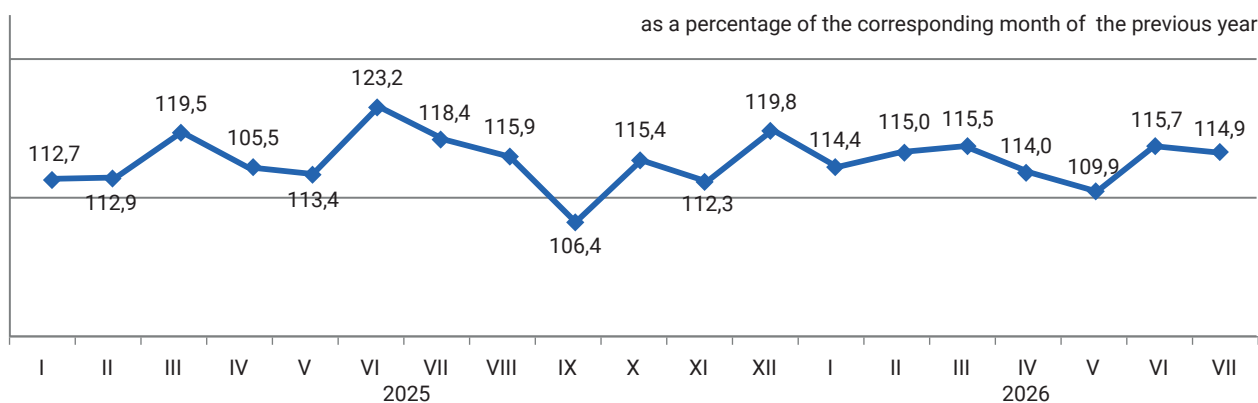

Indices of physical volume of construction



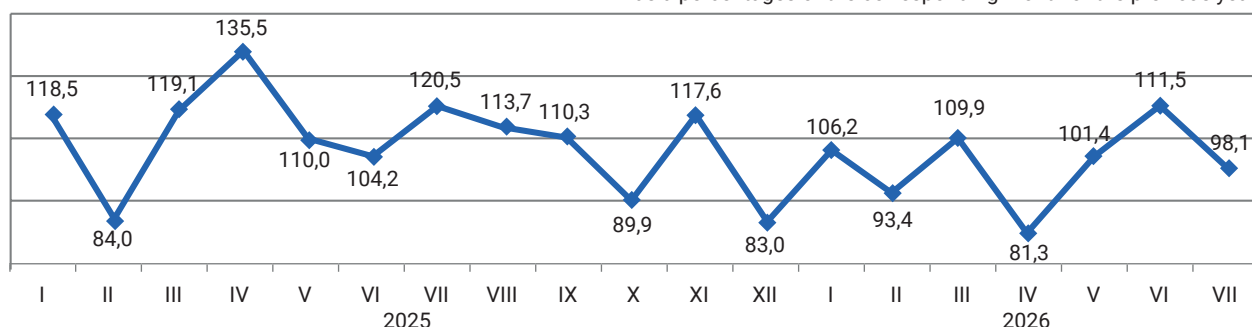

as a percentages of the corresponding month of the previous year

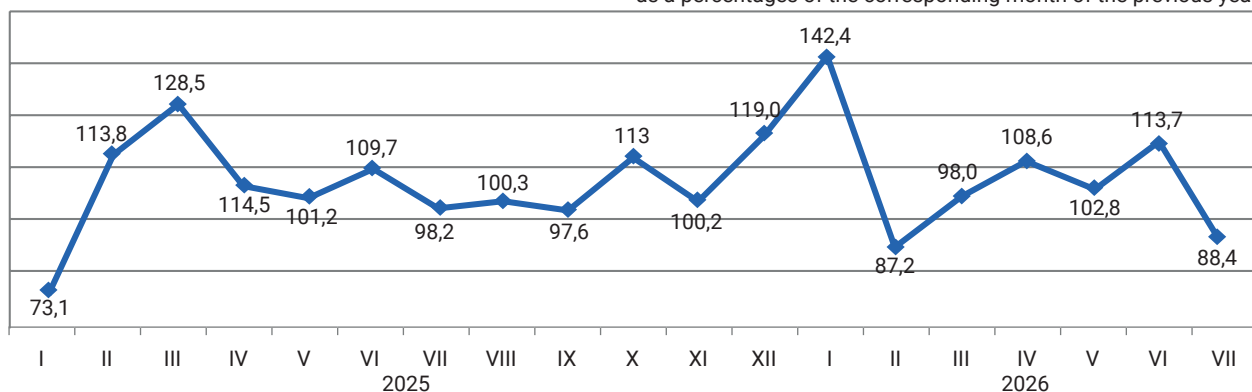


In January-July 2026, the total area of housing put into operation to January-July 2025 increased by 3,9% and amounted to 9746 thousand square meters, of which in multi-apartment buildings – by 9,2% (6546,4 thousand square meters). At the same time, the total area of commissioned individual residential buildings decreased by 3,9% (3157,9 thousand square meters).

In the total volume of commissioned housing, the share of multi-apartment buildings was 67,2%, individual – 32,4%. The average actual cost of construction of 1 square meter of total housing area increased by 5,6%.

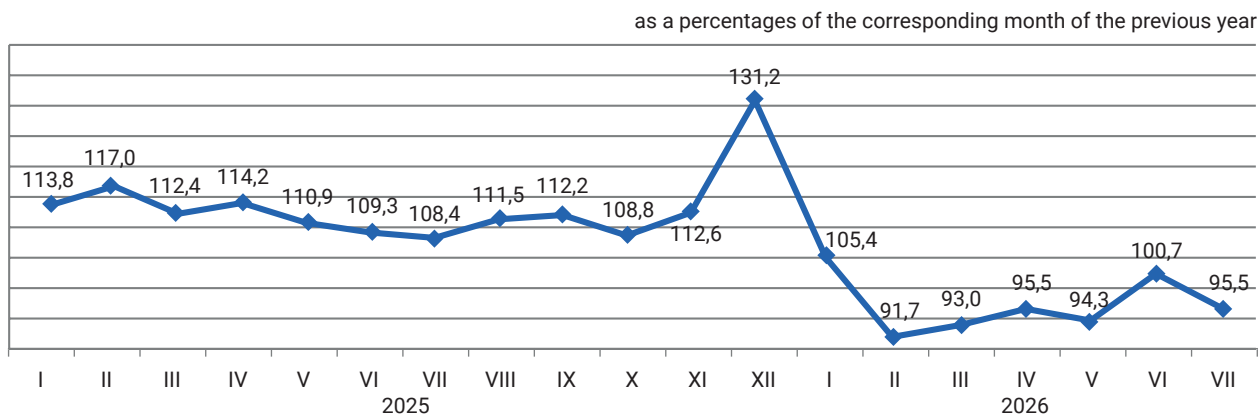

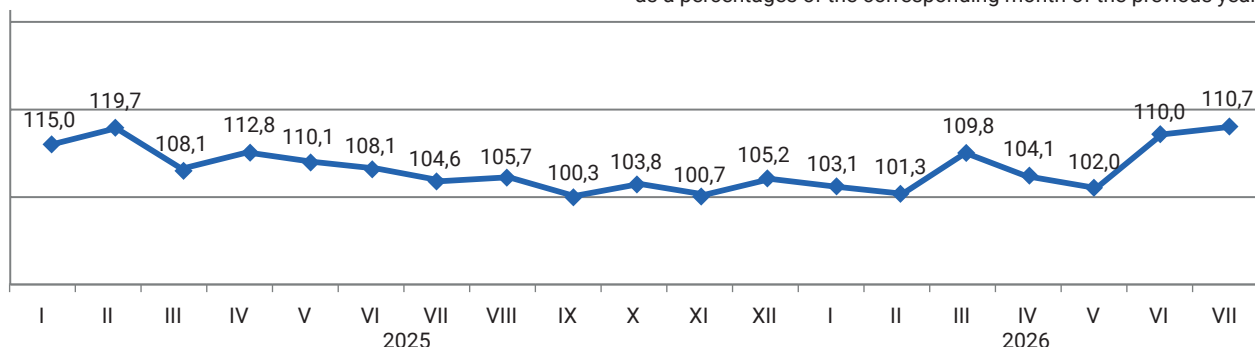

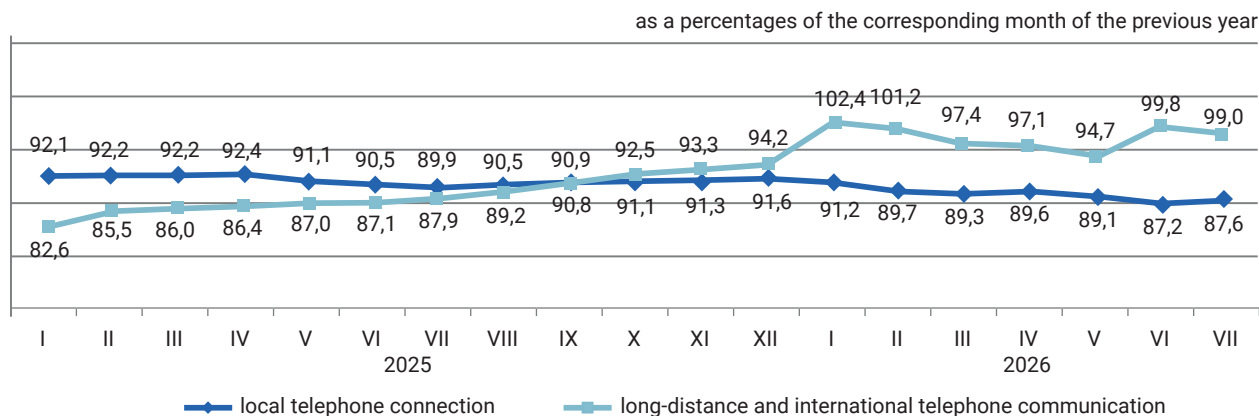

3.11 Statistics of communications

Indices of the physical volume for communication services in January-July 2026 compared to January-July 2025 amounted to 104,3%, of which 242.6% for mobile services¹⁾, 111.4% for other telecommunications services and 65.7% for Internet services.

3.12 Statistics of enterprises

In July, compared to June 2026, there is a slight increase in the number of registered legal entities (by 0,5%), compared to the corresponding period of the previous year, their number increased by 1,3%. At the same time, there is an increase in the number of operating legal entities - by 0,4%, compared to the corresponding period of the previous year, their number increased by 4,3%. Since the beginning of the year, by type of economic activity, the largest number of registered legal entities remains in the industry «Wholesale and retail trade; car and motorcycle repair», the share of which as of August 1, 2026. amounted to 26,2%. On the second place – «Construction» (13,6%), on the third – «Provision of other types of services» (10%). Together, the share of these three types of activities is 49,8% of all registered legal entities.
