

Gross regional product of the Republic of Kazakhstan for 2025 with the allocation of the unobserved economy

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1. Key points

The volume of the produced Gross Domestic Product (GDP) for 2025 (updated data) amounted to 159608552,9 million tenge. GDP increased by 6,5% in real terms compared to the previous year.

High Gross regional product (GRP) growth rates are observed in Turkistan (13%), Soltustik Kazakhstan (11,6%) regions and Astana city (10,2%).

2. GDP structure by regions

In the structure of GDP for 2025, occupies the largest share are Almaty city (22,7%), Astana city (12,3%) and Atyrau region (10,4%).

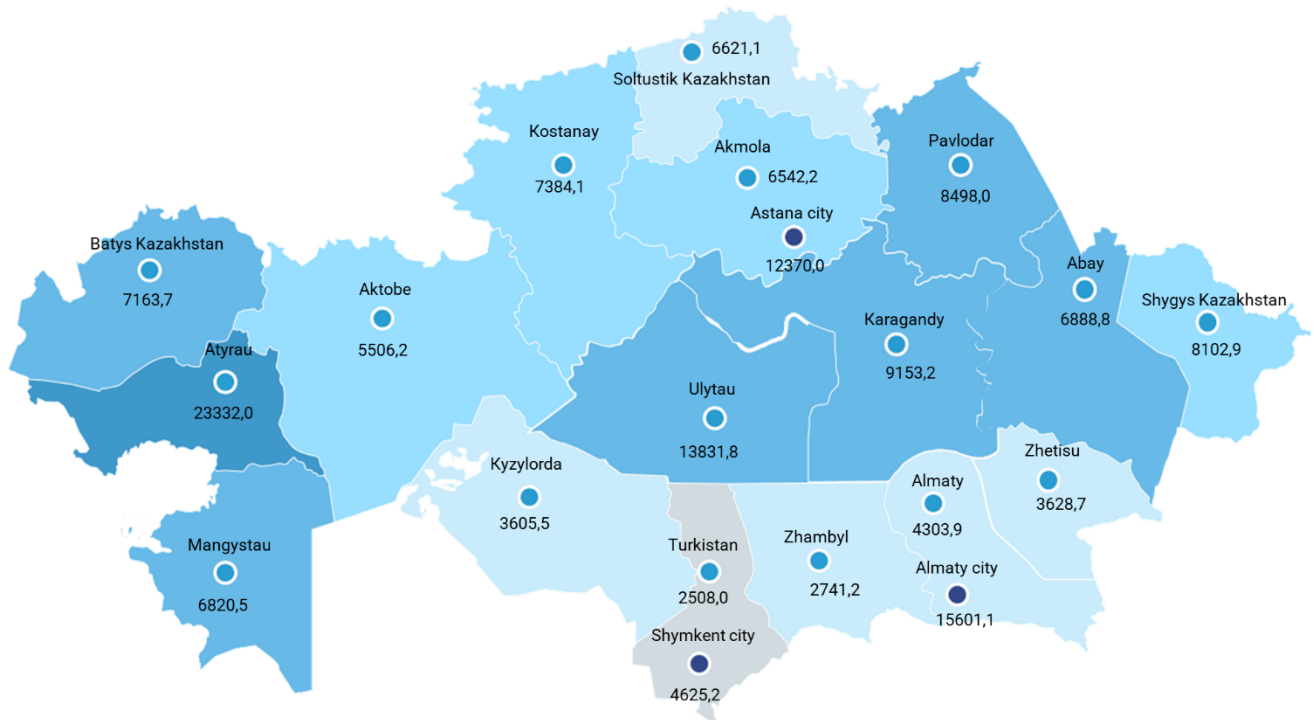

GDP per capita in 2025 amounted to 7827,2 thousand tenge. By region the leading positions are occupied by Atyrau region (23332 thousand tenge), Almaty city (15601,1 thousand tenge), Ulytau region (13831,8 thousand tenge), Astana city (12370 thousand tenge) and on last positions are Turkistan (2508 thousand tenge), Zhambyl (2741,2 thousand tenge) and Kyzylorda (3605,5 thousand tenge) regions.

Gross domestic product per capita by region for 2025 (GRP per capita)

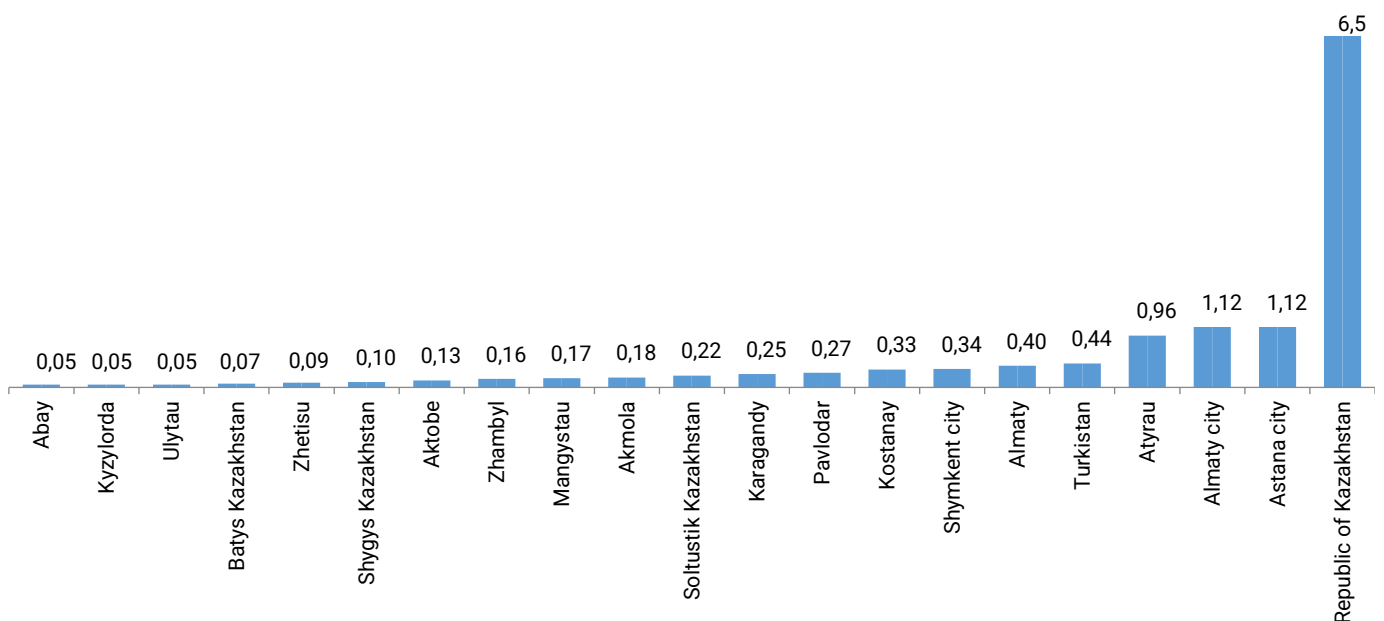

The largest contribution to increase of GDP is observed in Astana city (1,12 p.p.), Almaty city (1,12 p.p.) and Atyrau region (0,96 p.p.).

3. Non-observed economics

The share of the non-observed economy in the GDP of 2025 amounted to 15,69% and decreased by 1,02 p.p. compared to the previous year.

The largest shares of the non-observed economy in GDP are observed in Almaty city (3,78%), Astana city (2,52%) and Turkistan region (0,95%), the smallest – in Ulytau (0,10%), Abay (0,30%) regions and Soltustik Kazakhstan (0,35%).

4. Glossary

Gross regional product (GRP) is the final result of the production activities of resident producer units in a particular region, over a certain period of time and calculated at market prices.

Gross value added is the value of gross output less the value of intermediate consumption, which serves as an indicator of the contribution to GDP made by individual producers, industries or sectors of the economy.

Gross output – the output of goods and services, representing the total value of goods and services resulting from the production activities of resident units of the national economy in the reporting period.

Intermediate consumption is the value of goods and services that are transformed or completely consumed in the production process.

Contribution – the value of the influence of the percentage change in the indicator on the total value of GDP.

Taxes on products include taxes, the amount of which directly depends on the cost of goods produced and services rendered.

5. Methodological notes

Gross regional product is the value of the final goods and services of a particular region, over a certain period of time. The GRP is calculated using the production method and is the sum of the gross value added of all economic activities and includes net taxes. The sum of the GRP must equal the Gross Domestic Product.
