[1. Key points](#)

In the II quarter of 2026, the average monthly wages in the Republic of Kazakhstan increased by 8,4% compared to the corresponding quarter of 2025 and amounted to 486388 tenge.

The median value of wages in the Republic of Kazakhstan, according to estimates for the II quarter of 2026 amounted to 348415 tenge.

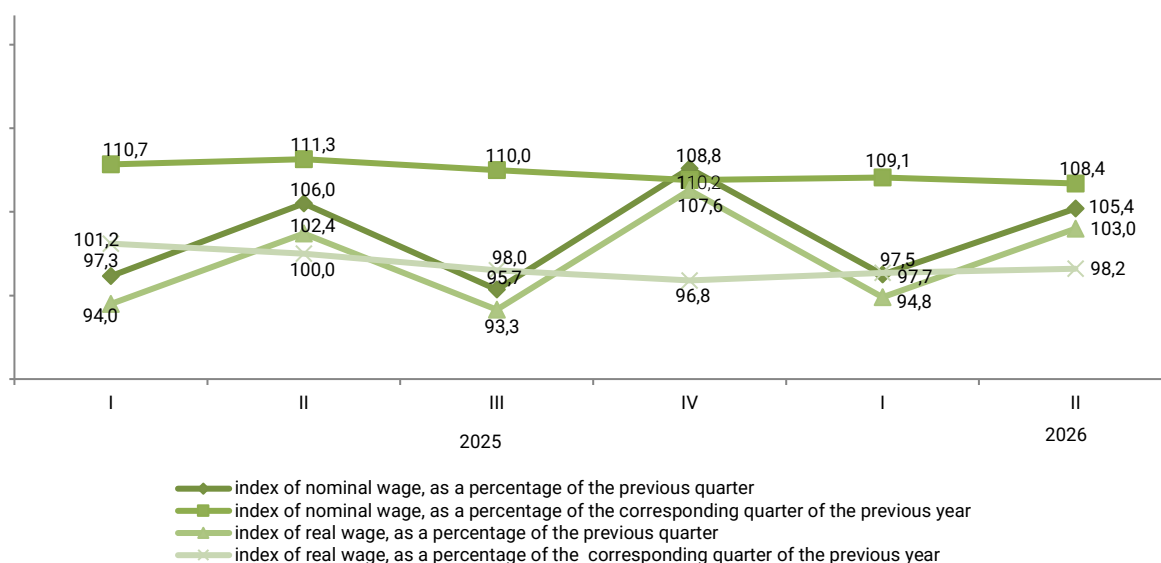
From January 1, 2026, the minimum wage is set at 85000 tenge.

[2. Wage dynamics](#)

Compared to the corresponding quarter of 2025, the average monthly wage increased by 8,4%, the real wage index was 98,2%.

Compared to the previous quarter, the average monthly wage decreased by 105,4%, the real wage index was 103,0%.

Index of nominal and real wages by quarters in the Republic of Kazakhstan

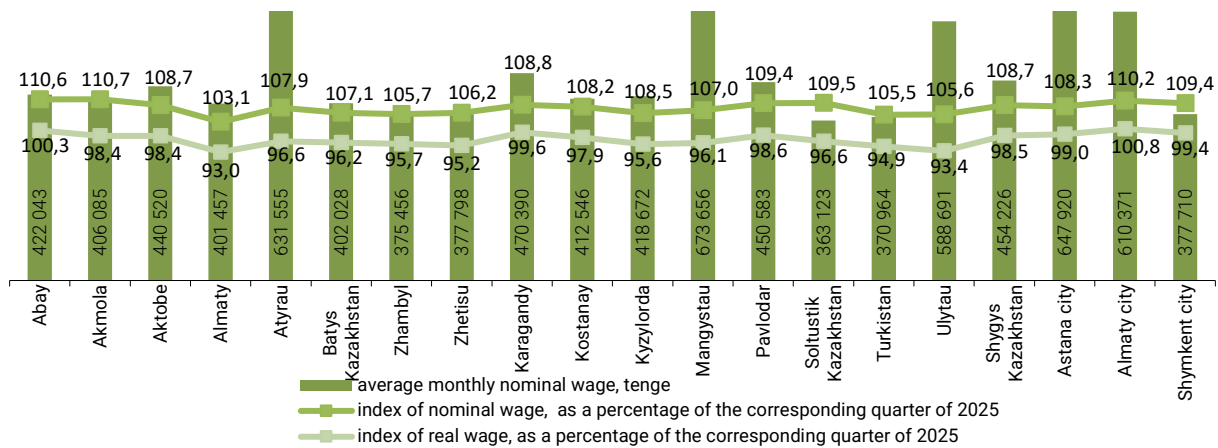

Regionally, the largest increase in average monthly nominal wages in the II quarter of 2026 compared to the corresponding quarter of 2025 was in the Akmola region - by 10,7%, in the Abay region - by 10,6%, in the Almaty city – by 10,2%, in the Soltustik Kazakhstan region – by 9,5%, in the Pavlodar region and Shymkent city – by 9,4%.

The largest increase in average monthly wages compared to the corresponding quarter of 2025 was recorded in agriculture, forestry and fisheries – by 17,5%, in construction – by 16,9%, in financial and insurance activities – by 16,0. In industry the average monthly wage increased – by 11,4%, water supply; water disposal, waste collection, treatment and disposal, pollution elimination activities – by 14,7%, electricity, gas, steam, hot water and air conditioning supply – by 13,6%.

The smallest increase in the average monthly wages compared to the corresponding quarter of 2025 was noted in education – by 3,2%, arts, entertainment and recreation – by 3,4%, in information and communication – by 3,8%.

In the sectoral structure, the highest nominal wages are recorded in financial and insurance activities – 2,3 times higher than the national average, in mining and quarrying – 2,0 times, in information and communication – 1,7 times respectively.

3. Vacancies and the movement of labor in enterprises

At the end of the II quarter of 2026, the number of vacant jobs (required employees) at enterprises and organizations amounted to 56594 units and compared to the previous quarter decreased by 2480 units. Of these, in the sectoral structure, 28,4% are vacant places in industry, 17,6% – in public administration and defense; compulsory social security and 11,4% – in transport and storage.

Among the regions, the leaders in the number of vacancies are Almaty city – 12998 units, Astana city – 6823 units, as well as Karagandy region–4441 units and Pavlodar region – 4254 units.

4. Glossary

Wages are an important form of income for a significant part of the economically active population, namely, employees. According to the Labor Code of the Republic of Kazakhstan, wages are remuneration for work depending on the qualifications of the employee, complexity, quantity, quality and conditions of the work performed, as well as compensation and incentive payments.

According to the ILO standards, there are four main groups of remuneration:

- 1) wages accrued according to tariff rates and official salaries;
- 2) lump-sum payments and bonuses;
- 3) compensation payments related to working hours and working conditions;
- 4) payment for unworked time.

The average monthly nominal salary is determined by dividing the amount of the accrued salary fund by the actual number of employees and by the number of months in the reporting period.

The nominal wage index is a relative indicator that characterizes the change in wages in the reporting period compared to the base period.

The real wage index is a relative indicator that characterizes the change in nominal wages in the reporting period compared to the base period, taking into account price changes. The real wage index is determined by dividing the nominal wage index by the consumer price index for goods and services. Both indexes belong to the same time period.

Median salary is the amount of wages that is in the center of the distribution of the number of employees by the size of the accrued salary and divides it into two equal parts – with wages below and above the median.

5. Methodological explanations

The objects of state statistical observations on wage statistics are all legal entities and their structural and separate subdivisions of all types of economic activity, with a population of over 100 people, as well as with a population of up to 100 people, except those reporting on the statistical form "On the activities of a small enterprise" (index 2-MP), regardless of their affiliation and forms of ownership.

State statistical observations of the average monthly salary, the composition of the wage fund, and the employer's labor costs are conducted using a continuous method.

The source of data on the average monthly salary is the national statistical observation "Labor Report" (index 1-T, quarterly, annual frequency). According to this statistical observation, all large, medium and small enterprises (excluding small enterprises engaged in entrepreneurial activity) are subject to examination.
