

1. Social indicators

Population size and migration

The population of the country as of July 1, 2023 amounted to 19899.4 thousand people, including urban – 12317.7 thousand (61.9%), rural – 7581.7 thousand (38.1%) people.


In January-June 2023, compared to January-June 2022, the number of arrivals in Kazakhstan increased by 87.3%, the number of departures from Kazakhstan decreased by 43.3%.

The main migration exchange of the country takes place with the CIS countries. The share of arrivals from the CIS countries and departures to these countries amounted to 89.1% and 75.4%, respectively.

The number of migrants moving within the country increased by 5.8%. In terms of interregional movements, a positive net migration of population has developed in 3 regions of the country: the cities of Almaty (16044 people), Astana (15611people) and Shymkent (1049 people).


Changes in the rate of population growth

Income of the population

The average per capita nominal cash income of the population, according to an estimate in June 2023, amounted to 174035 tenge (preliminary data), which is 15.6% higher than in June 2022, real cash income for the specified period increased by 0.9%.

Employment of the population

The number of employees at enterprises (organizations) in the II quarter of 2023 amounted to 3928.5 thousand people, of which at large and medium-sized enterprises - 2879.7 thousand people.

In the II quarter of 2023, 244.3 thousand people were hired by enterprises. 258.8 thousand people dropped out for various reasons. Worked by one employee 457.5 hours.

At the end of the II quarter of 2023, 54.5 thousand vacancies were not filled at enterprises (1.4% of the number of employees).

The number of unemployed, determined according to the methodology of the ILO, in the II quarter¹⁾ of 2023 amounted to 452.6 thousand people, the unemployment rate was 4.7%.

The employed population²⁾ amounted to 9115.1 thousand people, including employees – 6945.8 thousand people, individual entrepreneurs – 1581.6 thousand people, persons engaged in private practice – 19.3 thousand people, individuals, who are founders (participants) of business partnerships and founders, shareholders (participants) of joint-stock companies, as well as members of production cooperatives – 19.2 thousand people, independent workers – 549.2 thousand people.

In the II quarter of 2023, the average monthly nominal salary of one employee amounted to 365502 tenge (excluding employees of small enterprises engaged in entrepreneurial activities). In the II quarter of 2023, the median salary was estimated to be 240779 tenge.

From January 1, 2023, the minimum wage is set at 70000 tenge.

2. Economic indicators

Statistics of prices

The consumer price index in July 2023 compared to June 2023 was 100.6%. Prices for paid services increased by 1%, non–food products – by 0.7%, food products – by 0.1%.

The tariff increase was noted for garbage collection by 4.5%, gas transported through distribution networks – by 2.5%, electricity – by 1.7%. Prices for air passenger transport services increased by 4%, cellular communications – by 2.8%, hairdressers and personal service establishments – by 1.5%, residential maintenance and repair services – by 1.4%, recreation and sports activities – by 1.3%, healthcare – by 1%.

The increase in prices in July was observed for audiovisual equipment by 9.6%, household appliances – by 1.2%, tableware – by 1.1%, equipment for sports, tourism and recreation – by 0.9%, textiles, personal goods – by 0.8%. Prices compared to last month increased for liquefied gas in cylinders by 6.2%, Al-95/96 gasoline – by 4.5%, Al-98 gasoline – by 3.6%.

Food prices for rice increased by 2.1%, canned milk – by 1.2%, butter – by 0.7%. An increase in prices was noted for soft drinks by 0.9%, alcoholic beverages – by 1%, mineral and drinking water – by 1.9%, tobacco products – by 2.6%. Fresh vegetables fell in price by 3.8%, sunflower oil – by 2.5%, buckwheat groats – by 2.2%, fresh fruits – by 2%, granulated sugar – by 1.2%.

In July 2023, compared with the previous month, the price index of producers of agricultural products amounted to 99.6%, crop production - 99.1%, livestock products – 101.1%. Prices for wheat decreased by 1.9%, rape seeds - by 1.4%, flax seeds – by 1.2%,

barley - by 0.4%, and for hay increased by 1.2%. Tomatoes of the closed ground fell in price by 1.5%, and bulb onions rose in price - by 1.5%, cabbage -by 0.7%. Prices for cattle decreased by 0.4%, and poultry meat increased by 4.2%, pigs – by 1.6%. Eggs rose in price by 2.1%, raw milk by 0.5%.

Prices of manufacturing enterprises for industrial products in July 2023 decreased by 0.1% compared to the previous month. Prices for metal ores became lower by 3.2%, coal – by 0.7%. Of petroleum products, propane and butane liquefied rose in price by 7.1%. A decrease in prices was noted for aluminum by 4.6%, ferroalloys and precious metals – by 2.5%, zinc – by 1.8%, rolled ferrous metals – by 1.2%, copper – an increase of 1.9%, lead – by 1.5%. From food products, cereals fell by 6.2%, vegetable oil – by 4.2%, livestock meat - by 3%, wheat flour – by 1.8%, rice – by 0.5%, sugar – by 0.4%, poultry meat –rose by 1.5%.

In the service sector, tariffs for the carriage of goods by all modes of transport in July 2023 compared to June 2023 increased by 1.3%, tariffs for communication services, postal and courier services have not changed.

In July 2023, compared to the previous month, the price index in construction amounted to 100.6%, for construction and installation work –100.7%, for machinery and equipment – 99.9%, for other work and costs – 99.7%.

Gross domestic product

In the structure of GDP for January-March 2023, according to reporting data, the production of goods amounted to 35.4%, the production of services - 55.7%. The main share in the production of GDP is occupied by industry - 29.1%, wholesale and retail trade; repair of cars and motorcycles - 16.1%.

According to the a reporting data, in the sectoral structure of income formation for January-March 2023, the share of wages in the production of goods and services amounted to 23 % and 35.2%, respectively, the share of other taxes on production is 2.2 % in the production of goods and 1.7 % in the production of services, the share of gross profit/gross mixed income was 74.8% and 63.1%.

The Gross Domestic Product calculated by the final expenditure method for January - March 2023 amounted to 23190740,7 million tenge. In comparison with the corresponding period of last year in real terms there is an increase in the component of final consumption expenditure: households – by 9.8%, government – by 8.4% and non-profit organizations serving households – by 5%.

Investment statistics

In January-July 2023, the volume of investments in fixed capital amounted to 8103.7 billion tenge, which is 12.4% more than in January-July 2022.

The predominant sources of investment financing remain the own funds of economic entities, the volume of which in January-July 2023 amounted to 6161.1 billion tenge.

In January-July 2023, compared with January-July 2022, there is an increase costs for the purchase of machinery, equipment and vehicles and their capital repairs by 22.6%.

A significant share of investments in fixed capital in January-July 2023 accounted for mining and quarrying (32.4%), operations with real estate (19.2%), transport and warehousing (11.9%) and manufacturing industry (8.3%).

The volume of investments of large enterprises in January-July 2023 amounted to 3412.1 billion tenge.


Statistics of domestic trade

The volume of retail trade in January-July 2023 amounted to 9481 billion tenge, which is 8.8% more than the corresponding period in 2022. Retail sales of goods by trading enterprises increased by 11.7%, individual entrepreneurs, including those trading in the markets, increased by 2.1% compared to January-July 2022

As of August 1, 2023, the volume of commodity stocks of trading enterprises (for reporting enterprises) in retail trade amounted to 1465.5 billion tenge, in trading days - 59 days.

The share of food products in the total volume of retail trade is 29.9%, non-food products - 70.1%. The volume of sales of food products compared to January-July 2022 decreased by 7.2%, non-food products increased by 17.4%.

The volume of wholesale trade in January-July 2023 amounted to 20661.5 billion tenge, or 10% more than the corresponding period in 2022. Non-food products and industrial and technical products (82.4%) prevail in the structure of wholesale trade.


Statistics of foreign and mutual trade

According to SRCMF and BNS

Foreign trade turnover in January-June 2023 amounted to 67.2 billion US dollars (increased by 4.3% in nominal terms compared to January-June 2022), including exports – 38 billion US dollars (10.3% less) and imports – 29.3 billion US dollars (increased by 32.2%).

Exports with the EAEU countries amounted to 5430.1 million US dollars, or 36.8% more than in January-June 2022, imports – 8413 million US dollars, decreased by 9.9% compared to the corresponding period last year.

Gross output of products (services) of agriculture, forestry and fisheries in January-July 2023 amounted to 2764.0 billion tenge, including gross crop production - 386.7 billion tenge, Livestock - 2352.0 billion tenge, services in agriculture - 2.1 billion tenge, the volume of products (services) in the hunting sector - 0.9 billion tenge, in forestry - 11.2 billion tenge, in fisheries and aquaculture - 11.1 billion tenge.


Statistics of industrial production

The volume of industrial production in January- July 2023 amounted to 26272.9 billion tenge. In the mining and quarrying industry - 12255.9 billion tenge, in the manufacturing industry - 12272.9 billion tenge, in the supply of electricity, gas, steam, hot water and air conditioning - 1522.7 billion tenge, in water supply, collection , waste treatment and disposal , pollution elimination activities - 221.4 billion tenge.

Statistics of building and housing construction

In January-July 2023, the volume of construction work (services) amounted to 2942.3 billion tenge.

The largest amount of work in January-July 2023 was performed on the construction of facilities (1327.8 billion tenge), non-residential buildings (1144 billion tenge), and residential buildings (470.5 billion tenge).


The volume of construction and installation work in January-July 2023 compared to January-July 2022 increased by 11.6 and amounted to 2495.7 billion tenge. The volume of construction work on capital repairs increased by 39.1% compared to the corresponding period last year, while on current repairs it decreased by 4.5%.

In January-July 2023, the construction of 20459 new buildings was completed, of which 19331 are residential and 1128 are non-residential.

- The following social and cultural facilities were put into operation:
- secondary school 24;
- preschool organizations 19;
- hospital 1;
- outpatient organizations 11.

In January-July 2023, 1505.6 billion tenge was allocated for housing construction. In the total volume of investments in fixed capital, the share of disbursed funds in housing construction amounted to 18.6%.

The main source of financing for housing construction in January-July 2023 is the own funds of developers, the share of which is 88.2%.

Indices of physical volume of investments in housing construction



In January-July 2023, the total area of housing put into operation increased by 11.7% and amounted to 8551.6 thousand square meters, of which in multi-apartment buildings - by 22% (5030.2 thousand square meters). At the same time, the total area of individual residential buildings put into operation decreased by 0.2% (3480.4 thousand square meters)

In the total volume of commissioned housing, the share of multi-apartment buildings was 58.8%, individual - 40.7%. The average actual cost of construction of 1 square meter of total housing area increased by 20.5%.




Statistics of transport

Cargo turnover

Cargo turnover for January-July 2023 decreased by 2.4% from the level of the corresponding period of the previous year. In January-July 2023, compared to January-July 2022, there is a increase in the turnover of railway transport (by 5.1%).

as a percentage of the corresponding month of the previous year





Passenger turnover

Passenger turnover in January-July 2023 increased by 13% compared to the corresponding period of the previous year. In January-July 2023, compared to January-July 2022, there is an increase in passenger traffic in road transport (by 2.2%), air transport (by 41.5%) and railway transport (by 0.9%).


Statistics of communications

IPV for communication services in January-July 2023 compared to January-July 2022 amounted to 108,5%, of which 117,6% for Internet services, 108,6% for other telecommunications services and 94,4% for mobile services. A significant share in the total volume of communication services is occupied by Internet services, mobile communications and other telecommunication services, the shares of which amounted to 45,7%, 21% and 20,7%, respectively.

The structure of performance indicators for SMEs as of August 1, 2023

According to the Statistical Business Register, the largest number of operating individual entrepreneurs is concentrated in Almaty city (16.0%) of the total, Astana city (10.9%), Turkistan (8.6%), Shymkent city (7.3%), Almaty (6.6%) and Karaganda (5.0%) regions.

At the same time, a significant number of active peasant or farm enterprises were recorded in Turkistan (30.4%), Almaty (10.8%), Zhambyl (10.4%) and Zhetisu (7.6%) regions.
