1. Social indicators

Population size and migration

The population of the country as of June 1, 2024 amounted to 20139.9 thousand people, including urban – 12552.6 thousand (62.3%), rural – 7587.3 thousand (37.7%) people.

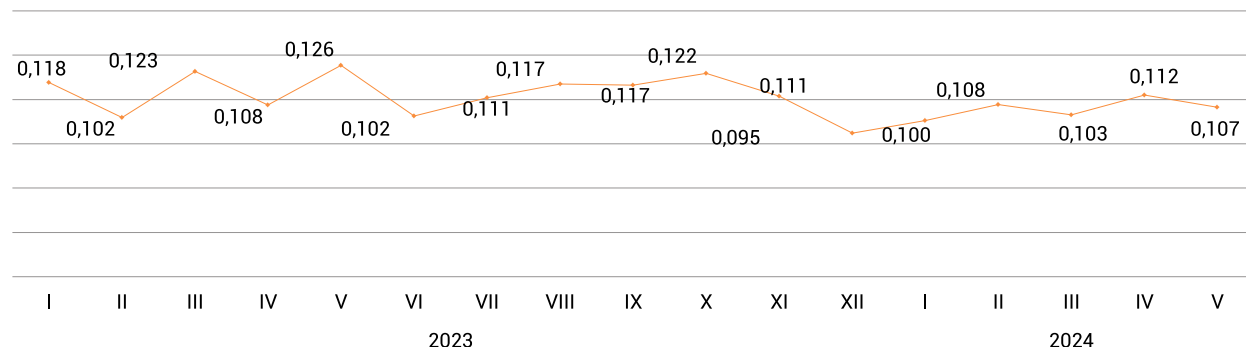
In January-May 2024, compared to January-May 2023, the number of arrivals in Kazakhstan increased by 2.3%, the number of departures from Kazakhstan increased by 15.8%.

The main migration exchange of the country takes place with the CIS countries. The share of arrivals from the CIS countries and departures to these countries amounted to 77.4% and 75.2%, respectively.

The number of migrants moving within the country increased by 108.6%. In terms of interregional movements, a positive net migration of population has developed in 4 regions of the country: the cities of Astana (23865 people), Almaty (13255 people), Shymkent (4392 people) and in Almaty region (1318 people).

Total population growth (decrease) and growth rate

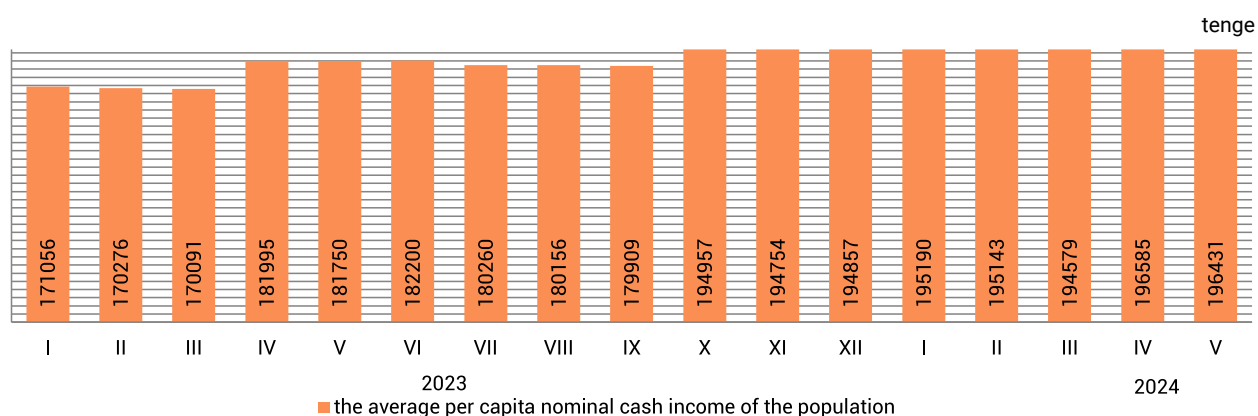

Income of the population

The average per capita nominal cash income of the population, according to an estimate in May 2024, amounted to 196431 tenge (preliminary data), which is 8.1% higher than in May 2023. Real cash income for the specified period decreased by 0.4%.

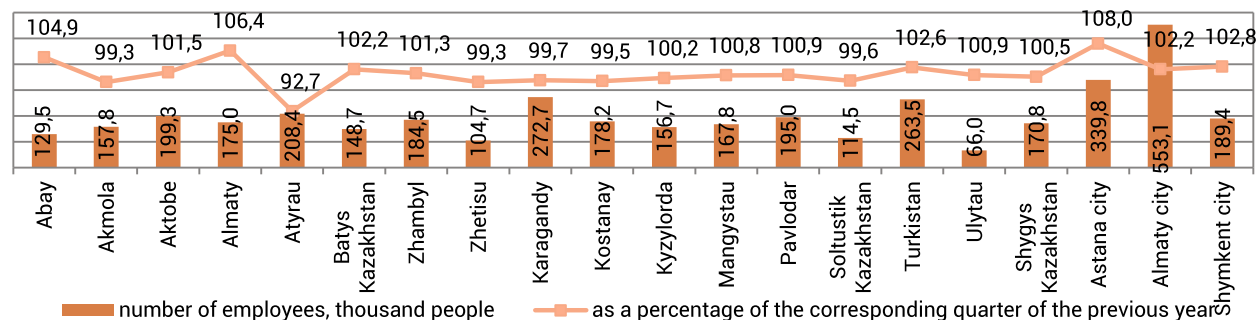
Employment of the population

The number of employees at enterprises (organizations) in the I quarter of 2024³⁾ amounted to 3975.6 thousand people, of which at large and medium-sized enterprises – 2889.4 thousand people.

In the I quarter of 2024, 281.0 thousand people were hired by enterprises. 274.2 thousand people dropped out for various reasons. Worked by one employee 452.7 hours.

At the end of the I quarter of 2024, 57.4 thousand vacancies were not filled at enterprises (1.4% of the number of employees).

The number of unemployed, determined according to the methodology of the ILO, in the I quarter¹⁾ of 2024 amounted to 452.7 thousand people, the unemployment rate was 4.7%.

The employed population²⁾ amounted to 9167.3 thousand people, including employees – 6981.4 thousand people, individual entrepreneurs – 1666.0 thousand people, persons engaged in private practice – 32.7 thousand people, individuals, who are founders (participants) of business partnerships and founders, shareholders (participants) of joint-stock companies, as well as members of production cooperatives – 13.0 thousand people, independent workers – 474.2 thousand people.

In the I quarter of 2024, the average monthly nominal salary of one employee amounted to 382279 tenge (excluding employees of small enterprises engaged in entrepreneurial activities). In the I quarter of 2024, the median salary was estimated to be 251997 tenge.

From January 1, 2024, the minimum wage is set at 85000 tenge.

2. Economic indicators

Statistics of prices

The consumer price index in June 2024 compared to May 2024 was 100.4%. Prices for non-food products and paid services increased by 0.6%. The food price index was 100%.

An increase in prices in June this year was noted for a kitchen stove – by 8.4%, an air conditioner – by 4.6%, and a washing machine by – 4%. Furniture and household items rose in price – by 1.7%, clothing and shoes – by 0.9%, textiles, personal goods – by 0.5%.

Prices for services for the organization of comprehensive recreation increased by 13%, sanatoriums – by 5.6%, children's attractions – by 4.4%. Hairdressers and beauty salons rose in price – by 1.9%, catering – by 1%.

Among food products, a decrease in prices was observed for cucumbers by 18.7%, cabbage – by 18%, sweet pepper – by 17.9%, garlic – by 14.9%, tomatoes – by 13.3%, lemons – by 7.4%. The price increase was noted for potatoes by 10.7%, grapes – by 3.6%, apples – by 2.1%, carrots – by 1.9%.

In June 2024, compared with the previous month, the producer price index for agricultural products amounted to 100.1%, crop production – 100.2%, livestock products – 99.6%.

Prices for dried peas increased by 2.6%, flax seeds - by 1.9%, dried lentils - by 1.6%, forage grain crops - by 0.9%, wheat - by 0.5% and for rape seeds - decreased by 1.6%. Tomatoes of the closed ground fell in price by 8.2%, cucumbers of the closed ground - by 5.2%, cabbage - by 0.5%.

Prices for flowers increased by 12.4%.

Natural honey rose in price by 2.3% and poultry meat fell in price by 1.1%, raw milk - by 0.4%.

Prices of manufacturing enterprises for industrial products in June 2024 decreased by 0.4% compared to the previous month. Oil prices fell by 3.3%. Among petroleum products, propane and liquefied butane fell in price by 1.5%, fuel oil – by 0.7%.

Price increases were noted for copper by 10.7%, zinc – by 10.2%, lead – by 6.1%, aluminum – by 5.3%, metal ores increased in price by 3.5%, precious metals – by 2.3%, coal – by 0.9%, rolled ferrous metals – by 0.4%, natural gas – by 0.3%.

Among food products, fish prices increased by 1.4%, vegetable oil – by 0.6%, wheat flour - by 0.5%, poultry meat, rice and pasta – by 0.4% each, livestock meat and sugar fell in price by 0.6%, cereals – by 0.5%.

In the service sector, tariffs for the transportation of goods by all calendar transportation and tariffs for postal and courier services in June 2024 increased by 0.2% compared to the previous month, communication services remained unchanged.

In June 2024 compared to the previous month the prices index in construction and for construction and installation work amounted to 100.1%, for machinery and equipment – 99.9%. for other work and costs – 100.5%.

The short-term economic indicator for January–June 2024 compared to January–June 2023 amounted to 103,9%. The calculation of the short-term economic indicator is carried out to ensure efficiency and is based on changes in output indices for basic sectors: agriculture, industry, construction, trade, transport and communications, accounting for over 60% of GDP.

Gross Domestic Product

In the structure of GDP for January-March 2024, to reported data, the production of goods amounted to 35,1%, the production of services – 57,9%. The main share in the production of GDP is occupied by industry – 28,5%, wholesale and retail trade; repair of cars and motorcycles – 16,5%.

The Gross Domestic Product calculated by the final expenditure method for January–March 2024 amounted to 25500733,2 million tenge. Compared to the corresponding period last year, in real terms there is an increase in the final consumption expenditure component by 4,4% due to an increase in household final consumption expenditure by 7% and a decrease in general government expenditure by 6,7%.

According to the reporting data, in the sectoral structure of income formation for January-March 2024, compensation of employees in the production of goods and services amounted to 23,5% and 35,2%, respectively, the share of other taxes on production is 2,9 % in the production of goods and 2% in the production of services, respectively, the share of gross operating surplus /gross mixed income was 73,6 % and 62,8%.

Investment statistics

In January-June 2024, the volume of investments in fixed capital amounted to 6654.3 billion tenge, which is 3.5% less than in January-June 2023.

The predominant sources of investment financing remain the own funds of economic entities, the volume of which in January-June 2024 amounted to 4787.9 billion tenge.

In January-June 2024, compared with January-June 2023, there is an increase costs for the purchase of machinery, equipment and vehicles and their capital repairs by 7.7%.

A significant share of investments in fixed capital in January-June 2024 accounted for mining and quarrying (23.5%), operations with real estate (21.5%), transport and warehousing (16.1%) and manufacturing industry (9.9%).

The volume of investments of large enterprises in January-June 2024 amounted to 2332.4 billion tenge.

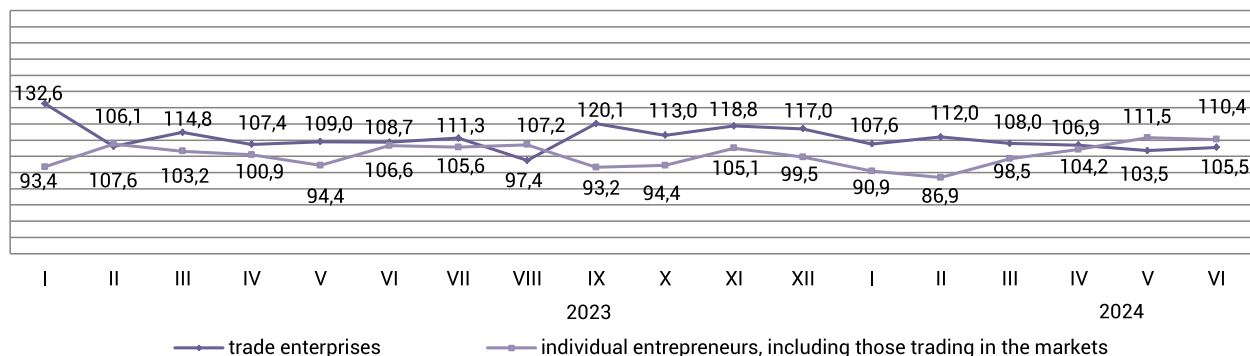
The volume of retail trade in January-June 2024 amounted to 8710.5 billion tenge, which is 5.6% more than the corresponding period in 2023. Retail sales of goods by trading enterprises increased by 7.1%, individual entrepreneurs, including those trading in the markets, decreased by 1.7% compared to January-June 2023.

As of July 1, 2024, the volume of commodity stocks of trading enterprises (for reporting enterprises) in retail trade amounted to 1553.8 billion tenge, in trading days - 68 days.

The share of food products in the total volume of retail trade is 30.6%, non-food products – 69.4%. The volume of sales of food products compared to January-June 2023 increased by 9.6%, non-food products increased by 4%.

The volume of wholesale trade in January-June 2024 amounted to 18770.5 billion tenge, which is 3.3% more than the corresponding period in 2023. Non-food products and industrial and technical products (79.6%) prevail in the structure of wholesale trade.

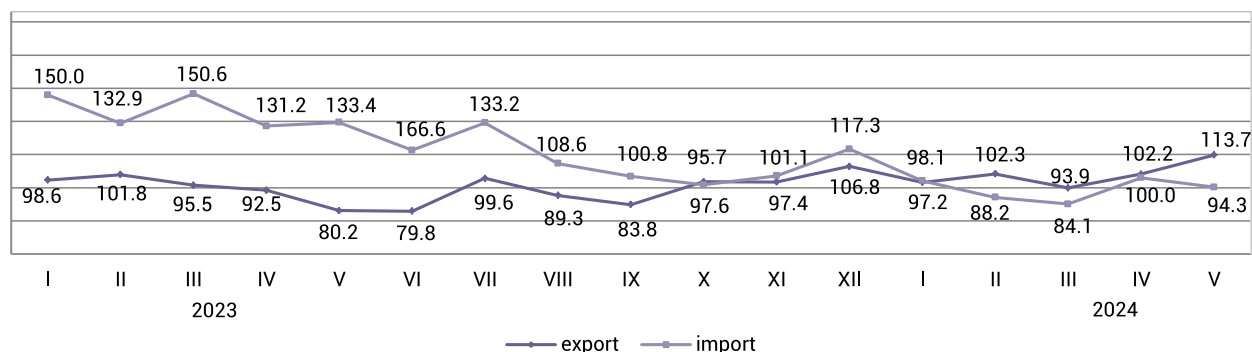

Foreign trade turnover in January–May 2024 amounted to 55.3 billion US dollars (less by 2.1% in nominal terms compared to January–May 2023), including exports–32.5 billion US dollars (1.8% more) and imports–22.9 billion US dollars (less by 7.2%).

Exports with the EAEU countries amounted to 3881.3 million US dollars, or 19.3% less than in January–May 2023, imports–6797.8 million US dollars, decreased by 7.4% compared to the corresponding period last year.

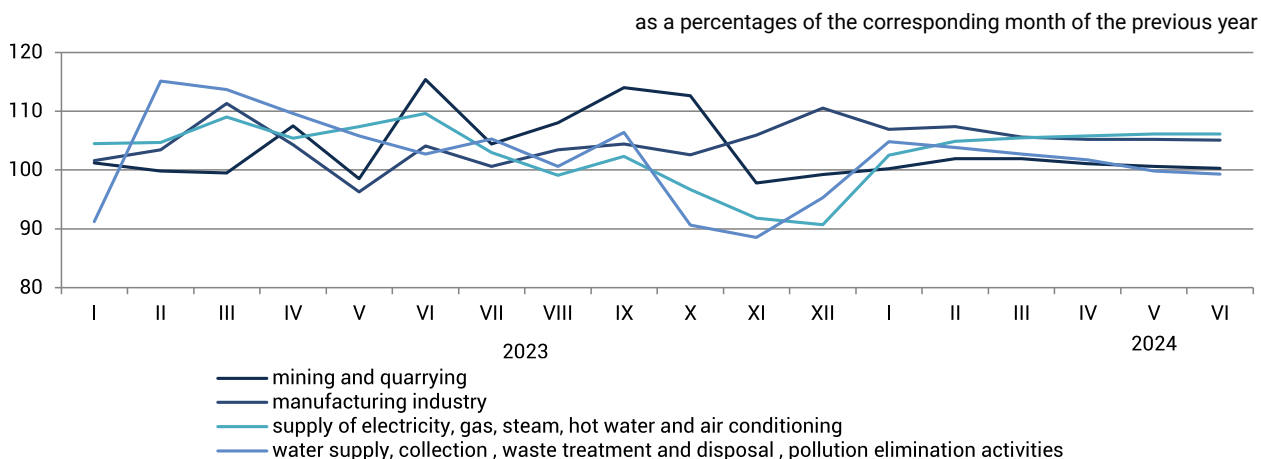

Statistics of building and housing construction

In January-June 2024, the volume of construction work increased by 8.6% and amounted to 2748.2 billion tenge.

The largest amount of work in January-June 2024 was performed on the construction of facilities (1278.9 billion tenge), non-residential buildings (969.1 billion tenge) and residential buildings (500.1 billion tenge).

The volume of construction and installation work in January-June 2024 compared to January-June 2023 increased by 8% and amounted to 2343.4 billion tenge. The volume of construction work on major repairs increased by 13% and on current repairs by 11.6%.

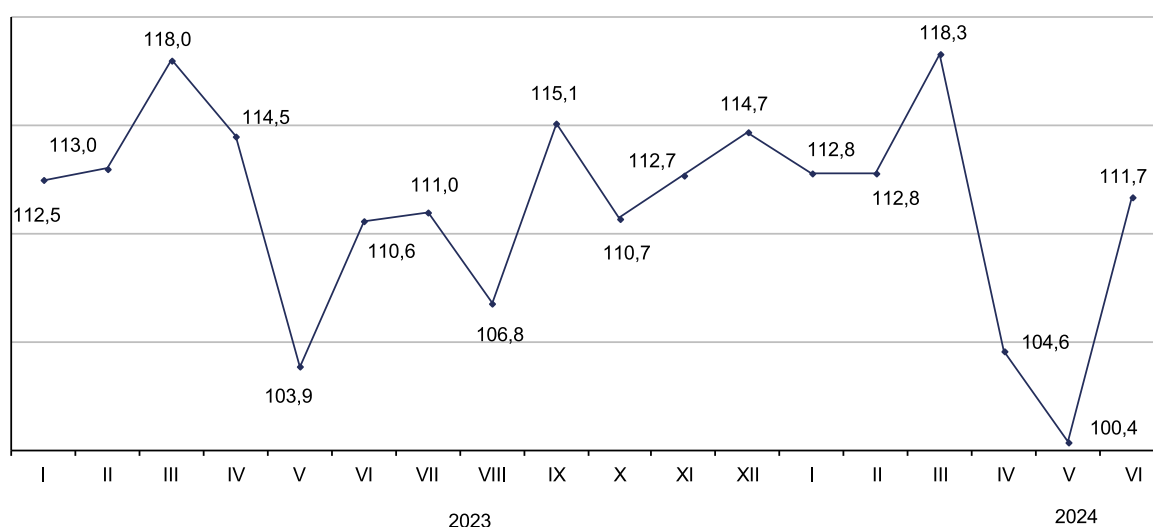
In January-June 2024, the construction of 16531 new buildings was completed, of which 15645 are residential and 886 are non-residential.

The following social and cultural facilities were put into operation:

- secondary school – 23;
- preschool organizations – 14;
- hospital – 1;

as a percentage of the corresponding month of the previous year



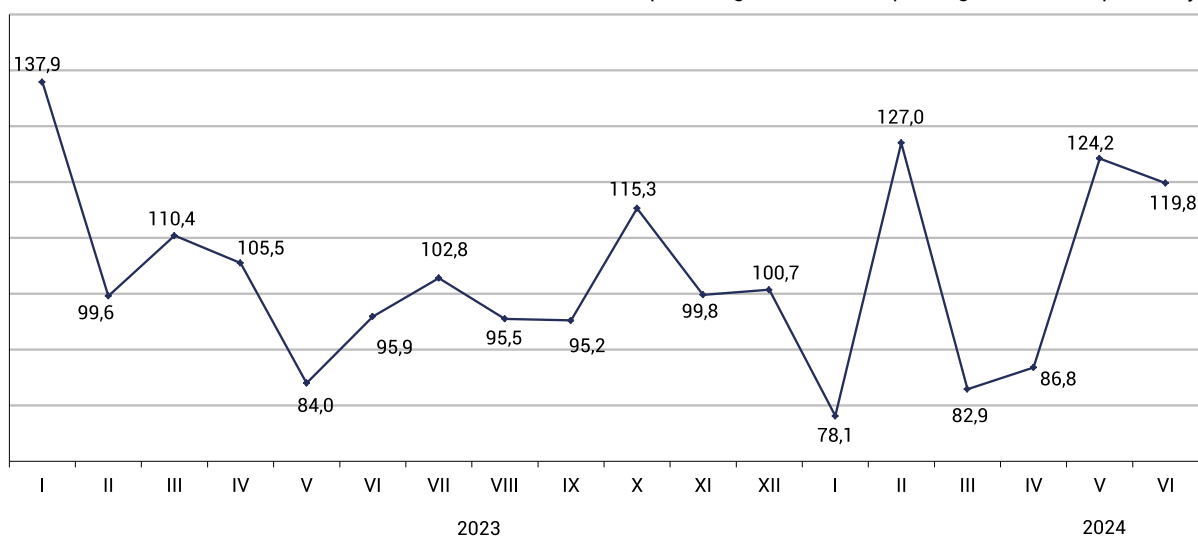

In January-June 2024, 1374.7 billion tenge was allocated for housing construction. In the total volume of investments in fixed capital, the share of disbursed funds in housing construction amounted to 20.7%.

The main source of financing for housing construction in January-June 2024 is the own funds of developers, the share of which is 88.3%.

as a percentages of the corresponding month of the previous year

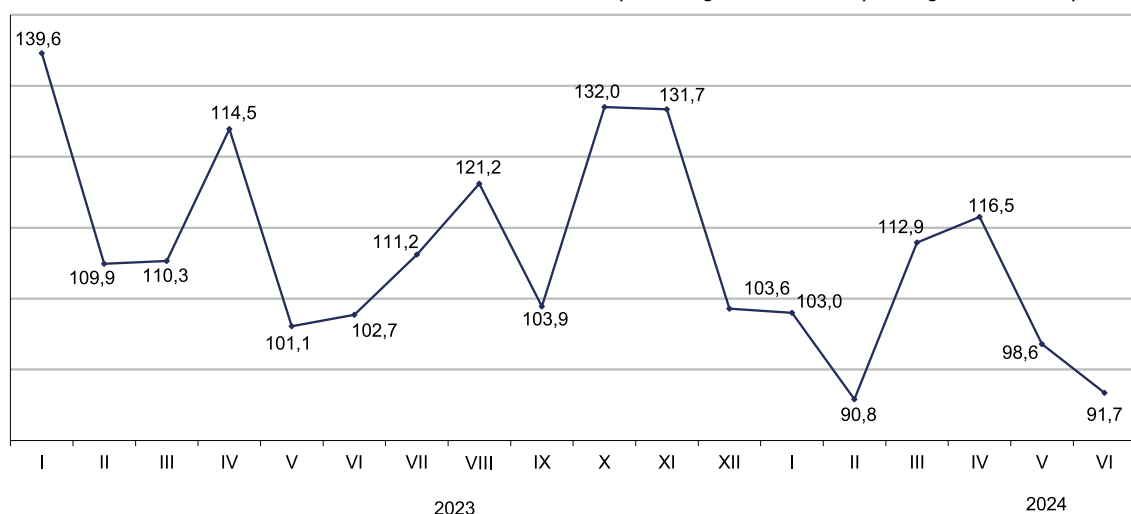


In January-June 2024, the total area of housing put into operation to January-June 2023 increased by 1% and amounted to 7440.5 thousand square meters, of which in multi-apartment buildings - by 5.9% (4574.8 thousand square meters). At the same time, the total area of individual residential buildings put into operation decreased by 6% (2827.6 thousand square meters).

In the total volume of commissioned housing, the share of multi-apartment buildings was 61.5%, individual – 38%. The average actual cost of construction of 1 square meter of total housing area increased by 3.3%.

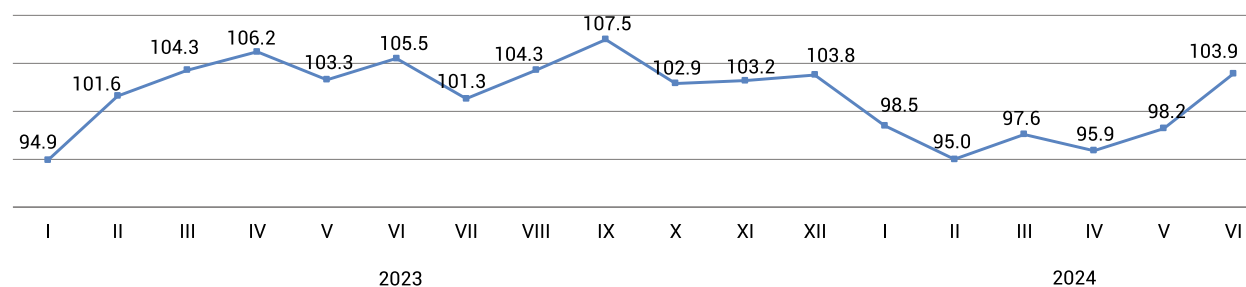

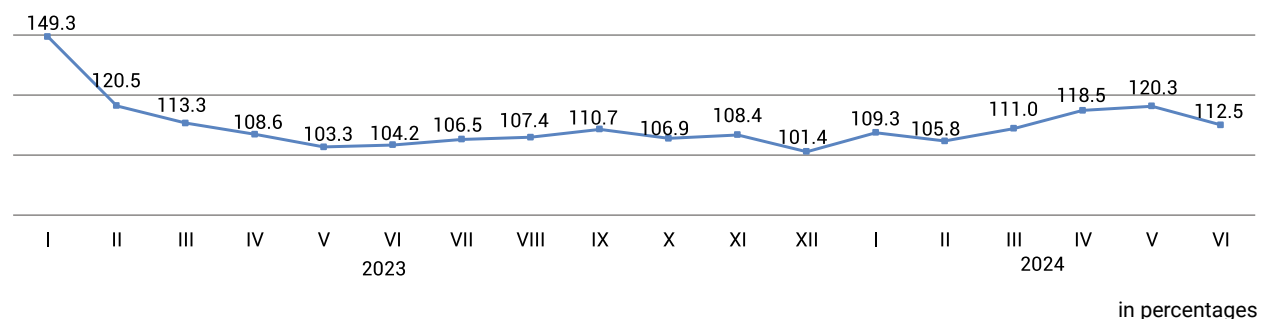

Passenger turnover in January-June 2024 increased by 12.9% compared to the corresponding period of the previous year and amounted to 38.5 billion p-km. 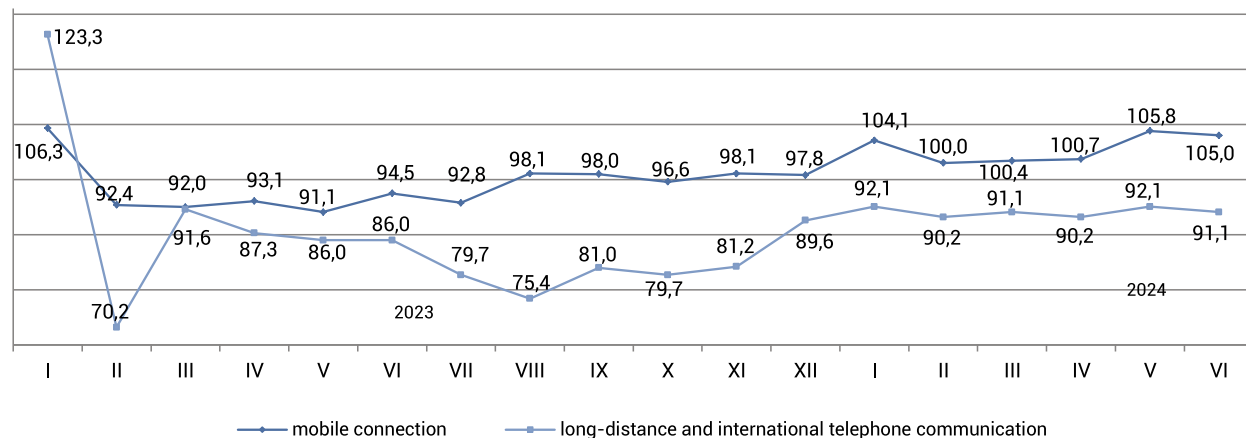

Statistics of communications

Indices of the physical volume for communication services in January-June 2024 compared to January-June 2023 amounted to 108,7%, of which 114,6% for Internet services, 102,6% for other telecommunications services and 104,3% for mobile services. SME entities The output of products by SME entities in January-March 2024 amounted to 16761.4 billion tenge.

SME entities as of July 1, 2024 amounted to 2028.8 thousand units.

The number of people employed in SME as of April 1, 2024 amounted to 4239 thousand people.

SME entities

In January-March 2024 compared to the previous year, there was an increase in the output of products (goods, services) by SMEs in the Kyzylorda (55.8%) region, Ulytau (46.4%) and Zhetisu (40%) regions.

The largest number of operating individual entrepreneurs is concentrated in Almaty city (17.3%) of the total, Astana city (11.6%), Turkistan (8.2%), Shymkent city (7.4%), Almaty (6.8%) and Karagandy (5.1%) regions.

At the same time, a significant number of active peasant or farm enterprises were recorded in Turkistan (29.8%), Zhambyl (11.2%), Almaty (10.8%) and Zhetisu (7.7%) regions.
