1. Key points

The volume of produced Gross domestic product of Kazakhstan for 2022 amounted to 103765518,2 million tenge. Compared to the corresponding period of the previous year, GDP increased in real terms by 3.2%. High GRP growth rates are observed in Akmola region (7.7%), Shymkent city (6.8%), and SoltustikKazakhstan region (5.6%).

2. GDP structure by regions

In the structure of GDP for 2022, the Almaty city occupies the largest share - 18.5%, the smallest share is the Zhetisu region - 1.4%.



GDP per capita in 2022 amounted to 5284.7 thousand tenge. By region the leading positions are occupied by Atyrau region (19974.1 thousand tenge), Almaty city (8985.6 thousand tenge) and Astana city (8053.9 thousand tenge) and on last positions are Zhambyl (2212.2 thousand tenge), Zhetisu (2042.1 thousand tenge) and Turkistan region (1671.8 thousand tenge).

Gross domestic product per capita by region for 2022 (GRP per capita)



The largest contribution to increase of GDP is observed in Almaty city (0.89 p.p.), Astana city (0.58 p.p.) and Akmola region (0.25 p.p.).

Labor productivity**

Labor productivity for 2022 in the economy amounted to 10083.2 thousand tenge per employee and showed an increase of 1.3% in real terms compared to the previous year.

The share of the non-observed economy in the GAP of 2022 amounted to 18.78% and decreased by 0.97% compared to the previous year. The largest shares of the non-observed economy are observed in Almaty (4.03%), Astana (1.96%), Atyrau region (1.48%) regions, the smallest – in Abai (0.44%), Zhetisu (0.44%), Ulytau (0.19%) regions.

5. Glossary

Gross regional product (GRP) is the final result of the production activities of resident producer units in a particular region, over a certain period of time and calculated at market prices.

Gross value added is the value of gross output less the value of intermediate consumption, which serves as an indicator of the contribution to GDP made by individual producers, industries or sectors of the economy.

Gross output - the output of goods and services, representing the total value of goods and services resulting from the production activities of resident units of the national economy in the reporting period.

Intermediate consumption is the value of goods and services that are transformed or completely consumed in the production process.

Contribution - the value of the influence of the percentage change in the indicator on the total value of GDP.

Taxes on products include taxes, the amount of which directly depends on the cost of goods produced and services rendered;

6. Methodological notes

Gross regional product is the value of the final goods and services of a particular region, over a certain period of time. The GRP is calculated using the production method and is the sum of the gross value added of all economic activities and includes net taxes. The sum of the GRP must equal the Gross Domestic Product.
