Obtaining timely information on the size and characteristics of the country's population is a prerequisite for planning socio-economic development and making informed decisions. Vital statistics and their subsequent analysis and interpretation are essential for setting targets and assessing the implementation of socio-economic plans, including monitoring health and population programs, and for measuring such important demographic indicators of living standards or quality. life as life expectancy at birth, infant and child mortality rates.

S.4 Presentation of statistical information

S.4.1 Data description

Natural population growth, live births, the number of deaths, the number of deaths before 1 year, the number of registered marriages and divorces. Natural increase rate, crude birth rate, crude death rate, infant mortality rate, crude marriage and divorce rates.

S.4.2 Classification system

S.4.3 Sectoral coverage

Local executive bodies of cities, districts (including districts in cities of regional and republican significance) that carry out state registration of acts of civil status (hereinafter referred to as registration bodies), no later than the 6th day following the reporting month, send second copies to the city (district) statistics departments records of births (together with medical certificates of birth), death (together with medical certificates of death and perinatal death), conclusion and dissolution of marriages (hereinafter referred to as civil status records), selected separately according to the types of civil status records according to the accompanying inventory registration of acts of civil status, which indicates the number of submitted acts and their numbers for each type of acts. Inventories are drawn up in two copies, one of which remains with the registering authorities, the second is sent to the territorial statistical offices.

S.4.4 Statistical concepts and definitions

Natural population growth - the difference between the number of live births and the number of deaths over a certain period. Vital data is collected and processed on the basis of civil registration records registered with the Civil Registry Office. Births include only those born alive.

The total fertility rate is an indicator that determines the intensity of childbearing in relation to the entire population. It is the ratio of the total number of live births during the period to the average population. Typically calculated per 1000 population. The general mortality rate is an indicator that determines the intensity of mortality in the population. It is the ratio of the total number of deaths during the period to the average population. Typically calculated per 1000 population. The rate of natural increase is the difference between the general rates of fertility and mortality.

The infant mortality rate is an indicator that determines the mortality rate of children under one year of age. It is calculated by the ratio of the number of deaths under the age of 1 year to the number of those born alive. The infant mortality rate is calculated per 1000

live births.

Information about entered into marriages and divorces (divorced marriages) is based on the statistical development of data contained in the second copies of civil status acts compiled for each such event by the Civil Registry Office. The data in the tables cover only cases of marriage and divorce registered with the Civil Registry Office.

The total marriage and divorce rates are calculated as the ratio, respectively, of the number of prisoners and divorces during the period of marriages to the average population.

Then acts and medical certificates of birth and death are transferred to the regional departments of statistics, where the data is encoded according to normative and reference information, entered into an electronic database, and checked for logical and arithmetic control.

Local executive bodies of cities, districts (including districts in cities of regional and republican significance) that carry out state registration of acts of birth, death, marriage and divorce (hereinafter referred to as the registering bodies), no later than the 6th day following the reporting month, are sent to the city (district) Department of statistics second copies of records of acts of birth, death, marriage and divorce according to the accompanying inventory of registration of acts, which indicates the number of acts submitted. Inventories are drawn up in two copies, one of which remains with the registering authorities, the second is sent to the territorial statistical offices. District and city departments of statistics, in turn, check the correctness of filling out the acts, in case of errors or incompleteness of information, they are returned for replenishment. Then all acts and medical certificates of birth and death are transferred to the regional departments of statistics, where the data is encoded according to normative and reference information, entered into an electronic database, and checked for logical and arithmetic control. After that, the generated databases of birth, death. on marriage and divorce is transferred to the Information and Computing Center of the Committee, where logical and arithmetic control is carried out at the republican level, editing, processing of data and issuing tables according to the plan of statistical work for the current year. Then the generated tables are transferred to the Bureau of national statistics, where the analysis, approval and dissemination of information is carried out.

At the end of 2019, the natural growth of the population of the Republic of Kazakhstan amounted to 269.2 thousand people. The overall rate of natural increase was 14.54 per 1000 population.

According to the Civil Registry Office, 402.3 thousand people were born in 2019, the total fertility rate was 21.73 per 1000 population. For the specified year, the number of deaths was 131.1 thousand people, the overall mortality rate was 7.19 per 1000 population. The number of deaths of children under the age of 5 in 2019 was 4,300 people, the infant mortality rate was 10.69 per 1,000 births. The number of deaths before 1 year was 3,360 babies, the infant mortality rate was 8.37 per 1000 live births. The number of registered marriages was 139.5 thousand marriages. The crude marriage rate is 7.54 per 1000 population. In 2019, 59.8 thousand divorces were registered, the total divorce rate was 3.23 per 1000 population.
