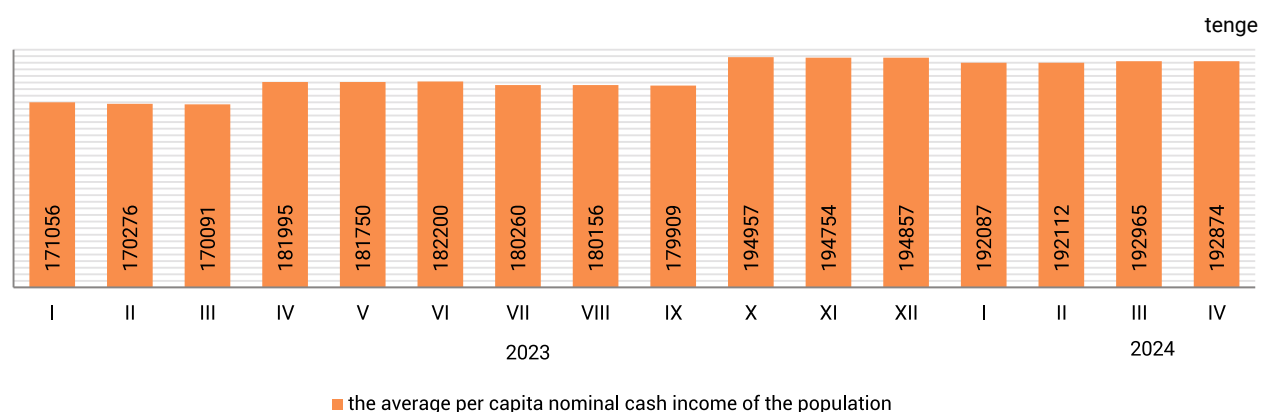

The average per capita nominal cash income of the population, according to an estimate in April 2024, amounted to 192874 tenge (preliminary data), which is 6% higher than in April 2023 real cash income for the specified period decreased by 2.5%.

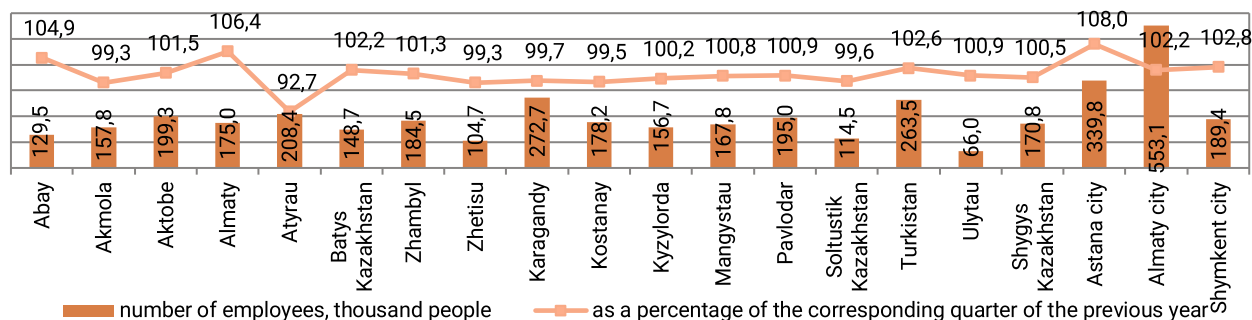
## Employment of the population

The number of employees at enterprises (organizations) in the I quarter of 2024<sup>3)</sup> amounted to 3975.6 thousand people, of which at large and medium-sized enterprises – 2889.4 thousand people.

In the I quarter of 2024, 281.0 thousand people were hired by enterprises. 274.2 thousand people dropped out for various reasons. Worked by one employee 452.7 hours.

At the end of the I quarter of 2024, 57.4 thousand vacancies were not filled at enterprises (1.4% of the number of employees).

The number of unemployed, determined according to the methodology of the ILO, in the I quarter<sup>1)</sup> of 2024 amounted to 452.7 thousand people, the unemployment rate was 4.7%.

The employed population<sup>2)</sup> amounted to 9167.3 thousand people, including employees – 6981.4 thousand people, individual entrepreneurs – 1666.0 thousand people, persons engaged in private practice – 32.7 thousand people, individuals, who are founders (participants) of business partnerships and founders, shareholders (participants) of joint-stock companies, as well as members of production cooperatives – 13.0 thousand people, independent workers – 474.2 thousand people.

In the I quarter of 2024, the average monthly nominal salary of one employee amounted to 382279 tenge (excluding employees of small enterprises engaged in entrepreneurial activities). In the I quarter of 2024, the median salary was estimated to be 251997 tenge.

From January 1, 2024, the minimum wage is set at 85000 tenge.

## 2. Economic indicators

### Statistics of prices

The consumer price index in May 2024 compared to April 2024 was 100.4%. Prices for paid services increased by 1%, non-food products – by 0.5%, and prices for products decreased – by 0.2%.

In the sphere of paid services, tariffs for garbage collection increased by 6.1%, payment for intercom – by 3.1%, electricity – by 1.8%, services for maintenance and repair of residential premises – by 1.7%, rent for comfortable housing – by 1.5%. Prices for dental services increased by 3.3%, sanatoriums - by 2.1%, hairdressers and beauty salons - by 1.4%, catering - by 1.3%.

Among non-food products, prices for household appliances increased by 1%, clothing and footwear – by 0.9%, textiles – by 0.7%, personal goods – by 0.6%. Medicines rose in price by 0.4%.

Among food products, prices fell for cucumbers decreased by 29%, cabbage – by 19.1%, tomatoes – by 15.4%, eggs – by 9.8%, sweet peppers – by 5.8%, garlic – by 5.3%, buckwheat – by 3.3%, sunflower oil – by 2.1%, pearl barley – by 1.1%. Price increases were noted for onions by 28.3%, potatoes – by 18%, beets – by 15.5%, carrots – by 7%, apples – by 3.3%.

In May 2024, compared with the previous month, the producer price index for agricultural products amounted to 99.5%, crop production – 100.1%, livestock products – 97.9%.

Chicken eggs fell in price by 13.9%, poultry meat – by 1.2%, natural honey - by 1%.

Prices for oats decreased by 1.3%, sunflower seeds - by 0.6%, safflower seeds - by 0.4% and for dried lentils – increased by 2.4%, dried peas - by 2.1%, millet - by 1.9%, barley - by 0.6%. Cucumbers of the closed ground fell in price by 14.9%, tomatoes of the closed ground – by 8.5%, cabbage by – 1.9%, bulb onions – by 0.4% and potato rose in price by 2.2%, carrot – by 1.8%.

Prices of manufacturing enterprises for industrial products in May 2024 increased by 1.4% compared to the previous month. Oil prices were higher by 2.4%, natural gas – lower by 0.9%, coal – by 0.5%. Of petroleum products, fuel oil rose by 3.4%, gasoline – by 2.2%, diesel fuel – by 2%, propane and butane liquefied fell by 1.6%. An increase in prices was noted for aluminum by 10.8%, zinc – by 10.5%, copper – by 5.2%, precious metals – by 2.8%, lead – by 2.3%, for rolled ferrous metals – a decrease by 0.7%. From food products, pasta rose by 1%, dairy products and cereals – by 0.5%, poultry meat fell by 3.6%, tea – by 1.6%, sugar – by 1.3%, rice – by 0.4%.

In the service sector, tariffs for the cargo transportation by all types of transport in May 2024 decreased as compared to the previous month by 0.3%, tariffs for postal, courier services and communication services remained unchanged.

In May 2024 compared to the previous month the prices index in construction, for construction and installation work and for other work and costs amounted to 100.2%, for machinery and equipment – 99.8%.

The short-term economic indicator for January-May 2024 compared to January-May 2023 amounted to 103,7%. The calculation of the short-term economic indicator is carried out to ensure efficiency and is based on changes in output indices for basic sectors: agriculture, industry, construction, trade, transport and communications, accounting for over 60% of GDP.

## Gross Domestic Product

In the structure of GDP for January-March 2024, flash estimates, the production of goods amounted to 35,5%, the production of services - 57,4%. The main share in the production of GDP is occupied by industry – 28,8%, wholesale and retail trade; repair of cars and motorcycles – 16,6%.

## Investment statistics

In January-May 2024, the volume of investments in fixed capital amounted to 4895.2 billion tenge, which is 6.5% less than in January-May 2023.

The predominant sources of investment financing remain the own funds of economic entities, the volume of which in January-May 2024 amounted to 3654.6 billion tenge.

In January-May 2024, compared with January-May 2023, there is an increase costs for the purchase of machinery, equipment and vehicles and their capital repairs by 12.5%.

A significant share of investments in fixed capital in January-May 2024 accounted for mining and quarrying (26.7%), operations with real estate (22%), transport and warehousing (14.4%) and manufacturing industry (10.5%).

The volume of investments of large enterprises in January-May 2024 amounted to 1877.3 billion tenge.

## Statistics of domestic trade

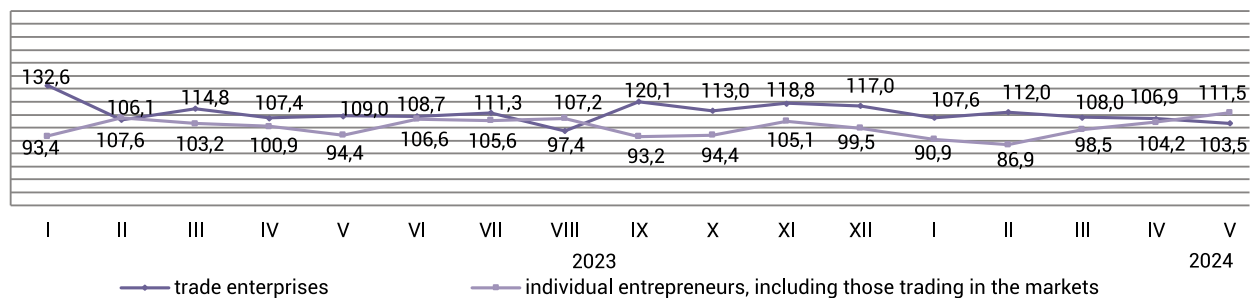
The volume of retail trade in January-May 2024 amounted to 6838.1 billion tenge, which is 5.2% more than the corresponding period in 2023. Retail sales of goods by trading enterprises increased by 7.5%, individual entrepreneurs, including those trading in the markets, decreased by 1.5% compared to January-May 2023.

As of June 1, 2024, the volume of commodity stocks of trading enterprises (for reporting enterprises) in retail trade amounted to 1582.1 billion tenge, in trading days - 73 days.

The share of food products in the total volume of retail trade is 29.6%, non-food products –70.4%. The volume of sales of food products compared to January-May 2023 increased by 9.7%, non-food products increased by 3.5%.

The volume of wholesale trade in January-May 2024 amounted to 15102.8 billion tenge, which is 2.2% more than the corresponding period in 2023. Non-food products and industrial and technical products (79.3%) prevail in the structure of wholesale trade.

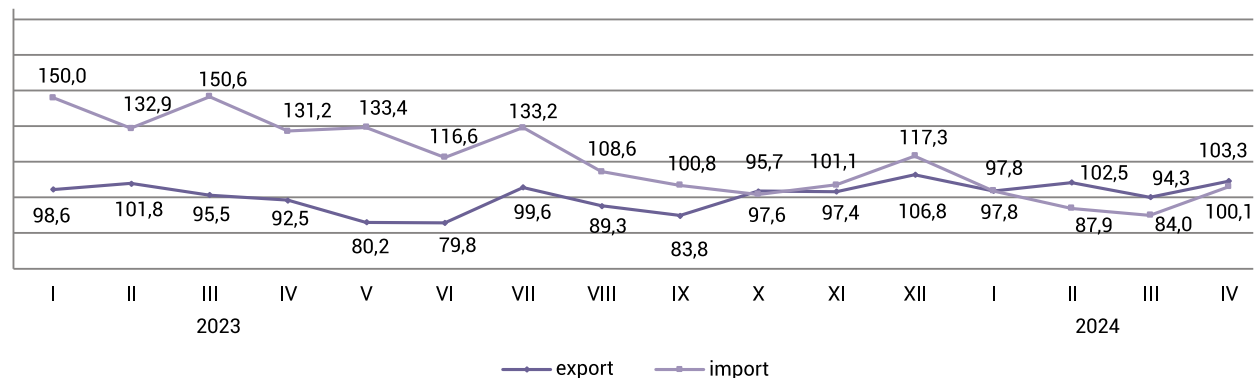

Foreign trade turnover in January-April 2024 amounted to 43,3 billion US dollars (less by 3,6% in nominal terms compared to January-April 2023), including exports – 25,6 billion US dollars (0,5% less) and imports – 17,8 billion US dollars (less by 7,8%).

Exports with the EAEU countries amounted to 2835,3 million US dollars, or 25,1% less than in January-April 2023, imports – 5337,5 million US dollars, decreased by 6,5% compared to the corresponding period last year.

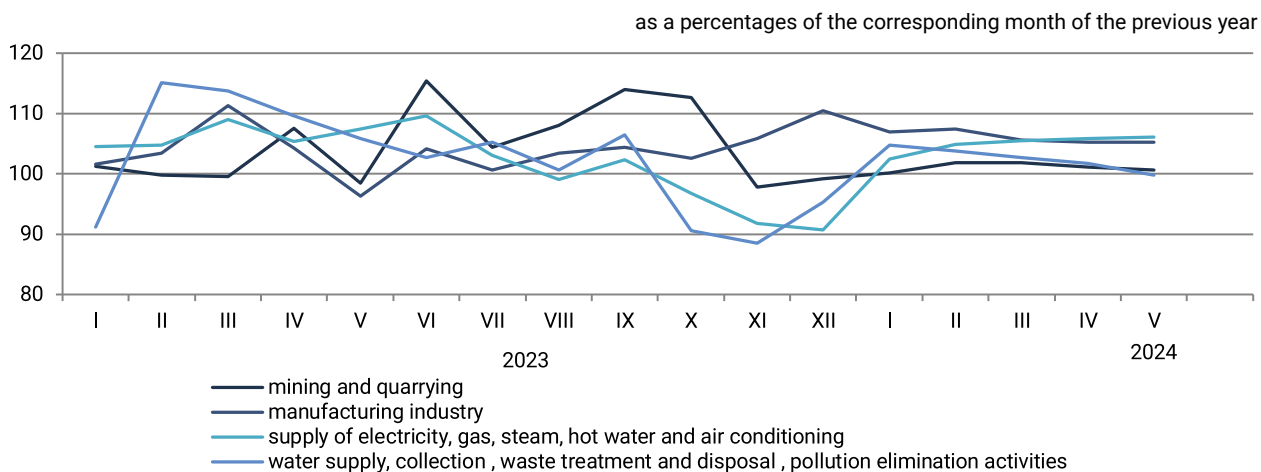

## Statistics of building and housing construction

In January-May 2024, the volume of construction work increased by 8.1% and amounted to 1705 billion tenge.

The largest amount of work in January-May 2024 was performed on the construction of facilities (776,9 billion tenge), non-residential buildings (621.8 billion tenge) and residential buildings (306,3 billion tenge).

The volume of construction and installation work in January-May 2024 compared to January-May 2023 increased by 6% and amounted to 1473.3 billion tenge. The volume of construction work on major repairs increased by 29,4% and on current repairs by 17,3%.

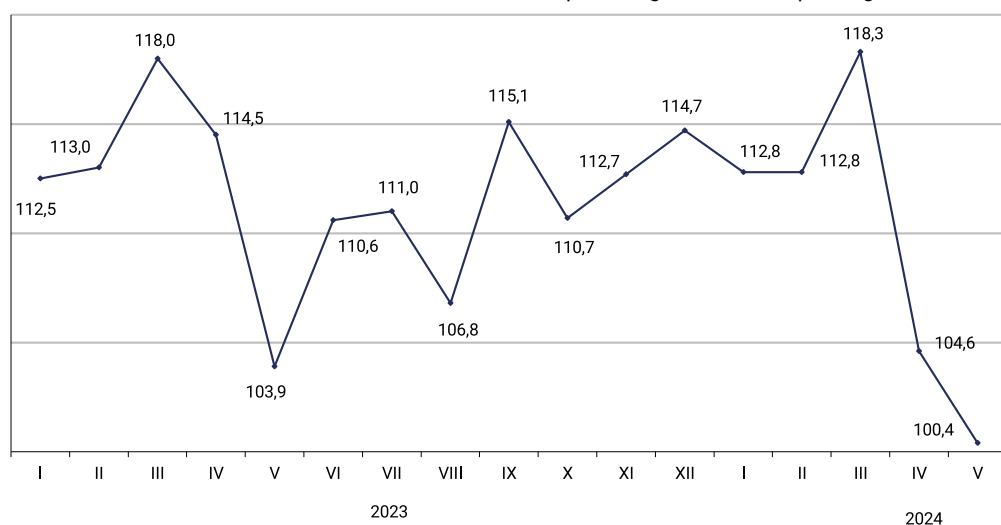
In January-May 2024, the construction of 12286 new buildings was completed, of which 11598 are residential and 688 are non-residential.

as a percentage of the corresponding month of the previous year



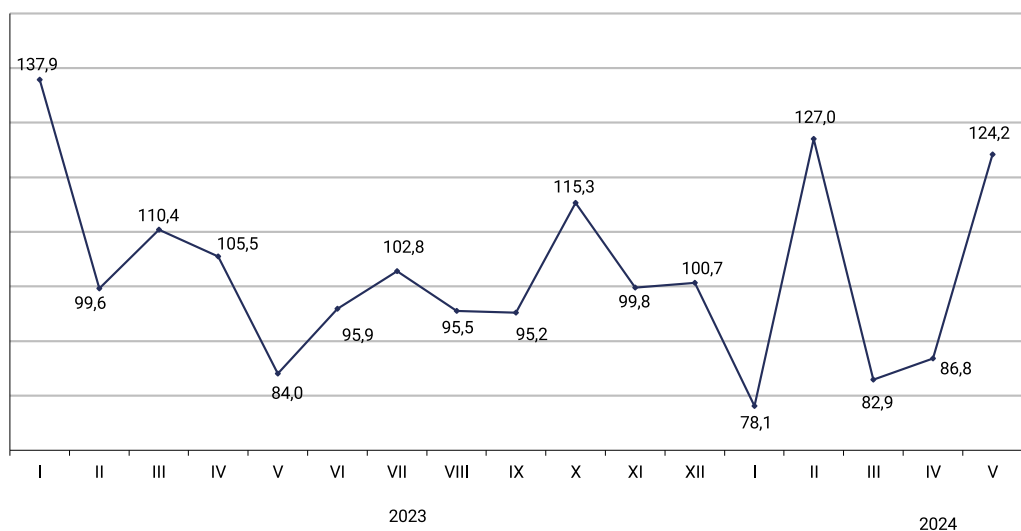

In January-May 2024, 1027.7 billion tenge was allocated for housing construction. In the total volume of investments in fixed capital, the share of disbursed funds in housing construction amounted to 21%.

The main source of financing for housing construction in January-May 2024 is the own funds of developers, the share of which is 88,9%.

as a percentages of the corresponding month of the previous year

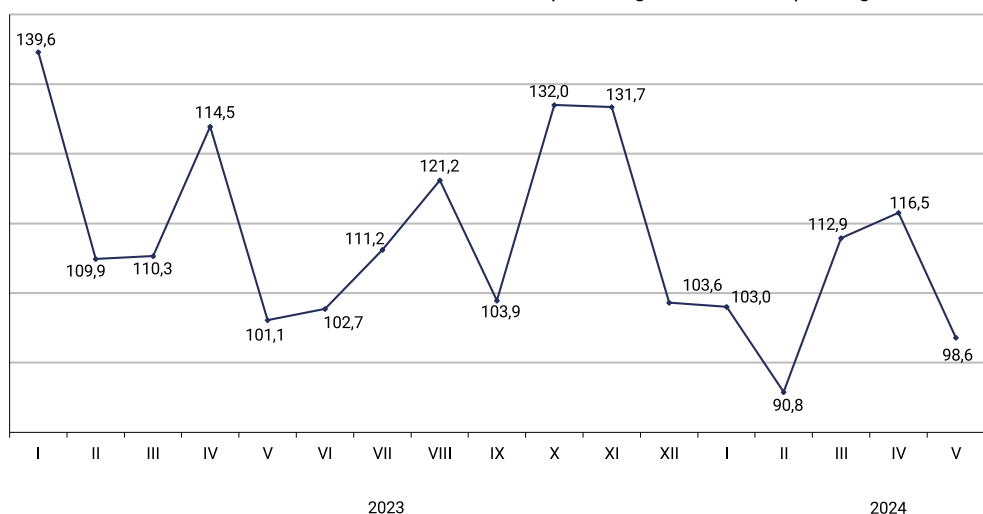


In January-May 2024, the total area of housing put into operation to January-May 2023 increased by 4,2% and amounted to 5697,4 thousand square meters, of which in multi-apartment buildings - by 15,7% (3585,2 thousand square meters). At the same time the total area of individual residential buildings put into operation decreased by 10,8% (2083,1 thousand square meters).

In the total volume of commissioned housing, the share of multi-apartment buildings was 62,9%, individual – 36,6%. The average actual cost of construction of 1 square meter of total housing area increased by 4,2%.

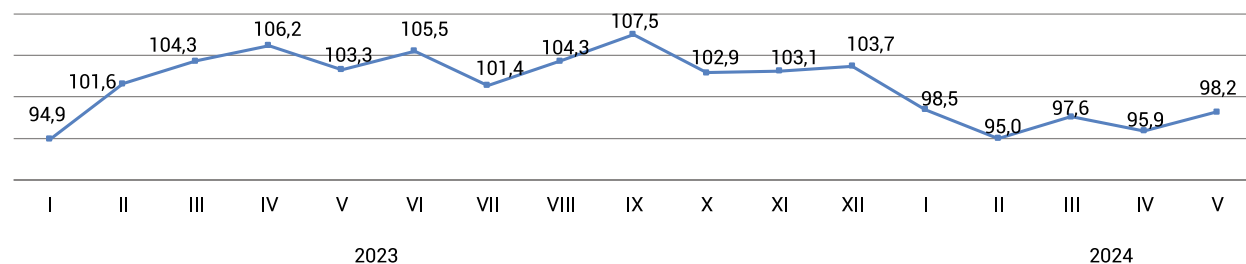

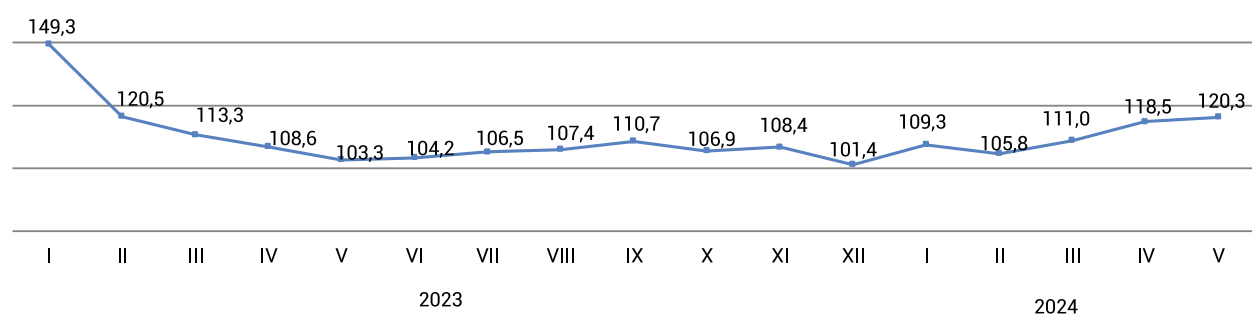

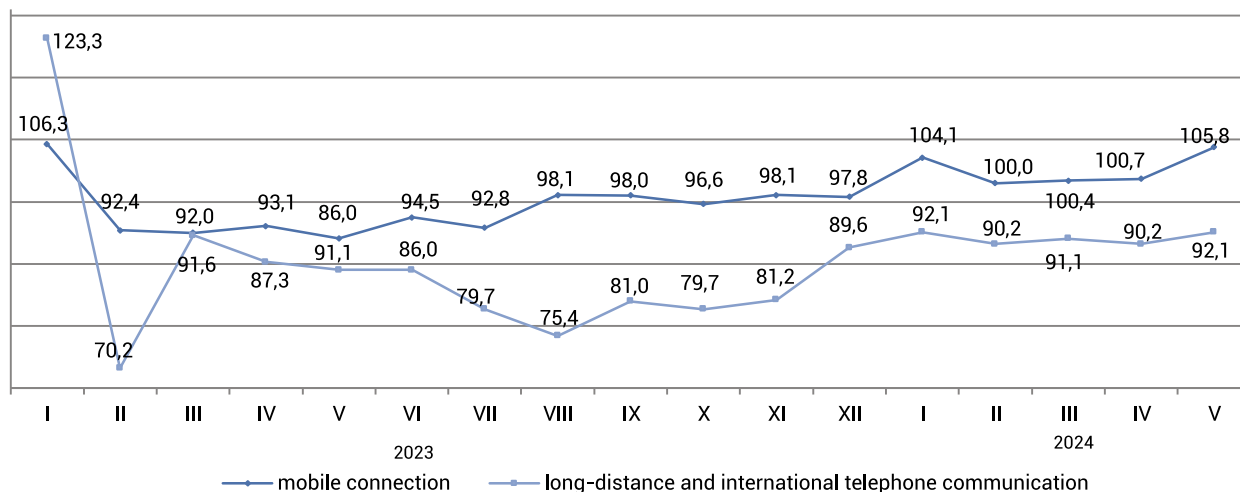

### The structure of performance indicators for SMEs as of June 1, 2024

As of June 1, 2024, the number of active subjects SMEs increased by 1.5% compared to the corresponding date of the previous year. In the total number of active subjects SMEs, the share of individual entrepreneurs was 68.9%, legal entities of small enterprises – 17.8%, peasant or farm enterprises – 13.2%, legal entities of medium enterprises – 0.1%.
