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S.2 Introduction – Relevance

Nationwide statistical observations on the volumes of completed construction works (services) and on commissioned facilities in the Republic of Kazakhstan are organized for the purpose of forming key indicators that characterize construction activities in the Republic of Kazakhstan.

Data on the volumes of completed construction works (services) and commissioned facilities in the Republic of Kazakhstan are compiled annually by region, form of ownership, sources of financing and technological structure, as well as by types of construction projects and aggregated types of construction works. Statistical information is generated on the basis of primary statistical data in accordance with the «Methodology for Forming Construction Statistics Indicators», approved by Order NO. 245 of the Chairman of the Committee on Statistics of the Ministry of National Economy of the Republic of Kazakhstan dated October 21, 2016.

Main indicators of construction statistics:

The volume of construction works includes the cost of construction works performed by enterprises engaged in construction activities under concluded construction contracts, which cover the construction of new facilities, major and current repairs, reconstruction, modernization of residential and non-residential buildings, and engineering structures.

The Physical Volume Index (PVI) of construction works (services) is determined by the ratio of the volume of completed construction works of the analyzed period to the previous period in actual prices, taking into account the deflator (price index).

Finished construction products include completed residential and non-residential buildings, structures, facilities of various types of activities that have been commissioned in accordance with the established procedure.

The total area of an apartment building is calculated as the sum of the total areas of all dwellings and the areas of all non-residential premises, as well as the areas of parts of an apartment building that are common property.

Considering that construction activities play an important role in the development and effective functioning of the state's economy, the main users of statistical information are the Government of the Republic of Kazakhstan, government agencies, international organizations, educational institutions, business structures and a number of other users.

The Bureau holds meetings of working groups (focus groups), with the participation of potential users and respondents, representatives of interested government agencies, as well as the National Chamber of Entrepreneurs «Atameken», which assess the indicators of national statistical observations for their relevance and whether there is duplication with the indicators of departmental statistical forms and forms of administrative data.

Feedback from respondents and users of official statistical information is provided through the Unified Contact Center of the Bureau at 1446.

S.4 Presentation of Statistical Information

S.4.1 Description of data

The volume of construction works is distributed according to:

- the technological structure of the types of work;

- types of objects under construction (residential, non-residential buildings and structures);
- types of construction work in accordance with OKED 41-43 «Construction»;
- the size of enterprises by the number of employees;
- forms and types of ownership.

Information on finished products is generated by:

- sources of financing;
- the size of enterprises by the number of employees;
- forms and types of ownership;
- types of commissioned non-residential facilities (capacities);
- according to the types of commissioned housing.

S.4.2 Classification system

The following statistical classifiers are used:

OKED – General Classifier of Economic Activities;

KATO – Classifier of Administrative and Territorial Objects;

KSP – Statistical Indicators Directory;

MKEI – Interstate Classifier of Units of Measurement and Accounting and the directory of units of measurement not included in Table 1 of the MKEI;

S.4.3 Sectoral Coverage

In accordance with the General Classifier of Types of Economic Activity, the statistics on construction activities cover entities operating in Section F «Construction», regardless of the form of ownership or enterprise size.

S.4.4 Statistical Concepts and Definitions

1. Observation type: complete (census).

2. Data collection tools: nationwide statistical forms «Report on the Volume of Completed Construction Works (Services)» (index 1-KS, annual), «Report on Commissioned Facilities» (index 2-KS, annual), «Report on Commissioned Facilities by Individual Developers» (index 1-IS, annual).

3. Respondent groups:

Form 1-KS is submitted by legal entities and/or their structural and separate subdivisions whose primary or secondary activity is «Construction» according to codes 41–43 of the General Classifier of Types of Economic Activity, regardless of the number of employees.

Form 2-KS is submitted by legal entities and their structural and separate subdivisions that commission facilities during the reporting period, regardless of the number of employees.

Form 1-IS is submitted by structural subdivisions of local executive bodies responsible for architecture and urban planning (for facilities commissioned by individuals and individual entrepreneurs), as well as peasant or farm enterprises at the moment of commissioning.

4. Statistical forms are available on the Bureau's website in the «For Respondents» section. Submission may be electronic or on paper.

Electronic submission is carried out using the «Online Data Collection» information system available in the «Respondent's Cabinet».

S.4.5 Statistical Object

The classification unit for the «Construction» activity is an enterprise assigned to one of the groupings of Sections 41–43 of Section F of the General Classifier of Types of Economic Activity (NACE).

Objects of observation in construction product statistics include construction projects under way and completed, construction phases, launch complexes, and construction sites as a whole.

S.4.6 Total Population (principle of unit selection)

Observation is carried out using a complete enumeration method.

S.13.1 Quality Assurance

The quality and reliability of construction statistics data are maintained through standard procedures:

- The Administrative Code (KoAP) establishes administrative liability for violating the procedure for submitting primary statistical data in accordance with Article 497. Liability for providing inaccurate data includes a warning; failure to submit statistical data to the statistical authorities within the established timeframe results in a fine;
- Compliance with basic principles of primary accounting;
- Use of standard statistical classifications;
- During the stages of collection and processing of primary data, all control schemes (format-logical, arithmetic) are developed and implemented;
- To confirm the accuracy of primary data, the law provides the possibility of obtaining additional information from respondents.

S.14.1 Needs

The main users of the information are the Government of the Republic of Kazakhstan, government agencies, international organizations (CIS Statistical Committee, UN Statistics Division, UNECE, Eurasian Economic Commission), educational institutions, business entities, and other users.

Publication of preliminary results for annual data is not provided. Before the annual data are published, operational data are compiled on a monthly basis.

The time spent processing the first results, from the date of submission by respondents to the first publication of the main construction activity indicators, averages 110 days.

Results in the bulletin are published annually on July 4 and are considered final. Release dates are approved and published in the Statistical Work Plan and the Official Statistics Dissemination Schedule.

The Methodology for the Formation of Construction Statistics Indicators is coordinated with all structural units of the Bureau.

S.19 Burden

Data collection is carried out electronically and on paper at the respondent's discretion. Online data collection uses a digital signature (ECP) system, which includes automated arithmetic and logical controls to prevent typical input errors. Processing is automated, with input and output checks in place. Time required to complete the statistical form does not exceed 1 hour. There is no duplication with other surveys. Administrative data or other sources are not used. In 2024, 42 309 respondents submitted reports, over 71,7% of whom reported online.

S.21 Statistical Data Processing

S.21.1 Source Data

The information base for compiling indicators of the volume of construction work performed consists of primary statistical data from nationwide statistical surveys of construction organizations and enterprises with secondary activity classified as "Construction".

The information base for compiling indicators on commissioned facilities (capacities) consists of primary statistical data from nationwide statistical surveys of legal entities and their structural and separate units that commissioned facilities during the reporting period, regardless of the number of employees, as well as structural units of local executive bodies (LEBs) performing functions in the field of architecture and urban planning (for facilities commissioned by individuals and individual entrepreneurs), and peasant or farming households at the time of commissioning.

In addition, on a monthly basis, statistical data are cross-checked with data from the Automated Information System «State Urban Development Cadastre» (AIS SUD) regarding commissioned residential buildings.

S.21.3 Method of Collecting Primary Statistical Data
Data are collected using a complete enumeration method. Submission of the statistical form can be done on paper or electronically. Electronic submission is carried out using the Online Data Collection information system available on the Bureau's website (<https://e.stat.gov.kz>).

S.21.4 Accuracy of Primary Statistical Data

Data accuracy is confirmed by primary reports, which on paper are certified with stamps and signatures of top management, and in electronic form by a digital signature. The Bureau ensures data quality through arithmetic and logical controls when checking primary reports. In the case of extreme values or sharp deviations, the respondent either confirms the questionable data to the Bureau's territorial staff or makes corrections in accordance with legal requirements.

Moreover, primary statistical data are compiled based on primary accounting documents prepared according to International Financial Reporting Standards (IFRS) in the proper form. Unjustified discrepancies between primary accounting data and data reflected in statistical surveys are not allowed.

In accordance with Article 17 of the Law of the Republic of Kazakhstan «On State Statistics», respondents are obliged to provide accurate primary statistical data during statistical surveys in accordance with the schedule for submission of primary statistical data and the statistical methodology.

Data imputation is applied when forming operational data. For annual data, no adjustment is applied, as respondents submit data based on a finalized annual balance.
