S.2 Introduction-Relevance

National statistical observations on the volume of completed construction work (services) and on the objects put into operation in the Republic of Kazakhstan are organized in order to form the main indicators characterizing construction activity in the Republic of Kazakhstan.

Annual data on the volume of completed construction work (services) and commissioned facilities in the Republic of Kazakhstan are formed in the context of regions, forms of ownership, sources of funding and technological structure, as well as by types of facilities under construction, enlarged types of construction work. Information on the volume of construction work (services) performed is formed on the basis of primary statistical data in accordance with the "Methodology for the formation of indicators of construction activity", approved by the Order of the Chairman of the Bureau of national statistics of the Agency for strategic planning and reforms of the Republic of Kazakhstan dated October 21 2016 No. 245.

Key indicators of construction statistics:

The number of construction contractors;

The volume of construction work (services) performed, which includes construction and installation work, as well as other contract work performed under general, direct and subcontracting contracts at the expense of all sources of financing for the construction of new facilities, capital and current repairs, reconstruction, modernization of residential and non-residential buildings, engineering structures;

The volume of construction work performed - the cost of construction work performed by enterprises carrying out construction activities under the concluded construction contracts.

The volume index (IPO) of construction work (services) is determined by the ratio of the volume of construction work performed in the analyzed period to the previous period in actual prices, taking into account the deflator (price index).

Finished products. Finished construction products include completed residential and non-residential buildings, structures, capacities and objects of various types of activity, taken into operation in accordance with the established procedure.

Considering that construction activity plays an important role in the development and effective functioning of the state economy, the main users of statistical information are the Government of the Republic of Kazakhstan, state bodies, international organizations, educational institutions, business structures and a number of other users.

Feedback from users is carried out through the blog of the Minister of National Economy of the Republic of Kazakhstan on the website of the Ministry of National Economy of the Republic of Kazakhstan.

In addition, every year the Bureau of national statistics of the Agency for strategic planning and reforms of the Republic of Kazakhstan holds meetings of working groups (focus groups) with the participation of potential users and respondents, representatives of interested government agencies, as well as the National Chamber of Entrepreneurs " Atameken ", which assess the indicators of national statistical observations for their relevance and the presence of duplication with indicators of departmental statistical forms and forms of administrative sources.

The main indicators of construction activity statistics are formed in value and real terms. The indicators of the volume of construction work, in turn, are distributed according to the following sections:

1) the structure of types of work (construction and installation works, major and current repairs), broken down into residential, non-residential buildings and structures;

2) the types of facilities under construction, based on the purpose of fixed assets, that is, the sphere of economic activity in which they operate;

3) types of construction work in accordance with OKED 41-43 "Construction";

4) administrative-territorial objects (district, region, republic);5) the size of enterprises by the number of employees (small, medium, large);

6) forms and types of ownership (state, private, foreign).

Information on finished products is formed by the types of commissioned objects, by forms of ownership, by sources of financing and the size of enterprises and organizations.

S.4.2 Classification system

The following statistical classifiers are used:

1) OKED - General classifier of economic activities;

2) KATO - Classifier of administrative-territorial objects;

3) PCB - Statistical Indicators Directory (not posted on the Bureau of national statistics website;

4) SKPSH - Directory of products (services) of agriculture, forestry and fisheries;

5) MKEI - Interstate classifier of units of measurement and counting and a directory of units of measurement not included in table 1 MKEI;

6) KFS - Classifier of forms and types of ownership;

7) KRP - Classifier of the dimension of legal entities;

8) KOPF - Classifier of organizational and legal forms of management;

9) CSE - Classifier of sectors of the economy

S.4.3 Sectoral coverage

According to the indicator "Volume of completed construction work (services)"

1) for large and medium-sized enterprises with primary and secondary types of economic activity, code 41-43 "Construction" (monthly);

2) for small enterprises with primary and secondary types of economic activity, code 41-43 "Construction" (quarterly);

3) for large, medium and small enterprises with primary and secondary types of economic activity, code 41-43 "Construction" (once a year).

The commissioned objects are represented by respondents (developer organizations) of all types of economic activity, regardless of the form of ownership and organizational and legal form of economic entities that commission the objects.

Also for individual developers - a structural subdivision of the Local Executive Body (LEB), performing functions in the field of architecture and urban planning (for commissioned objects by individuals and individual entrepreneurs), as well as peasant or farm enterprises at the time the object is put into operation.

- S.4.4 Statistical concepts and definitions
 - 1. The type of observation is continuous.
 - 2. The circle of respondents:

for construction activities - represent legal entities and (or) their structural and separate subdivisions, with the main and secondary activities "Construction" according to the codes of the General Classifier of Economic Activities 41-43, regardless of the number of employees;

for commissioned facilities - represented by legal entities and their structural and separate divisions that carry out commissioning of facilities in the reporting period, regardless of the number of employees.

The submission of these statistical forms is carried out on paper or in electronic format. Filling in the statistical form in electronic format is carried out through the use of the information system "Online data collection" posted on the Internet resource Bureau of national statistics of the Agency for strategic planning and reforms of the Republic of Kazakhstan (www.stat.gov. kz).

S.4.5 Statistical object

The classification unit of the type of activity "Construction" is an enterprise classified, depending on the nature of the main and secondary types of economic activity, to one of the groupings of the General Classifier of Economic Activities (hereinafter - OKED) of Sections 41-43 of Section F. Objects of observation in the statistics of finished products of construction are under construction and completed construction objects, construction queues, start-up complexes and construction sites in general.

S.4.6 General population (principle of selection of survey units)

The observation is carried out by a continuous method.

S.4.7 Territorial coverage

Republic of Kazakhstan (14 regions, cities of republican significance, the capital).

S.4.8 Time coverage

Yearly data are available from 1991 to 2018.

S.4.9 Base period

Corresponds to the previous year.

The collection is carried out electronically and on paper. Data collection is carried out online, in which automated arithmetic and logical controls are provided for the respondent, excluding the possibility of typical input errors. Information processing processes are automated using local software systems, control of input and output information is provided. Time spent on filling out the statistical form up to 1 hour.
