1. Social indicators

Population size and migration


The population of the country as of January 1, 2024 amounted to 20033.5 thousand people, including urban – 12451 thousand (62.2%), rural – 7582.5 thousand (37.8%) people.

In January-December 2023, compared to January-December 2022, the number of arrivals in Kazakhstan increased by 46.9%, the number of departures from Kazakhstan decreased by 33.8%.

The main migration exchange of the country takes place with the CIS countries. The share of arrivals from the CIS countries and departures to these countries amounted to 86.4% and 77.3%, respectively.

The number of migrants moving within the country increased by 27.5%. In terms of interregional movements, a positive net migration of population has developed in 3 regions of the country: the cities of Astana (50078 people), Almaty (38113 people) and Shymkent (3416 people).

The average per capita nominal cash income of the population, according to an estimate in December 2023, amounted to 187100 tenge (preliminary data), which is 10.2% higher than in December 2022 real cash income for the specified period increased by 0.4%.


Employment of the population

The number of employees at enterprises (organizations) in the IV quarter of 2023³⁾ amounted to 3939,2 thousand people, of which at large and medium-sized enterprises – 2869,9 thousand people.

In the IV quarter of 2023, 247,2 thousand people were hired by enterprises. 241,2 thousand people dropped out for various reasons. Worked by one employee 473,1 hours.

At the end of the IV quarter of 2023, 54.2 thousand vacancies were not filled at enterprises (1.4% of the number of employees).

The number of unemployed, determined according to the methodology of the ILO, in the IV quarter¹⁾ of 2023 amounted to 445.9 thousand people, the unemployment rate was 4.7%.

The employed population 2 amounted to 9042.3 thousand people, including employees -6906.3 thousand people, individual entrepreneurs -1626.7 thousand people, persons engaged in private practice -31.8 thousand people, individuals, who are founders (participants) of business partnerships and founders, shareholders (participants) of joint-stock companies, as well as members of production cooperatives -16.2 thousand people, independent workers -461.3 thousand people

2. Economic indicators

Statistics of prices

The consumer price index in January 2024 compared to December 2023 was 100,8%. Food prices increased by 1.1%, paid services – by 0.7%, non-food products – by 0.5%.

Of the food products, the prices for tomatoes increased by 18.5%, cucumbers – by 14.9%, sweet peppers by – 12.1%, garlic – by 7.4%. eggs – by 5%, fresh fruits – by 3.2%, wheat bread made from – by 1.9%, drinking milk – by 1.1%, fish and seafood –by 0.9%, black tea, fruit and vegetable juices – by 0,8%, pasta – by 0.5%. Te increase in prices for tobacco product was hoted by 3%. Sunflower oil fellin price by 1.7%, sugar – by 1.4%, bulb onions – 1.3%, carrot – 1.1%. cabbage – by 0.7%.

In the field of paid services, prices for legal services and car insurance increased by 7.0%, railway passenger transport services – by 6.8%, preschool institutions – by 2.6%, outpatient – by 1.6%, visit to the bathhouse – by 1.5%, tahi fare – by 1.1%. Air passenger transport services have fallen in price by 6.8%.

Among non-food products, prices for cars increased by 1.6%, hard coal – by 1.5%, personal goods- – by 1.3%. Compared to the previous month, prices for medicines increased by 2%, construction materials – by 1%, clothing and footwear –by 0.6%.

In January 2024, compared with the previous month, the producer price index for agricultural products amounted to 100.2%, crop production – 100.1%, livestock products – 100.2%.

Prices for millet increased by 1.2%, rape seeds – by 0.9%, wheat - by 0.5%, oats - by 0.4%, lentils - by 0.3% and for sunflower seeds decreased by 2.3%.

Cucumbers of the closed ground rose in price by 4.5%, tomatoes of the closed ground – by 3.1%, and onions fell in price by 2.1%, potatoes – by 1.5%. Sheep rose in price by 0.9%, horses – by 0.3% and poultry meat fell in price by 2.3%. Prices for chicken eggs increased by 4.9%, cow's milk – by 0.5%.

Prices of manufacturing enterprises for industrial products in January 2024 decreased by 1.5% compared to December 2023. Oil prices were lower by 4.8%, metal ores – by 0.3%, coal – higher by 1.5%, natural gas – by 0.3%. Of petroleum products, propane and butane liquefied rose by 5.7%, fuel oil fell by 7.9%. An decrease in prices was noted for lead by 3.4%, aluminum – by 1.7%, ferroalloys – by 1%, rolled ferrous metals – by 0.6%, for zinc – a increase by 2.7%, copper – by 1%. From food products, wheat flour fell by 1.3%, vegetable oil – by 1.2%, livestock meat – by 0.7%, cereals – by 0.5% dairy products rose by 1%.

In the service sector, tariffs for the carriage of goods by all modes of transport in January 2024 compared to December 2023 in creased by 1.2%, postal and courier services by 0.5%, tariffs for communication services by 0.1%.

In January 2024 compared to the previous month the price index in construction amounted 100.1%, for

construction and installation work - 100%, for machinery and equipment – 100.5%, for other work and costs – 105.1%.

Investment statistics

In January 2024, the volume of investments in fixed capital amounted to 790.8 billion tenge, which is 0.6% more than in January 2023.

The predominant sources of investment financing remain the own funds of economic entities, the volume of which in January 2024 amounted to 653.3 billion tenge.

In January 2024, compared with January 2023, there is an increase costs for the purchase of machinery, equipment and vehicles and their capital repairs by 49.6%.

A significant share of investments in fixed capital in January 2024 accounted for mining and quarrying (37%), operations with real estate (18.2%), transport and warehousing (15.5%) and manufacturing industry (11.7%).

The volume of investments of large enterprises in January 2024 amounted to 319.6 billion tenge.


Statistics of domestic trade


The volume of retail trade in January 2024 amounted to 1174.3 billion tenge, which is 3.7% more than the corresponding period in 2023. Retail sales of goods by trading enterprises increased by 7.6%, individual entrepreneurs, including those trading in the markets, decreased by 9.1% compared to January 2023.

As of February 1, 2024, the volume of commodity stocks of trading enterprises (for reporting enterprises) in retail trade amounted to 1594.3 billion tenge, in trading days - 78 days.

The share of food products in the total volume of retail trade is 26.8%, non-food products – 73.2%. The volume of sales of food products compared to January 2023 decreased by 0.9%, non-food products increased by 5.8%.

The volume of wholesale trade in January 2024 amounted to 2644.1 billion tenge, or 3.4% more than the corresponding period in 2023. Non-food products and industrial and technical products (80%) prevail in the structure of wholesale trade.





Statistics of building and housing construction

In January 2024, the volume of construction work increased by 12.8% and amounted to 123.2 billion tenge.

The largest amount of work in January 2024 was performed on the construction of facilities (52.1 billion tenge), non-residential buildings (48.3 billion tenge) and residential buildings (22.8 billion tenge).

The volume of construction and installation work in January 2024 compared to January 2023 increased by 15.8% and amounted to 118.2 billion tenge. The volume of construction work on major repairs decreased by 56.4% and on current repairs it increased by 14.3%.


In January 2024, the construction of 1848 new buildings was completed, of which 1689 are residential and 159 are non-residential.

as a percentage of the corresponding month of the previous year





In January 2024, 134.3 billion tenge was allocated for housing construction. In the total volume of investments in fixed capital, the share of disbursed funds in housing construction amounted to 17%.

The main source of financing for housing construction in January 2024 is the own funds of developers, the share of which is 91.9%.

as a percentage of the corresponding month of the previous year




In January 2024, the total area of housing put into operation increased by 3% and amounted to 1048 thousand square meters, of which in multi-apartment buildings - by 20,1% (751.7 thousand square meters). At the same time, the total area of individual residential buildings put into operation decreased by 27% (284.5 thousand square meters).

In the total volume of commissioned housing, the share of multi-apartment buildings was 71.7%, individual -27.1%. The average actual cost of construction of 1 square meter of total housing area increased by 7.4%.

as a percentage of the corresponding month of the previous year









In the III quarter of 2023, wage arrears at enterprises of the republic amounted to 373.5 billion tenge and increased by 14.2% compared to the corresponding period of 2022. The overdue debt amounted to about 2.6 billion tenge or 0.7% of the total wage arrears.
