1. Social indicators

Population size and migration

The population of the country as of August 1, 2024 amounted to 20182 thousand people, including urban – 12656.2 thousand (62.7%), rural – 7525.8 thousand (37.3%) people.

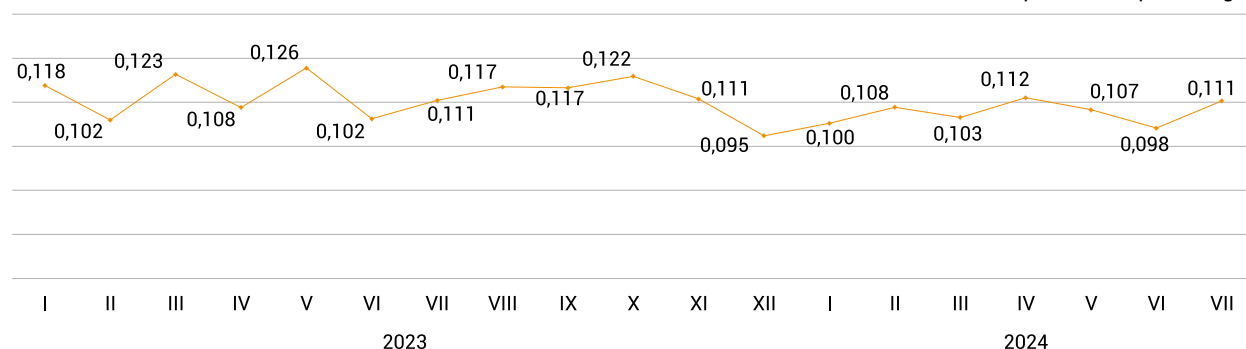
In January-July 2024, compared to January-July 2023, the number of arrivals in Kazakhstan increased by 3.8%, the number of departures from Kazakhstan decreased by 14.7%.

The main migration exchange of the country takes place with the CIS countries. The share of arrivals from the CIS countries and departures to these countries amounted to 78.8% and 78%, respectively.

The number of migrants moving within the country increased by 58.6%. In terms of interregional movements, a positive net migration of population has developed in 4 regions of the country: the cities of Astana (36424 people), Almaty (19500 people), Shymkent (5115 people) and in Almaty region (902 people).

Total population growth (decrease) and growth rate

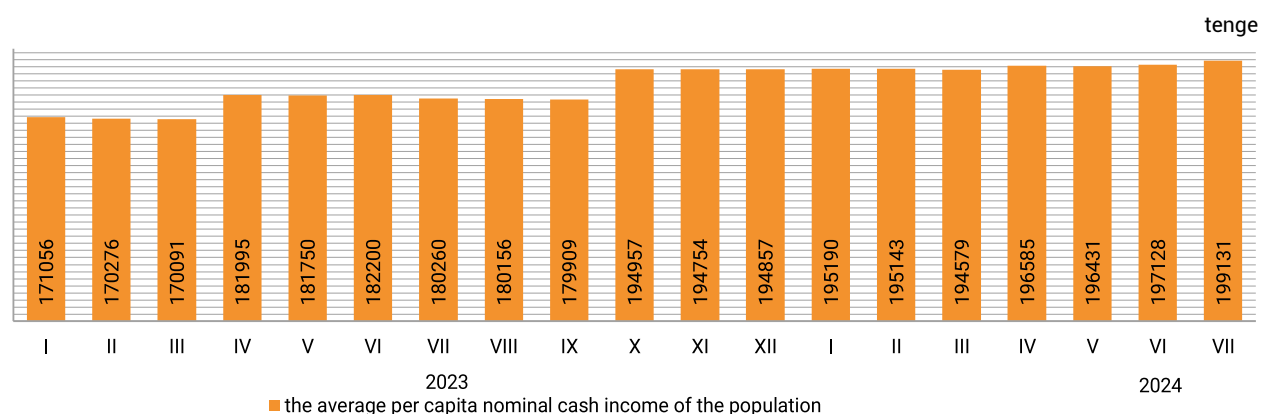

Income of the population

The average per capita nominal cash income of the population, according to an estimate in July 2024, amounted to 199131 tenge (preliminary data), which is 10.5% higher than in July 2023, real cash income for the specified period increased by 1.7%.

Employment of the population

The number of unemployed, determined according to the methodology of the ILO, in the II quarter¹⁾ of 2024 amounted to 451 thousand people, the unemployment rate was 4.7%.

The employed population²⁾ amounted to 9190.4 thousand people, including employees – 6971 thousand people, individual entrepreneurs – 1717 thousand people, persons engaged in private practice – 32.5 thousand people, individuals, who are founders (participants) of business partnerships and founders, shareholders (participants) of joint-stock companies, as well as members of production cooperatives – 14.9 thousand people, independent workers – 455 thousand people.

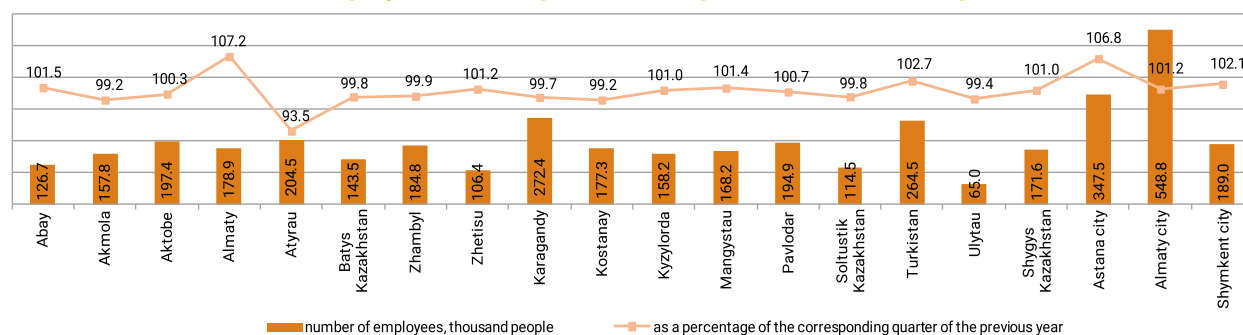

The number of employees at enterprises (organizations) in the II quarter of 2024³⁾ amounted to 3971.9 thousand people, of which at large and medium-sized enterprises – 2876.2 thousand people.

In the II quarter of 2024, 262.5 thousand people were hired by enterprises. 274.7 thousand people dropped out for various reasons. Worked by one employee 463.5 hours.

At the end of the II quarter of 2024, 55.8 thousand vacancies were not filled at enterprises (1.4% of the number of employees).

From January 1, 2024, the minimum wage is set at 85000 tenge.

2. Economic indicators

Statistics of prices

The consumer price index in August 2024 compared to July 2024 was 100.6%. Prices for paid services increased by 1.1%, non-food products – by 0.8%. The food price index was 100%.

In the housing and communal services sector, tariffs for gas, transported through distribution networks increased by 11.6%, for water disposal – by 1.6%, and for cold water – by 0.9%. City bus fares increased by 9.3%, and taxi fares – by 1.8%. An increase in prices for rental housing of 1.4% was noted.

Price increase for school backpack in August this year amounted to 4.7%, children's clothing – by 1.8%, children's footwear – by 1.3%, accessories – by 1.1%. Liquefied gas in cylinders increased in price by 1.7%.

Among food products, prices for oranges increased by 4.2%, sunflower oil, cabbage – by 2.2% each, onions – by 1.9%. A decrease in prices was noted for grapes by 10%, sweet peppers – by 8.6%, tomatoes – by 7.8%, cucumbers – by 6.1%, buckwheat – by 3.6%, beets – by 3.2%.

In August 2024, compared with the previous month, the producer price index for agricultural products was 99.6%. Prices for crop production decreased by 0.4%, livestock products – by 0.5%.

Prices for dried lentils increased by 2.4%, soy beans – by 0.9%, flax seeds – by 0.6%, and for barley – decreased by 1.2%, durum wheat – by 1%, wheat, except durum wheat – by 0.9%. There is an increase in prices for tomatoes of the closed ground by 4.5%, stone fruits – by 1.5%, potatoes – by 0.4%, and a decrease in prices for cucumbers of the closed ground by 3.8%, peppers – by 1.2%, hay – by 0.6%.

Natural honey increased in price by 0.7%, horses – by 0.5%, raw cow's milk – by 0.4%, sheeps – by 0.3%, and chicken eggs decreased in price by 4.5%, pigs – by 0.4%, cattle – by 0.2%.

Prices of manufacturing enterprises for industrial products in August 2024 increased by 1.2% compared to the previous month. Oil prices were higher by 2.2%, coal – by 0.2%, metal ores – lower by 0.6%. Of petroleum products, propane and butane liquefied rose by 4.2%.

An increase in prices was noted for precious metals by 3.1%, ferroalloys – by 0.8%, rolled ferrous metals – by 0.4%, for zinc – a decrease by 5.8%, aluminum – by 3.2%, lead – by 0.7%.

From food products, vegetable oil rose by 2.3%, wheat flour – by 0.9%, pasta – by 0.2%, sugar – fell by 0.4%.

In the service sector, tariffs for the transportation of goods by all types of transportation in August 2024 increased by 0.6% compared to the previous month, communication services and tariffs for postal and courier services remained unchanged.

In August 2024 compared to the previous month the price index in construction amounted to 100.2%, for construction and installation work – 100.2%, machinery and equipment – 100.3%, other work and costs – 99.7%.

The short-term economic indicator for January–August 2024 compared to January–August 2023 amounted to 104,4%. The calculation of the short-term economic indicator is carried out to ensure efficiency and is based on changes in output indices for basic sectors: agriculture, industry, construction, trade, transport and communications, accounting for over 60% of GDP.

Gross Domestic Product

In the structure of GDP for January-June 2024, flash estimates, the production of goods amounted to 36,2%, the production of services – 56,7%. The main share in the production of GDP is occupied by industry – 28,6%, wholesale and retail trade; repair of cars and motorcycles – 16,1%.

Investment statistics

In January-August 2024, the volume of investments in fixed capital amounted to 9764.8 billion tenge, which is 0.1% more than in January-August 2023.

The predominant sources of investment financing remain the own funds of economic entities, the volume of which in January-August 2024 amounted to 6621.5 billion tenge.

In January-August 2024, compared with January-August 2023, there is an increase costs for the purchase of machinery, equipment and vehicles and their capital repairs and costs for works on construction and capital repair of buildings and constructions by 6.7%.

A significant share of investments in fixed capital in January-August 2024 accounted for mining and quarrying (22%), operations with real estate (20%), transport and warehousing (18%) and manufacturing industry (9.5%).

The volume of investments of large enterprises in January-August 2024 amounted to 3311 billion tenge.

Statistics of domestic trade

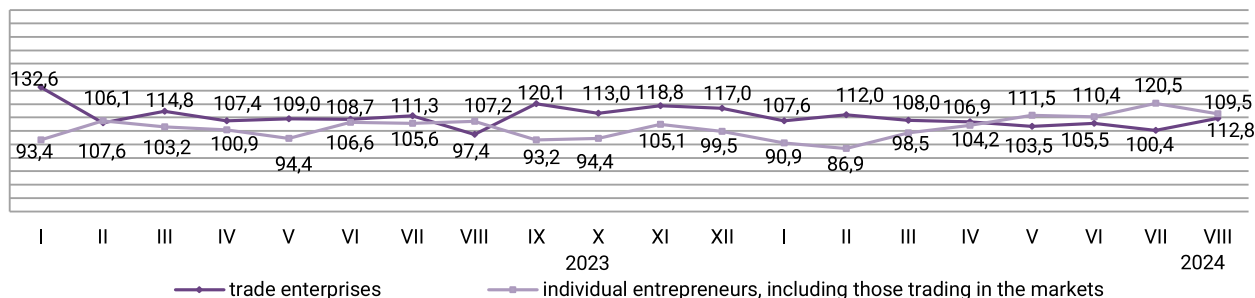
The volume of retail trade in January-August 2024 amounted to 12731.9 billion tenge, which is 6.8% more than the corresponding period in 2023. Retail sales of goods by trading enterprises increased by 6.9%, individual entrepreneurs, including those trading in the markets, decreased by 6.5% compared to January-August 2023.

As of September 1, 2024, the volume of commodity stocks of trading enterprises (for reporting enterprises) in retail trade amounted to 1543.8 billion tenge, in trading days - 62 days.

The share of food products in the total volume of retail trade is 31.9%, non-food products – 68.1%. The volume of sales of food products compared to January-August 2023 increased by 8.7%, non-food products increased by 5.9%.

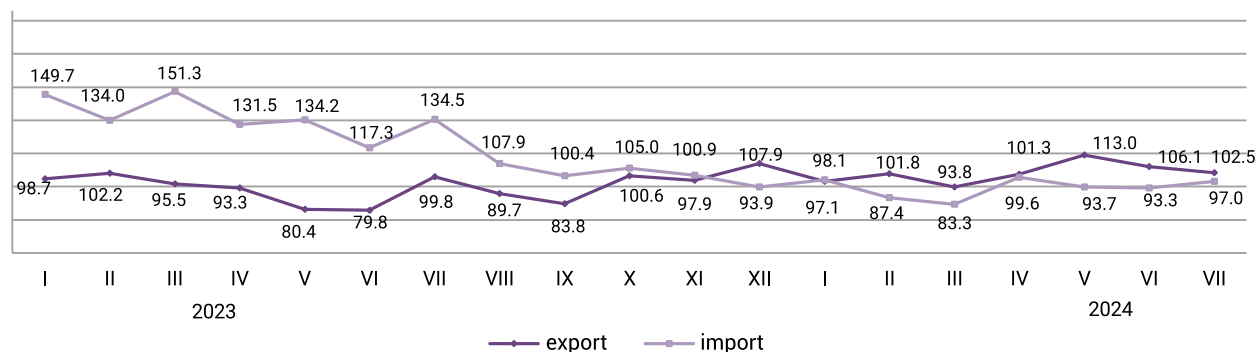

Foreign trade turnover in January–July 2024 amounted to 79 billion US dollars (less by 1.8% in nominal terms compared to January–July 2023), including exports–46.1 billion US dollars (2.2% more) and imports – 32.8 billion US dollars (less by 6.9%).

Exports with the EAEU countries amounted to 5737.6 million US dollars, or 15.9% less than in January–July 2023. Imports – 10061.4 million US dollars, decreased by 4% compared to the corresponding period last year.

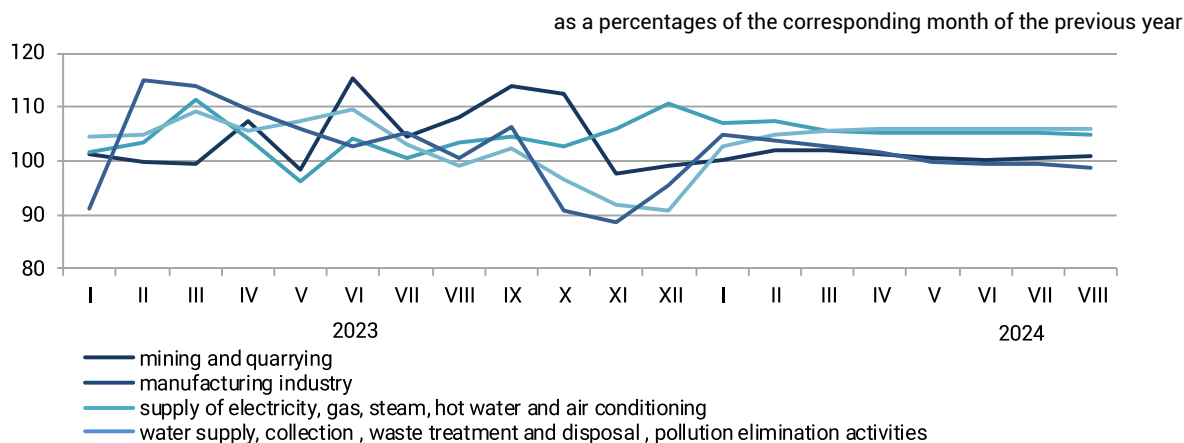

Statistics of building and housing construction

In January-August 2024, the volume of construction work increased by 8.8% and amounted to 3996.8 billion tenge.

The largest amount of work in January-August 2024 was performed on the construction of facilities (1968.2 billion tenge), non-residential buildings (1339.1 billion tenge) and residential buildings (689.4 billion tenge).

The volume of construction and installation work in January-August 2024 compared to January-August 2023 increased by 8.5% and amounted to 3380.9 billion tenge. The volume of construction work on major repairs increased by 7.2% and on current repairs by 13.2%.

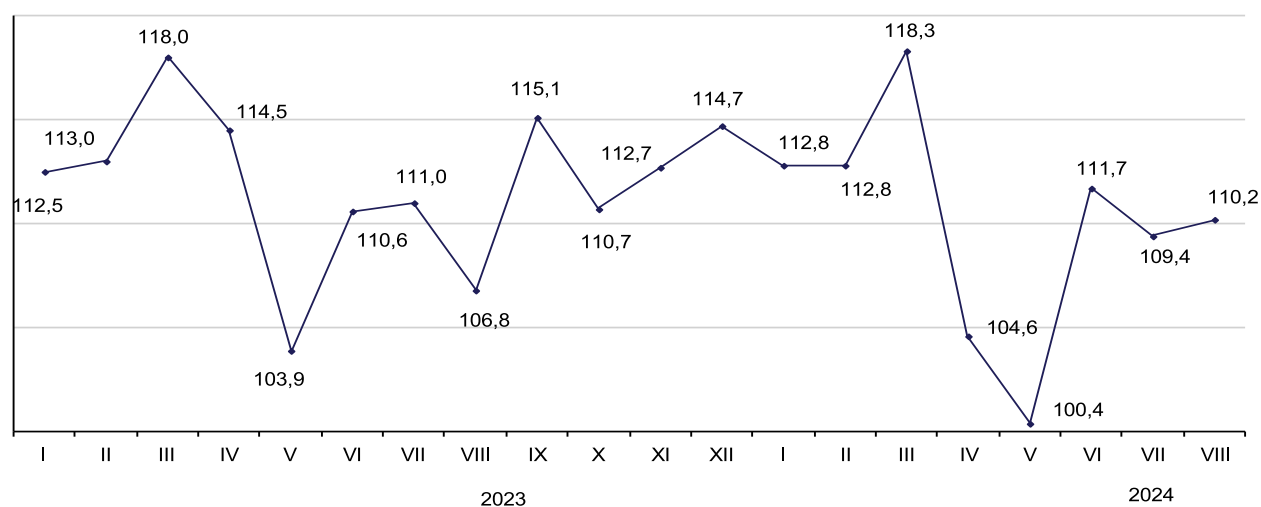
In January-August 2024, the construction of 23172 new buildings was completed, of which 21943 are residential and 1229 are non-residential.

as a percentages of the corresponding month of the previous year



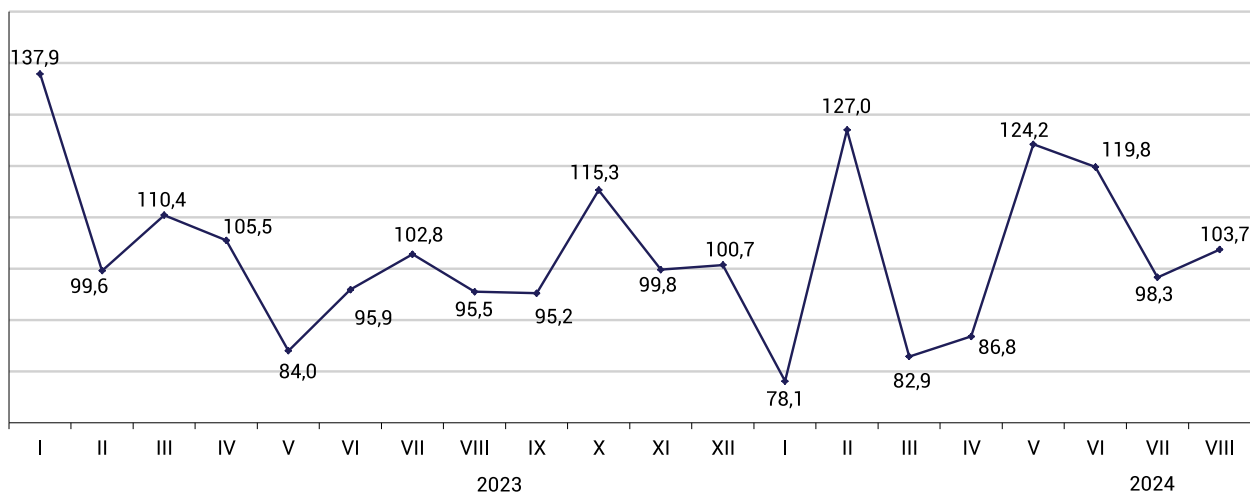

In January-August 2024, 1866.7 billion tenge was allocated for housing construction. In the total volume of investments in fixed capital, the share of disbursed funds in housing construction amounted to 19.1%.

The main source of financing for housing construction in January-August 2024 is the own funds of developers, the share of which is 87.2%.

as a percentages of the corresponding month of the previous year

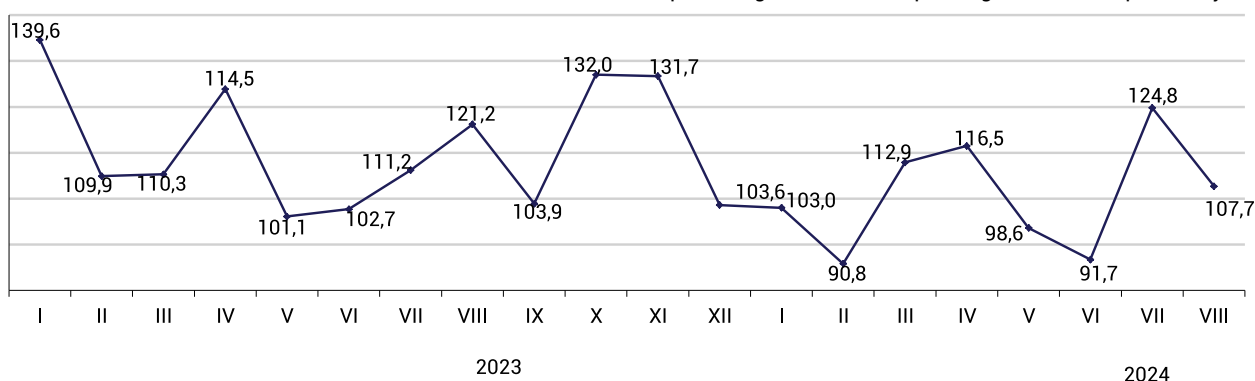


In January-August 2024, the total area of housing put into operation to January- August 2023 increased by 4.7% and amounted to 10464 thousand square meters, of which in multi-apartment buildings - by 11.1% (6519.3 thousand square meters). At the same time, the total area of individual residential buildings put into operation decreased by 4.6% (3886.9 thousand square meters).

In the total volume of commissioned housing, the share of multi-apartment buildings was 62.3%, individual - 37.1%. The average actual cost of construction of 1 square meter of total housing area increased by 2.6%.

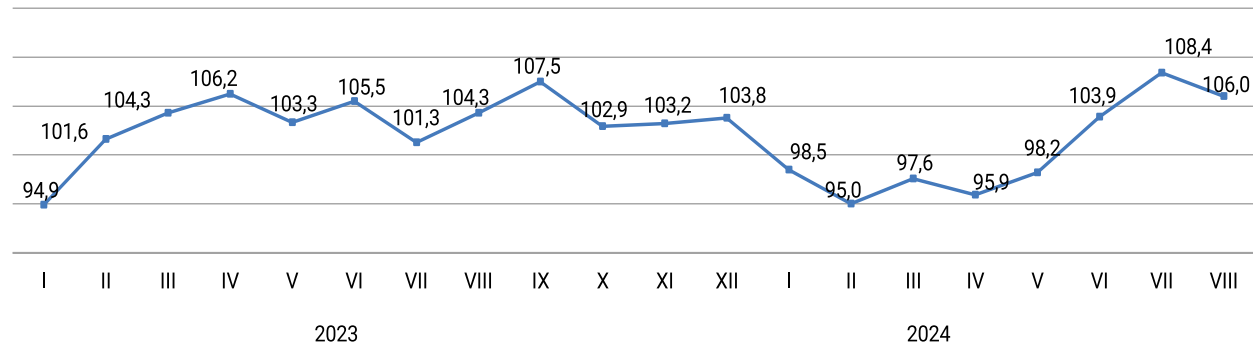

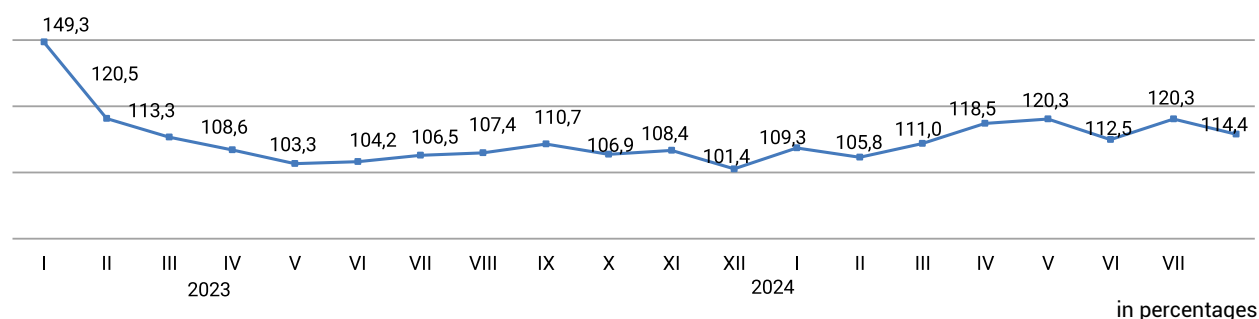

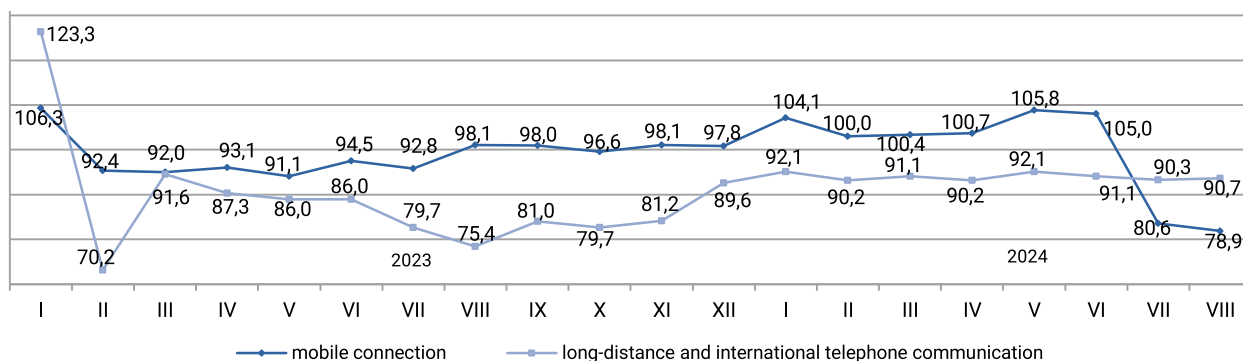
