1. Social indicators

Population size and migration

The population of the country as of April 1, 2024 amounted to 20096 thousand people, including urban – 12513 thousand (62.3%), rural – 7583 thousand (37.7%) people.


In January-March 2024, compared to January-March 2023, the number of arrivals in Kazakhstan decreased by 2.7%, the number of departures from Kazakhstan increased by 42.1%.

The main migration exchange of the country takes place with the CIS countries. The share of arrivals from the CIS countries and departures to these countries amounted to 75.6% and 74.7%, respectively.

The number of migrants moving within the country increased by 120.1%. In terms of interregional movements, a positive net migration of population has developed in 4 regions of the country: the cities of Astana (15390 people), Almaty (9187 people), Shymkent (3536 people) and in Almaty region (168 people).



Income of the population

The average per capita nominal cash income of the population, according to an estimate in March 2024, amounted to 192965 tenge (preliminary data), which is 13.4% higher than in March 2023 real cash income for the specified period increased by 3.9%.


Employment of the population

The number of employees at enterprises (organizations) in the I quarter of 2024³⁾ amounted to 3975.6 thousand people, of which at large and medium-sized enterprises – 2889.4 thousand people.

In the I quarter of 2024, 281.0 thousand people were hired by enterprises. 274.2 thousand people dropped out for various reasons. Worked by one employee 452.7 hours.

At the end of the I quarter of 2024, 57.4 thousand vacancies were not filled at enterprises (1.4% of the number of employees).

The number of unemployed, determined according to the methodology of the ILO, in the I quarter¹⁾ of 2024 amounted to 452.7 thousand people, the unemployment rate was 4.7%.

The employed population²⁾ amounted to 9167.3 thousand people, including employees – 6981.4 thousand people, individual entrepreneurs – 1666.0 thousand people, persons engaged in private practice – 32.7 thousand people, individuals, who are founders (participants) of business partnerships and founders, shareholders (participants) of joint-stock companies, as well as members of production cooperatives – 13.0 thousand people, independent workers – 474.2 thousand people.

From January 1, 2024, the minimum wage is set at 85000 tenge.

2. Economic indicators

Statistics of prices

The consumer price index in April 2024 compared to March 2024 was 100.6%. Prices for non-food products and paid services increased by 0.7%, food products - by 0.3%.

Price increase in April of this year marked on the TV by 26.9%, ironing board – by 9%, iron – by 6.2%. Level price for clothing and footwear increased by 0.9%, medicines, personal goods – 0.8% each.

In the field of housing and communal services, tariffs for electricity increased by 2.3%, water disposal - by 1.1%, payment for housing maintenance - by 1.6%. Bathhouse services increased in price by 2.8%, healthcare – by 1.4%, hairdressing and beauty salons – by 1.2%.

Among food products, price increases were observed for carrots by 4.9%, cabbage – by 4.2%, apples – by 3.3%, grapes – by 2.5%. Prices for granulated sugar increased by 3.7%, confectionery products - by 2.8%, mineral and drinking water - by 2.5%, butter - by 1.1%. Cucumbers fell in price by 16.3%, onions - by 10%, tomatoes - by 4.3%, eggs - by 3.2%, sunflower oil - by 2.9%, buckwheat - by 2.8%.

In April 2024, compared to the previous month, the producer price index for agricultural products, including crop products and livestock products amounted – 99.7%.

Prices for sunflower seeds decreased by 1.3%, buckwheat – by 0.6%, rape seeds – by 0.4%, wheat – by 0.2%, and for flax seeds – increased by 1%. Cucumbers of the closed ground fell in price by 7.6%, potato – by 3%, bulb onions – by 2.3%, tomatoes of the closed ground– by 1.3%, cabbage by – 0.7%, and table carrot rose in price by 1.2%, beet – by 0.4%.

Chicken eggs fell in price by 6.3%, pigs – by 0.8%, and natural honey rose in price by 3.4%, poultry meat – by 1.5%, sheeps –by 0.9%, cattle – by 0.6%, horses – by 0.5%.

Prices of manufacturing enterprises for industrial products in April 2024 increased by 0.6% compared to the previous month. Oil prices were higher by 0.8%, metal ores – lower by 2.4%, coal - by 0.3%, natural gas – by 0.2%. Of petroleum products, fuel oil rose by 0.9%, propane and butane liquefied fell by 3.4%, diesel fuel - by 2.1%. An increase in prices was noted for zinc by 5.3%, precious metals – by 3.9%, copper – by 3.7%, aluminum – by 1.7%, ferroalloys – by 0.8%, for lead – a decrease by 2.2%. From food products, sugar rose by 1.6%, poultry meat – by 1.4%, rye flour fell by 3.5%, cereals – by 1.3%, vegetable oil – by 0.6%, dairy products – by 0.5%.

In the service sector, tariffs for the cargo transportation by all types of transport and postal, courier services in April 2024 increased as compared to the previous by 0.1%, tariffs for communication services remained unchanged.

In April 2024 compared to the previous month the prices index in construction for construction and installation work amounted 100.1%, for machinery and equipment – 101.3%, for other work and costs – 100%.

Gross Domestic Product

In the structure of GDP for January-March 2024, flash estimates, the production of goods amounted to 35,5%, the production of services - 57,4%. The main share in the production of GDP is occupied by industry – 28,8%, wholesale and retail trade; repair of cars and motorcycles – 16,6%.

Investment statistics

January-April 2024, the volume of investments in fixed capital amounted to 3741.6 billion tenge, which is 5.3% less than in January-April 2023.

The predominant sources of investment financing remain the own funds of economic entities, the volume of which in January-April 2024 amounted to 2855.6 billion tenge.

In January-April 2024, compared with January-April 2023, there is an increase costs for the purchase of machinery, equipment and vehicles and their capital repairs by 20.1%.

A significant share of investments in fixed capital in January-April 2024 accounted for mining and quarrying (27.7%), operations with real estate (21.3%), transport and warehousing (14.6%) and manufacturing industry (10.8%).

The volume of investments of large enterprises in January-April 2024 amounted to 1454.5 billion tenge.

Statistics of domestic trade


The volume of retail trade in January-April 2024 amounted to 5407,8 billion tenge, which is 5.2% more than the corresponding period in 2023. Retail sales of goods by trading enterprises increased by 8.6%, individual entrepreneurs, including those trading in the markets, decreased by 4.5% compared to January-April 2023.

As of May 1, 2024, the volume of commodity stocks of trading enterprises (for reporting enterprises) in retail trade amounted to 1554.2 billion tenge, in trading days - 75 days.

The share of food products in the total volume of retail trade is 29.1%, non-food products – 70.9%. The volume of sales of food products compared to January-April 2023 increased by 7%, non-food products increased by 4.6%.

The volume of wholesale trade in January-April 2024 amounted to 11786,4 billion tenge, which is 1% more than the corresponding period in 2023. Non-food products and industrial and technical products (79.2%) prevail in the structure of wholesale trade.



Foreign trade turnover in January-March 2024 amounted to 31.2 billion US dollars (less by 5.6% in nominal terms compared to January-March 2023), including exports – 18.5 billion US dollars (1.9% less) and imports – 12.7 billion US dollars (less by 10.6%).

Exports with the EAEU countries amounted to 2121.9 million US dollars, or 23.6% less than in January-March 2023, imports – 3993 million US dollars, decreased by 5.1% compared to the corresponding period last year.



Statistics of building and housing construction

In January-April 2024, the volume of construction work increased by 12.2% and amounted to 1217.5 billion tenge.

The largest amount of work in January-April 2024 was performed on the construction of facilities (536.9 billion tenge), non-residential buildings (460.3 billion tenge) and residential buildings (220.3 billion tenge).

The volume of construction and installation work in January-April 2024 compared to January-April 2023 increased by 11.4% and amounted to 1070.8 billion tenge. The volume of construction work on major repairs increased by 14.2% and on current repairs by 25.1%.


In January-April 2024, the construction of 9448 new buildings was completed, of which 8853 are residential and 595 are non-residential.

as a percentage of the corresponding month of the previous year





In January-April 2024, 761.2 billion tenge was allocated for housing construction. In the total volume of investments in fixed capital, the share of disbursed funds in housing construction amounted to 20.3%.

The main source of financing for housing construction in January-April 2024 is the own funds of developers, the share of which is 89.9%.

as a percentages of the corresponding month of the previous year




January-April 2024, the total area of housing put into operation increased by 5.6% and amounted to 4572.1 thousand square meters, of which in individual residential buildings - by 18.8% (2940.4 thousand square meters). At the same time, the total area of multi-apartment buildings put into operation decreased by 11.9% (1606.8 thousand square meters).

In the total volume of commissioned housing, the share of multi-apartment buildings was 64.3%, individual - 35.1%. The average actual cost of construction of 1 square meter of total housing area increased by 0.2%.






