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S. 2 Introduction-Relevance

The main purpose of the System of National Accounts (hereinafter - SNA) is to provide a comprehensive conceptual framework and accounting structure that could be used to create a macroeconomic database suitable for analyzing and assessing the performance of the economy. The presence of such a database is a prerequisite for formulating sound and rational policies and making appropriate decisions. Gross Regional Product (hereinafter - GRP) is the final result of the production activity of resident manufacturing units of a particular region, for a certain period of time and calculated in market prices. Due to the fact that there is no information base for the implementation of full-fledged calculations at the regional level of all components of final use and distribution, the GRP is calculated by the production method. Regional accounts data are required for both territorial and central government bodies of any country. At present, the relevance of the formation of GRP is due to the need to develop a regional statistical system by expanding the corresponding information base, the data of which is used both for scientific and applied research and development, as well as for modeling economic processes carried out by scientific and educational institutions and other organizations studying the economic the situation in the regions.

The main users are government bodies such as the Ministry of National Economy and the Republic of Kazakhstan, regional akimats, territorial departments of the Bureau of National Statistics of the Agency for Strategic Planning and Reforms of the Republic of Kazakhstan, local government bodies and research institutes.

S.4 Presentation of statistical information

S.4.1 Data description

GRP, calculated by the production method for 17 regions of the Republic of Kazakhstan, is the difference between the output of goods and services as a whole, on the one hand, and intermediate consumption, on the other, or as the sum of the added values created in the sectors of the economy of each region. The calculation of GRP by the production method is carried out according to the following formula:

$$\text{GRP} = \text{GVA} + \text{NT}$$

$$\text{GVA} = (\text{Out} - \text{IC})$$

Where:

GRP - GRP;

GVA - Gross value added of the industry, million tenge;

Out - Gross output of the industry, million tenge;

IC - Intermediate consumption of the industry, million tenge;

NT - Net taxes on production and imports.

GRP by the production method is formed at current and constant prices by type of economic activity. Gross value added (hereinafter - GVA) is calculated as the difference between the output of goods and services and intermediate consumption (hereinafter - PP).

GRP calculations are carried out by a top-down approach, this approach is to distribute data on the economy as a whole between regions in accordance with indirect indicators characterizing the types of economic activities of the regions. To distribute the Gross Domestic Product (hereinafter referred to as GDP), statistical data from industry and structural statistics in the regional context are used. The gross output (hereinafter - BB) of the SNA, formed in the economy as a whole, taking into account adjustments and adjustments for the non-observed economy, is distributed in accordance with sectoral outputs for each type of activity in the context of regions. An example of the distribution of GDP by region is shown in Table 1.

The source of information for calculating intermediate consumption are the statistical forms "Report on the financial and economic activities of the enterprise" (index 1-PF) and "Report on the activities of a small enterprise" (index 2-MP). Based on these forms, the share of intermediate consumption in gross output for each industry in the context of regions is calculated. The sources of information are the data of the branch departments Bureau of National Statistics of the Agency for Strategic Planning and Reforms of the Republic of Kazakhstan and the state body (Ministry of Finance of the Republic of Kazakhstan).

GRP is calculated based on reported data on a quarterly and annual basis in the context of economic activities.

The system of national accounts is a logically consistent, harmonious and integral set of macroeconomic accounts, balance sheets of assets and liabilities, and tables, which is based on a number of internationally agreed concepts, definitions, classifications and accounting rules.

GRP is one of the most important indicators of the level of socio-economic development of the country's regions. This indicator is used in the formation of models for forecasting economic development.

Basic concepts with corresponding definitions according to SNA 2008:

Gross domestic product is one of the most important indicators of the system of national accounts, which characterizes the final result of a country's economic activity;

Gross output - represents the total value of goods and services produced in the economy in the reporting period;

Gross value added - characterizes the end result of production activities and represents the value added by processing in a given production process;
Intermediate consumption is equal to the value of goods and services that are transformed or completely consumed in the production process;
The volume index (hereinafter referred to as IFO) is a relative indicator characterizing the change in production volumes in the compared periods. It is calculated by dividing the value of a certain indicator in the current period, estimated in the prices of the reference period, by its value in the reference period;

Product taxes include taxes, the amount of which is directly related to the value of the products produced and the services provided. Product taxes include: value added tax, excise taxes, tax on imported goods and services, and others;
Subsidies for products - current uncompensated payments from the State budget to enterprises, provided that they produce a certain type of goods and services;
Net taxes on products are taxes less related subsidies.

The reason for the postponement of the publication date: Service note No. 36-01 / 380-VN of July 30, 2019 and service note No. 36-2-17 / 287-VN of August 27, 2019 on the postponement of the publication date from August 22 to September 27, 2019 of the Bulletin "Gross Regional Product of the Republic of Kazakhstan for 2018" in connection with the calculations of GDP and the corresponding retrospective recalculation in accordance with the new Methodology for assessing the non-observed economy, approved by order of the Chairman of the Bureau of National Statistics of the Agency for Strategic Planning and Reforms of the Republic of Kazakhstan dated August 7, 2019 No. 4. Registered with the Ministry of Justice of the Republic of Kazakhstan on August 8, 2019 No. 19215. From the 1st half of 2018, the calculation of the "Gross Regional Product of the Republic of Kazakhstan" has been made for 17 regions on the basis of the President's signing of the decree "On some issues of the administrative and territorial structure of the Republic of Kazakhstan" dated July 19, 2018 No. 702, on the classification of the city of Shymkent to the category of republican significance and renaming the South Kazakhstan region into the Turkestan region with the administrative center of the city of Turkestan.
