

## Brief results of the 2025 Agricultural Census by coverage indicators and participation formats

The results on the coverage and formats of participation in the National Agricultural Census 2025 (hereinafter referred to as NACC 2025) are published in order to inform government agencies, businesses and society about the scale of the statistical survey conducted, the level of respondent involvement and the data collection channels used.

The National Agricultural Census 2025 was conducted in accordance with the instructions of the Head of State and the decision of the Government of the Republic of Kazakhstan, as well as international recommendations of the UN FAO, and is a key element in the formation of a relevant and comparable statistical base for the agricultural sector.

It should be noted that the 2025 Agricultural Census is the second national agricultural census in Kazakhstan, the previous census was conducted in 2006–2007 (hereinafter referred to as the 2006/07 Agricultural Census).

The census was conducted from August 1 to October 20, 2025, throughout the Republic of Kazakhstan. However, private farms were not surveyed in cities of national significance and regional centers; therefore, these areas were excluded from this component of the census.

Data collection was conducted using a combined method. From August 1 to 31, 2025, online self-completion was conducted via a digital platform, with 91.3% of agricultural enterprises and 19.3% of private farms participating. From September 20 to October 20, 2025, data collection was conducted through in-person interviews with respondents by census personnel.

Overall, the proportion of respondents surveyed was 97.2% among organized farms and 96.9% among private subsidiary farms, which indicates a high level of coverage and ensures the representativeness of the data for the subsequent formation of statistical results of the census.

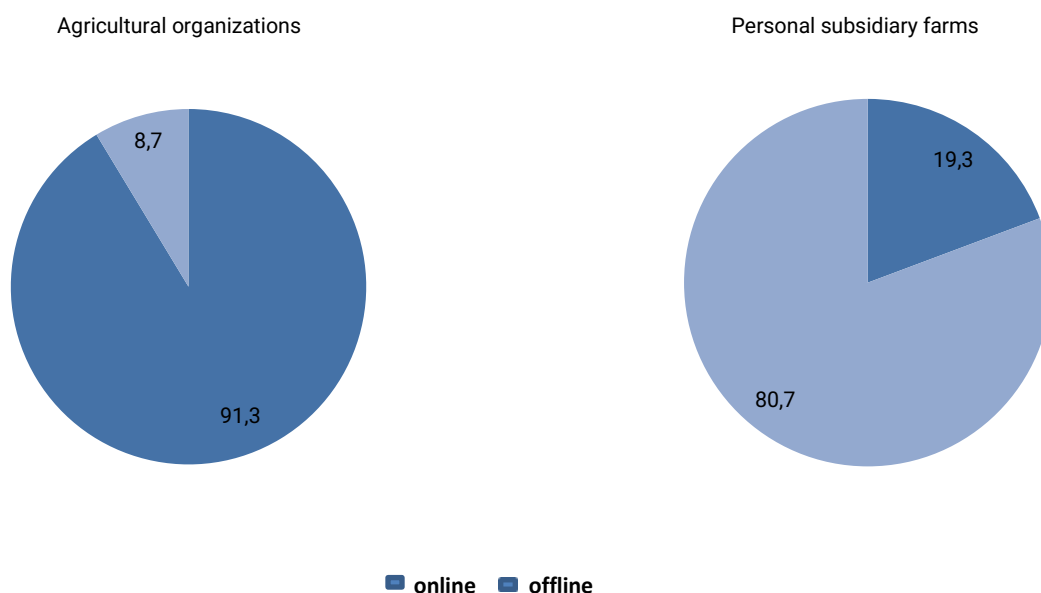
The obtained results indicate significant structural changes in agriculture during the intercensal period and a shift towards organized forms of activity.

The number of private household plots (PHP) decreased by 31% – from 2 191.3 thousand to 1 502.0 thousand, which reflects the continued trend of a declining role of PHP in agricultural production.

The number of agricultural enterprises increased more than 2.2 times – from 9.5 thousand to 20.9 thousand, while the number of peasant (farm) households and individual entrepreneurs (PFH/IE) increased by 38% – from 194.3 thousand to 268.3 thousand.

The recorded structural changes reflect the growing role of enterprises and peasant farms/individual entrepreneurs in ensuring the sustainability of the agricultural sector.

The results of online participation among agricultural organizations confirm a high level of digital engagement in the agricultural sector.

The main results of the census, including detailed data on the structure of agriculture, land use, crop production, livestock production, material and technical resources, labor resources, and other characteristics of the agricultural sector, will be presented in 2026 in an expanded analytical format.

The results will be published in the form of an interactive dashboard, data tables, and a PDF collection with details by farm category and administrative-territorial unit (region/district/rural district).
